PENN STATE HOCKEY

THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This weekend marks the 26th and 27th meetings all-time between the two sides with Notre Dame holding the 15-7-3 edge.
- The Irish have held the Nittany Lions to three or fewer goals in 17 of the 25 previous games including eight of the last ten with the two outliers being a 6-3 victory for Penn State in the first round of the 2021 Big Ten Tournament and a 5-4 overtime win for Notre Dame last month.
- Junior Connor McMenamin leads all Nittany Lions with seven points in his career against Notre Dame on two goals and five assists in 11 games. Classmate Connor MacEachern has six assists in 11 career games against the Irish but has yet to find the back of the net while sophomore Jimmy Dowd Jr. scored twice against the Irish back in January, the first multi-goal game of his career.

FANTASTIC FRESHMAN

- Freshman Ryan Kirwan saw his career-best seven-game point-streak (4-6-10) snapped last Saturday during a 6-0 loss to Ohio State as it marked just the third time in his last 16 games that he was held off the stat-sheet.
 - Kirwan was named the Big Ten Second Star of the week two weeks ago after pacing the conference with four goals tallying a pair of goals in each game including a string of three-straight goals from Friday into Saturday marking the first two multi-goal games of his career during a sweep of Wisconsin.
 - Kirwan was the first Nittany Lion to register back-to-back multi-goal games since Alex Limoges '21 accomplished that feat during the Big Ten Quarterfinals on March 8-9, 2019, also against Wisconsin.
 - Kirwan is tied for third on the team with 21 points and nine goals marking the most points by a Nittany Lion freshman since the 2017-18 season when Limoges registered 21 points. His nine goals are also the most by a Penn State freshman since Evan Barratt scored 11 during that same 2017-18 campaign.
 - Kirwan's 21 points are tied for the 9th most in program history for a freshman while his nine goals place him ninth for rookies in Penn State history. His 21 points are also tied for 12th in the country and 6th in the Big Ten among freshmen while his nine goals are tied for eighth and third, respectively.
 - Penn State is 12-1-1 this season when a freshman scores a goal including a perfect 7-0-0 when Kirwan lights the lamp.
- ## SEVENTH HEAVEN
- Two weeks ago Penn State racked up seven goals in a game for the first time since beating Michigan 9-5 on December 3, 2020.
 - All-time Penn State has now scored seven or more goals on 25 occasions including seven times in Big Ten contests. Twice each now against Wisconsin, Minnesota and Michigan and once against Notre Dame.

SCHOEN YOU THE WAY

- Freshman Ben Schoen is up to seventh on the team in scoring with six goals and nine assists for 15 points. The rookie had the primary assist on Dzhaniyev's goal last Friday before scoring the equalizer in a 2-2 tie against Ohio State. Schoen then potted the shootout winner to earn Penn State the extra point.
- Schoen had three goals and five points in a two-game stretch in a 7-2 victory over Wisconsin and the 2-2 tie against Ohio State.
- Penn State's scoring has been evenly distributed throughout all four classes this season, however, the freshmen have shined as of late scoring nine of the last 13 goals the Nittany Lions have scored over the past two weekends with Kirwan (4) and Schoen (3) leading the charge.

SHOOTOUT MADNESS

- Last Friday Connor MacEachern kept the shootout rolling with his first career shootout goal and after a Liam Souliere save at one end, Schoen skated down the other end for the magical moment.
- The shootout victory for Penn State was the first in over three calendar years dating back to a victory over Wisconsin on November 30, 2018. Alex Limoges '21 scored the winner that night.
- The shootout was also the first at Pegula Ice Arena in nearly two years dating back to February 7, 2020 also against Ohio State with the Buckeyes earning the extra point that evening.

WELCOME BACK CONNOR MACEACHERN

- After missing the series at Michigan, junior Connor MacEachern returned to the lineup two weeks ago and stretched his point streak to a career-long six games in the process, however, that streak came to an end last weekend against Ohio State.
- MacEachern potted his 12th goal of the season two weeks ago and is now sixth in the Big Ten.
- MacEachern now has five powerplay tallies on the year a mark good for second in the Big Ten, behind Michigan's Matty Beniers with eight, and tied for 14th in the nation.
- The five man-advantage scores for MacEachern are tied for the fifth-most in a single season in Penn State history just one shy of the program record held by four different players.
- MacEachern's powerplay goal was of the 5-on-3 variety giving Penn State it's third such goal this season after going all of the 2020-21 season without a 5-on-3 goal.
- Kirwan's first goal on Friday was also a 5-on-3 goal for Penn State marking the first time in the history of the program that the Nittany Lions have scored a 5-on-3 goal in back-to-back games.

