### LEADING OFF

- Penn State visits Ohio State a key three-game series, beginning on Friday.
- The Nittany Lions have won 10 of their last 13 games, dating back to a win over Purdue on April 16.
- PSU snapped a six-game win streak at Georgetown on Tuesday.
  - The Nittany Lions are coming off a three-game sweep over Michigan State.
- Penn State swept Sunday's doubleheader, winning 15-3 and 10-4.
- On Monday, the Nittany Lions walked it off in the 11th on a bases-loaded walk by Johnny Piacentino for a 10-9 win.
- In Monday's win, Jay Harry set a program record with six hits, including a double, and scored three runs. Matt Wood batted .500 in the series with a double, two homers. six runs and seven RBI.
- Harry's six hits are tied for the most in a Division I game this season. Wood ranks seventh in the nation in batting average (.414) and 13th in on-base percentage (.505), leading the Big Ten in both categories.
- Wood has reached base in 27-straight games.

Wood Leading Big Ten In Batting Average

- Through 44 games played, junior Matt Wood is batting .414 with 12 doubles, three triples, eight homers, 44 RBI and 42 runs.
- He leads the Big Ten in batting average (.414), good for seventh in the country and second among Division I catchers. He also paces the conference in on-base percentage (.505), sitting 13th in the nation.
- In batting average, Wood is 22 points ahead of the second-highest average in the Big Ten.
- Wood also sits second in the Big Ten in hits per game (1.48), slugging percentage (.682) and OPS (1.187), fourth in triples (3) and sixth in hits (65).
- Wood leads the Nittany Lions in batting average, hits, runs, triples, homers, RBI, walks (30), slugging percentage and on-base percentage. He's tied with Ben Kailher for the team lead in steals (5).
- Among Division I catchers, Wood ranks second in batting average and on-base percentage, fourth in OPS, sixth in triples and ninth in slugging percentage.
- The lefty batter has been impressive facing righty (.400) and lefty (.447) pitchers.
- Wood is batting .514 with runners in scoring position.
- In Big Ten play, Wood is hitting .478 with 32 hits in 18 games. He has six doubles, two triples, four homers and 23 RBI. He has an OPS of 1.318.
- Wood paces PSU with 22 multi-hit games and 10 multi-RBI games this season and tallied a 26-game hit streak, which was snapped at Georgetown. The 26-game streak is the second-longest in program history behind only Michael Campo (41, 2000).
- During the 26-game hit streak, Wood had 15 multi-hit performances. He batted .469 (45-of-96) with eight doubles, two triples and four homers. He also drew 16 walks and three hit-by-pitches.

#### Pennsylvania Influence In Pitching Staff

- In 40 of 45 games this season, Penn State's starting pitcher has been a PA native.
- Sophomore Travis Luensmann (Altoona) has made 10 starts, and 12 appearances, with 64 strikeouts in 54.1 innings. Luensmann struck out eight in six innings against Maine (2/25).
- In Big Ten games, Luensmann has a 2.77 ERA in six appearances (four starts), sitting third in the conference.
- Freshman Tommy Molsky has made 10 starts, and 13 appearances, tallying 39 strikeouts. Molsky tied a career high with six strikeouts against UMass (3/12).
- Graduate student Mason Mellott has made four starts and 17 appearances.
- Mellott, graduating in August 2021 with a bachelor's degree in Kinesiology, is tied third all-time at Penn State with 15 saves and ranks third with 84 appearances, one appearance away from tying David Lutz (2007-10) for second.
  - Junior Kellan Tulio has made eight starts and 12 appearances. with 39 strikeouts and a 4.50 ERA. He threw five innings, allowing no earned runs, and struck out a career-high seven at Northwestern (4/9).
  - Jaden Henline has struck out 50 batters in 50 innings and sits fourth in the Big Ten in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.85). He threw a complete game to earn the win against Michigan State (5/8), allowing three runs (two earned) and striking out six. It was PSU's first complete game since Greg Welsh vs. Michigan State on May 17, 2013.
- Senior Pittsburgh native Steven Miller made his first career start at Northwestern (4/9), throwing three shutout innings and striking out three. He has 29 strikeouts.
- Senior Tyler Shingledecker has made 17 appearances and three starts with a team-high five wins. The lefty has held opponents without an earned run in 10 of his 17 outings. He has 44 strikeouts and only 11 walks.
- Junior Souderton native Jordan Morales leads PSU with 22 appearances and has 48 strikeouts and only nine walks. He is 3-0 on the season.
- Carson Kohls has been another effective member out of the bullpen in 13 appearances (one start), including three scoreless outings where he went three or more innings.
- Entering the season, Penn State was challenged with replacing a 2021 rotation that featured three MLB draft selections in Conor Larkin (9th round, Toronto Blue Jays), Kyle Virbitsky (17th round, Oakland A's) and Bailey Dees (18th round, New York Yankees).
- The Nittany Lions were one of only four Division I schools to have all three members of their starting rotation selected. Penn State has eight pitchers who have been drafted since 2016.

