Drexel Notes

- The Dragons are 6-3 this season and have not yet played a CAA game. The squad is on a three-game winning streak, which started with 1-0 overtime win over then-No. 13 Temple on Sept. 21.
- Offensively, Rachel Sumfest leads the team with five goals and 14 points on the season.
- Defensively, the Dragons rank seventh nationally with a 0.99 goals against average and sixth in shutouts per game (0.44).
- Goalkeeper Jantien Gunter is fourth nationally with a .833 save percentage.
- Denise Zelenak is in her 20th season as the head coach.

Series History

Penn State is 31-7-2 against Temple in a series that dates back to 1977. Last season, the Owls picked up a 3-0 victory, but the Nittany Lions had won the previous 13 meetings.

Last Time Out

Penn State is coming off two Big Ten road wins. First, the Nittany Lions received first-half goals from redshirt senior Natalie Buttinger (Kitchener, Ontario, Canada) and senior Casey Haegele (Warrington, Pa.) and held

on for a 2-1 victory at No. 18 Michigan State. Then, with the help of two goals from senior Jenna Chrismer defeated Ohio State, 4-3.

Herold Hits a Hundred

Senior Taylor Herold (Fredericksburg, Va.) posted a goal and two assists at Ohio State (Sept. 28), giving her 100 career points. She has 43 goals and 14 assists. Her 43 goals are five shy of tying her for 10th on Penn State's all-time list.

Herold's Heroics

Herold posted three goals, all in the second half, against No. 14 Princeton on Sept. 12. It marked her first career hat trick. Against Ohio State (Sept. 28), she had a career-high two assists. She is first on the team with 23 points, nine goals and five assists. Virginia (Aug. 31) and at Quinnipiac Herold has three multi-goal games this season. The senior ranks 14th nationally in goals per game.

Gebhart on the Assist

Senior Laura Gebhart (Mount Joy, Pa.) has started all 73 games since arriving on campus as a freshman. Currently, she has 42 assists, which is one away from tying her for eighth on Penn State's all-time list.

Coming up with Corners

The Nittany Lions rank fourth nationally with 8.30 penalty corners per game. The squad has had 12 or more Ehret Making Noise on three separate occasions, including a season-high 16 against Lock Haven. Penn State has only had less than seven corner attempts three times.

Big Ten Honors

Redshirt senior goalkeeper Kylie Licata (Mountain Top, Pa.) was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week Dinunzio posted the first multi-goal twice this season. Most recently, she made a career-high 14 saves at No. 3 UConn and shut out Quinnipiac to earn the honor on Sept. 9. Licata earned Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week (Sept. 2), while

back Cori Conley (Oak Park, III.) was named Freshman of the Week following the season-opening wins. Licata (Mountain Top, Pa.), the Nittany Lions made a career-high nine saves against the Lady Monarchs and shut out the Cavaliers. Conley played a key role defensively, helping a unit that held Virginia scoreless in a game for the first time since 2011.

Chrismer Capitalizing

Senior Jenna Chrismer (Mountain Top, Pa.) has been impressive offensively. Most recently, Chrismer tallied two goals at Ohio State. Prior to that, she posted a career-high two assists against No. 14 Princeton (Sept. 12) before tying her personal best with two goals vs. Lafavette (Sept. 14). She scored each of the team's goals in the 2-1 win over Old Dominion (Aug. 29), before tallying an assist against (Sept. 7). She is second on the team with 18 points and four assists.

Solid in the Cage

Licata has been a force between the posts, making nine saves against Old Dominion and holding Virginia scoreless, the first time the Cavaliers were blanked since 2011. Then, at No. 3 Connecticut, she stopped a careerhigh 14 shots. Most recently, she made 10 saves against No. 18 Michigan. She ranks eighth nationally with a .819 save percentage.

Sophomore Emilee Ehret (Philadelphia, Pa.) has scored a goal in four of the last five games, and posted a goal and an assist in two of those games. She has played a key role in penalty corner chances, being the primary player to insert for the Nittany Lions.

Penn State has again put together a top-tier schedule, facing nine teams that were ranked in the 2014 NFHCA Preseason Poll, including conference-foes Maryland (1), Northwestern (14), Michigan State (16), Michigan (17) and Iowa (20). The longest tenured coach in the Big Ten and the sixth-longest tenured at a single school in Division I field hockey history, Charlene Morett-Curtiss enters her 28th season as head coach of the Penn State field hockey program in 2014. Morett-Curtiss boasts a remarkable resume covering her time as the leader of the Nittany Lions. Over the last six years, Morett-Curtiss has led the Nittany Lions to three Big Ten regular season titles, two Big Ten Tournament championships and five NCAA Tournament appearances.

Morett-Curtiss currently ranks fifth all-time in Division I history in wins with 458 and is one of just six DI coaches to accumulate 400 career wins. She has led the Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 24 of her 27 years as head coach of Penn State and has helped maintain Penn State's distinction as the No. 3 ranked school in all-time NCAA Tournament appearances with 29.

A seven-time NFHCA Mideast Region Coach of the Year, Morett-Curtiss is an excellent teacher of field hockey. Her players earn national recognition on a yearly basis, 11 of whom have been named two-time first team All-Americans with Kelsey Amy being the most recent. Her teams dominate the national scene, consistently ranking among the Top 10 in the national polls. Penn State was ranked in the Top 10 of the STX/NFHCA poll for 32 consecutive weeks from the first poll of the 2005 season ending with the second poll of 2008. The squad achieved a No. 1 ranking in the STX/NFHCA poll for the first time in program history. From 2005-08, Penn State finished eighth, sixth, ninth and 11th respectively, in the final poll of the season.

Under Morett-Curtiss' tutelage, five of her players have been named Big Ten Athlete of the Year -- Traci Anselmo, Jen Coletta, Heather Gorlaski, Tracey Larson and Kiley Kulina. Six players have been voted the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year -- Natalie Berrena, Dawn Lammey, Larson, Tara Maguire, Allison Scola and Kelsey Amy. In 2012 and 2013, Brittany Grzywacz was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, earning the ninth and 10th Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors from Penn State, joining Anselmo, Gorlaski, Becca Main, Jill Martz, Jill Pearsall and Jen Long. Long, Anselmo and Grzywacz are the only Lions to be named Defensive Player of the Year twice.

Since Penn State's entry into the Big Ten in 1992, Morett's program has produced more First Team All-Big Ten selections, Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year, Big Ten Athletes of the Year and Big Ten Freshmen of the Year than any other program. Penn State's 10 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honorees are five more than any other school.

With Laura Gebhart, Brittany Grzywacz, Taylor Herold, Ashtin Klingler and Kylie Licata earning All-Big Ten laurels last season, Penn State has now totaled 94 All-Big Ten selections since 1992, including 65 first team All-Conference choices, the most of any Big Ten school since Penn State moved to the Big Ten in 1992.