SCOUTING NOTRE DAME



- The Irish enter this weekend having won six of their last eight games including the series sweep against the Nittany Lions last month. Notre Dame is currently ranked 13th in the nation following a series split against No. 8 Minnesota last weekend in South Bend. This weekend brings to an end a five-game homestand for the Irish.
- Notre Dame had a perfect 6-0-0 month of November and the six-game win-streak marked the longest for the Irish since the 2018-19 season.
- Max Ellis leads the team with 15 goals and 25 points. His 15 goals are tied for third in the Big Ten and 12th nationally. Trevor Janicke has added ten goals while Ryder Rolston has chipped in nine. Spencer Stastney leads the Irish with 15 assists. Stastney ranks fourth in the Big Ten for defensemen scoring with 20 points on the season.
- Notre Dame has used a two-goalie system most of the year, however, Ryan Bischel has started five of the last eight games between the pipes since the semester began posting a 4-1-0 record in those starts. Bischel ranks second in the Big Ten with a 2.07 goals-against average behind only Jakub Dobes of Ohio State at 1.98. Matthew Galajda is third in the Big Ten with a 2.13 goals-against average while both goaltenders have a .922 save percentage which ranks tied for fourth in the Big Ten and 17th nationally.
- Notre Dame is one of the best defensive teams year in and year out and that remains true in 2021-22 as the Golden Domers rank second in the Big Ten and ninth nationally allowing just 2.19 goals per game. The Irish PK is also tops in the nation killing off 92.9 percent (92-for-99) of opponent powerplays. ND has allowed just nine powerplay goals this season and have scored five shorthanded goals to lead the Big Ten and rank tied for fourth nationally.
- The Irish have only allowed four goals five times this season and have only yielded five in one game which came just last week in a 5-1 loss to Minnesota. Notre Dame is 16-0-0 this season when scoring three or more goals.
- Notre Dame currently has 8 NHL draft picks on its roster (Jack Adams, Nick Leivermann, Jake Pivonka, Spencer Stastney, Trevor Janicke, Landon Slaggert, Ryder Rolston, Jake Boltmann).





PAULY DEFENSE

• Senior Paul DeNaples has 32 points in his career breaking a tie with Connor Varley for the eighth-most all-time at Penn State for defensemen.

• DeNaples has also moved into the top spot all-time at Penn State for career plus/minus at +53 for his career.

• DeNaples is +14 this season while his defensive partner Clayton Phillips is +15 for a combined +29, the highest mark among a defensive pair in the Big Ten.

JDJ #DODAMAGE

• Sophomore Jimmy Dowd Jr. registered a career-best three assists two weeks ago against Wisconsin tying his career-high with three points.

• Dowd is currently in the middle of a career year with three goals and 16 assists for 19 points surpassing each of his totals from a season ago when he scored twice while adding eight assists for 10 points as a freshman.

• Dowd's 19 points are fifth in the Big Ten among defensemen while his 16 assists are the third most among blue-liners in the conference.

• Dowd's 19 points are also the 10th-most by a defenseman in a single-season in Penn State history while his 16 assists are tied with Luke Juha for the eighth most in a single-season. With 24 career assists, Dowd now ranks ninth all-time at Penn State for defensemen while his 29 career points are tied with Nate Jensen '15 for 10th all-time.

YOU'RE MY WONDERWALL

• Junior Kevin Wall leads the team with 14 goals and 25 points to rank fifth and tied for seventh in the Big Ten. His 14 goals rank 16th nationally.

• Wall collected two assists in each game against Wisconsin a few weeks ago, each of which was a primary assist, giving him seven multi-point games this season and 14 for his career.

THE SWISS ARMY KNIFE

• Senior Adam Pilewicz is in his fifth year with the Nittany Lions and has already skated in a career-high 26 games surpassing the 14 games he played as a sophomore in 2018-19.

