### ON THE FLY...

• Michigan State hosts Penn State in its final regular-season home series of the season this weekend at Munn ... With four games remaining, MSU has 24 points and is in sixth place, just four points out of third place as the third through sixth-place teams are separated by a total of just four points.

• Penn State, which swept Minnesota at home last weekend, is in fifth place with 26 points.

• The Spartans will honor their three seniors – Cody Milan, Brennan Sanford and Zach Osburn – prior to the start of Saturday's game.

• Junior Taro Hirose continues to lead the nation in both points (47), points per game (1.57), assists (32) and assists per game (1.07) ... He leads the country - or is tied for the lead - in 10 different categories.

• Both Taro Hirose (6-10--16) and Mitchell Lewandowski (9-5--14) have points in nine of the last 10 games.

• Michigan State is the only team in the nation to have three players in the top 12 nationally in points in linemates Taro Hirose (15-32--47), Patrick Khodorenko (16-17--33) and Mitchell Lewandowski (15-18--33) ... The KHL line has combined for 113 points (48% of the team total).

• Khodorenko and Lewandowski are both tied for 12th nationally in points, while Khodorenko ranks sixth in goals and Lewandowski 11th.

• With 113 points (33g, 80a) in 100 career games, Hirose's 1.13 points per game average is the highest among all Spartans that have hit the 100-point mark since 2000.

• Freshman Dennis Cesana leads all Big Ten freshmen in assists with 19, while he's tied for first in points among league rookies with 22 ... Cesana has four assists over the last four games, including one in each game last weekend.

• Cesana's 22 points are the most by a Spartan freshman defenseman since Jeff Petry's 24 in 2007-08.

• The Spartans have extinguished 18-of-19 opponent power plays (.947) over the last five games.

• Since the beginning of January, the Spartans are averaging 3.33 goals per game, which ranks 17th over the span and is 0.43 above their season average.

### About Penn State

After dropping four in a row, Penn State has won three straight games and is coming off a sweep of Minnesota (7-2, 6-2) last weekend at home ... PSU leads the country in goals (131), goals per game (4.68) and shots on goal per game (39.68) ... The Nittany Lions are sixth nationally in power-play percentage (.258) and are 45th in penalty killing (.781) ... Penn State boasts the third and sixth-highest scoring players in the country in Evan Barratt (15-22--37) and Alex Limoges (16-20--36), respectively ... Junior Peyton Jones has made 21 starts in goal, going 12-7-2 with a 3.28 GAA and .900 save percentage.

### Against the Nittany Lions

Dating back to last season, MSU is 2-3-1 with a shootout win vs. the Nittany Lions ... Taro Hirose is the Spartans' active leader in points against Penn State with 14, including six goals and eight assists, in 10 games ... Mitchell Lewandowski has six points (3g, 3a) in six career meetings vs. PSU.

### Hirose Continuing to Lead the Nation

Junior Taro Hirose has proven to be one of the most consistent offensive producers in the country and for the sixth straight week he leads the country in both points (47), points per game (1.57), assists (32) and assists per game (1.07). He has had multiple points in 14 of the Spartans' 30 games this season and dating back to the end of last season, he has points in 32 of the Spartans' last 39 games.

Hirose has points in all but six games this season, including in 18 of the last 21, and is coming off a career best nine-game point streak over which he had 16 points (6g, 10a).

Hirose has 14 multi-point games this season, which is tied for the most in the country, including an NCAA-best nine three-point games. MSU is 10-3-1 when Hirose records multiple points, and 7-1-1 when he has three points.

### For Comparison's Sake...

Hirose's 47 points, which are the most by a Spartan since Jim Slater's 48 in 2004-05, are the same amount last year's Hobey Baker Award winner, Adam Gaudette, had through 30 games in 2017-18. Hirose also has three more assists (32) than any other player through 30 games last season.

### Khodorenko's Scoring Touch

Patrick Khodorenko is having his best season for the Green and White with a career-high 16 goals and 33 points, which rank sixth and 12th, respectively, in the country. In the 12 games since the beginning of January, Khodorenko has 16 points (4g, 12a).

The native of Walnut Creek, California, who played for Danton Cole with the USNTDP has found a good amount of success on the power play as his seven goals on the man-advantage are tied for second in the Big Ten and are fifth most in the nation.

Khodorenko had four points vs. Wisconsin (Feb. 1-2), including two goals in the 4-1 win. On Jan. 4 vs. Ohio State he became the first Spartan since Greg Wolfe in 2011 to have four assists in a game. It was his second four-point game of the season as he was named the Big Ten First Star of the Week on Nov. 6 for the first time in his career after a hat trick and assist on Nov. 2 in a win over Ferris State.

