SERIES HISTORY: RU holds a 30-18 advantage over Penn State in the all-time series dating back to 1977, including an 11-1 record as Big Ten opponents. Rutgers has won six in a row, including three-straight at the Bryce Jordan Center and a season sweep in 2020-21 (60-55 away and 74-56 home).

NOTES & NEWS

B1G TIME: The Scarlet Knights opened Big Ten play holding No. 8 Maryland 11 points under its season scoring average, producing a +7 rebounding margin, and forcing the Terps into 15 turnovers after they came into the game with the NCAA's best turnover percentage. Rutgers battled Maryland with four players in double-figure scoring for the first time this season, led by Shug Dickson's 18 and Tyia Singleton's second-career double-double of 10 points and 12 rebounds.

RUTGERS RALLIES: Rutgers' 4-1 opening stint concluded with a heart-stopping win for the Scarlet Knights against Harvard that featured an 18-point comeback, a game-tying three-pointer at the end of regulation, and two blocked shots in the final 30 seconds of overtime. The comeback for the win was the second largest in school history (since overcoming 22 at Providence in 1993) and tied for the fifth largest in Big Ten Conference history. In the opening game of the Paradise Jam, Rutgers nearly erased another 18-point deficit, getting within two points of DePaul before a tight, 77-74 loss. Last game out, Rutgers widdled down a 15-point deficit to four points in the fourth quarter against the defending Big Ten champion and No. 8-ranked Maryland Terrapins.

OH MY OSH: Osh Brown, a graduate transfer from Ball State now with 1,568 career points, is the NCAA Division I active career leader in rebounds with 1,204 and in double-doubles with 50. Brown grabbed her first Rutgers double-double in grand fashion in the Paradise Jam opener with a 20-point, 20-rebound performance against DePaul, Rutgers' first 20-20 since Betnijah Laney's in 2014 against UNC.

TO THE POINTS: The Scarlet Knights are one of just five teams in NCAA Division I to boast three current 1,000-point scorers on the 2021-22 roster: Osh Brown (1,568), Lasha Petree (1,466), and Victoria Morris (1,430) combining for 4,453 points. Jailyn Mason has 991 career points and Shug Dickson has 960. They would become the fourth and fifth, making Rutgers the only school in the country to roster four or more 1,000 career point scorers.

WHO STEPS UP TODAY? Rutgers has employed seven different starting lineups in 10 games. With eight returners (three upperclassmen) and eight newcomers, Rutgers entered the new season with 20% of last year's scoring and 11% of last season's assists. Eight different Scarlet Knights have tied or led Rutgers in scoring this season, and six games featured at least 10 players scoring points.

TURN 'EM OVER & TURN IT UP: Rutgers is 4-0 this season when outscoring opponents in points off turnovers and points on the fast break. RU is 0-6 when trailing in those specialty categories.

#TRENDING

- Against No. 8 Maryland, Tyia Singleton recorded the second double-double (10pts, 12reb) of her career and the first since the 2020-21 regular-season finale against Ohio State. It was her fifth career game in double-figure scoring and fifth with double-digit rebounds.
- Tyia Singleton, who ranked fourth in the Big Ten in blocks last season, continues the trend into 2021-22 with a No. 4 conference ranking at 1.3 blocks per game.
- Osh Brown's 20-point, 20-rebound double-double vs. DePaul was Rutgers' first in a game since Betnijah Laney's 24-24 against UNC on Dec. 5, 2014 in a 2OT game (21-20 at the end of regulation). It fell two shy of Brown's career-high of 22 rebounds, set in the 2021 NCAA Tournament last season, a Ball State program record.
- Rutgers' highest-scoring quarter has been the fourth in seven of 10 games this season – including 20 apiece against Saint Peter's, South Alabama, and No. 9 Arizona, 15 against Fairfield and Stony Brook, and 25 against Harvard.
- The Rutgers defense has held opponents under their scoring average in 27 of its last 29 games, and 114 of its last 124 dating back to 2017-18.
- Rutgers ranks 16th in the country in both total steals (100) and total blocks (48).
- Sayawni Lassiter grabbed a career-high five steals against Fairfield. She has three or more steals in five Rutgers games this season. The Florida State transfer ranks fifth in the Big Ten with 1.9 thefts per game.
- Rutgers' specialty stats show the Scarlet Knights clicking in the paint and off the bench. RU is outscoring opponents by an average of 3.2 points in the paint and by 9.1 in bench points.
- Rutgers passed out 21 assists on its 22 field goals in the St. Peter's victory, setting a school modern-era record (since 2001-02) for the highest percentage of field goals assisted (95%).
- In the St. Peter's win, Rutgers forced its most turnovers by an opponent (34) since 38 against Penn State during the 2014-15 season.
- The nation's fourth-best steals per game team last season, Rutgers grabbed 21 steals in the 2021-22 season opener, the most since 22 at Wisconsin in Game 2 last season on Dec. 11, 2020.

