QUICK HITS

- Penn State's 19 overall wins are the most under coach Patrick Chambers.
- By date, the 2017-18 team has won its 19th game earlier (2/15) than any other Nittany Lion team in the Big Ten era.

THON has raised more than \$147 million and helped more than 3,700 families.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

Penn State became the first Big Ten team to record a win in the 2017-18 season with a late afternoon tipoff time vs. Campbell.

With the Big Ten season-opening win at Iowa, Penn State had its first 1-0 start in conference play since the 2010-11 season.

The February 3 win over the Hawkeyes gave the Nittany Lions their first-ever sweep of Iowa.

THE WINS

Penn State has achieved 15 or more wins in five straight years -- a first for the Nittany Lion program. Prior to the 2013-17* seasons under Coach Patrick Chambers, the Nittany Lions had not previously reached at least 15 wins in four-consecutive seasons since joining the Big Ten Conference.

The Lions also have at least eight regular-season, nonconference wins in each of Chambers' seven seasons with 10 in 2017-18.

B1G WINS

With the February 3 Big Ten victory over Iowa, the 2017-18 Nittany Lions made another impact on Penn State's Big Ten basketball history. The sixth league win for coach Patrick Chambers gave the Nittany Lions a third-consecutive season with six or more Big Ten wins, accomplished only once before in seasons 1993-94, 1994-95 and 1995-96.

MBB LEADS BIG TEN; POSTS FIFTH-STRAIGHT YEAR WITH 100% GSR

Penn State student-athletes continue to graduate well above their peers nationwide, delivering a record-tying academic performance, according to data announced by the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA).

The NCAA's annual graduation rates study of institutions across the nation revealed Penn State student-athletes at the University Park campus earned a Graduation Success Rate (GSR) of 90 percent to tie the school's all-time record, previously set in the 2010 NCAA report. Nittany Lion students posted a 90 percent graduation rate compared to the 86 percent average for all Division I institutions for students entering from 2007-08 through the 2010-11 academic year.

The NCAA data revealed student-athletes from nine Penn State squads, including men's basketball, earned a Graduation Success Rate of 100 percent, an increase of two from last year's seven teams and up four from the 2015 total of five squads.

The men's basketball team had a perfect 100 percent GSR score for the fifth consecutive year and its graduation figure was 22 points higher than the Division I average (100 to 78 percent).

EARLIEST TO 19

The Nittany Lions' 19th win of the 2017-18 season vs. Ohio State (2/15) marked earliest in terms of date that Penn State has reached 19 wins in a season in its Big Ten era. The earliest by number of games came in the 1995-96 season when the Nittany Lions reached 19 wins in 27 games (19-8).

EARLIEST BIG WIN

Prior to the December 2, 2017 win at Iowa in 2017-18, Penn State's January 1, 2017 win over Rutgers marked its earliest Big Ten win since the 2010-2011 season.

RANKED FOES TESTED IN BJC

Penn State has won five of six games against ranked teams in the Bryce Jordan Center, including four-consecutive contests against top-25 squads over the 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons.

EVERY DAY OF THE WEEK

Penn State's 2017-18 schedule has the Nittany Lions playing at least one scheduled basketball game on every day of the week during the 2017-18 season, including, for the first time, Big Ten games that span the week. The Nittany Lions played their first Thursday game of the season at Ohio State January 25 (W, 82-79). Penn State played host to Northwestern for its first-ever Friday night conference home game vs. Northwestern January 5 (W, 78-63).

To date, Penn State has played six games on Fridays (5-1) and Saturdays (5-1) records and four games on Tuesdays (1-3).

AND FIVE TIMES ON SUNDAY

Five Nittany Lion games are slated for Sundays, with two wins during the nonconference portion of the schedule over Fairleigh Dickinson (11/12) in the BJC and at George Mason (12/17), and a win at Illinois (2/11).

The remaining two Sunday games are against league opponents and are both on the road at Purdue February 18 and at Nebraska February 25.