### Hirose On Pace With Elite Spartans

Taro Hirose's offensive pace is placing him with some of the best Spartan point-producers since 2000. With 113 points in 100 games, he became just 15th Spartan to hit the 100-point mark since 2000 (69th in program history).

Most impressively are Hirose's points and assists-per-game averages. Of the 15 Spartans to reach 100 career points since 2000, Hirose has the highest point-per-game average at 1.13, above even Jim Slater (1.1 points per game/172 career points) and Shawn Horcoff (0.98 points per game/152 career points).

With 80 total helpers, Hirose's 0.8 assist per game average is the highest of any Spartan that reached the 100 point mark since 2000. The 80 assists are the sixth most by a Spartan since 2000.

In his career (100 games), Hirose has more games with multiple points (31) than games without a point (28).

### January Brings Goals

The Spartan offense has trended upward with the beginning of the new calendar year. The Spartans' 29 goals in January were tied for the fifth most in the country during the month, and their average of 3.62 during the month ranked ninth in the country and third in the Big Ten over the span.

MSU scored at least five goals in three straight games (Jan. 12-20) for the first time since Feb. 2008. Their 10 total goals in the sweep of Minnesota were their most in a series since an Oct. 2017 sweep of Lake Superior State (4-3, 6-0).

Currently, the Spartans are averaging 2.9 goals per game, which ranks 30th in the country and is 0.37 higher than their average from last season.

### Cesana Leading B1G Rookies

Rookie Dennis Cesana has made a significant impact on the Spartan blue line this season as he leads all freshmen in the Big Ten with 19 assists, while he's tied for first in points among rookies with 22. He had an assist in each game last weekend and his 22 points are the most by a Spartan freshman defenseman since Jeff Petry's 24 in 2007-08.

The native of Providence, R.I., who led all defensemen in the AJHL in points (75) last season, has produced three three-point games since Dec. 30. Cesana had a goal and two assists against Lake Superior State in the GLI; scored the tying goal with 47 seconds to play - and added two helpers - in the 7-7 tie vs. Ohio State on January 4; and had three assist in the Jan. 19 5-3 win over Minnesota. He has 14 points (2g, 12a) over the last 14 games.

### Lewandowski Heats Up

After being held without a point in the final three games of December, Mitchell Lewandowski has been on a hot streak with 17 points over the last 12 games, since the beginning of January. His 10 goals over the stretch are tied for the most in the country since January began.

While his career long eight-game point streak came to an end last Friday, Lewandowski bounced back the following night with two goals, giving him 14 points (9g, 5a) over the last 10 games. On the season, his 33 points (15g, 18a) rank 12th in the NCAA and are one shy of his total from last season.

Last year's Big Ten Rookie of the Year was named the league's second star of the week on Jan. 22 after scoring two goals in both games of the sweep of Minnesota.

### In B1G Play...

Taro Hirose leads the league in points (31), points per game (1.55), plus/minus (+13) and is tied for the lead in assists (21) ... Mitchell Lewandowski is second in goals (12) and sixth in points (24) ... Patrick Khodorenko is tied for third in points (25) and is tied with Hirose for fifth in goals (10) ... Tommy Apap leads in faceoff wins (239) and his .593 faceoff winning percentage is third highest.

### Rosburg Having a Career Best Season

After posting 11 points in each of his first two seasons, redshirt junior defenseman Jerad Rosburg has 14 (3g, 11a) this season, which is tied with Zach Osburn for the second most among Spartan blue liners. Six of Rosburg's points (1g, 5a) have come in the 12 games since the Beginning of January. He also leads the Spartans in blocked shots with 55.

### Young on the Back End

For the second straight year, the Spartans have just one senior defenseman in Zach Osburn. While Osburn is the Spartans' active leader in games played at 135, he is surrounded by youth with three freshmen - Dennis Cesana, Cole Krygier and Christian Krygier - and a sophomore - Tommy Miller - in the regular playing group. Redshirt junior Jerad Rosburg has played in all 30 games, while junior Butrus Ghafari has played in 22.

Since playing together in the first game of last season, Patrick Khodorenko (16-17--33), Taro Hirose (15-32--47) and Mitchell Lewandowski (15-18--33) have combined to form one of college hockey's most dangerous lines.

