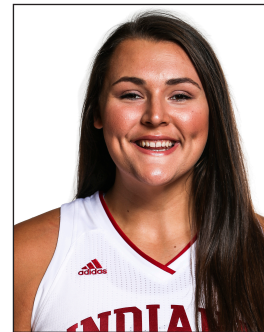

ABOUT THE LADY LIONS

Penn State is still looking to notch its first conference win of the season, most recently falling to Maryland at home. The Lady Lions are led by Kelly Jekot's 16.4 points per game and 7.1 rebounds per contest. Makenna Marisa adds 14.3 points, 5.1 assists and 5.7 rebounds per game. Maddie Burke leads behind the 3-point line with 13 makes and Johnasia Cash is also averages double figures with 10.9 points per game. They are averaging 78.7 points per game and shooting 44.6 percent from the floor.

BOUNCE BACK

The Hoosiers are looking to regroup after its first Big Ten loss on Monday night at No. 14 Maryland. Facing as much as a 16-point deficit early in the fourth quarter, a late IU surge wasn't enough in the end.

BIG NIGHT FOR BERGER

Junior guard Grace Berger scored a new career-high 26 points against Maryland on Monday night. She also notched a career-high 13 made field goals and bested her previous record of 25 points at Minnesota last season. It was her sixth 20-point scoring game of her career.

THE SERIES

Indiana has reversed course as of late in the all-time series with the Lady Lions. IU has won six of its last seven games between the two schools dating back to the 2014-15 season.

LOCK IT DOWN DEFENSE

A staple of a Teri Moren team is defense and the Hoosiers are living up to that expectation this season. They are currently second in the Big Ten and 30th in the nation in scoring defense, allowing just 56.8 points per game through eight games.

TAKING CARE

The Hoosiers have taken great care of the ball this season and are one of the nation's leaders in turnovers per game. They are averaging just 11.2 turnovers each outing, which ranks 10th in the nation and hold a +5.88 turnover margin which ranks 22nd nationally. IU holds a team goal of less than 12 turnovers per game.

NOT IN HER HOUSE

Sophomore forward Mackenzie Holmes is one of the nation's leaders in blocked shots. Her 23 total blocks are 4th in the country and her 3.1 blocks per game ranks 9th overall. For her career, Holmes has tallied 52 swats in 40 career games played.

MACK LEADING THE WAY

Holmes has put up consistent numbers for the Hoosiers in her first seven games of the season. The Gorham, Maine native is leading IU with 16.5 points per game and averaging 3.1 blocks

per contest (25 total) while pulling down 6.6 rebounds per game. Holmes also got off to an incredible start in the Hoosiers' season opener, going a perfect 13-for-13 from the floor in the victory over EKV. It set a new school record for single game field goal percentage and ties the Big Ten record set by Iowa's Megan Gustafason set in 2018. Holmes finished the night with a new career-high 26 points and eight rebounds along with another new career-high seven blocks.

WELCOME PAIGE

The Hoosiers added a new face in the last week, as November signee Paige Price has joined the program from Australia. A 6-2 guard, Price averaged 13.0 points, 7.6 rebounds, 4.8 assists and shot 51 percent as part of Team Australia in the 2019 Oceania Championships. Price is listed as the No. 1 ranked player in Australia by Aussie Basketball USA Pathways, No. 3 international player and four-star recruit by Premier Basketball Report and the No. 55 overall recruit by All Star Girls Report.

PAIR OF 1,000 POINT SCORERS

The IU roster features a pair of 1,000 point scorers in senior guards Jaelynn Penn (1,278 - 17th) and Ali Patberg (1,069 - 25th). They are the first duo since Amanda Cahill and Tyra Buss were on the same roster in the 2017-18 season to reach their 1,000 career point milestone.

GRABBED THE BOARDS

The Hoosiers cleaned up on the boards against the Cornhuskers on Dec. 20, grabbing a season-high and Teri Moren era team high of 61 rebounds. The Hoosiers grabbed 23 offensive boards in the win and marked the third-most rebounds in a single game. It was the most in a single game since 1985 and just the fourth time IU has grabbed 60 or more rebounds in school history. It also marked a team-high in rebounds by a Big Ten school this year as well.

SEEING DOUBLE (DOUBLES)

A pair of double-doubles highlighted IU's Big Ten opening win over Nebraska as junior forward Aleksa Gulbe (18 points, 12 rebounds) and freshman forward Kiandra Browne (12 points, 10 rebounds) each posted their first career double-doubles. It marked the first time

NIKKI'S IN

Redshirt junior guard Nicole Cardaño-Hillary made her IU debut on Thursday night against the Lady Vols. The George Mason transfer was to sit out the 2020-21 season due to NCAA transfer rules but a blanket waiver issued on Dec. 16 for all transfers in the 2020-21 season granted her immediate eligibility.