GETTING OFFENSIVE

Last season, Rutgers produced its highest scoring average during C. Vivian Stringer’s 26-year tenure “On the Banks.” The next four highest scoring averages are all from NCAA Tournament teams, including the Elite Eight squad from 1999 and the Sweet 16 group from 1998.

THE LEGEND CONTINUES

Rutgers University and head women’s basketball coach C. Vivian Stringer have agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension that will keep the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame Coach court-side through the 2025-26 season. Stringer has led the Scarlet Knights to a top-three finish in the Big Ten Conference in two of the past three seasons and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances during that stretch.

“Coach Stringer has had an immeasurable impact on the lives of the many women who have come through our program over the years,” said Rutgers Director of Athletics Pat Hobbs. “She is a giant in the world of college athletics and beyond. Her many accomplishments – 1,000 wins, Final Four appearances, being inducted into several Halls of Fame, and countless awards and honors speak for themselves. She is an inspiration to all of us and we are proud to have her build on that legacy and continue to inspire future Scarlet Knights.”

“Vivian Stringer has set the standard of excellence both on the court and off,” said Rutgers University President Jonathan Holloway. “She is an icon in her field. Rutgers is blessed to have her among our roster of great coaches, and I am thrilled that we were able to negotiate a new contract for coach Stringer.”

“Rutgers is family, and I’m proud to be given the opportunity to continue a tradition of excellence with the next generation of Scarlet Knights,” Stringer said. “This is what I love to do, and I do it today with as much care and passion as when I began. I am grateful to our administration, Director of Athletics Pat Hobbs, Deputy Athletic Director Sarah Baumgartner, and President Jonathan Holloway for their continued support as we seek to win championships while developing, mentoring, and teaching young women for life in and around the game of basketball.”

From 2021-22 through 2025-26, the contract guarantees compensation of \$5.5 million (beginning at \$1 million in year one), plus performance incentives and retention bonuses. Stringer, who last signed a four-year extension before the 2017-18 season, will enter her 27th season at the helm of the Scarlet Knights.

The first coach to ever lead three different programs to the Final Four, Stringer has guided Rutgers to 17 NCAA Tournament berths, including two trips to the Final Four and a National Championship appearance.

Stringer and the Scarlet Knights have posted a record of 58-24 for a .707 winning percentage over the past three seasons, finishing third in the 14-member Big Ten in two of the last three years, never finishing lower than fifth during that span.

Academic success with a focus on graduation has been a staple of Stringer’s tenure. Over the past two years, the Rutgers women’s basketball program has posted consecutive perfect scores of 100 in Graduation Success Rate, and this past winter, boasted a program-record six selections to the Academic All-Big Ten list.

The standard of excellence extends to Stringer’s staff and student-athletes. In March of 2021, Stringer was honored in the Sports Business Journal as a Leader in Diversity and Inclusive Hiring. Stringer also recruited, developed, and coached Arella Guirantes, a first-round prospect in the 2021 WNBA Draft, a two-time All-American, and overall, one of the most decorated players in Rutgers history. Guirantes joins a tradition of “CVS Kids” to turn pro, becoming the 21st Scarlet Knight to hear their name called on draft day.