- The trio makes MSU the only team with three players in the top-12 nationally in points
- Has 15 (8g, 7a) of the Spartans' 29 total points over the last four games
- Combined for 113 of 235 (48%) of the Spartans' total points, up from 108 (44g, 64a) last season in 36 games ... That's a combined 221 points in 66 career games playing together (3.3/gm)
- Combined for a season-high 10 points on Jan. 4 vs. Ohio State

Khodorenko – 16 goals (T-6 NCAA), 33 points (T-12 NCAA) ... MSU's active career leader in goals (36) ... Ranked 12th in the Big Ten and third on the team in points (32) last season.

Hirose – Has led the nation in points (46) assists (31) since Jan. 5 ... Has an NCAA-best nine game-winning points ... Has points in 32 of 39 games dating back to last season ... Has 14 multi-point games this season and 31 in his career ... Just the 15th Spartan since 2000 to hit the 100-career point mark (33-80--113) ... 2018 All-Big Ten second team ... His 42 points last season were the most by a Spartan since Corey Tropp had the same number in 2009-10.

Lewandowski – Team leader with four game-winning goals and active leader with nine in his career ... 15 goals (T-11 NCAA), 33 points (T-12 NCAA) ... 2018 Big Ten Freshman of the Year and only unanimous selection to the Big Ten All-Freshman team ... Led all rookies nationally in goals (19) and tied for the most in the Big Ten (among all players) during the regular season.

### DeRidder the Nation's Youngest Goaltender

Freshman Drew DeRidder, the youngest goaltender in college hockey (DOB: 5/1/00), has made 16 starts this season, sporting a .910 save percentage and 3.12 GAA. DeRidder has started each of the last five games, which is the most consecutive starts for either Spartan goalie this year. He made 52 saves in the 2-2 tie vs. Wisconsin on Feb. 2, marking the first time a Spartan goaltender made at least 50 stops since Jeff Lerg in Jan. 2009.

The native of Fenton was named the Big Ten Second Star of the Week the first week of December after turning away 78 of 82 shots against Michigan, Nov. 30-Dec. 1. He has three games this season with at least 40 saves and eight with at least 30.

### Historical Comeback vs. Ohio State

The Spartans' dramatic rally from two separate three-goal, third-period deficits on Jan. 4 vs. No. 7/4 Ohio State included several feats not seen by the program in years:

- It was the Spartans' first three-goal, third-period comeback for a tie or win since Feb. 20, 1996 at Notre Dame (4-4 T) ... MSU trailed Notre Dame 4-1 and scored three goals in the final 3:33.
- The Spartans scored five goals in the third period for the first time since doing so vs. Lake Superior State on Oct. 24, 2002 (7-0 W).
- MSU's seven goals were its most since topping New Hampshire 7-4 in November 2015.

Against Ohio State on Jan. 4, the Spartans trailed 4-2 entering the third period and were down 7-4 with 5:00 to play. MSU scored three goals in a 3:48 span to tie the game (Zach Osburn, 4:35 remaining; Taro Hirose, 3:29 remaining; and Dennis Cesana, 47 seconds remaining). MSU also trailed 6-3 with 12:36 to play.

### A Weekend of Firsts vs. Minnesota

Three of the Spartans' last four wins have been aided largely by production from up and down the lineup. In the sweep of Minnesota, four players notched their first career goals or assists. Freshmen Cole Krygier and Adam Goodsir both scored in Sunday's 5-3 win, while Christian Krygier and goaltender John Lethemon got their first career points with assists in Saturday's 5-3 win. Lethemon's assist on Jerad Rosburg's empty-net goal was the first by a Spartan goaltender since Jake Hildebrand on Jan. 29, 2016, in a 4-2 win at Ohio State.

### Down, But Never Out

Michigan State has demonstrated it is never out of games this season as the Spartans have trailed in the second period in three of their 10 wins, and in the second period or later in both of their extra-point OT/shootout wins in league play. MSU trailed in wins at Cornell on Oct. 27 (down 1-0 in 2nd period, won 4-3); at Minnesota (down 2-0 in the 2nd period, won 4-2); and vs. Michigan on Nov. 30 (down 2-1 in the 2nd period, won 4-3). The Spartans' most dramatic comeback of the year took place on Jan. 4 vs. No. 7/4 Ohio State when they rallied from two separate three-goal deficits (6-3, 7-4) in the third period and wound up tying the Buckeyes, 7-7, before earning the extra point with a 3-on-3 OT win. It was the first time MSU rallied from a three-goal deficit in the third period to tie or win since Feb. 20, 1996. MSU was down 1-0 to Michigan on Dec. 1, but came back to tie the game and then won the shootout for the extra point.