#### **Penn State Hitting Stride**

- The Nittany Lions won six-straight games between April 27 and May 9 and won 10 of their last 12 games before falling at Georgetown.
- Penn State has won three-straight Big Ten series for the first time since 2012 and is coming off a three-game sweep over Michigan State.
  Over the 12 games, Penn State hit .307 as a team with 131 hits and 94 runs. The Nittany Lions tallied 45 extra-base hits.
- Matt Wood led five batters hitting over .300 during that stretch with a .442 average. Jay Harry (.417), Josh Spiegel (.404), Derek Cease (.360) and Cole Bartels (.302) also hit over .300. Spiegel had 21 hits, Harry had 20 and Wood had 19.
- Over those 12 games, Penn State has a 4.38 team ERA. Mason Mellott is 2-0 with an 0.73 ERA in five appearances.

#### **Nittany Lions Finding Power In Big Ten Play**

- In 18 Big Ten games, Penn State has collected 61 extra-base hits, including 31 doubles, 10 triples and 20 homers.
- Matt Wood leads the Nittany Lions with 12 extra-base hits, including six doubles, two triples and four homers, to go with 23 RBI.
- Jay Harry has 11 extra base hits (five doubles, two triples, four homers), while Josh Spiegel has 10 (five doubles, one triple, four homers). Spiegel has 19 RBI, while Harry has scored 17 runs.
- On the season, Wood leads PSU with eight homers to go with 12 doubles, while Spiegel paces PSU with 14 doubles. Spiegel has seven homers and 35 RBI this season, while Jay Harry has five homers. Billy Gerlott has four homers.
- Penn State has already recorded 16 triples this season, leading the Big Ten, and sits just two off the program record, accomplished in 1986, 2007 and 2010.
- Led by Wood, Tayven Kelley and Johnny Piacentino's three triples, six Nittany Lions have multiple triples this season.

# THE OPPOSITION

#### **Scouting Ohio State**

- Ohio State head coach Greg Beals is in his 12th season coaching the Buckeyes.
- Beals is 342-286-1 in his time leading Ohio State. He has guided Ohio State to three NCAA Regional appearances and two Big Ten Championships.
- Ohio State is 17-28 overall and 6-13 in the Big Ten this season.
- The Buckeyes are batting .278 as a team with three members of the lineup batting above .300.
- Marcus Ernst leads OSU with a .349 average and 60 hits. Brent Todys, the reigning Big Ten Player of the Week, is hitting .321 with four homers, while Zach Dezenzo has team highs with 16 doubles, 13 homers, 44 RBI and 47 runs.
- Isaiah Coupet ranks second in the Big Ten with 84 strikeouts and leads the conference with 14.18 per nine innings, good for fifth in the country.
- Wyatt Loncar is 1-4 with a 4.66 ERA in 12 appearances (nine starts), while Nate Haberthier has a .635 ERA in 11 starts.

