QUICK HITS

- Penn State, the 13th-seed in the Big Ten Tournament, will take on fifth-seeded Iowa in the second round of the league tourney at approximately 2:30 p.m. ET/1:30 CT Thursday in Chicago's United Center. It is the second of four second-round games and will be broadcast on BTN.
- The Nittany Lions defeated Nebraska in first-round action, 68-65, Wednesday. **D.J. NEWBILL** scored 26 points and **BRANDON TAYLOR** produced five blocks with both figures tying PSU tourney records. As a team, Penn State tallied 16 blocks, an all-time program best and record for the Big Ten Tournament. [MORE: Page 3]
- Penn State fell in overtime to Iowa in the lone regular-season meeting, 81-77, Feb. 28 in University Park. Four players scored in double-figures and the team out-shot and out-rebounded the Hawkeyes, while also producing a total of 10 3-pointers in the loss. The Lions turned the ball over, down one, with 30 seconds remaining in OT and Iowa finished 6-6 from the free-throw line for the win. [MORE: Page 2]
- **D.J. NEWBILL** was selected by both coaches and media to the All-Big Ten Second Team Monday. He also was a second-team honoree a year ago and an honorable mention selection in 2012-13. He is the first player to lead the league in scoring and not be named to the first team since 2006.
- Penn State is 10-17 in the Big Ten Tournament since the event began in 1998. The Lions have one appearance in the championship game (2011). The win over Nebraska Wednesday is the program's first B1G tourney win since 2011. [MORE: Page 4]
- Twelve players on the 2014-15 roster have now seen action in the Big Ten Tournament, led by **ROSS TRAVIS'** four appearances. **D.J. NEWBILL** has averaged 20.7 ppg in three tournament games and has the eighth-most points among PSU players all-time. [MORE: Page 3]
- **D.J. NEWBILL** passed both 600 (667) points on the season and 2,000 (2,068) for his career vs. Ohio State March 4. He has led the Big Ten in scoring since the season tipped off, averaging 20.8 ppg to lead all NCAA players from Power 5 conferences and own the No. 7 spot in Division I. He is fourth in Penn State career scoring, after three seasons, and owns two spots in single-season scoring records.
- In the last five games, there are three players averaging in double figures. Newbill is producing 19.2 ppg with 10+ points of support from **SHEP GARNER** (12.8) and **GENO THORPE** (11.0).
- With a 17-15 record on the year, Penn State's 17 wins are a season-best for head coach **PATRICK CHAMBERS** and the most since 2011, topped only twice in the last decade and four times since 2000. A winning season is guaranteed for the fifth time since 2000 and first time since 2011.
- Through 32 games, Penn State has had 14 decided by five points or fewer, including 13 in the regular season. Overall, Penn State moves to 9-5 in five-point games this year. In Big Ten Tournament games all-time, Penn State is now 5-4 tournament games decided by five points or less.

THE MATCHUP

SCOUTING IOWA

- Winners in each of their last six games, Iowa enters the Big Ten Tournament with a 21-10 record and a final mark of 12-6 in league play, finishing tied for third. The Hawkeyes are the fifth seed based on tie-breakers.
- Since last facing Penn State, Iowa has gone 2-0 and finished the regular season with a 69-52 win over Northwestern.
- During Iowa's six-game win streak, First Team All-Big Ten selection Aaron White is averaging 21.2 points and 9.2 rebounds with one turnover.
- White is leading the team in scoring and rebounding with 15.9 ppg and 7.4 rpg, respectively. He recently moved into No. 4 all-time in Iowa career scoring.
- Jarrod Uthoff is second with 12.2 ppg, an average which goes up to 13.3 ppg in Big Ten play. Uthoff shoots nearly 40 percent from behind the arc and has a team-high 53 triples.