Danton Cole, a coaching veteran with international, professional and collegiate experience, was appointed head coach of the Michigan State hockey program on April 11, 2017. Cole, who was a key member of some of the most successful Spartan hockey teams in program history, came to Michigan State from USA Hockey's National Team Development Program where he mentored some of the nation's top young players on the U-17 and U-18 teams for seven seasons.

With the fourth-youngest roster in the nation that included just three seniors and 19 underclassmen, Cole facilitated progress in all facets of the Spartan program during his first season behind the bench in 2017-18. With five wins against ranked opponents, including three vs. top-10 teams, the Spartans improved their win total over the previous season against a schedule that ranked fifth-toughest in the country. In posting a winning record at home, including going undefeated against non-conference teams, the Spartans were rewarded with strong home crowds as Munn Ice Arena ranked 10th nationally in average home attendance during the season. In the classroom, 19 Spartans finished the year with a GPA of 3.0 or better.

The young Spartan roster was bolstered by one of the top lines in the country and the program's highest-scoring trio in 10 seasons as sophomores Taro Hirose and Patrick Khodorenko and rookie Mitchell Lewandowski combined for 108 points. Lewandowski became the first Spartan since 2006 to be named a conference rookie of the year as he was voted Big Ten Freshman of the Year, while Hirose earned All-Big Ten second team accolades.

Prior to returning to Michigan State as the seventh head coach in program history, Cole's highly-successful run with USA Hockey included guiding the U.S. to two gold medals (2012, 2014) and one bronze medal (2016) at the International Ice Hockey Federation Men's Under-18 World Championship and three top-three finishes at the World Under-17 Hockey Challenge (2011, 2013, 2014), the top events in each age group.

His teams also enjoyed success in numerous international tournaments, having captured U17 titles at the Four Nations (2010, 2012) and Vlad Dzurilla (2011) tournaments. While leading the U18s, the U.S. placed first on three occasions in major competitions: twice at the Four Nations (2011, 2015) and once at Five Nations (2014) tournaments.

Cole's first taste of international coaching came with the U.S. Under-18 Select Team at the 2009 Ivan Hlinka Memorial Cup, where he served as assistant coach. He assumed that same role in 2013 for the bronze-medal winning U.S. Men's National Team at the IIHF Men's World Championship.

Cole's coaching career started immediately following his playing days. After retiring from the Grand Rapids Griffins in 1999-2000, he remained with the team as an assistant before spending 2001-02 with Muskegon in the United Hockey League, guiding the team to the playoff championship.

Cole followed that with a nearly three-year stint as head coach of the Griffins which included two Calder Cup Playoff appearances in 2003 and 2004. After coaching the UHL's Motor City Mechanics through 2006, he amassed a five-year pro coaching record of 222-126-17 (.632).

In 2006-07, Cole landed his first college job as an assistant at Bowling Green. After one year at BGSU, he was hired as head coach at Alabama-Huntsville where he went 23-59-12 in three seasons. He led UAH to the College Hockey America tournament title in his third season with the school in 2009-10, earning the program's second-ever berth in the NCAA Tournament, before moving on to USA Hockey in 2010.

Cole's playing career at MSU began in 1985-86 as he helped further the Spartans' trek to sustained national prominence under legendary coach Ron Mason. In his four years at Michigan State, the Spartans went 131-44-8 (.738), winning a NCAA National Championship (1986), making three NCAA Frozen Four appearances (1986, 1987, 1989), capturing two CCHA regular-season titles (1986, 1989) and two CCHA Tournament championships (1987, 1989).

As a junior at MSU, Cole was second in team scoring with 20 goals and 56 points, and then was the third-highest scorer as a senior with 29 goals and 62 points.

Cole, who was the recipient of the Distinguished Spartan Award in 2013, ended his Michigan State career with 69 goals and 94 assists for 163 points. He shares the MSU career games played record of 180 with former teammate Don McSween.

Cole graduated with a degree in finance in 1989 and excelled in the classroom at MSU as he was a three-time CCHA All-Academic Team honoree. He is one of nine Spartan hockey players to have received the Big Ten Medal of Honor, garnering the accolade as a senior.

Cole was drafted in the sixth round, 123rd overall, by the Winnipeg Jets in the 1985 NHL Entry Draft and went on to play 11 seasons professionally. He played 318 NHL games over six seasons with Winnipeg (1989-92), Tampa Bay (1992-95), New Jersey (1995), the New York Islanders (1995-96) and Chicago (1995-96).

His best season in the NHL came in 1993-94 when he put up 20 goals and 23 assists for 43 points in 81 games for the Tampa Bay Lightning.

He is one of 11 Spartans to have hoisted the Stanley Cup, as he helped the New Jersey Devils to the 1995 Cup.

