## NEED TO KNOW

### BACK AT IT!

- The Penn State women's hockey team gets set for another Thurs.-Fri. home series at Pegula Ice Arena welcoming the No. 7/8 Boston College Eagles to Hockey Valley Sept. 30-Oct. 1

### THE MATCHUP

- This will be the first-ever matchup between the two programs in their history. It will also be the first ranked opponent Penn State will face at home since Oct. 25-26, 2019 when Penn State hosted Boston University.
- Both teams have two of the top head coaches in the sport leading their programs. Jeff Kampersal (379 wins) and Katie Crowley (335) both rank in the top ten all-time in Division 1 women's hockey victories.

## IMPORTANT NUMBERS

**2** Penn State senior forward Natalie Heising is just two points away from becoming the third Nittany Lion to reach 100-career points, joining Laura Bowman and Amy Petersen. With 98 career points, she is seven points shy of breaking Bowman's 104-point record.

**3** The Nittany Lions had 3 CHA player of the week honorees after week one. Natalie Heising was named Forward of the Week, freshman defender Karley Garcia was Defender of the Week, and sophomore goalie Josie Bothun was Goaltender of the Week.

**1** Penn State was picked to finish first in the 2021-22 Preseason CHA Coaches Poll release Sept. 16, 2021. Sophomore forward Kiara Zanon was picked as the preseason CHA Player of the Year.

**19** Penn State returns 19 student-athletes, all but two, from its championship roster a season ago, including six of its seven All-CHA performers.