MAKE IT 11

Eleven victories have come in 2017-18, when opponents have been held to fewer than 60 points by the defensive-minded Nittany Lions. When keeping its opponents below 70 points, Penn State is 25-1 over the last two seasons.

The Illini made the list with 52 points and scored 16 in the second half, the lowest in either half by a Nittany Lion opponent this season.

Penn State allowed the Scarlet Knights only 43 points, tying the low scoring total by an opponent this season. Coppin State also had 43 points (12/30/17). Iowa scored 58 points, its lowest point total in the Big Ten this year.

For the third time this season, most recently against Illinois and No. 8 Ohio State, Penn State has kept back-to-back opponents from scoring more than 60 points.

AND UNDER 40

Penn State added another win to its in 2017-18 record, now 14-0, when holding an opponent with a field goal percentage under 40 percent. Ohio State was 21-54 (38.9%). The Nittany Lions are 68-18 in the coach Patrick Chambers' era when the statistic holds true.

The Nittany Lions were 9-1 in 2016-17 when holding opponents under 40 percent shooting from the field. The lone loss was to then-No. 14 Purdue, which shot 39.7 percent Feb. 21 in the BJC.

20-POINT TANDEMS

Sophomores Tony Carr and Lamar Stevens had teamed up for four games with each having 20-plus point efforts with two in 2016-17 and two so far in 2017-18

Against Nebraska, Stevens and Mike Watkins added their names and Carr and Watkins paired for another entry on the list of now six Penn State games with two 20-point scorers on the 2017-18 roster.

When Carr and Stevens recorded their 20-plus points in November 2016, it marked the first time since March 15, 1989 that two Penn State freshmen posted 20 or more points in the same game (Freddie Barnes-24 & Monroe Brown-32 vs. Murray State in the opening round of the NIT).

CENTENNIAL GAMES

On a team dominated with youth, two Nittany Lions eclipsed the century mark for games played. Graduate student Julian Moore reached the 100-game milestone at the end of the 2016-17 season and now has played in 130 games which is 24th on the NCAA Division I active career leaders list. Senior Shep Garner played in his 100th game as a Nittany Lion in the season opener vs. Campbell and is now at 127.

MARGINS OF EXCELLENCE

In the Patrick Chambers era, steady progress has been made in increasing the Nittany Lions' scoring and rebounding averages. In the most recent NCAA statistical rankings, Penn State is ranked 35th for scoring margin of +10.2. Its highest ranking came in December when the Nittany Lions were 35th with a +14.2. scoring margin.

On the rebounding side, the Nittany Lions are ranked 79th with a +3.4 margin.

ON THE BOARDS

Penn State had moved up to 56th in the national rankings in rebound margin with a +5.1 advantage over its opponents this season, and are now at +3.4. In 17 games in which the Nittany Lions have outrebounded their opponents, they are 15-2.

POINTS RISING

Just one of the indicators of Penn State's increase in its offensive output was the setting of the program's record for points scored in the Big Ten (1,262) and finish in the top 10 for total points (2,367) in 2016-17.

In comparing the season's figures after 28 games, the current 76.1 points per game average is the highest at this point in the season and a 14.3-point difference from Chambers' first season in 2011-12.

THREES HIGHER

The Nittany Lions had their highest 3-point field goal total in the Patrick Chambers' era with 14 against Coppin State, one shy of the program record 15 (Hartford, 2008; Purdue 2001).

When Penn State had 12 3-pointers at Iowa (12/2/17), it was the highest total for the Nittany Lions in a Big Ten game since connecting on 14 vs. Northwestern in the BJC during the 2004-05 season. It also matched the high mark for threes in a conference road game, previously recorded at Northwestern on February 8, 1998.

Since the 2011-12 season, Penn State has had 34 games with nine or more 3-point field goals and since 2015-16 has registered 14 games with 10 or more 3-point field goals.