Consistently conquering adversity throughout her profession career and personal life, Stringer guided Rutgers to another successful season in 2020-21 despite challenges stemming from a global pandemic. Following a five-week pause in competition, Rutgers won its final nine regular season games and posted its best offensive numbers since Stringer took over the program in 1994. She was named the ESPN National Coach of the Week on February 17 following the first three victories during that historic stretch – a conference winning stint not seen since the 2004-05 season.

More history was made in November of 2018 when Stringer eclipsed the monumental 1,000 career victory milestone. She became the fifth NCAA Division I women’s basketball coach to reach 1,000 career wins, and was the first African-American coach to reach the milestone. She now ranks fifth all-time in NCAA women’s basketball with 1,055 career victories.

In 2019-20, Stringer surpassed the late, great Pat Summitt and became the NCAA record holder with 37 seasons of 20 or more victories. Following the season, she received the John R. Wooden Award “Legends of Coaching” honor based on character, success on the court, graduation rate of student-athletes in their basketball program, coaching philosophy, and identification with the goals of the John R. Wooden Award.

Joining her Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame induction, Stringer entered another elite club with a 2020 induction into the New Jersey Hall of Fame alongside Eli Manning, Rick Barry, Ed Harris, and Anne Hathaway.

AN ALL STAR FROM THE LONE STAR

Incoming freshman guard Kierra Sanderlin wrapped up her final high school season with a slew of major accolades before starting her career with the Rutgers women's basketball team.

Sanderlin, who signed her National Letter of Intent with the Scarlet Knights during the early signing period in November 2020, finished her high school career as a Texas Association of Basketball Coaches and Texas Girls Coaches Association All-State selection after leading Judson High School to the state semifinals with 16.9 points, 6.3 rebounds, 3.7 assists, and 4.0 steals per game.

She was named the Express News Player of the Year. The effort also landed her District MVP honors, along with All-District First Team, Express News Super Team, TABC All-Star, and TABC All-Region accolades. Sanderlin heads to the college ranks as a Who's Next All-American and a McDonald's All-America Game nominee.

Sanderlin scored 1,413 points in high school, but that was only part of a well-rounded repertoire out of the backcourt. She grabbed 543 rebounds, good for 5.4 per game, and will join a Rutgers team that ranked No. 4 in the nation in steals per game in 2020-21 after 338 high school career steals (3.4 per contest). The versatile shooting guard added 288 assists and 70 blocks during her Judson stint.

The Converse, Texas native earned excellence in the classroom, as well, named to the District All-Academic Team following her senior year.

ANOTHER B1G MILESTONE FOR STRINGER

Head coach C. Vivian Stringer became the first Big Ten women's basketball coach to record 200 wins in conference play in the Scarlet Knights' 45-41 win over Northwestern on Dec. 28.

She currently owns a 233-98 record in regular season Big Ten contests, which includes 169 victories while at Iowa from 1983-95 and 64 at Rutgers.

STRINGER MILESTONE NUMBERS TO REMEMBER

Rutgers head coach Stringer has compiled a 1055-426 career record in her 50 seasons of coaching and joined the elite 1,000 career victory club on November 13, 2018 in the Scarlet Knight victory over Central Connecticut State.

Stringer is the sixth NCAA women's basketball coach and fifth NCAA Division I women's basketball coach to reach the milestone victory. In 2013, Stringer became just the seventh coach - men's or women's - to reach the 900-win mark.

With a 60-54 win over Minnesota on Feb. 28, 2019, Stringer was credited with her 36th 20-win seasons to tie former Tennessee head coach Pat Summitt for women's basketball coaches with the most 20-win seasons.

A 63-48 victory over Wisconsin on Feb. 27, 2020 clinched Stringer's 37th 20-win season, breaking the tie with Pat Summitt and setting the new NCAA record.

The Naismith and Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Coach is the third winningest active coach in women's basketball and one of three current active coaches among all divisions with more than 1,000 career victories. She is fifth all-time in career wins among women's basketball coaches.
