COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

543	Head coach Jeff Jackson has 543 career wins, which ranks second among active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and 16+ seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks 11th all-time (John MacInnes ranks 10th with 555 career wins).
21	Graduate student Matthew Galajda has 21 career shutouts, which ranks tied for third in NCAA Div I men's hockey history.
16	Sixteen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players Cam Burke (brother Cal graduated in 2020), Graham and Landon Slaggert , Trevor and Justin Janicke and Brady Bjork (brother Anders played 2014-17).
13	With Alex Steeves making his NHL debut on Dec. 7, 13 former Fighting Irish players have played in the NHL this season: Anders Bjork (Buffalo Sabres), Ian Cole (Carolina Hurricanes), Jake Evans (Montreal Canadiens), Jordan Gross (Colorado Avalanche), Vinnie Hinostroza (Buffalo Sabres), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New York Islanders), Andrew Peeke (Columbus), Cal Petersen (Los Angeles Kings), Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh Penguins), Riley Sheahan (Seattle Kraken), Alex Steeves (Toronto Maple Leafs) and TJ Tynan (Los Angeles Kings).
8	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history - each under Jeff Jackson (three regular-season).
5	Notre Dame has an active five-straight NCAA tournament appearances streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA. The Irish have also appeared in eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments (due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020 NCAA tournament did not take place and all appearance streaks remained intact).
4	Notre Dame forward Justin Janicke is the fourth-youngest player in NCAA Div. I men's hockey this season, with only Northeastern's Jack Hughes, Denver's Jack Devine and Michigan's Luke Hughes younger than the Irish freshman.
1.87	The Fighting Irish rank fifth in the country and first in the Big Ten with a 1.87 goals against average.
1	Notre Dame's penalty kill is 69-for-74 on the season, which ranks first in the country at 93.2% (Quinnipiac is second at 92.86).

NOTES

SETTING THE STAGE

- Notre Dame returns to Big Ten play with a weekend road series at Penn State on Friday, Jan. 7 (7 p.m. ET) and Saturday, Jan. 8 (5 p.m. ET).
- It will mark the first road games for the Fighting Irish since a pair of overtime wins at Michigan on Nov. 19-20.
- Notre Dame is coming off a series split with Niagara, including a 5-0 game two win on Sunday, Jan. 2, while Penn State most recently posted a 5-3 win at Army on Jan. 1.
- Ryan Bischel stopped all 19 shots he faced to earn his first career shutout in that win over Niagara, while Trevor Janicke and Cam Burke each had a pair of goals.
- The Fighting Irish head into the weekend fourth in the Big Ten standings with 17 points (6-4-0-2-1-0), while Penn State is seventh with eight points (3-7-0-1-0-0).
- Notre Dame is in the midst of playing seven games in the first 19 games of January, including Big Ten series at Penn State (Jan. 7-8) and at Ohio State (Jan. 14-15).
- Senior captain Jake Pivonka returned from injury to play a limited role in the Michigan State series after missing the first 15 games of the season, while last weekend's series versus Niagara marked the first time this season the full Irish roster was available.
- Max Ellis leads the Irish with a career-best 21 points on a team-high 11 goals and 10 assists.
- Ellis' 11 goals rank 16th in the country (tied for second in the Big Ten).
- Ellis is also tied for the NCAA lead with two shorthanded goals this season.
- Sophomore Ryder Rolston is second on the team with a career-best 17 points on six goals and a team-best 11 assists.
- With three game-winning goals, Rolston is tied for the team lead with Cam Burke (they are tied for seventh in the country and third in the Big Ten).
- All told, 15 Notre Dame players have scored so far this season, while nine players have at least 10 points on the season.
- The Irish are 9-1-0 when scoring first this season.
- Notre Dame's penalty kill is 69-for-74 on the season (.9324), which ranks first in the NCAA.
- The Irish also have four shorthanded goals this season (Ellis 2, Cam Burke, Spencer Stastney), which is tied for the fourth-most in the country (first in the Big Ten).
- Notre Dame has made each of the last five NCAA Tournaments, the longest streak in program history, and eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments overall.

THE NOTRE DAME - PENN STATE SERIES

- Notre Dame has a 13-7-3 all-time record/series lead against Penn State in games played while both teams were at the NCAA DI level (ND leads 16-7-4 including games against Penn State from 1983-85).