SERIES HISTORY

- Iowa holds a 27-13 advantage in the series vs. Penn State and has won seven of the last nine meetings, with the two Nittany Lion wins coming at the Bryce Jordan Center.
- The Hawkeyes took the lone meeting this season, an 81-77 overtime decision Feb. 28 in the BJC.
- Penn State and Iowa have met just once in Big Ten Tournament play, with the Hawkeyes winning 94-74 March 10, 2001, in the United Center. Gyasi Cline-Heard finished with a team-leading 26 points for the Nittany Lions, the point scoring record D.J. Newbill tied Wednesday vs. Nebraska.

LAST TIME VS. THE HAWKEYES

UNIVERSITY PARK (Feb. 28, 2015) - Despite double figure scoring from four Nittany Lions, Penn State up short in an 81-77 OT loss to Iowa at the Bryce Jordan Center. Aaron White stole an in-bounds pass with 30 seconds left in overtime and converted on 6-6 free throws down the stretch.

D.J. Newbill scored 19 points for Penn State. Shep Garner added 17 points, Geno Thorpe 14 and Ross Travis 10 for the Nittany Lions.

Iowa's Aaron White scored 21 points, including six free throws in overtime, and the Hawkeyes were able to scrape past Penn State. Mike Gesell (14), Gabriel Olaseni (12), Josh Oglesby (12) and Jarrod Uthoff (11) also scored in double figures for the Hawkeyes (19-10, 10-6 Big Ten), who were 25 of 27 from the free-throw line.

14-15 NITTANY LIONS VS. IOWA

Thirteen players on the current roster have seen action vs. the Hawkeyes, including 10 in the first meeting this season. D.J. Newbill leads all players with 21.8 ppg and 6.3 rpg after putting up 19 and five, respectively, Feb. 28 in the Bryce Jordan Center.

THREE NOTABLE GAMES

Feb. 16, 2012 (PSU, 69-64): Having reduced a 16-point Penn State lead to three with 24 seconds to play, Iowa intentionally put redshirt freshman Jon Graham on the foul line. He hit both to effectively ice a 69-64 victory for the Nittany Lions.

Jan. 26, 2011 (PSU, 65-51): One of the two home games in the last eight not separated by five or fewer points was decided by Talor Battle's 23-point outing that gave Penn State its third-consecutive Big Ten home win.

March 27, 1995 (PSU, 67-64): Pete Lisicky nailed a 3-pointer with 2.1 seconds left to send the Nittany Lions to the semifinals of the NIT.

TEAM

- The Nittany Lions advanced to the second round of the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2011 with a 68-65 victory over Nebraska.
- D.J. Newbill tied a single-game PSU Big Ten Tournament record with a game-high 26 points, matching Tim Frazier (vs. Indiana, 2012) and Gyasi Cline-Heard (vs. Iowa, 2001). Shep Garner joined Newbill in double figures with 19 points. Together, the duo had 45 of Penn State's 68 points, while also combining for nine triples.
- Penn State finished with 16 blocks to set both a Big Ten Tournament and a PSU program record, as four different Nittany Lions recorded multi-block performances. The mark is the most for the Nittany Lions in a Big Ten tournament game since PSU notched eight against Indiana, 3/8/12.
- Brandon Taylor led the team with a game-high five blocks, which matches a Penn State Big Ten Tournament single-game record originally set by Calvin Booth against Northwestern in 1999.
- Penn State recorded nine blocks in the first half alone to set the tone. Taylor led the way with three, while Julian Moore added two.
- The Nittany Lions have a total of three players in the Penn State Top 10 in the blocks category, with Donovan Jack leading the way at No. 7 with 82 career blocks. Jordan Dickerson is ninth with 79 while Taylor is 10th with 74.
- Through 32 games, Penn State has had 14 decided by five points or fewer, including 13 in the regular season. Overall, Penn State moves to 9-5 in five-point games this year. In Big Ten Tournament games, Penn State is now 5-4 tournament games decided by five points or less.
- The Penn State bench outscored the Husker bench 15-10, marking the 16th time this season PSU's Bench Mob has won the advantage.
- With a 17-15 record on the year, Penn State's 17 wins are a season-best for head coach Patrick Chambers and the most since 2011, topped only twice in the last decade and four times since 2000.

