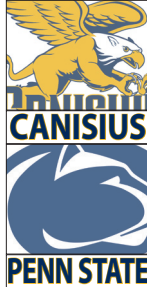

GRIFFS OPEN 2015-16 SEASON VERSUS PENN STATE

The Canisius College hockey team begins the 2015-16 campaign with a home game against Big Ten foe Penn State at HARBORCENTER. The schools open the season on Saturday at 7:35 p.m.

SCOUTING THE GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius went 18-12-7 record last season and placed second in the AHC standings (15-7-6 record) – matching the program's best finish.
- ▶ The Griffis advanced to Atlantic Hockey Championship weekend for the third-straight season, falling, 2-1, to RIT in the semifinals.
- ▶ Senior **Ralph Cuddemi** returns after leading the team in points (32) and goals (22). His 22 tallies were one shy of the school record.
- ▶ Sophomore **Reilly Turner** is the only Canisius netminder with collegiate experience, posting a 2.54 goals against average and .915 save percentage in 13 games last season.

EXHIBITION RECAP

- ▶ The Griffis began the 2015-16 season with an exhibition game versus Ontario Institute of Technology on Sunday, falling 4-2.
- ▶ Senior **Ralph Cuddemi** and freshman **Josh Supryka** each netted goals for Canisius.
- ▶ Sophomore **Reilly Turner** took the loss in net, stopping 10-of-14 shots, while freshman **Simon Hofley** stopped all four shots.
- ▶ Canisius outshot the Ridgebacks, 38-18, in the loss.

CANISIUS IN SEASON OPENERS

- ▶ The Griffis are set to begin their 36th season of play and their 18th year at the Division I level on Saturday.
- ▶ Canisius is 11-20-4 all-time in season openers and 5-10-2 at the Division I level, including a 4-6-0 mark with **Dave Smith** as head coach.
- ▶ The Griffis are unbeaten (4-0-1) in their last five home openers.
- ▶ Last season, the Griffis ended a three-game losing streak in openers with a 4-2 home victory against Western Michigan.

HOME SWEET HOME

- ▶ The Griffis are beginning their second season at HARBORCENTER on Saturday – a \$172 million facility in downtown Buffalo.
- ▶ Canisius finished its inaugural year 9-4-5 at HARBORCENTER, including an 8-1-2 mark in its last 11 home games.

KEY GRIFFS NUMBERS

0 The Griffis have never defeated a Big Ten school, going 0-6-1 in seven meetings.

2 Canisius matched its best regular-season finish in school history with a second-place AHC finish last season.

2.24 Canisius posted a school-record low scoring defense of 2.24 goals per game last season.

4 The Griffis were picked fourth in the AHC Preseason Poll.

5 Canisius is unbeaten in its last five home openers (4-0-1).

12 The Canisius roster features 12 freshmen this season – only three schools have more.

16 Ralph Cuddemi has netted 16 power-play goals during his career – tied for the third most among active players.

35 Canisius is the only Atlantic Hockey school to return two players with at least 35 points last season (Shane Conacher and Ralph Cuddemi).

CANISIUS - PENN STATE SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ The schools are meeting for the first time as Division I programs.
- ▶ Canisius did play Penn State eight times from 1981 to 1995 when the Griffins were a Division III program and the Nittany Lions were a club team with Canisius winning six of the eight meetings.

GRIFFS VERSUS BIG TEN TEAMS

- ▶ In its third year of a hockey conference, Canisius has played three of the six teams in the Big Ten.
- ▶ Canisius remains in search of its first victory against a Big Ten school, going 0-6-1 all-time against conference teams. The Griffins are 0-1-0 against Minnesota, 0-3-1 versus Ohio State and 0-2-0 against Wisconsin.
- ▶ The lone result for Canisius against a Big Ten school was a 3-3 draw versus Ohio State in the HARBORCENTER opener last season.

ABOUT THE NITTANY LIONS

- ▶ Penn State is coming off an 18-15-4 season, falling in the Big Ten Quarterfinals to Ohio State.
- ▶ The team averaged 3.22 goals per game last year, while allowing 3.05 tallies per game.
- ▶ The Nittany Lions lost two of their top three scorers from a season ago, returning David Goodwin, who totaled 34 points, 15 goals and 19 assists last year.
- ▶ The team also returns two goalies who saw action during the 2014-15 campaign in Matthew Skoff (2.81 gaa / .907 save pct.) and Eamon McAdam (3.13 gaa / .910 save pct.).

A NEW LOOK GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius will have a new look during the 2015-16 campaign as the Griffins lost 11 letterwinners following the 2014-15 season.
- ▶ The Griffins graduated the second-largest senior class in the country last season, while both netminder Keegan Asmundson and Chris Rumble leaving with a year of eligibility remaining.
- ▶ Overall, nine of the team's top 13 scorers plus its all-conference netminder will no longer skate for the Griffins.