- The teams met five times last season, with Penn State knocking the Irish out of the Big Ten Tournament with a 6-3 win on March 14 in the teams' third-straight meeting.
- Colin Theisen and Jesse Lansdell gave Notre Dame a 2-0 lead in that game, but the Nittany Lions scored the game's next five goals before Ryder Rolston netted his first career goal midway through the third.
- To close out the 2020-21 regular season, the Irish swept the Nittany Lions by scores of 5-2 and 7-1 (March 5-6).
- In game one, five different players scored and Lansdell had a pair of assists.
- In game two, Max Ellis had a goal and two assists, while Alex Steeves and Jake Pivonka each had a goal and an assist.
- Earlier in the 2020-21 season, the teams each won an overtime game at the Pegula Ice Arena (Jan. 28-29), with Penn State taking game one 2-1 and the Irish winning game two 3-2.
- Spencer Stastney had the overtime winner in game two for Notre Dame.
- During the 2019-20 season, the Fighting Irish went 3-1-0 against Penn State as the teams split a series at the Compton Family Ice Arena as Penn State won game one 4-2 (Dec. 13) and a 4-2 Notre Dame win on Dec. 13.
- Then at Penn State, the teams skated to a 3-3 tie in game one (Jan. 31), with Cam Burke's shootout winner securing the extra point, and Notre Dame posted a 4-2 win in game two (Feb. 1).
- In 2018-19, the teams met five times, culminating in Notre Dame's 3-2 win in the Big Ten Championship game on March 24, 2019.
- Spencer Stastney, Cal Burke and Cam Morrison (game winner) scored for the Irish in the championship game, while Cale Morris made 46 saves en route to earning Big Ten Tournament Most Outstanding Player honors for the second consecutive season.
- That championship game win over Penn State marked the 500th career victory for head coach Jeff Jackson.
- In 2017-18, Notre Dame was undefeated in five contests against Penn State (4-0-1) including a Big Ten Tournament semifinal victory.
- In that 2018 semifinal win at Compton Family Ice Arena, Jack Jenkins netted the game winner with 31 seconds left in regulation for a 3-2 win, propelling the Irish to the championship and sparking their "cardiac kids" run where they won five straight games by scoring the game-winner in the final minute of regulation or in overtime.
- Notre Dame's career offensive leaders against Penn State include Max Ellis (6 GP; 3-3-6), Graham Slaggert (14 GP; 3-3-6), Jake Pivonka (14 GP; 1-5-6), Jesse Lansdell (9 GP; 2-3-5) and Spencer Stastney (14 GP; 2-3-5).

ONE-TWO PUNCH

- Fighting Irish goaltenders Ryan Bischel and Matthew Galajda are one of the top tandems in college hockey, with two of the nation's top-10 save percentages.
- Galajda, who is 8-3-0, ranks eighth in the NCAA with a .930 mark, while Bischel, who is 5-3-0, ranks ninth with a .928 save percentage.
- In goals against average, the duo also ranks eighth and ninth, with Galajda at 1.74 and Bischel at 1.83.
- Galajda (2) and Bischel (1) have also combined for three shutouts.

SLAGGERT: TEAM USA X2

- Sophomore forward Landon Slaggert was named to the U.S. National Junior Team, USA Hockey announced on Dec. 16.
- The South Bend, Indiana native was named an alternate captain for Team USA and scored the game winner in Team USA's tournament-opening 3-2 win over Slovakia (Dec. 26).
- The International Ice Hockey Federation then canceled the 2022 World Junior Championship in Edmonton and Red Deer, Alberta due to COVID-19 protocols.
- Slaggert was one of six players from the 2021 U.S. National Junior Team that won a gold medal in Edmonton.
- Slaggert became the seventh Notre Dame player to take part in two World Junior

- At last season's World Junior Tournament, Slaggert skated in all seven games for Team USA and became the first Fighting Irish player to medal at the event since 2018 – when current Columbus Blue Jackets defenseman Andrew Peeke helped the U.S. secure the bronze in Buffalo.
- Slaggert's gold marked the eighth medal by a Notre Dame player at the event as he also joined Anders Bjork (bronze in 2016), Mario Lucia (gold in 2013), Kyle Palmieri (gold in 2010 and bronze in 2011), Kyle Lawson (bronze in 2007) and Ben Simon (silver in 1997).
- Slaggert was the 23rd Notre Dame player to take part in the World Junior Championship and joined Palmieri (2010/11), Ian Cole (2008/09), Rob Globke (2001/02), Connor Dunlop (2000/01), Simon (1997/98) and Jack Brownschilde (1977/79) as two-time Irish participants.