Cole played four more seasons in the IHL for the Grand Rapids Griffins before retiring with the team in 1999-2000.

He represented the USA as a member of the Men's National Team on three occasions (1990, 1991, 1994) and earned outstanding player of the 1991 IIHF Men's World Championship.

A native Michigander, Cole was born in Pontiac and raised in Lansing. He and his wife Debbie, a Lansing native, have three daughters - Ashton, Madeleine and Payton.

### Board Approves – Munn to Get Major Upgrades

With a vote on August 31, the Michigan State University Board of Trustees voted to authorize the planning phase of the estimated \$16 million Munn Ice Arena addition. The new addition, which will occur outside building's footprint on the south side, will include a hall of history, new locker rooms, weight room, video room and team offices among other amenities.

The 44-year-old arena has received several major upgrades since 2013, including: new lighting, high-definition video boards, LED ribbon boards, increased chairback seating and replacement of all bleachers, ice plant, boards and glass.

### RECENT SERIES NOTES

#### Of Note vs. Michigan (Feb. 8-9)

The Spartans killed all five U-M power plays on Feb. 8 to extend their streak of not allowing a power-play goal to four games ... MSU killed 7-of-8 U-M power plays on the weekend ... Jerad Rosburg assisted on both of Mitchell Lewandowski's goals on Feb. 9.

#### Of Note vs. Wisconsin (Feb. 1-2)

The Spartans scored power-play goals in both games of a weekend series for the second time in its last four series and finished the weekend 2-for-8 on the man-advantage ... MSU didn't allow a power-play goal, extinguishing all seven UW power plays, marking the first time it held an opponent without a power-play goal in a weekend series since Nov. 2-3 vs. Ferris State ... The KHL line accounted for 12 of the Spartans' 15 total points ... Drew DeRidder's 52 saves in the 2-2 tie were the most by a Spartan goaltender since Jeff Lerg made 54 saves in Jan. 2009 at Miami.

#### Of Note vs. Notre Dame (Jan. 25-26)

Cody Milan had the first two-goal game of his career in the Spartans' 6-3 loss ... MSU held Notre Dame to 0-of-4 on the power play in the 1-1 tie, marking the first time they held an opponent without a power-play goal since Nov. 16 ... The Spartans' 52 shots on goal in the loss were a season high and their most in a game since Feb. 11, 2011 at Northern Michigan when they also had 52 ... MSU was 1-for-7 on the power play in the series.

#### Of Note vs. Minnesota (Jan. 19-20)

The sweep was the Spartans' first of Minnesota since 1976; first Big Ten sweep since Feb. 2016 at Wisconsin and first home sweep of a Big Ten opponent since March 2015 vs. Wisconsin ... The Spartans scored in all three periods in back-to-back games for the first time this season ... MSU scored 10 goals in a series for the first time since Oct. 2017 ... The Spartans averaged 38.0 shots on goal – their highest in a series this season.

#### Of Note vs. Penn State (Jan. 11-12)

The Spartans got their first win at Penn State since Feb. 2014 ... The win was MSU's first when allowing at least four goals ... Brennan Sanford (2g, 1a) and Logan Lambdin (1g, 1a) had their first multi-point games of the season in the victory ... Cody Milan had his second three-assist game of the year and third of his career in the 6-4 victory ... The Spartans had power-play goals in both games, going 1-for-5 and 1-for-1 ... John Lethemon tied a season-high with 40 saves in the win ... MSU scored three goals in the first period in the 6-4 win for the first time since Nov. 2 in a victory over Ferris State.

### Magee Hits the 1500 Mark

Longtime Michigan State equipment manager Tom Magee was recognized at the Spartans' Nov. 16 matchup vs. Notre Dame for working his 1,500th collegiate game. Magee is in his 38th season with the Spartans and has been a part of nearly 900 MSU victories. He's the second member of the Spartan hockey staff to hit the 1,500-game milestone as associate head athletic trainer Dave Carrier accomplished the feat in March 2017.

### All in the Family

Freshmen defensemen Christian and Cole Krygier are the first twins to play for the Spartans in program history. In following in the footsteps of their older brother, Brock, who was a defenseman for the Spartans from 2012-15, the Krygiers are the first trio of brothers to play for MSU since Kip (1986-90), Kevin (1984-88) and Kelly Miller (1981-85).

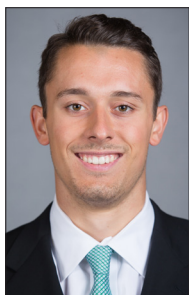