#### **Against The Buckeyes**

- The Nittany Lions will Ohio State for the 111th time in program history on Friday.
- Ohio State is one of five opponents Penn State has played more than 100 times, joining Bucknell (131-31-1), Michigan (49-51), Pitt (88-46-1) and West Virginia (72-43).
- In last season's series, the Nittany Lions won the series finale, 10-6.
- Tayven Kelley hit a two-run homer, while Matt Wood had three hits and three runs. Mason Mellott closed out the game with four shutout frames.



#### **Head Coach**

The 2022 baseball season is Rob Cooper's ninth as head coach of the Nittany Lion baseball program. Cooper was selected as the 14th head baseball coach in Penn State history on August 9, 2013. Not shy about stating his ultimate goal of returning Penn State to Omaha in June, the Lions have made significant strides under his leadership.

Under his tutelage, 11 players have been drafted and 12 total have signed with MLB teams in the last four seasons with a full draft. However, his strong belief in the first part of the term "student-athlete" is perhaps the top reason he has proven to be an excellent fit at Penn State. Even with state-of-the-art facilities, the chance to take on elite competition and a program history that includes five trips to the College World Series, Cooper cites the value of a Penn State degree as one of the top reasons to play baseball at Penn State.

The Nittany Lions finished the 2021 season with an 18-24 record, playing against exclusively Big Ten opponents. The wins included a 3-2 victory over No. 18 Michigan on March 26 and a series sweep over Michigan State in which Penn State out-scored the Spartans, 39-13. The Nittany Lions also won two series against Rutgers. Penn State scored 10 or more runs in six games, Penn State's most against Big Ten opponents since 2008 (8) and the most in a season since 2016.

Penn State led the Big Ten in doubles (93) and doubles per game (2.21), ranking 10th in the country in doubles per game. The Nittany Lions sat third in the conference in batting average (.269). Penn State hit 34 home runs, its most since 2012, and had five players with four or more homers.

Sophomore Matt Wood collected Second Team All-Big Ten honors, batting .295 with four homers and 21 RBI. Wood became the fifth All-Big Ten selection under Cooper. Senior Gavin Homer led the Nittany Lions with a .310 batting average, a .429 on-base percentage and tied with Johnny Piacentino for the team-lead in runs (30). Junior Justin Williams hit .302 and paced Penn State with 48 hits. Piacentino led the squad with eight homers and 32 RBI to go with a team-best .525 slugging percentage.

Senior Kyle Virbitsky paced the Penn State rotation with a 4.17 ERA, five wins, 77.2 innings pitched and 88 strikeouts. Virbitsky ranked seventh in the Big Ten in strikeouts and third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.40). His 88 strikeouts are tied for the 10th-most in a season at Penn State. Senior Conor Larkin earned three wins and 69 strikeouts in 63.2 innings and fellow senior Bailey Dees was responsible for four wins and 53 strikeouts in 66 innings.

The Nittany Lions continued their success in the classroom with a program-record 19 players earning Academic All-Big Ten accolades.

Penn State had four players drafted from the 2021 squad. Larkin was selected in the ninth round (272nd overall) by the Toronto Blue Jays. Williams was a 17th round selection (508th overall) by the Houston Astros and Kyle Virbitsky followed, being selected 518th overall by the Oakland A's. Bailey Dees was drafted in the 18th round (543rd overall) by the New York Yankees. All three members of the starting rotation were drafted, making Penn State one of only four schools to accomplish that in 2021.

