OPENING SERVE

The Nittany Lions lost in straight sets to George Mason back in late February but turned things around two days later with a sweep of Charleston in their previous matches against both of their upcoming weekend opponents. An injured Penn State squad fell victim to the Patriots on the road before finding its groove two days later to beat the Golden Eagles on their home floor.

Penn State is riding a current season-long four match winning streak which began March 19 against Ohio State and has catapulted the Nittany Lions from fourth place in the EIVA standings to second place and only one match out of first place with four matches remaining in the season. Last week, Penn State defeated

Saint Francis 3-0 on Tuesday and followed up with wins at Harvard 3-1 and Sacred Heart 3-0.

George Mason is ranked #15 in the AVCA National Coaches Poll and is coming off a weekend split at home last weekend with a four-set loss to EIVA leader Princeton and a four-set win over NJIT. They sit just behind Penn State in the EIVA standings in third place with a 7-3 record.

Charleston has been eliminated from post-season play in the EIVA with a 1-9 mark in conference play and a 9-16 overall record. In a pair of nonconference matches last Friday at Lourdes, the Golden Eagles swept Lawrence Tech before dropping in straight sets to the host, Lourdes.

HEAD COACH MARK PAVLIK

25TH SEASON

PENN STATE '82

- » Mark Pavlik holds an overall record of 571-196, good for a .744 winning percentage since the 1994 season.
- » His 559 career wins entering the 2019 season ranks second all time in NCAA DI-II men's volleyball history, trailing only Ohio State's Pete Hanson (702 wins, 34 seasons).
- » Pavlik's record against EIVA opponents sits at an outstanding 235-18 (.928) and includes 14 undefeated seasons in conference.
- » The Nittany Lions have finished in first place in the EIVA standings 22 of the last 24 season since Mark Pavlik took over as head coach of the program.
- » Pavlik was named the 2008 AVCA Men's Volleyball Coach of the Year after leading the Nittany Lions to their second NCAA National Championship.
- » Before being named head coach in 1995, Pavlik was an assistant coach for Tom Peterson and was on the Nittany Lion staff during Penn State's first NCAA National Championship in 1994.
- » Under Pavlik's direction, the Nittany Lions have had at least three players earn All-EIVA honors each season.
- » Pavlik has been named EIVA Coach of the Year a record seven times, with the latest award coming in 2015.

About The Slate

- » Penn State is set to face seven teams ranked in the AVCA Division I-II Preseason Top 15 poll, including #1 ranked Long Beach State Feb. 8. The Nittany Lions' first home match against an opponent ranked in the Top 15 will be fourth-ranked BYU Jan. 18.
- » Penn State will participate in the Big Ten/Pac 12 Challenge as the Nittany Lions travel to Los Angeles to take on host USC and UCLA.
- » The Nittany Lions' home slate includes 12 total home matches in Rec Hall, including four matches each in January and March.
- » The 2019 schedule includes home and away matches with Penn State's Eastern Intercollegiate Volleyball Association opponents, including Saint Francis (Pa.), Princeton, Harvard, Sacred Heart, NJIT, George Mason, and Charleston (WV).
- » The Nittany Lions will take on three opponents for the first time in program history in 2019. Penn State's home matches against North Greenville, McKendree, and Lindenwood in January will mark the first time Penn State has squared off with each respective program.
- » The winner of the regular-season conference schedule will serve as host of the 2019 EIVA Championship. The top four teams in the regular-season standings will earn a berth in the EIVA Tournament. The EIVA Semifinals and Championship will be held Thursday and Saturday, April 18 and 20, on the campus of the No. 1 seed.
- » Long Beach, Calif. will be the site of the 2019 National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Championship May 2-4. Penn State served as the host of the event at Rec Hall on May 5-7, 2016.

NEWS & NOTES

Scandinavian Firepower

Redshirt Junior outside hitter Henrik Falck Lauten has started every match for the Nittany Lions this season and has brought a spark to the regular rotation.

- » Falck Lauten leads the team with 206 kills. He set a new career high with 18 while swinging .538 (18-4-26) against NJIT 3/2.
- » He has 11 matches of double-digit kills in 2019 and has led the Nittany Lions in kills nine times, the most on the team.
- » Falck Lauten was named EIVA Defensive Player of the Week 3/25 after a team-best eight dig outing to pair with 10 kills 3/19 vs. Ohio State.
- » He hit .500 (9-2-14) in Penn State's 3-0 win over McKendree 1/25.
- » Falck Lauten recorded Penn State's first double-double of 2019 with 11 kills and a personal-best 10 digs 2/2 at Loyola Chicago.
- » He has shown that he is also a well-rounded defender with 44.0 blocks (3rd on team) and 105 digs (2nd on team).

Big Man In the Middle

Redshirt junior Jason Donorovich has emerged as one of the top middles in the country this season:

- » Donorovich is 2nd in the EIVA with a .384 hitting percentage while ranking 17th in the conference in kills (153).
- » He has also been noticeable on the service line and on defense, leading the Nittany Lions in service aces (29) and total blocks (74).
- » Donorovich was named EIVA Offensive Player of the Week Feb. 18 after posting two single-game career highs with 13 kills 2/15 vs Harvard and four aces 2/16 vs Sacred Heart.
- » Donorovich was named EIVA Defensive player of the week 1/28 after picking up 15 blocks (5 solo) in three games between 1/21-1/26. He had a nine-block game 1/26 vs. Lindenwood.
- » Donorovich started the last 10 games of 2018, beginning with a stellar offensive performance against Lewis on 3/10/18 when he converted 10 of his 12 swings into kills and didn't commit an attacking error.
- » Donorovich was named EIVA Defensive Player of the Week 4/9/18 after his career-best 10 block effort 4/7/18 at George Mason.