ALEX STEEVES MAKES NHL DEBUT

- Former Irish forward Alex Steeves (2018-21) made his NHL debut for the Toronto Maple Leafs on Dec. 7 against Columbus (and former Notre Dame teammate Andrew Peeke) in a 5-4 Toronto win.
- Steeves, who earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors in 2020-21, became the 25th former Irish player under head coach Jeff Jackson to reach the NHL and the Notre Dame program's 39th NHL player overall.
- Prior to Steeves, the most recent Notre Dame players to make their NHL debuts were Jordan Gross, Peeke, Jake Evans and Thomas DiPauli during the 2019-20 season.

BURKE & MORRIS INK NHL DEALS

- Former Fighting Irish All-American goaltender Cale Morris (Chicago) and former captain Cal Burke (Colorado) recently inked NHL deals and were recalled to their teams' respective taxi squads.
- Morris, who played from 2016-20 and led the Irish to the 2018 NCAA Championship game, signed a one-year entry-level deal on Dec. 31.
- Burke, who also played from 2016-20 with the Irish, signed a one-year contract with Colorado on Dec. 16 and later was recalled to the taxi squad.

SENIORS WITH CLASS

- Forward Graham Slaggert and defenseman Spencer Stastney have been named two of the 20 candidates for the 2021-22 Senior CLASS Award®.
- The Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete, who must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. STEPPING UP

- Several Fighting Irish skaters have increased their point totals this season over the past few years.
- After a freshman season with one goal in eight games and a sophomore season with 16 points in 24 games (5-11-16), Max Ellis has 11 goals and 10 assists for a career-best 21 points in 19 games.
- Ellis posted the first hat trick of his career, capped by scoring the overtime game-winning goal, at Michigan on Nov. 20 marking the first visiting player to record a hat trick at Yost Ice Arena in 15 years (2006).
- In 19 games this season, Cam Burke has six goals and six assists for 12 points, all of which represent career-high totals for the senior.
- Solaj Bakich has a career-high 12 points (3-9-12) in 15 games this season after scoring once in 10 games as a freshman and then notching seven points (4-3-7) in 28 games as a sophomore.
- Ryder Rolston had six points on a goal and five assists last season as a freshman and now has six goals and 11 assists for 17 points in 19 games as a sophomore.
- Defenseman Jake Boltmann joined the Irish for the second semester last season, skating in 19 games (0 points).
- This season, Boltmann has a goal and seven assists for eight points in 19 games.

FAMILY TIES

- The 2021-22 Notre Dame roster features quite a few family connections to the program and hockey world.
- Two sets of brothers are currently on the roster, including Justin and Trevor Janicke and Graham and Landon Slaggert.

- Cam Burke played his first two seasons in an Irish uniform alongside his older brother, Cal Burke, who signed with the Colorado organization for the second consecutive season for 2021-22.
- Freshman forward Brady Bjork is the younger brother of former Irish All-American and current Buffalo Sabre Anders Bjork.
- The Janickes represent the 16th set of brothers to play for Notre Dame.
- The Slaggerts also are part of the fifth set of father-son combinations to suit up for the Irish, joining their father and associate head coach Andy Slaggert.
- Justin and Trevor Janicke are the sons of Curtis Janicke, who played for the Irish from 1989-93, appearing in 125 games while scoring 46 goals and adding 98 assists for 144 points.
- Justin, Trevor and Curtis represent the sixth father-son duo to play for the Irish.
- Senior forward Jake Pivonka is the son of Czech Republic native and former NHL player Michael Pivonka, who played over 800 games with the Washington Capitals (1986-99).
- Junior forward Solag Bakich is the son of Huntley Bakich, who was a linebacker for the Fighting Irish football team during the Lou Holtz era.
- Sophomore forward Ryder Rolston is the son of former NHLer and Stanley Cup Champion Brian Rolston.

