Nittany Lions Open Big Ten Play with Indiana: Penn State baseball opens Big Ten competition on Friday as it hosts the Indiana Hoosiers for a 6:05 first pitch at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park. Penn State is coming off a 5-3 win over Pittsburgh this past Wednesday at Medlar Field.

Most Recently: In front of 1,150 fans at Medlar Field, Penn State earned a 5-3 victory over Pittsburgh on Wednesday. Senior Jordan Steranka had a huge day for the Lions, going 4-4 from the plate with four RBI, including a three-run homer in the third inning. Senior pitcher Mike Franklin had a very quality outing, going 5.2 innings and giving up three earned runs. Sophomore Greg Welsh and freshman Casey Kullina threw 3.1 scoreless innings of relief for Franklin. Kullina earned his second save of the season. Senior Sean Deegan and sophomore Steve Snyder each recorded two hits on the day. Deegan made a nice play in the

eightth inning, as he threw out a runner at home from left field.

What's Next: Following Indiana this weekend, Penn State returns to Medlar for a doubleheader next Wednesday against Coppin State beginning at 2 p.m. The Nittany Lions will hit the road for its second Big Ten series of the year at Purdue.

Penn State Probables: Junior pitcher John Walter will take the hill on Friday night, making his first Friday start of the season. Walter enters the series with a 0-3 record, but has pitched very well in his last two outings. Last Saturday at East Carolina, Walter had his best outing of the season, going 7.2 innings of five-hit ball and giving up just one run. Walter also punched out four batters and walked three on the day in a no-decision effort. Saturday's starter will be sophomore Joe Kurrasch, who made his first career start in a Penn State uniform last weekend and was impressive. He didn't allow a base runner from the fourth to the beginning of the eighth inning in that outing against East Carolina. Kurrasch fanned seven batters and gave up four earned runs in his first-career start in a Nittany Lion uniform. He threw 109 pitches in a com-

plete game effort and only walked one batter. Senior Steven Hill will get the ball in Sunday's 1:05 contest. Hill enters the series looking for his first win of the season, but has pitched very solid as of late. Hill had a quality start last Sunday against the Pirates, going six innings, giving up two earned runs and striking out two batters.

Scouting Indiana: Indiana enters this weekend with an 8-13 overall record with a 5-12 mark in away contests. The Hoosiers will throw two lefties and a righty in Joey DeNato (3-1, 1.64), Drew Leininger (2-2, 5.09) and Kyle Hart (0-1, 3.51). The Hoosiers enter Big Ten play hitting .250 as a team, while its opponents hit .286 off their pitchers. Sam Travis has a team-leading .342 batting average and has started in all 21 of Indiana's games. Indiana's power comes from Kyle Schwarber and Justin Cureton. Schwarber has belted four homeruns this season with 18 RBI while Cureton has hit three homers to go along with 17 RBI.

All-Time vs. Indiana: Penn State holds a 38-28 all-time advantage on the Hoosiers, including a 21-11 edge in games played on the Penn State campus. Indiana took two of three last year in Bloomington.

Steranka Moves into Third All-Time: With his four RBI performance against Pittsburgh, Jordan Steranka moved into third place all-time on the Penn State RBI list with 153. Steranka trails Chris Wright by 23 runs for second place in the school record books. Steranka is approaching a handful of records including at bats (ranks third, 78 behind first), runs (tied for seventh), hits (third, 14 behind second), doubles (tied for sixth) and triples (fourth). With his homer against Pitt, Steranka moved into the school's top 10 list for homers with 24.

Coban's Career Day: In this past Saturday's loss, Penn State got a great performance out of freshman catcher JC Coban. Coban was a single short of the cycle in a four RBI performance. Coban connected on an RBI double in the third, a two-run homer in the seventh,

and an RBI triple in the ninth. The freshman also scored two runs on the day. The four runs he drove in were the most of any Penn State player this season.

Diaper Dandies: Lately, the freshmen have stepped up into big roles for Penn State. Aaron Novak has started the last six games in right field for the Nittany Lions. On March 10 against UAB, Novak blasted a homer over the leftfield fence for his first career-hit as a Penn Stater. Novak recorded two hits in that game, which earned him a start the next day. In Penn State's win on March 11, Novak hit two singles and drove in a run to help the Lions pick up a big

He blasted his first career homerun at ECU last weekend in a four RBI performance. Coban is hitting .296 and slugging .519 in his eight career games.

Penn State to Have at Least Four Games Televised this Season: The Nittany Lion baseball team will play in four games televised by the BTN starting with the Friday, Apr. 13 matchup against Michigan at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park. PSU's visit to Target Field to play Minnesota will air Saturday, May 5 at 3:00 p.m. as well Illinois' trip to Happy Valley on Sunday, May 13. Penn State's regular season BTN finale at Michigan State is scheduled for Saturday, May 19 at Noon. Should the Nittany Lions return to the Big Ten Tournament for a second consecutive season, their games will once again be shown live on Big Ten Network throughout the week of May 23-27.

Hill Earns Preseason Honors from College Sports Madness: Penn State junior pitcher Steven Hill has been named to the College Sports Madness Big Ten Preseason All-Conference Second Team. Hill is coming off a stellar 2011 season, as he was named Second Team All-Big Ten and Academic All-Big Ten. the beginning of the 2009 season. His year was highlighted by a pair of shutouts after he blanked Northwestern, 12-0, on April 9 before firing another gem against Minnesota during a 7-0 victory on May 13. In his 15 starts last year, he posted a 6-5 record, including three wins during conference action. Hill held his opposition to three or fewer runs during 10 starts. Incredibly accurate, he averaged just 1.01 walks-per-nine innings, which stood as the 15th best rate in the nation. Overall, he issued just 12 free passes during the year.

THIS SEASON: Earned the start against West Virginia (2/18) in the Big Ten/BIG EAST Challenge ... After a slow start, settled down to strike out seven batters in just four innings of work ... Tossed 4.0 innings against UNCG, striking out seven batters for the second consecutive game ... Hurlled a quality start at Samford (3/4/12), where he went six innings, giving up one run and fanning seven batters... Had his best start of the season to this point at East Carolina (3/17/12), going 7.2 innings and giving up just one earned run while striking out four batters to earn the no decision.

AS A SOPHOMORE IN 2011: Pieced together an outstanding sophomore campaign, earning third-team All-Big Ten honors after going 6-4 with a 3.19 ERA and 59 strikeouts in 84.2 innings of work ... Held his opposition to a .234 batting average, which was the lowest mark in the conference ... Also ranked among the top-10 pitchers in wins, ERA, innings pitched, and strikeouts ... Allowed two runs or less in nine of his first 10 outings during the year ... Picked up his first win of the season after limiting NC State to one run on four hits over 5.1 innings of work on March 5 ... Continued to shine against top-notch competition after recording seven strikeouts while holding No. 26 Wichita State to just one hit over five innings on March 20 ... Posted another seven strikeouts during six shutout innings against Le Moyne on March 27 ... Put together his finest start of the season against Illinois on April 2 after setting a career-high with nine strikeouts while allowing just one run during a complete game effort ... Allowed just two runs in each of his next three starts, highlighted by a six-inning, one-hit effort against Purdue on April 17 and an eight-inning, five-strikeout performance against Ohio State on April 23 ... Earned his sixth win of the season after striking out seven while allowing just three hits over 6.2 innings against Iowa on May 7 during a nationally televised game on the Big Ten Network ... Wrapped up conference action with a 4-0 record, 3.06 ERA, and 36 strikeouts ... Started the first game of the Big Ten Tournament against Purdue, firing five innings with two strikeouts on May 25 ...
