PENN STATE HOCKEY

THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This weekend marks the 32nd and 33rd all-time meetings between Minnesota and Penn State with the series all tied at 15-15-1.
- Ever since a 4-3 double-overtime victory in Detroit during the 2017 Big Ten Tournament semifinals, Penn State has controlled the series with an 8-1-1 record in the last 10 games and an even better 12-2-1 record in the last 15 meetings including its first-ever sweep of Minnesota at Mariucci one year ago outscoring the Gophers 14-5 in the two game series. Penn State went 3-0-1 against the Gophers last season and has now won the season series three-straight years.
- The two teams were set to meet in the Big Ten semifinals at Pegula Ice Arena back in March prior to the post-season being canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Nittany Lions would have been making their fifth-straight tournament semifinal appearance and their sixth overall in just the seventh year of the conference marking the second most semifinal appearances in league history behind Ohio State's seven.
- Penn State is opening Big Ten play against Minnesota for the second time in the past four seasons with the last coming during the 2017-18 season. The Nittany Lions won that opening game 3-1 before falling 6-3 in game two.
- Overall, Penn State is 5-2-0 in Big Ten Conference openers and 5-2-1 all-time in season opening games including a 4-1-0 record over the past five seasons with the lone loss coming at Clarkson the last time the Nittany Lions opened on the road to begin the 2017-18 season.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

- For the first time in program history, Penn State secured the Big Ten regular-season championship in 2019-20 and No. 1 overall seed entering the conference tournament. Penn State's 12 victories and 41 points in conference play last season were both program highs.

LONG TIME COMING

- Penn State and Minnesota last met 271 days ago on February 22 in what proved to be the final game of the 2019-20 season for the Nittany Lions. Both teams were set for a rematch in the Big Ten semifinals 21 days later prior to the cancellation of the postseason due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- This series will make it four-straight games for Penn State against Minnesota marking the second time in program history the Nittany Lions have battled the Gophers in four consecutive games. It last happened during the 2017-18 season when Penn State defeated Minnesota in all four contests, ultimately punching its second-straight trip to the NCAA Tournament.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Penn State played extremely well on the road last season posting a 9-5-1 record, the best mark in the Big Ten and the most road wins in a single-season in program history. The Nittany Lions averaged a league best 3.33 goals per game on the road, a mark good for eighth in the nation.

CHANGING OF THE GUARD

- Four years ago Peyton Jones stepped between the pipes for the Nittany Lions earning the starting goaltender position that he never relinquished. After setting nearly every Penn State goaltender record, Jones graduated in May and inked a two-year AHL contract with the Colorado Eagles.
- Jones' absence this season opens the door for junior Oskar Autio. Autio made four starts a season ago posting a 2-1-1 record with a .930 save percentage and a 1.87 goals-against average.
- Freshman Liam Souliere will also fight for time between the pipes this season. Souliere was injured to begin his 2019-20 season in the BCHL, but posted fantastic numbers the year prior in the CCHL with the Brockville Braves earning the league's Goaltender of the Year award with a 26-8-0 record, a 2.13 goals-against average and a .930 save percentage.

BREAK THE WALL DOWN

- While sophomore Kevin Wall had only seven points on a pair of goals and five assists in 26 games last season he scored one of Penn State's biggest goals of the season 271 days ago against Minnesota as just 31 seconds after the Nittany Lions tied the contest midway through the third period, Wall ripped home the eventual game-winner from the slot.
- The sophomore was playing his best hockey late in the year finally finding his game after having played with 12 different linemates throughout the season.

- Both of his goals in 2019-20 and four of his points (2G, 2A) came against the Gophers in four games while he had only three points in 22 games against teams not named Minnesota.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

- Senior Alex Limoges was named Penn State's 2020-21 captain and earned his second-straight preseason First-Team All-B1G nod after earning honorable mention accolades at the conclusion of the 2019-20 season.
- Limoges leads all active Big Ten players in points with 103 for his career to rank fifth nationally. His 41 career goals are the second-most among active players in the Big Ten entering the season also good for fifth nationally.
- Limoges became the eighth Nittany Lion in program history to reach the 100-point mark for his career last season and is currently tied for seventh on the Penn State all-time points list just 37 shy of Nate Sucec '20. The senior's 41 goals are the eighth most all-time at Penn State.

HOCKEY VALLEY FIVE-0

- Penn State's magic number is five, the Nittany Lions were 11-0-0 last year when scoring at least five goals and 77-1-2 all-time when scoring five or more goals with the lone loss coming during the 2018-19 season against Wisconsin at the Kohl Center in an 8-5 defeat.
- In 2019-20 the Nittany Lions were also 16-1-3 when scoring first and a perfect 15-0-2 when leading entering the third period.

