# PENN STATE HOCKEY

## THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

• Penn State opens conference play with a 2-game series against No. 20 Michigan on Thursday and Friday evenings.

• This weekend marks the 15th and 16th games in the series history with Michigan holding the 8-6-0 advantage while Penn State enjoys a 3-2 mark at Pegula Ice Arena.

## LAST TIME THEY MET

• Michigan and Penn State last met in the 2016 Big Ten Tournament semifinals where the Wolverines skated away with a 7-2 victory on their way to the B1G Championship.

## HOME SWEET HOME

• This series concludes a 10-game home stand for the Nittany Lions which they are currently 8-0-0 during. So far this season Penn State is 9-1-0 inside the friendly confines of Pegula Ice Arena.

• PSU is also currently riding a 47 game sold out streak as they have filled the 5,704 seat venue in 62-of-64 career games played in the House that Terry Built.

• This season Penn State is averaging 5,944 fans good for fifth in the country while their 104.2% capacity ranks first in the nation.

## IT FEELS SO GOOD'TO'WIN

• Senior **David Goodwin** is one of just 12 players nationally to reach the 100-point milestone for his career as his 103 points place him 11th in the nation.

• Up until last year the Des Peres, Missouri native had also enjoyed a 6-3 record against Michigan including an overtime game winner his freshman year and a four-point outburst during his sophomore campaign. One of just two games where the senior has registered four points in his career.

• However, the Wolverines took all five meetings between the two schools during the 2015-16 season with a combined 33-11 score including a 7-2 victory in the Big Ten semifinals.

• Now a senior, Goodwin looks to end his career on a high note against Michigan, a team he has played well against over his career. In 14 games he has registered five goals and nine assists for 14 points (13.6 percent of his career scoring).

## ELITE COMPANY

• Freshman **Denis Smirnov** might not be a household name quite yet, but the rookie stands in elite company with some of the best freshman to have ever laced them up at the collegiate level.

• Averaging 1.60 points per game through the first 13 of his career, Smirnov trails only Kyle Connor (1.87) and Jack Eichel (1.77) for the most by a freshman since 2000. Eichel was the 2015 Hobey Baker Award winner after his incredible season with BU while Connor was a Hobey Hat-Trick member last year for Michigan after leading the nation in points with 71 (35G, 36A).

• However, through 13 games last year Connor averaged

just 1.23 points per game before an incredible stretch during conference play. So, could this be the same fate Smirnov will have? I'm sure every member of Nittany Nation would enjoy that!

• Eichel was also the No. 2 overall pick behind Connor McDavid in the 2015 NHL draft and is having a very successful NHL career with the Buffalo Sabres while Connor was the 17th overall pick that same year and is in his first season with the Winnipeg Jets.

• Smirnov went undrafted this past June, but remains eligible for the 2017 NHL draft.

## NUMBERS DON'T LIE

• The Nittany Lions current boast the most potent offensive attack in the nation as their 62 goals tops all other teams while their 4.77 goals per game, 618 shots, 47.54 shots per game and +36 goal differential all lead the nation.

• PSU's 11 wins also ties for the top spot in the country with Bemidji State and Boston College.

## SPECIAL TEAMS SUCCESS

• This week's match-up pits the top two penalty kill units against the 10th and 16th ranked power-plays, so be prepared to see great execution on both ends of the ice.

• Michigan ranks just above PSU in PK at 92.2 percent killing off 59 of 64 chances so far this season while the Nittany Lions aren't far behind at 91.8 percent (56-61).

• On offense the Wolverines are converting 22.6 percent (12-53) of their man-advantage chances, good for tenth in the nation while Penn State has scored 16 PPG's in 80 chances this season (20 percent) placing them 16th.

## DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS

• Both Penn State and Michigan rank first in the Big ten and tied fifth in the nation with 26 goals against this season.

• Penn State leads the conference and is tied for third in the country allowing 2.00 goals per contest while Michigan trails at tied-seventh at 2.17 as they have played one less game than the Lions.

## CONTROLLING THE DOT

• Penn State is second in the nation in face-off percentage as they enter the weekend winning 57.6 percent of draws while Michigan is 39th with a 48.4 win percentage.

• Chase Berger is Penn State's leader winning 61.1 percent of his draws which is good for top-25 in the nation while the Wolverines leader is Jake Slaker at 55.2 percent.

• All of Penn State's main five face-off contributors rank above Slaker as Ricky DeRosa (.603), Nate Sucece (.590), Nikita Pavlychev (.582) and Dylan Richard (.572) are all winning more than 50 percent of their face-offs.

## SEVENTH HEAVEN

• Penn State enters this match-up ranked the highest they have ever been as they enter the week No. 7 in the

## SCOUTING MICHIGAN



Michigan is coming off a Big Ten Tournament Championship in 2015-16 as they advanced all the way to the Midwest Regional Final where they fell to eventual National Champion North Dakota, 5-2.

• A new look Wolverine team this season is currently ranked 20th in the uscho.com poll with a record of 6-5-1.

• Michigan is without six of their top seven scorers from last season including their leading four while only two players who recorded 10 plus goals last year, out of nine, have been a factor this season as junior Tony Calderone ties for the team lead with six goals and senior Alex Kyle is tied for fifth on the team with six points (2G, 4A).

• Michigan is without their dominant "CCM" line which consisted of Kyle Connor, JT Compher and Tyler Motte. That line accounted for 71, 63 and 56 points, respectively, which ranked them one, two and four in the entire NCAA. Connor and Motte potted 35 and 32 goals, respectively, to lead the NCAA. Both Connor and Motte are currently playing in the NHL with Winnipeg and Chicago, respectively, and have each dressed in 18 games so far this season while Compher has appeared in 12 games for the San Antonio Rampage the AHL affiliate of the Colorado Avalanche.