It marked the third time in program history that Penn State had four or more players selected in a single year and the second time that Penn State had three pitchers selected in a draft. The Nittany Lions have had eight pitchers drafted since 2016. The four selections were double of any other Pennsylvania school and three of the draftees are Pennsylvania natives. Penn State was off to a 10-5 start in 2020 before the COVID-19 pandemic canceled the remainder of the season. Penn State was among the conference leaders offensively, ranking second in on-base percentage (.394), slugging (.422), triples (7), doubles (30), third in batting average (.289) and walks (77), and fourth in scoring (6.7 runs/game) and runs (100). On the mound, Penn State ranked sixth in the NCAA with a 1.01 WHIP and also eighth with a 2.16 team ERA. The Nittany Lions also ranked 15th with 6.33 hits allowed per nine innings and 18th with a 3.63 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

Penn State baseball's trip to Cuba prior to the 2016 season is perhaps the best example of Cooper's commitment to the first part of the "studentathlete" term. The Nittany Lions attended academic lectures and toured Havana, becoming the first NCAA Division I team to compete against a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. team at any level to defeat a Cuban National Series team, the first U.S. baseball team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties with Cuba, the second NCAA team to play in Cuba since restoration of diplomatic ties (Coastal Carolina men's basketball, August 2015) and the fifth NCAA Division I baseball team to compete in post-revolutionary Cuba. The harmony between academics and athletics was on full display, as multiple Penn State professors and a group of journalism students also joined the travel party.

The rare, once-in-a-lifetime experience helped bring a young Penn State team together, and the Lions went on to earn their first winning record (overall and in conference) since 2012. The starting lineup included at least three freshmen in all but six games and five to six freshmen in 19 games, and took on nine eventual NCAA tournament teams, including a three-game series at home against College World Series participant TCU. The Lions' 28 wins were a 10-win improvement over the previous season, and its 12 Big Ten wins doubled the 2015 total. Haley and Anderson were the first drafted out of Penn State since 2012, and Anderson and senior outfielder Greg Guers became the program's first All-Big Ten picks also since 2012. Pitcher Justin Hagenman became Penn State's first Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American since 1997.

Shortly after Cooper accepted the PSU head coaching position in 2014, the California native traveled to Taichung, Taiwan to serve as the head coach of USA Baseball's 18U National Team at the IBAF U18 World Cup. Cooper steered Team USA to an 8-1 record in World Cup play, including seven consecutive victories to win the gold medal.

Not long after the triumph in Taiwan, Cooper received one of the highest honors bestowed in the profession, as he was announced as the Rod Dedeaux USA Baseball Coach of the Year. With the honor, Cooper became just the 16th individual in the award's history to receive the accolade, joining the likes of Scott Brosius, Davey Johnson and Tommy Lasorda.

Cooper was also a member of the coaching staff for the 2007 and 2009 USA College National teams. The 2007 team earned a silver medal at the Pan Am Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Fourteen of the 20 players on the 2007 team reached the Major Leagues, including 2013 All-Star Pedro Alvarez. Fourteen of the 22 members of the 2009 team also reached the Major Leagues, including three-time All-Star Gerrit Cole.

Cooper brought an accomplished resume to Penn State that included three NCAA Tournament appearances as a head coach at Wright State and five more at various stops as an assistant coach, including two trips to the College World Series with Miami (Florida). Cooper was twice named the Horizon League Coach of the Year and guided Wright State to three league tournament championships and two regular-season championships after the team suffered six losing seasons in the seven years before his arrival.

Cooper began his coaching career at national power Miami, spending two seasons (1994-95) as a student/graduate assistant on the Hurricanes' staff. While at Miami, Cooper helped the Hurricanes to College World Series berths in 1994 and 1995. Cooper spent the 1996 season as an assistant and team academic coordinator at Wake Forest, then moved on to Tulane for the next two seasons, serving as the Green Wave's hitting coach. In 1997, the Green Wave won the Conference USA regular-season crown, and in 1998, they advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Cooper left Tulane following the 1998 season and returned to Sacramento City College, where he starred in the early 1990's before lettering at Miami in 1993.

Along with his college coaching experience, Cooper also was an associate scout for the Los Angeles Dodgers from 1990-92 and has been selected to four coaching stints with USA Baseball in 2000, 2007, 2009 and 2013.

Cooper earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Miami in 1994 and a master's in sports sciences/administration from Miami in 1996. He is married to his wife, Maureen, and has two sons, Jake and Tyson, who are both current members of the Penn State baseball team.