SCOUTING MINNESOTA



- The Gophers were picked to finish first by the Big Ten coaches in the preseason poll and are ranked 11th in both national polls to open the season.
- Minnesota returns nine of its top 10 scorers from last season including each of the top-six led by leading scorer and former Big Ten Freshman of the Year, Sammy Walker who had 30 points on 11 goals and 19 assists last season. Walker's 30 points were good for ninth in the conference.
- Scott Reedy led all Gophers last season with 15 goals, a mark tied for fourth in the Big Ten. Sampo Ranta added 12 goals and 20 points for the Gophers while Brannon McManus had nine goals and 18 assists for 27 points.
- The Gophers had four players land on preseason All-Conference teams led by Walker on the first team while McManus and Jackson LaCombe earned second team recognition and Ben Meyers was an honorable mention.
- Between the pipes, Jack LaFontaine returns for Minnesota. He started nine-straight contests to end the 2019-20 season posting a 3-3-3 record over that stretch with a .941 save percentage and a 1.96 goals against average. Overall LaFontaine raised his save percentage to .919 and dropped his goals against to 2.55. Including his time with Michigan, LaFontaine is 0-3-1 all-time against Penn State in five appearances with a .922 save percentage and a 4.09 goals against average. His performances of 54 saves (2/21/2020) and 53 saves (12/2/2016) against Penn State are the top-two performances of his career to date.
- The Gophers struggled on the power-play last season ranking last in the Big Ten and 43rd nationally with just 19 goals in 117 chances (16.2 percent) while the PK was slightly better at 82 percent (82-for-100) to rank tied for 24th nationally and third in the Big Ten.
- Minnesota was arguably one of the hottest teams in the country at the end of last season having gone 11-5-3 following Christmas break.





WELL, THAT'S A PLUS

• In just two seasons in Hockey Valley junior alternate captain Paul DeNaples is a plus-49 in 73 career games ranking second all-time at Penn State behind the plus-50 of Andrew Sturtz '20

• DeNaples finished second in the Big Ten last season with a plus-18 rating only behind his defensive partner Cole Hults who was plus-23. As a freshman, DeNaples led the entire nation with a plus-31 rating.

• DeNaples has had just 12 games with a negative plus-minus out of his 73 career games played. In those games, Penn State is just 4-7-1 including a 1-3-1 record last season.

ETCHED INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

• Penn State will look a little different when they hit the ice this season after graduating the largest senior class in program history and arguably one of the most decorated throughout the nation as well as having two juniors leave early after signing entry-level NHL contracts.

• The 2020 senior class accounted for 85 victories over their four years, just one shy of the most-ever by a single class, a distinction held by the class of 2019 with 86 wins.

• The group consisted of four of the top-10 scorers in program history led by Penn State's all-time leading scorer, Nate Sucece with 140 points and followed by Brandon Biro (116), Denis Smirnov (115) and Liam Folkes (103) in fourth, fifth and seventh, respectively. The group also featured Peyton Jones, the most decorated goalie in program history who holds nearly every single goaltending record Penn State.

• The 2020 senior class played in a total 1,142 games scoring 634 points on 258 goals and 376 assists and had four 100-point scorers.

• The Nittany Lions are also without the services of Evan Barratt and Cole Hults after the pair inked entry-level NHL contracts with the Chicago Blackhawks and the Los Angeles Kings back in April.

• Barratt ranked ninth on the all-time points list and tenth on the goals list at Penn State with 95 and 39, respectively, while Hults held nearly every single record for defensemen at Penn State and led the entire Big Ten with a plus-23 rating last season.

THE GREAT GADOWSKY

• Head Coach Guy Gadowsky was named a finalist for Big Ten Coach of the Year last season after leading the Nittany Lions to their first-ever B1G regular-season title. The Bench Boss secured the seventh 20-win season of his collegiate coaching career and his fourth with the Nittany Lions with a 3-2 victory over Minnesota to close out the regular season.

• The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory earlier this year and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 318 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 45th with his 318 wins and is currently 13th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

• Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 126-of-135 home games, which included a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season games that was snapped earlier this season.

• More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 86 occasions including 10 games in 2019-20 while five of the final six home crowds last season rank in the top-10 all-time in the building including a record crowd of 6,475 in the last home game against Notre Dame on February 1, 2020.

• Last season, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,990) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (103.6 percent).

• Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its eighth season entering 2020-21. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.

• The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New for the 2020-21 season is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

• Arizona State will play each Big Ten team four times all on the road giving each team 28 regular season contests. ASU is not eligible for conference awards or the Big Ten Tournament.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 21st collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his ninth at Penn State in the 2020-21 campaign

AT PENN STATE

This past year, Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the 2019-20 Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.



Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 318 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 45th with his 318 wins and is currently 13th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucece landed on the Second-Team West while also being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucece took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten

wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice

for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with



the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning re-

cord in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn State faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, and capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to double-digit wins (13-14-0) during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13, with several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells

Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA in 2011-12, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

Before arriving in Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Gadowsky took a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and guided it to both the ECAC Hockey Tournament and Ivy League crowns in 2007-08. The team earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1998, and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he took a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign and garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. A three-time WCHA All-Academic team member, he collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, the Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

PERSONAL LIFE

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.