TRIP DOUB

Junior guard Grace Berger recorded the program's first ever triple-double in the season opener against ECU. Her 17 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists notched the historic mark - including just the second-ever triple-double in Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall history (Juwana Morgan, 2018). It's also the 18th recorded triple-double in a season opener in NCAA history.

THE FAVORITES

Indiana will start the season off with a target on its back as the preseason projected winner of the Big Ten in a vote by the league's coaches and media. In records kept by the conference since 1998-99, Indiana has never been selected to win the league.

AWARDED EARLY

Three different Hoosiers have earned preseason honors from national player of the year awards. Patberg is on the Nancy Lieberman Award watch list, an award she was a top 10 finalist for a season ago. She also earned a spot on the 2021 Jersey Mikes Naismith Trophy top 50, 2021 Wade Trophy watch list and 2021 Wooden Award preseason top 30. Berger is on the 2021 Cheryl Miller Award watch list for the nation's top small forward. Redshirt junior Nicole Cardaño-Hillary earned one of 20 spots on the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award watch list for the nation's best shooting guards.

LOOKING AT LAST YEAR

It was another historic year for the IU women's basketball team before the ongoing coronavirus pandemic nixed the NCAA Tournament. After winning a school record 24 games overall and another program record 13 Big Ten games, the Hoosiers advanced to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the first time since 2006 before the season came to an abrupt end. Indiana recorded its fifth-straight 20 win season in 2019-20, which is the longest

streak in program history. It marked the 10th season of 20 or more wins for the Hoosiers (1978-79, 1997-98, 2000-01, 2008-09, 2013-14, 2015-20).

THE SENIOR CLASS

Three Hoosiers will comprise IU's senior class this season including four-year players Jaelynn Penn and Keyanna Warthen while Ali Patberg joins the group in her sixth year of eligibility. As a four-year class Penn and Warthen have been a part of 73 total wins in three seasons including a WNIT Championship and 2019 NCAA Tournament second round appearance. Currently, the winningest senior class belongs to alum Kym Royster (2015-19) who won 88 games over the span of her four-year career.

THIS SEASON WILL BE DIFFERENT

Consistent with IU Athletics' ongoing efforts to protect the health and safety of students, coaches, staff, spectators and the local community, all men's and women's basketball games scheduled at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall - will be played without fans indefinitely. IU Athletics' decision is in response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and is consistent with what has transpired on all Big Ten campuses during the 2020 football season.

IU Athletics will continue to work with local and state health officials, the Big Ten, and campus leadership to determine if and when fans will be permitted to attend men's and women's basketball games at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall during the 2020-21 season.

THREE SIGN WITH IU

In the early signing period in November, the Hoosiers inked three to letters of intent for the 2021-22 season. Guards Keyarah Berry (Rockmart, Ga.), Kaitlin Peterson (Eufaula, Ala.) and Paige Price (Dromana, Victoria, Australia) each made their signing official on November 11.

SEVENTH YEAR AT INDIANA • 18TH YEAR OVERALL AS COLLEGE HEAD

Teri Moren enters her seventh season with Indiana Women's Basketball in the 2020-21 season.

The Indiana native has taken the program to new levels in her six seasons at the helm, coming off the program's fourth-straight 20-win season in 2019-20, when it set a new program mark for wins with a 24-8 overall record. In this historic season, IU was ranked in both national polls for much of the season including all 20 weeks of the Associated Press top 25 where it topped out at a program-record ranking of No. 12. They made history in the 2019 Paradise Jam where the Hoosiers upset then No. 5/6 South Carolina in the program's first top five non-conference victory in school history. In Big Ten play, Indiana finished fourth for the third time under Moren and went 13-5, setting a new school mark for wins in a conference season.

Moren, a Seymour, Indiana native, has coached 17 All-Big Ten honorees including 2019-20 first team honorees Ali Patberg and Grace Berger – the first time since 1986 that the program featured a pair of first team selections and just third time overall. In addition, junior guard Jaelynn Penn earned her third-straight All-Big Ten accolades on the honorable mention team and freshman forward Mackenzie Holmes was a Big Ten All-Freshman honoree.

Placing a priority on academics through her mantra "Graduate. Win. Serve" the Hoosiers have received 28 Academic All-Big Ten selections. In 2017-18, Amanda Cahill became the program's second back-to-back CoSIDA Academic All-American with a 3.92 GPA in Elementary education. In all, IU has had seven CoSIDA Academic All-District honors

It was another historic year for the Hoosiers in 2018-19, as Moren guided her team to its fourth-straight postseason appearance with an at-large bid in to the NCAA Tournament. IU won its first-round game over Texas and made its second appearance in four seasons in the Big Dance. They won 23 games, its fourth-straight 20-win season where three players earned All-Big Ten honors in Ali Patberg, Jaelynn Penn and Brenna Wise. The Hoosiers got off to a hot start, opening up the 2018-19 season 10-0 overall and had five Top 50 RPI wins and two AP Top 15 victories for the first time since 2001-02. In the classroom, seven players earned All-Big Ten honors, the most in a single season in program history while Patberg and Wise were honored as CoSIDA Academic All-District honorees.