• Recruited as a defenseman, Pilewicz played the majority of his 31 career games prior to this season as a forward including both games in 2018-19 when he scored goals. So, his two goals this season are the first of his career at his natural position of defense.

• Prior to winter break in a series at Wisconsin, Pilewicz, who has dressed over half of the games in his career as the extra skater, slotted in on defense one night and then forward the following night after Paul DeNaples and Kevin Wall were each handed game misconduct penalties in consecutive games.

THE BIG GADOWSKY

- Head Coach Guy Gadowsky registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State. Gadowsky is now 169-144-23 all-time behind the Penn State bench.

- The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory in 2019-20 and currently ranks 71st all-time throughout all divisions with 342 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 39th with his 342 wins and is currently 14th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

- Recently coach Gadowsky crafted his own burger that is now available at The Field Burger & Tap. The burger consists of Eleven Oaks Farm Waygu with cheddar cheese, sauteed onions, bacon and sour cream topped with a perogie as the crown jewel all on a brioche roll.

- It should also be noted that associate head coach Keith Fisher has not eaten one single french fry in over 15 years.

• Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 136-of-149 home games where fans were permitted to attend, which included a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season games from March 14, 2014 through November 22, 2019.

• More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 93 occasions including 10 games in 2019-20 while five of the final six home crowds during the 2019-20 season rank in the top-10 all-time in the building including a record crowd of 6,475 against Notre Dame on February 1, 2020.

• In 2019-20, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,990) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (103.6 percent).

• Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its ninth season entering 2021-22. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.

• The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New last season a continuing in 2021-22 is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 22nd collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his 10th at Penn State in 2021-22.

AT PENN STATE

In a season unlike any other in 2020-21, Gadowsky led Penn State back to the Big Ten semifinals for the sixth consecutive season and the seventh time overall as he became the winningest coach in the history of the tournament after securing his 11th victory in B1G tournament play.

The Bench Boss registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State.

Penn State captain Alex Limoges went on to sign an AHL contract with the San Diego Gulls and in just 23 games scored 11 goals while adding 10 assists for 21 points.

Following the season Aarne Talvitie inked his entry-level, NHL contract with the New Jersey Devils while earlier in the season former Nittany Lion Peyton Jones also put pen to paper on an NHL contract giving Penn State six NHL signees in the past two seasons and 10 overall.

Near the conclusion of the 2020-21 NHL season former Penn State forward Brett Murray (2017-18) made his NHL debut with the Buffalo Sabres becoming the second Nittany Lions to skate in an NHL contest.

Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship during the 2019-20 season with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.

Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October against Sacred Heart.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucese landed on the Second-Team West while also

being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucese took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nit-

tany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual



national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 cam-

paign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning record in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn

State faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, and capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to double-digit wins (13-14-0) during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13, with several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA in 2011-12, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

Before arriving in Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Gadowsky took a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and guided it to both the ECAC Hockey Tournament and Ivy League crowns in 2007-08. The team earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1998, and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he took a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's

arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign and garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. A three-time WCHA All-Academic team member, he collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, the Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season..