QUALITY OVER QUANTITY

- ▶ While the numbers returning are low, the quality of returnees is high.
- ▶ The Griffins return their top two scorers from a season ago in senior **Ralph Cuddemi** and junior **Shane Conacher**. Cuddemi led the team in points (39), goals (22) and power-play goals (8), while Conacher ranked second with 37 points, including a Canisius-best 26 assists.
- ▶ Canisius is one of only two teams in Atlantic Hockey to return multiple players that posted more than 30 points a season ago and the only school in the conference to return a pair of players with at least 35 points each during the 2014-15 campaign.

TOP LINE OF SUCCESS

- ▶ Last year, the Griffins relied on its top line – consisting of **Shane Conacher**, **Ralph Cuddemi** and **Ryan Schmelzer** – to lead the way offensively for the team.
- ▶ The line contributed (scored or assisted) on 54 of the Griffins' 94 goals last season (57.4 percent).

SENIOR DISCOUNT

- ▶ The Canisius senior class consists of just **Mathew Backhouse** and **Ralph Cuddemi** this season.
- ▶ The Griffins are tied with Massachusetts for the smallest senior class in the country.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

- ▶ On the opposite end, the Griffins feature 12 freshmen on the roster this season. Only Arizona State (15), Colorado College (14) and Wisconsin (13) have larger rookie classes.
- ▶ Add in eight sophomores on the roster and 20 of the 25 Griffins are underclassmen this season. Mercyhurst and Wisconsin are the only two schools with a larger total of freshmen and sophomores – both with 22.

CUDDEMI NAMED TEAM CAPTAIN

- ▶ Senior **Ralph Cuddemi** was named the team's captain for the 2015-16 season.
- ▶ Cuddemi has appeared in 115 career games and is the team's active leader in points (81), goals (41) and assists (40).
- ▶ Junior **Geoff Fortman** will serve as the team's assistant captain this season.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

- ▶ The Griffins feature a number of players with family connections to the NHL.
- ▶ The father of **Daniel LaFontaine**, Pat, was inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame after a career with the New York Islanders, Buffalo Sabres and New York Rangers from 1983 to 1998.
- ▶ **Shane Conacher's** bother, Cory, has played with four teams in the NHL.
- ▶ In addition, **Nolan Sheeran** is the cousin of current NHL players Brendan Smith (Detroit) and Reilly Smith (Florida).

GRIFFS SLATED TO FINISH FOURTH

- ▶ Canisius was picked fourth in the annual preseason Atlantic Hockey coaches poll.
- ▶ The Griffis finished second in the regular-season standings last year before advancing to its third-straight semifinal in the conference tournament.

CUDDEMI EARNS PRESEASON HONORS

- ▶ Senior **Ralph Cuddemi** was named to the Atlantic Hockey Preseason All-Star Team, announced by the league's media association.
- ▶ A second-team all-conference selection a year ago, Cuddemi led the Griffis with 39 points, 22 goals and eight power-play tallies.

THE FINISHING TOUCH

- ▶ Senior **Ralph Cuddemi** has had a lot of success finding the back of the net during his career.
- ▶ Entering his final season, Cuddemi has tallied 41 career goals – ranking eighth in the program's Division I history. His 22 scores during the 2014-15 campaign are tied for the second most in the school's record book.
- ▶ Cuddemi is within striking distance of the program's all-time goals record, currently held by Cory Conacher with 62 tallies. If Cuddemi duplicates his season from a year ago, he will surpass Conacher's record by one.

POWERFUL FORCE

- ▶ One key to **Ralph Cuddemi's** ability to score goals is his success on the power play.
- ▶ Cuddemi enters his senior campaign with 16 career goals with the extra-man advantage – tied for the third most among active players. Only Bentley's Andrew Gladiuk (27) and Quinnipiac's Sam Anas (19) have more power-play goals among active players in the country.
- ▶ Last season, Cuddemi ranked eighth nationally with eight power-play tallies.

ANYTHING YOU CAN DO, I CAN DO BETTER

- ▶ Junior **Shane Conacher** has a big name to live up to as his brother, **Cory Conacher**, is the program's all-time leading scorer and played with four NHL teams.
- ▶ The good news for younger brother Shane is he ahead of the pace set by his record-setting brother.
- ▶ Shane has 60 career points, while Cory had 52 at this point in his career.
- ▶ Cory finished his career with a program-best 147 points and 62 goals.

A PLUS IN SCHMELZER

- ▶ The third piece of the Griffis' top line from a season ago is sophomore **Ryan Schmelzer**.
- ▶ During his rookie campaign, Schmelzer centered the line between **Shane Conacher** and **Ralph Cuddemi** and finished with a plus/minus rating of +15 – the highest-mark since the program joined Atlantic Hockey in 2003.
- ▶ Schmelzer also contributed 14 points, five goals and nine assists on the offensive end.

GRIFFS LOOK TO CONTINUE DEFENSIVE TREND

- ▶ The key to Canisius' 2014-15 campaign was keeping the puck out of its own net.
- ▶ The Griffis set a school record by allowing only 2.24 goals per game. Canisius ranked first in Atlantic Hockey and 11th nationally in scoring defense.