D.J. NEWBILL, senior guard

- The All-Big Ten Second Team selection led the team with 26 points for his 17th 20-plus point scoring performance of the season. His game-high total also matched Tim Frazier (vs. Indiana, 2012) and Gyasi Cline-Heard (vs. Iowa, 2001) for the most amount of points scored in a Big Ten Tournament game.
- In three career Big Ten Tournament games, Newbill has recorded at least 20 points in two of the three outings (20 vs. Michigan; 2013). He's averaging a team-high 20.6 points per game in Big Ten

Tournament action. His 62 career Big Ten tourney points are also tied for eighth in PSU history with David Jackson (2008-11).

- Newbill drained four triples, for a 4-8 mark from behind the arc. He's tallied at least three 3-pointers in three of the last four games.
- Set a career-high mark with a team-high four blocks. His tally is the second most in a Big Ten Tournament single game.

BRANDON TAYLOR, junior forward

- Taylor set a career-high mark with five blocks to match a PSU Big Ten tournament record originally set by Calvin Booth vs. Northwestern in 1999. His mark also ties for third on the entire Big Ten Tournament single-game list.
- With a game-high five blocks, improved his career total to 74, to move up to No. 10 on the PSU all-time list with 74 blocks, tying Geary Claxton (2005-08).

SHEP GARNER, freshman guard

- Garner recorded double digit scoring with a career-high 19 points, to mark his third double figure scoring performance in the last four games.
- He led the team with a career-high five triples, shooting 5-8 from 3-point range. Garner has had at least one 3-pointer in all but four games this season and multiple treys in 16 games, including four of the last five outings.
- Garner also chipped in a career-high three steals.

JULIAN MOORE, redshirt freshman forward

- Matched a career-high mark with two blocks for his third consecutive outing with at least two blocks.

JORDAN DICKERSON, junior center

- With one block, Dickerson is in ninth place on the PSU all-time list with 79 career blocks. He needs one more block to match Jeff Brooks (2008-11) for eighth place (80).

DONOVON JACK, junior forward

- With three blocks, Jack moved into sole possession of seventh place on the PSU all-time list with 82 career blocks. He's notched at least one block in three of his last four appearances on the court.

DEVIN FOSTER, junior guard

- Foster had a career-high outing on the boards, grabbing a team-high eight rebounds, with seven off the defensive glass.

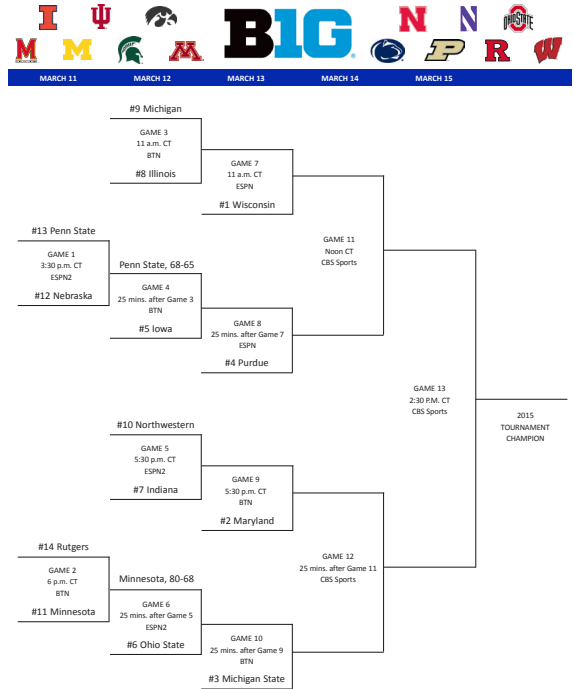