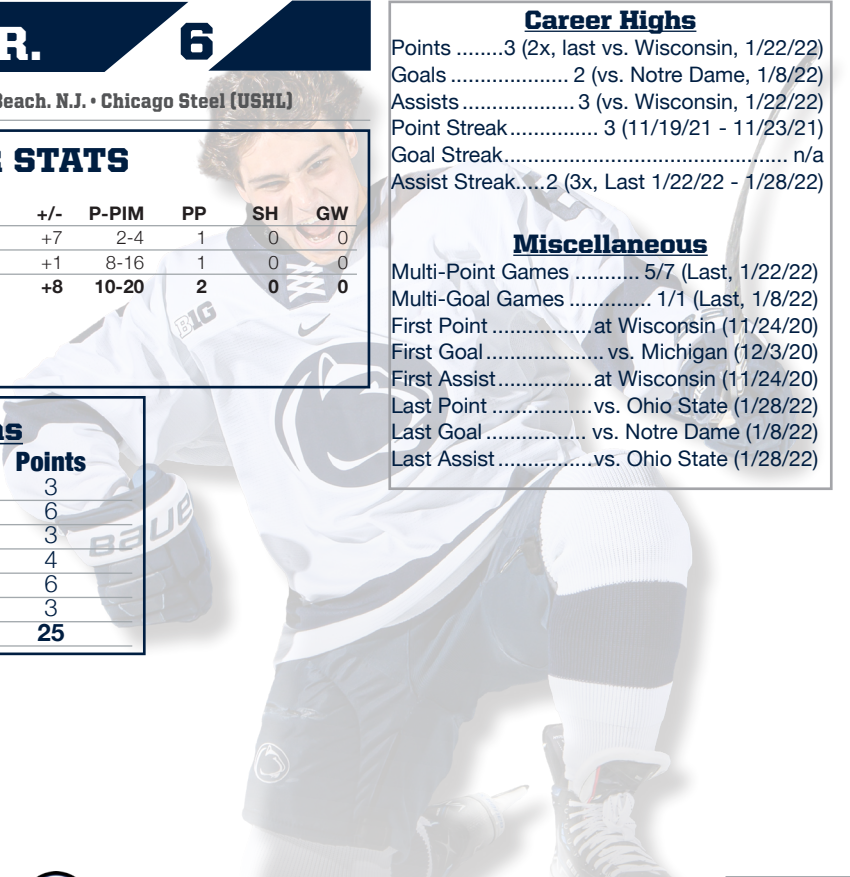

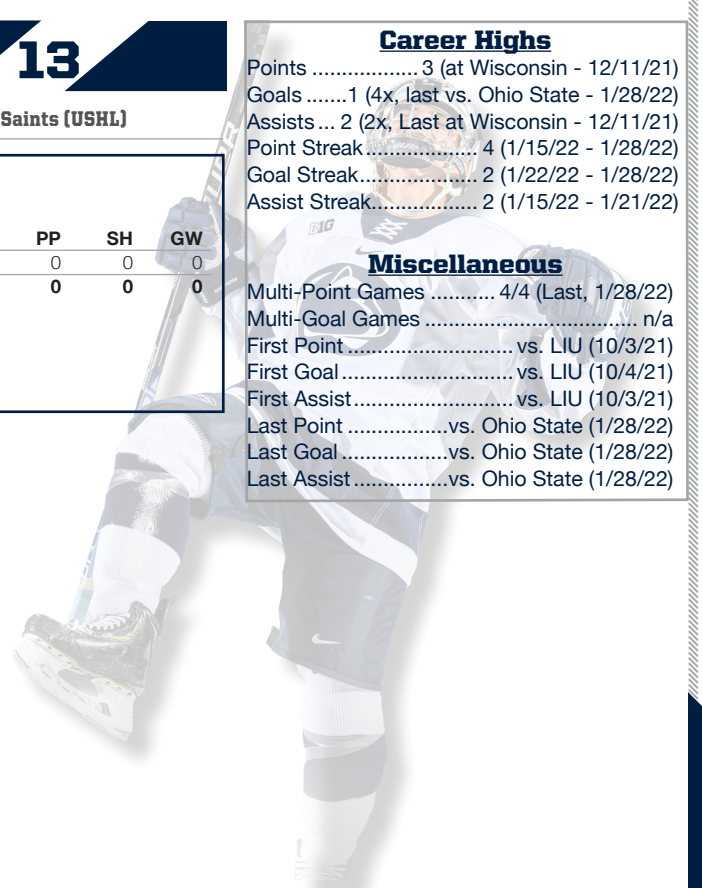

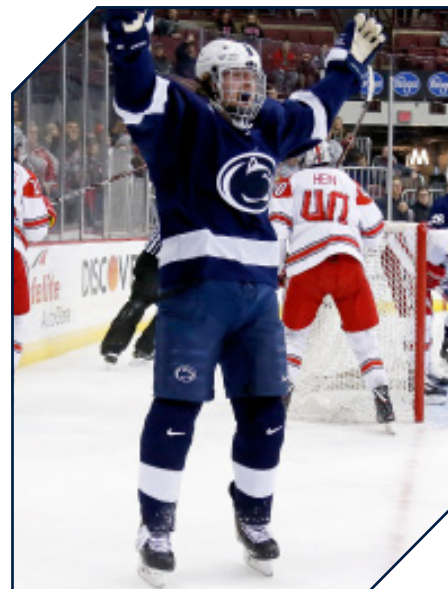