ADD WATKINS AGAIN

Add Mike Watkins' name to the Penn State record book again. When the redshirt sophomore went 9-10 from the field against Iowa, he tied Ed Fogell (9-10 vs. George Washington, 3/2/1988) for a Penn State individual game record for field goal percentage (min. 10 attempts).

The forward also tied Jarrett Stephens for a Penn State field goal percentage in a Big Ten game. Stephens went 9-10 in two league contests, vs. Purdue (2/1/1997) and vs. Minnesota (2/5/1997) four days later.

Watkins, who went 8-8 against the Hawkeyes on Feb. 3 before missing his first field goal, is also listed among the record holders for seven attempts when he went 8-8 vs. Iowa in the final regular-season game of 2016-17 (3/5/17).

STAYING ON TOP

Mike Watkins not only set the Penn State freshman mark for rebounds, he also claimed the top spot for career field goal percentage at 59.0 percent following his rookie campaign. With an accuracy of 69.7 from the field so far this season, which leads the Big Ten, Watkins has moved to a 64.2 field goal percentage for his career.

Watkins reached the minimum number of field goals made (240) in the Minnesota game to qualify for the NCAA Division I career leaders list. In the most recent NCAA statistics update, through games of Feb. 15, Watkins ranks third.

BLOCK PARTY

Redshirt sophomore Mike Watkins has 65 of the Nittany Lions' 146 blocked shots on the year, a total that has Penn State ranked 10th nationally for total blocked shots and 17th for blocked shots per game (5.4).

His 2017-18 numbers place him 18th nationally with 65 blocks and 2.50 per game (No. 21).

REAVES, PRINCE OF THIEVES

Junior Josh Reaves currently ranks in the NCAA top 30 individually for total steals (28th-53) and top 15 for steals per game (12th-2.30). His defensive contributions have helped Penn State to a No. 19 national ranking in total steals and No. 39 spot in steals per game.

With four steals against Rutgers, Reaves moved into the 10th spot on Penn State's all-time steals list. He holds the No. 9 spot on the PSU career list with 146. His 1.91 career per game average places him 18th on the NCAA list of active career leaders.

Reaves had 60 steals in 2016-17, a total just on the outside of Penn State's single-season chart at 11th, quite an accomplishment since Reaves missed six games to start the season.

DOUBLING UP, AGAIN

Josh Reaves (10 pts, 13 rebounds) and Lamar Stevens (10 pts, 11 reb) recorded the latest instance of two Nittany Lions with double-doubles in the same game vs. Rider (12/22). Stevens and Watkins teamed up for the feat at George Mason (12/17). Penn State now has had 33 instances of two players recording double-doubles in the same game.

The double-double statistics date back to the 1976-77 season and in that time period, only one known game with three players with double-doubles has occurred. Carvin Jefferson (16 pts, 10 reb), Steve Kuhn (14 pts, 11 reb) and Chris Ericksen (14 pts, 19 reb) all had double-doubles vs. Memphis State (12/17/1976).

MINUTE BY MINUTE

An injury at the end of 2016-17 sidelined sophomore guard Nazeer Bostick for the remainder of the season, just as his minutes on the floor were increasing. Bostick has three starts, has been first off the bench in eight games and has connected on six threes this season.



BASKETBALL IN THE BAHAMAS

Penn State traveled to the Bahamas for its foreign tour trip during the summer of 2017. While the Nittany Lions went 2-0 on their trip, including a double-overtime thriller in the first contest, they also got to experience some of the activities and culture of the islands. Coach Chambers, staff members and several players conducted a clinic on a nearby island on one of the first days after arrival.

NCAA champion, Olympian and Penn State alumnus Mike Sands, who now serves as the president of the Bahamas Association of Athletic Associations, was on hand for in the Nittany Lions' first win and visited with members of the coaching staff after the game.

An afternoon of snorkeling off the coast was scheduled as a break from practices and games and the team also met a group of elaborately costumed Junkanoo musicians playing traditional rhythms with trumpets, drums and percussion instruments.