What is a Griffin?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

GRIFFS TURN TO TURNER IN NET

- ▶ Sophomore **Reilly Turner** enters the 2015-16 season as the team's number one netminder and looks to build on a strong freshman campaign.
- ▶ In 13 appearances and 11 starts as a rookie, Turner posted a 2.54 goals against average and .915 save percentage – posting some of the best numbers by a Canisius rookie in program history.
- ▶ Among all rookie goalies with at least five starts, Turner registered the best goals against average in school history, while his save percentage was bested only by Tony Capobianco (.922) and Dan Giffin (.920).

GET TO TURNER EARLY

- ▶ If last season was a lesson and an opponent has hopes of beating **Reilly Turner** in net, they better plan on scoring in the first period against him.
- ▶ In the opening frame, Turner owned a 5.05 goals against average and .842 save percentage.
- ▶ However, following the first intermission, Turner posted a 1.40 goals against average and .951 save percentage.

Dave Smith

Head Coach • 10th Season • The Ohio State University '92

Taking the Canisius College hockey team to new heights during his career, Dave Smith is in his 11th season as head coach of the Golden Griffin program.

Smith has enjoyed a number of memorable moments during his coaching tenure and has continued to raise the bar while leading the Canisius program. Most recently, Smith has led the Griffs to three-straight trips to Atlantic Hockey

Championship weekend for the first time in school history, including consecutive appearances in the title game and the team's first crown in 2013. The program has also received national attention with its graduates having unprecedented success at the professional level.

During the 2012-13 campaign, Smith guided Canisius to the program's first conference title with a 7-2 victory in the Atlantic Hockey Championship against Mercyhurst and the team's first appearance in the NCAA Division I Tournament. The Griffs also finished the campaign ranked 19th in the final USCHO.com national poll, marking the program's highest finish in the national rankings.

Canisius nearly duplicated the remarkable feat the following two seasons, advancing to the 2014 Atlantic Hockey title game after again eliminating the top two seeds in the conference tournament before earning a second-place finish in 2015 – matching the program's best regular-season finish – and making a third-straight trip to the semifinals.

Away from campus, 2011 graduate Cory Conacher continued to make news at the highest level. Named one of the top 30 players at the Division I level in the last 10 seasons, Conacher became the first Griff to play in the National Hockey League and has enjoyed stints with the Tampa Bay Lightning, Ottawa Senators, Buffalo Sabres and New York Islanders. Conacher also became just the fourth player in AHL history to garner Most Valuable Player and Rookie of the Year accolades in the same season, helping lead the Norfolk Admirals to the 2012 Calder Cup just one year after graduating from Canisius and excelling under Smith's leadership.

The achievements under Smith are not limited to just the past three years. In his first 10 seasons leading the Golden Griffin program, he has guided numerous student-athletes to success both on and off the ice. The Griffs have collected athletic and academic honors as well as enjoying successful careers after graduation. The highlights include:

- A total of 31 Griffs have signed professional contracts after playing under Smith at Canisius, highlighted by Conacher and defender Carl Hudson inking NHL deals. Hudson became the first Griff to join an NHL franchise when he signed with the Florida Panthers after graduating in 2010.
- Smith has mentored three student-athletes who have earned individual postseason awards. Conacher highlights the honorees by being named the 2009-10 Atlantic Hockey Player of the Year, while David Kasch earned the league's Best Defensive Forward following the 2007-08 season and Dave Kostuch collected Rookie of the Year accolades in 2008-09.
- Nine Griffs earned all-conference accolades in the past seven seasons a total of 11 times, seven more than Canisius' first 10 seasons at the Division I level combined. Most recently, a school-record three Griffs earned All-Atlantic Hockey honors in 2014-15 when Chris Rumble collected first-team accolades, while Keegan Asmundson and Ralph Cuddemi were named to the second team.
- Canisius student-athletes have consistently ranked among the best in the country under Smith's leadership. Goaltender Tony Capobianco led all players in Division I with 1,256 saves during the 2012-13 campaign, which also ranks as the 12th-best total in NCAA history and the most since the 1988-89 season. Conacher ranked second nationally in points per game during the 2009-10 campaign after recording a program-record 53 points.
- The Griffs have enjoyed unparalleled success against some of the nation's top competition under Smith's watch. During the 2008-09 season, Canisius swept a pair of games against eventual NCAA quarterfinalist and 15th-ranked Air Force, marking the first victories for the Griffs against a nationally-ranked opponent, and has continued the trend with six wins against nationally-ranked schools, most recently against perennial-power Denver during the 2013-14 campaign.
- In his first 10 seasons, 170 Griffs have earned Atlantic Hockey All-Academic accolades, including a school-record 23 following the 2013-14 campaign. In addition, seven times a Griff was named the Atlantic Hockey Top Scholar Athlete for owning the top GPA in the league. The hockey program consistently owns the top GPA of any team at Canisius with a 3.52 cumulative mark following the 2014-15 academic year.