The Hoosiers made history in 2017-18, claiming the WNIT Championship and guiding the program to a 23-14 overall record. IU won 15 of its final 17 games en route to hanging a banner inside Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. Tyra Buss repeated for the third-straight time as a All-Big Ten First Team selection and second-straight WBCA All-American honorable mention while Amanda Cahill was a All-Big Ten Second Team honoree and CoSIDA Academic All-American for the second-consecutive season. The program's 23 wins marked the eighth time in program history the Hoosiers have reached 20 wins or more, including in three-straight seasons for the first time ever.

A record number of fans came out in Moren's fourth year in 2017-18, with four of the top 10 attended games in school history coming during the historic WNIT run. The Hoosiers averaged over 4,000 fans per game and set a new program attendance record during the WNIT Championship game where 13,007 fans saw IU defeat Virginia Tech, 65-57.

In 2016-17, Moren guided IU to 23 wins and an appearance in the WNIT Quarterfinals. The program also featured its first All-American in 31 years, as Tyra Buss was named a WBCA All-American Honorable Mention. For the first time since 2008-09, Indiana featured three players on All-Big Ten teams highlighted by a repeat All-Big Ten First Team selection Tyra Buss. Junior forward Amanda Cahill (second team) and senior guard Alexis Gassion (honorable mention) were also honored, as Gassion was selected to the league's All-Defensive team, also the first selection since 2008-09. In addition, Cahill earned CoSIDA Academic All-American honors, the first for the program since 1989 and the fifth player ever in school history.

In her second season 2015-16, Moren was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year after leading Indiana to a 21-12 overall record and the program's to its first NCAA Tournament berth in 14 years. Moren led the Hoosiers to the most regular season wins (20) in program history while also tying for overall wins (21) in a single season. Indiana had the school's second-most Big Ten victories (12) ever on her way to being named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She became just the second IU coach to earn the award (Maryalce Jeremiah, 1983) while leading the The Hoosiers won their first NCAA Tournament game since 1983 with a 62-58 triumph over eighth-seeded Georgia in the first round at Notre Dame as the No. 9 seed in the Lexington Region.

IU's 12 Big Ten victories were the school's most since 1982-83. Moren's 2015-16 Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and earned a No. 4 seed in the Big Ten Tournament, tying for the program's highest seed ever in conference tournament play. That season, Buss was named First Team All-Big Ten, becoming the first IU player to earn first team honors since 2006. Cahill earned Second Team All-Big Ten accolades. Buss and Cahill become the first IU duo to earn all-conference recognition in the same season since 2010.

During her first year in Bloomington in 2014-15, Moren led the Hoosiers to the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96, the best team free throw percentage (74.3 percent) since 2003-04 and the most steals (284) since 2010-11. IU nailed 236 3-point field goals, the second best total in school history, and also cracked the top five in program history in free throw percentage (4th), points scored (5th, 2,229), points per game (5th) and 3-point field goal percentage (5th, 33.1 percent)

Indiana University Vice President and Director of Athletics Fred Glass announced the hiring of Seymour, Ind., native as head coach of the IU women's basketball program on August 9, 2014. Prior to Indiana, Moren won a Missouri Valley Conference championship during her four seasons with Indiana State. She led the Sycamores to two WNIT appearances and had six players named All-MVC. ISU finished with a 20-12 record in 2013-14, the program's first 20-win season in eight years and just the fifth 20-win campaign in school history. With a 14-4 record in conference games, Moren's Sycamores won a share of the regular season MVC title and earned the No. 1 overall seed in the MVC Tournament.

Prior to ISU, Moren was associate head coach at Georgia Tech. In each of her three years there, the Yellow Jackets made an NCAA Tournament appearance and won 22 or more games each season.

Moren began her head coaching career at the University of Indianapolis (2000-07). The 2003 WBCA Region 4 Coach of the Year in NCAA Division II, her teams went to three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournaments and earned Great Lakes Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles in 2003.

Moren began her coaching career in 1992-93 at Butler (1992-1998), leading the Bulldogs to three 20-win seasons. Moren then spent two years as an assistant at Northwestern (1998-2000).

A 1992 graduate of Purdue University, Moren earned her bachelor's degree in the therapeutic recreation. She was a four-year basketball letterwinner and two-year starter for the Boilermakers under Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Coach Lin Dunn. She was part of three NCAA Tournament teams and Purdue's first Big Ten championship.

Moren graduated from Seymour High School in 1987 and was named an Indiana All Star. She led the Owls to four sectional titles, two regional championships, a semi-state win and a 1987 state finals appearance. She was inducted into the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame on April 26, 2014 and will be part of the inaugural class of the Seymour Athletics Hall of Fame in December 2017.
