

## **Penn State-Michigan State Game Parking Information; Nov. 29, 2014**

- Penn State will accommodate all fans traveling to the game. Leave early and allow extra time, particularly if you are parking in a remote location and will take a shuttle bus to the game. Traffic patterns may remain two ways on many campus roads.
- Only reserved and preferred prepaid vehicle passes will be accepted into campus lots. No yellow passes will be accepted into campus lots.
- Hard surface lot parking passes, with white rectangle and number, will be accommodated at the stadium in regular game day lots.
- All grass lots will be closed with the exception of the overnight RV lot for RVs with advance-purchase passes. This lot is accessed from Orchard road opening at 8 am Saturday morning.
- Vehicles without advance parking passes should park at the Technology Support Building (formerly Raytheon), 300 Science Park Road. Parking and shuttle in this lot will be \$10 with no charge with a yellow parking pass.
- Advance-purchase yellow cars, will park at Red A (west of Rec Hall and Atherton) and Innovation Park, and any of the other 12 remote locations in the community.
- All 12 remote locations in the community will have shuttle service to/from Beaver Stadium, beginning at 12 p.m. and returning until 60 minutes after the conclusion of the game. There will be no parking charge at community lots.
- Use of community bus transportation, such as CATA and Fullington, to the stadium is highly encouraged.
- RVs with numbered reserved spaces on paved surfaces can park in those assigned spaces at the stadium.
- All blue, orange and yellow RVs will be permitted to park only in the overnight RV lot, but RV owners should consider driving passenger vehicles only.
- RVs without advance-purchase parking passes will not be permitted on campus.
- The family-friendly lot has been moved to the Park Forest Baptist Church.
- Penn State fans are guests in the remote lots in the community. No alcohol should be consumed in the remote lots. School district parking lots are tobacco, drug and alcohol free. Many municipalities have open container policies.
- If you park in a remote lot in the community, please remember your route number to ensure that you board the correct bus to return to your vehicle after the game.

### **Relocation of grass parking assignments**

- Purple passes holders on grass, arriving via Porter Road, should park in lots 43 and 83, south of the outdoor track.
- Blue, orange and brown pass holders on grass should park in interior campus lots and access those lots via Park Avenue.
- Pink and green pass holders on grass, and purple pass holders on grass arriving via Park Avenue, should park in Katz Building, behind Housing and Food Services Building, Service Road and the East Deck. Both locations accessed from Park at Bigler.
- Pink ICA pass holders should park in the East Deck.
- Yellow pass holders should park in Red A (west of Rec Hall) and Innovation Park.
- Employees, who park with yellow hang tags in grass areas, should park at Innovation Park. The first employee shuttle to the stadium will run at 10 am.