The Philadelphia, Pa., native had his first career start against Columbia (11/17) and played a career-high 35 minutes, producing 10 points and a career-best eight rebounds. Against Pittsburgh, he had 10 points with four assists and four steals with no turnovers. He shared the team scoring lead with Jamari Wheeler with 14 points against Oral Roberts (11-24).

Bostick had consecutive games recording his Big Ten career best in points with eight vs. Minnesota and tying that total with eight at Northwestern.

Coach Patrick Chambers noted in his media availability sessions that Bostick has been an all-star in his role.

KING WHEELER

Freshman Jamari Wheeler has provided a spark for the Nittany Lions, playing in all 28 games (16.2 minutes per game) and earning three-straight starts against Nebraska, Minnesota and at Northwestern. He is second in the Big Ten with 42 steals behind teammate Josh Reaves after leading that category in January.

The Live Oak, Fla., native tied his career-best with seven rebounds vs. Coppin State and had a career-best and team season-high six steals at George Mason. In Big Ten play, he has had two games with four points and had a league game career-best with five rebounds vs. Nebraska.

Wheeler has led the Nittany Lions in steals 10 times this year with team-leading totals in assists three times, rebounds twice and scoring once.

CARR'S FRESHMAN 26

Tony Carr scored in double figures 26 times during his freshman season -- another Penn State rookie record to his credit. In addition to his 139 assists in 2016-17, he topped Jesse Arnelle (23) for most games with 10 or more points in a freshman season.

CARR'S FRESHMAN 28

When Carr was asked during media day if he had gained 28 pounds in the offseason, the Philadelphia, Pa., native was quick to quip that he gained 28 pounds of *muscle* to his frame, now weighing in, literally, at 204 for his sophomore season.