• The "CCM" line contributed for 39 percent of the Wolverine offense last season including an eye-popping 46 percent of goal scoring.

• A pair of freshman lead the way for the Wolverines this season as Will Lockwood and Jake Slaker have registered 10 and nine points, respectively. Lockwood ties with Calderone for the team lead with six goals.

• In net a pair of freshman as well as senior Zach Nagelvoort have all split time with Jack LaFontaine pacing the trio with five starts, however, Hayden Lavigne leads the team with a .956 save percentage, 1.50 goals against average and a 3-1-0 record. Lavigne's save percentage leads the nation while his GAA is good for third.

• Michigan has eight draft picks on their 2016-17 roster featuring two goalies, three forwards and three defenseman.





uscho.com poll and No. 6 in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll.

- This marks the first-ever meeting between the two schools where Penn State has been ranked higher in both national polls.

- Michigan is ranked No. 20 in the uscho.com poll and is unranked in the USA Today/USA Hockey magazine poll entering the week.

**THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT**

- Penn State has 10 freshman listed on their 2016-17 roster and all have seen significant time on the ice this season as eight have played in at least half of the first 13 games.

- Smirnov** has been named a B1G First Star and Second Star already this season as he leads the entire nation in freshman scoring with 22 points. His 13 assists tie for the best among first-year players while his nine goals are good for second. He also became just the fourth Nittany Lion in program history to record a hat-trick two weeks ago during a 7-4 victory over Arizona State.

- Classmate **Nate Sucese** has also been honored by the Big Ten with a weekly award as he sits tied for eighth in the nation for freshman scoring with 14 points on eight goals and six assists. His eight tallies tie for third amongst rookies.

- Goaltender **Peyton Jones** has also impressed as his 9-0-1 record is the best in the country while his 2.16 goals against average is 16th best and his .912 save percentage is also in the top half of goalies nationwide. Jones also has two assists to his credit.

- The rookies are contributing for 38 percent of the offense with their 63 points out of the 165 total that PSU has. Freshman have also scored 26 goals this season making up for 42 percent of the goal output.

- Nine freshman have registered at least one point so far this season with six finding the back of the net.

**#ANDYVALLEY**

- Not sure where the hashtag originated, but #Andy-Valley has taken #HockeyValley by storm in his first 48 games donning the Blue and White.

- The sophomore ranks tied for sixth in the nation with his 10 goals this season even after missing two games due to injury.

- Sturtz now has 28 goals and 11 assists for 39 points in his career. His 28 goals already place him fifth on the all-time list just one shy of David Glen '16 for fourth and only 17 off the pace of Casey Bailey who leads the way with 45.

- His six game-winning goals is also just one shy of Tom-mey Olczyk '16 for first on the career list.

- Sturtz currently holds the rookie record for goals by a freshman with 18 and his 27 points during the 2015-16 season ties Casey Bailey for the most by a freshman in program history. However, that record is destined to fall

## WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

## STRENGTH IN NUMBERS

• Penn State has 27 players on the 2016-17 roster and after dealing with injuries throughout the majority of last season they are excited about this added depth. With 16 forwards and eight defensemen the internal competition and confidence is high.

## THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its fourth season entering 2016-17. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 20 league games, including 10 home contests.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a shootout win and one point for a shootout loss.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only major football conference to sponsor men's hockey.

• The 2017 league tournament will take place at Joe Louis Arena in Detroit, Mich. with the tournament champion earning the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

### MEET COACH GADOWSKY

**Guy Gadowsky**, the 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year, will guide the Nittany Lions in his 17th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program in 2016-17. Gadowsky is currently coaching his fifth Penn State varsity team.

### AT PENN STATE

In 2015-16 the Nittany Lions rise continued as Gadowsky led Penn State to their best finish since making the leap to NCAA Division I status. The Lions secured their first 20-win season, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose to as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll during the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6th the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before bowing out to eventual champion Michigan 7-2 in the semifinals.

Of his 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

Those 2015-16 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense including most goals (140), assists (226), points (366), shots (1,579), goals/gm (3.68) and shots/gm (41.55) to go along with those program-best 21 victories.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, garnering a winning season in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title up until the final weekend of

the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs, eventually scoring his first NHL goal in the season finale. Bailey was an All-Big Ten First Team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable mention by the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign had gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play. Additionally, his Lions earned wins over every Big Ten team during the season including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions during the Big Ten Conference's first season. Penn State, which faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

In 2012-13, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to a 13-14-0 record during their inaugural NCAA Division I season. He guided the squad to several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten teams (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL arena (19,529).

In 2011-12, Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

### AT PRINCETON

Before coming to Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second straight NCAA tournament appearance.

During the 2007-08 campaign, Gadowsky, who inherited a program that had won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival, guided Princeton to both the ECAC Hockey tournament and Ivy League crowns. The team earned its first NCAA tournament berth since 1998, and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, pre-





sented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

While at Princeton, Gadowsky had more than 20 players go on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalembe (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

**AT ALASKA**

Prior to Princeton, Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he inherited a team that had not won more than 14 games in the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, who were ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

In addition, Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

**BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING**

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign as he garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

**PLAYING CAREER**

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. The three-time WCHA All-Academic Team member collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

In addition, Gadowsky spent a portion of the 1993-94 season competing with the Canadian National Team and also played professionally in Austria, The Netherlands and Sweden.

**PERSONAL LIFE**

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.

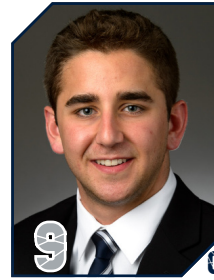
