OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Peter Russell – Penn State – 6-5 – Outside Hitter – Junior – Ellicott City, Md.

Junior Peter Russell was named the Mike Anderson Penn State Player of the Game vs. Loyola-Chicago. He combined to hit .358 for the week with a team-best 26 kills and four aces and was third on the team in digs with 13 (1.30 per set) and second on the team in blocks with 8 (0.80). In a 3-0 win over Loyola, Russell tied for first on the team with 10 kills on a team-high .667 hitting (zero errors), had a match-high three aces and a team-best seven digs and also added two blocks while leading the team with 14.5 points. Against SHU Russell was second on the team with four kills with a .429 hitting percentage, added two digs and tied for first on the team with three blocks in their 3-0 victory. Against Harvard he led the team with 12 kills, tallied an ace and four digs and tied for second on the team with three blocks while recording a team-high 14.5 points in the 3-2 win.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Connor Curry – Penn State – 6-0 – Libero – Redshirt-Sophomore – Newport Beach, Calif.

Sophomore Connor Curry was named the Mike Anderson Penn State Player of the Game vs. Harvard. He totaled a team-high 29 digs in three matches, averaging 2.64 per set while adding four assists. Curry helped Penn State hit .240 for the week, including .494 against Loyola and .313 against Sacred Heart. In a 3-0 win over Loyola, Curry was second on the team with five digs. Against Sacred Heart he was one of seven players to post at least two digs in Penn State's 3-0 victory. Curry tied his career-high with 21 digs and also added three assists in the 3-2 win against Harvard. This is Curry's second EIVA Defensive Player of the Week selection in 2013.