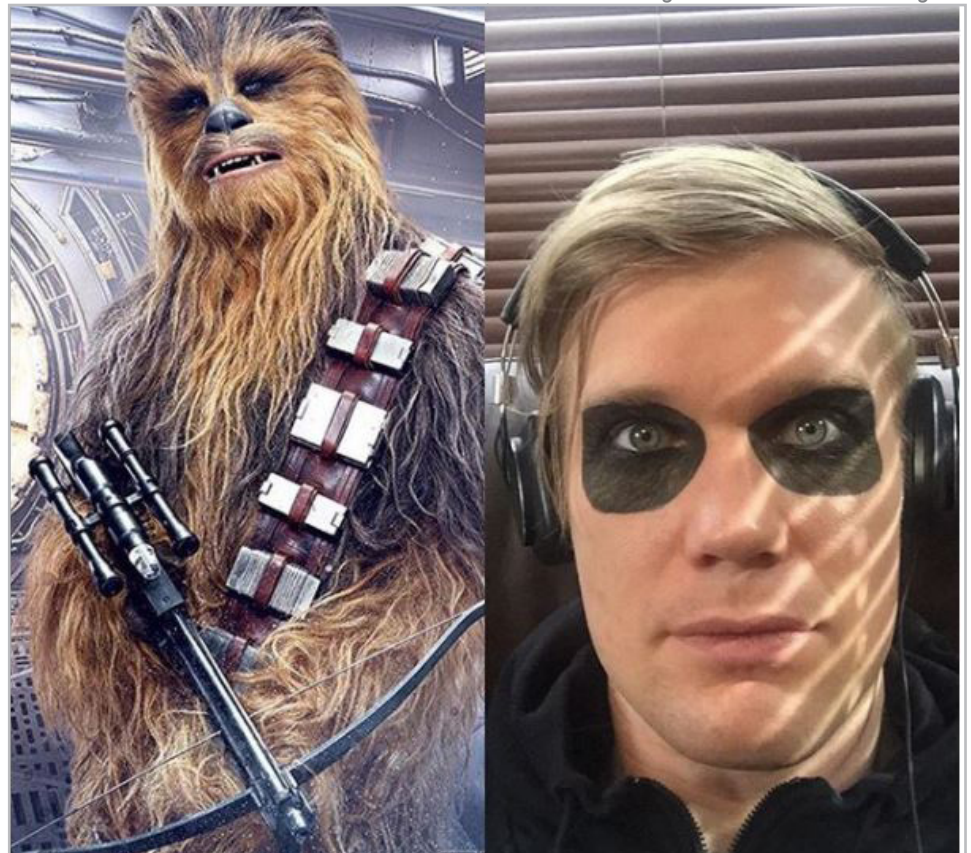
PHILLY SIX NOW SEVEN

With the addition of freshman John Harrar from Wallingford, seven Nittany Lions on the 2017-18 roster hail from the Philadelphia area. Nazeer Bostick, Tony Carr, Shep Garner and Lamar Stevens represent Roman Catholic High School. Mike Watkins is from The Phelps School and Julian Moore is from Germantown Academy.

THE HEARTBREAKERS

The one-point loss to Ohio State at the BJC on February 28, 2017, was Penn State's seventh Big Ten game decided in overtime or by one possession during the 2016-17 season. Five of

the 2016-17 conference losses were decided by five points or less: at Michigan (-3, 69-72); Indiana (-3, 75-78); Rutgers (-2, 68-70); Purdue (-4, 70-74 ot) and Ohio State (-1, 70-71).

NITTANY LION RETURNS

Penn State men's basketball coach Patrick Chambers announced in December 2017 that alumnus and four-year Nittany Lion letterman, Jarrett Stephens '00, will be working with the program as a consultant.

Stephens, who played from 1996-2000, will assist student-athletes in student development areas, which include life skills development, the transition from high school to college, life after college, and community engagement.

Stephens completed his Penn State career at No. 5 on the Nittany Lions' all-time scoring list with 1,372 career points and was eighth with 703 career rebounds. He held the top spot in career field goal percentage at 58.3 for 17 years until current redshirt sophomore forward

Mike Watkins claimed the No. 1 spot following the 2016-17 season.

Penn State's first-ever consensus first-team All-Big Ten selection, Stephens was an All-Big Ten Tournament and All-NIT Finals pick as well as a USWBA All-Region choice. Following his collegiate career, Stephens played professionally for nearly a decade with teams in Europe and South America.

SCORE BY THE NUMBERS

Five of the six top scorers from a year ago return for Penn State in 2017-18, accounting for 77 percent of the team's total points last season. The 2016-17 freshm trio of Tony Carr (13.2 ppg), Lamar Stevens (12.7 ppg) and Mike Watkins (7.7 ppg) contributed nearly half of the points.

TOPS IN TURNOVERS

Penn State led the Big Ten in forced turnovers in 2016-17. PSU opponents averaged 14.8 turnovers on the season and 14.5 in Big Ten play. Opponents had the same or more turnovers in all but four games.

SHARE THE LOVE

Seven players led the team in scoring at least once in 2016-17 and six players combined for 24 outings with 20 or more points. According to research conducted by Memphis, Penn State, UMass and Memphis were the only schools with six players to tally at least 20 points in a game in 2016-17.

NEW PLACES

Penn State guard and alumnus Tim Frazier (2009-14), who spent the 2016-17 season with the NBA's New Orleans Pelicans, was acquired by the Washington Wizards on the eve of the league's 2017 draft. In his final 15 games of last season, he dished out 76 assists while only committing 10 turnovers. Nittany Lion D.J. Newbill inked a new contract for 2017-18 and will play with the NBL's New Zealand Sky City Breakers.

Other Nittany Lion alumni will compete for new teams this year as Talor Battle is now with Petrol Olimpija in Ljubljana, Slovenia and both Brandon Taylor (Jamtland, Sweden) and Donovan Jack (Bayer Giants Leverkusen) signed with new clubs in August.