2021-22 QUICK HITS

- The 2021-22 season marks Notre Dame's 17th under head coach Jeff Jackson and its fifth season in the Big Ten.
- Overall, it is the 53rd season of NCAA Division I hockey for Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame returned four of its top-five point scorers from 2020-21, including Graham Slaggert (7-18-25), Landon Slaggert (8-14-22), Nick Leivermann (5-12-17) and Max Ellis (5-11-16).
- Key losses from 2020-21 included the graduation of Dylan St. Cyr, Pierce Crawford, Matt Hellickson and Colin Theisen; Nate Clurman and Alex Steeves signing professional contracts and Michael Graham being forced to medically retire (he has since joined the Irish coaching staff as an undergraduate assistant coach).
- The Irish welcomed four graduate transfers into the fold for the 2021-22 campaign, including forward Jack Adams, defenseman Chase Blackmun, goaltender Matthew Galajda, and defenseman Adam Karashik while goaltender Josh Graziano transferred into the program as a sophomore, having last played collegiately at Union.
- Five freshmen also joined the Irish this season in forward Tyler Carpenter, defenseman Ryan Helliwell, forward Justin Janicke, forward Hunter Strand and defenseman Hunter Weiss.

100% GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE

- The University of Notre Dame claimed the 2020 national championship for graduating student-athletes in all sports—in the process posting the top NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) figure (98) for the 14th-straight year (released on Nov. 17, 2020 by the NCAA).

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Graduate student Adam Karashik and seniors Jake Pivonka and Graham Slaggert will serve as team captains for the Irish this season.
- Additionally, seniors Nick Leivermann and Spencer Stastney will be alternate captains.
- Leivermann, Pivonka, Slaggert and Stastney will wear letters for the first time in their Notre Dame careers while Karashik served as UConn's captain in 2020-21 before joining the Irish.

PRESEASON BIG: SLAGGERT & STASTNEY

- Senior forward Graham Slaggert was named a Preseason Second Team All-Big Ten selection and senior defenseman Spencer Stastney earned Honorable Mention honors (Sept. 24)
- Notre Dame was also tabbed fourth in the Big Ten Preseason Coaches Poll.
- Slaggert, a South Bend, Indiana native, played 27 games last season and was the team's second-leading scorer with 25 points on seven goals and a team-best 18 assists.
- Slaggert's 25 points as a junior marked a season-best total and he enters his senior season with 15 goals and 29 assists for 44 points in 104 games played.
- Stastney skated in all 29 games for the Irish last season, scoring a career-high five goals and adding seven assists for 12 points.
- A fifth round selection (131st overall) by the Nashville Predators in the 2018 NHL Entry Draft, Stastney's five goals were tied with teammate Nick Leivermann and Michigan's Nick Blankenburg for the most by a Big Ten defenseman a season ago.
- Stastney has now played in 104 career games while scoring nine goals and adding 27 assists for 36 points. He was an Academic All-Big Ten selection each of the past two seasons and earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors last season.
- The Fighting Irish hockey program posted a perfect 100 GSR in the latest rankings, tying for first among NCAA DI men's hockey teams.
- Notre Dame hockey also posted a 95% Federal Graduation Rate (t-5th).
- Former players Cal Petersen, Andrew Oglevie and Dennis Gilbert, who all left following their respective junior seasons, were working towards completing their degrees this past semester.

JANICKE SELECTED IN 2021 NHL DRAFT

- Freshman forward Justin Janicke was selected in the seventh round (195th overall) by the Seattle Kraken in the 2021 National Hockey League Draft.
- The Irish have seen at least one player selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft every year since 2004, and in 22 of the last 23 years.

**HEAD COACH
JEFF JACKSON**



- The 2021-22 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson's 17th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 16 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have made 11 trips to the NCAA Championship (2007-09, 2011, 2013-14, 2016-19 and 2021), advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 16-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006-07 and 2008-09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team's first season in the Big Ten (2017-18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018-19).
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson's arrival, the Irish have had 43 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections.
- In that same span, 33 players from USA Hockey's National Team

- In addition, 25 of Jackson's Notre Dame players have gone on to play in the NHL.
- Jackson entered the 2021-22 season with a 21-year collegiate record of 530-271-91 for a .645 winning percentage, the third-highest winning percentage among all active coaches with five years or more in Division I (entering 2021-22).
- Entering the 2021-22 season, Jackson's 530 career wins rank 11th all-time in Division I and second among active coaches (entering 2021-22).