Hot Rod McLaren

Now a well-known weapon on the outside for the Nittany Lions, Matthew McLaren is one of PSU's top options on the outside after his breakout 2018 season.

- » McLaren ranks second on the Nittany Lions with 196 kills this season and ranks third with 2.72 kills/set.
- » In EIVA play, he leads the Nittany Lions with 78 kills (3.0 kps) in eight matches with a .320 hitting %.
- » McLaren has 13 matches with 10+ kills this season, including a season-high 18 kills 3/29 at Harvard
- » He was named EIVA Offensive Player of the Week 4/1 after posting 34 kills in three matches 3/26-30.
- » In his redshirt junior season, McLaren was named to his first All-EIVA First Team.
- » McLaren was the only Nittany Lion to play in all 26 games in 2018. He also started every match but one. Prior to last season, McLaren had only one career start in 20 games played between the 2016 and 2017 seasons.

Notable Numbers and Streaks

Here are a few Nittany Lions with notable streaks entering the week:

- » Matthew McLaren has 10+ kills in five of the last six matches. He has also swung better than .300 in five of the last six.
- » Henrik Falck Lauten has 10+ kills in six of his last 11 matches, including four matches with at least 13 kills since 3/1.
- » Falck Lauten has at least five kills in 20-of-24 matches in 2019.
- » Jason Donorovich has 15 straight matches with a block, including 12 matches with multiple stuffs.
- » Donorovich has six matches in a row with five or more kills while hitting .308 or better in the last five outings.
- » Will Bantle has 18 matches with at least five digs this season while leading the Nittany Lions in digs in 14 different matches this season.
- » Between setters Luke Braswell and Cole Bogner, the Nittany Lions have had a one player reach 30 assists in six of the last nine matches.
- » Penn State is 9-1 this season when holding the edge in service aces in matches.
- » In its 10 EIVA matches this season, Penn State holds a .292-.230 edge in team hitting percentage.

(Br)aswell As You Can Do It

The Nittany Lions have a luxury to have an experienced, steady performer at setter to turn to in Luke Braswell.

- » Braswell set a 2019 season high with 47 assists against NJIT and added 45 more 3/8 at USC.
- » Braswell surpassed the 2,000 career assist mark 2/15 against Harvard, becoming just the 11th active player to reach the milestone.
- » Braswell has tallied at least 25 assists nine times in 2019, including reaching 30+ helpers seven times.
- » In 2018 Braswell had 8 games with 40+ assists, 4 games with 50+ assists, and a 60-assist match 1/20 vs. USC. He's had good success against the Trojans, adding a career-high 62 assists 1/7/17 against Southern Cal.

Wild Thing

Penn State freshman outside hitter Brett Wildman is poised to become one of the top scorers in the EIVA in just his first season

- » Wildman has played in 19 matches this season and put together a solid weekend in Los Angeles 3/8-9. He had a season-best 16 kills against USC 3/8.
- » He has made seven-straight starts at opposite for the Nittany Lions. Over that span, he has 43 kills and 29 digs along with eight service aces.
- » Wildman was named to the United States Volleyball World University Games roster on 2/25. He is the youngest player on the US roster, the team's only true freshman, the lone representative of the EIVA on the team. The tournament will be held July 3-11 in Italy.
- » He ranks fourth on PSU with 105 kills and fourth with 131.0 points.
- » Wildman is also one of the Nittany Lions' top servers with 17 aces at a 0.25 aces/set rate, good for second on the team.

Bogging Down The Opposition

Freshman setter Cole Bogner has shown he has what it takes to play at a high level for the Nittany Lions ever since he stepped in for the injured Luke Braswell versus BYU.

- » Bogner started his first game in over a month 3/19 vs. Ohio State and finished with 32 assists.
- » Bogner had seven-consecutive starts under his belt 1/20-2/9 and has recorded at least 25 assists in five of his eight starts (27 sets).
- » He had 25 assists when playing the 3rd-5th sets of the BYU game 1/18.
- » His 40 assists at SFU 1/21 is a season high. He set a season high in digs with eight 2/2 at Loyola Chicago.
- » Bogner has also played well at the point of attack defensively of late, tallying a season-high four block assists 1/26 vs Lindenwood and 2/2 at Loyola Chicago.

New Kids On The Block

Penn State has featured the depth of its lineup in 2019 with contributions from multiple first-year student-athletes throughout the roster.

- » Redshirt freshman Will Bantle has been Penn State's primary libero this season and ranks second in the EIVA with 149 digs.
- » Freshman Canyon Tuman has started 21 matches for PSU and is second on the team with 49 blocks. He set three new single-game bests 2/24 at Charleston with seven kills and six blocks while also sporting a perfect 1.000 hitting %.
- » Freshman Cal Fisher has had at least five kills in 10 of 20 matches played this season.

Success in the EIVA

Penn State has historically dominated in EIVA play in its storied history and have had another strong showing in conference so far in 2019.

- » Penn State has an all-time EIVA record of 238-18 in conference play under Mark Pavlik, including an 8-2 mark this season.
- » The Nittany Lions are 4-1 at Rec Hall this season with a 13-4 edge in kill count. PSU has also outthit opponents by nearly .100 (.326-.227) in home conference matches.
- » Henrik Falck Lauten has 51 kills in five home conference matches and Jason Donorovich has hit .553 (27-5-38).

NCAA Career Leaders

Penn State men's volleyball has long been among the most storied programs in the sport's history with several past and present players in the NCAA record books.

Though both struggled with injuries early in 2019, Luke Braswell and Calvin Mende are among the top-25 of the active NCAA Division I-II student-athletes in a couple of categories:
