SCOUTING THE FIGHTING ILLINI

Illinois comes into the weekend with an 11-2 overall record and are 2-0 in Big Ten play after taking down Northwestern and Indiana in consecutive 3-0 sweeps. The Fighting Illini are averaging 13.9 kills per set, on a clip of .311, which is currently the 8th highest hitting percentage. Defensively, Illinois is the third in the nation at 3.29 blocks per set, and are leading the Big Ten. Ali Bastianelli, a junior middle blocker, is a key reason as to why the Illini are such a good blocking team as she is the national leader of blocks per set at 1.90. She is also effective on offense at fourth in the nation in hitting percentage at 0.491.

SCOUTING THE WILDCATS

Northwestern holds 10-4 record entering the weekend, but will head to Rutgers for their first match of the weekend. The Wildcats are currently 0-2 in league play after falling to then-ranked No.13 Purdue and Illinois, who is receiving votes. Northwestern is currently 11th in the nation, and lead the conference in aces per set at 1.77. The highlight of the Wildcats lineup is Symone Abbott. The outside hitter leads the conference in points per set at 4.93, while being second for kills per set at 4.37.

FIRST SERVE

>> Last week in the Big 10, the top three ranked teams were knocked off by lower-ranked opponents. The weekend started with then-unranked Michigan State knocking off No. 5 Wisconsin, 3-2; 14-25, 25-18, 25-22, 22-25, 15-13, and it followed with then-No. 14 Nebraska taking down the then-ranked No. 2 Nittany Lions, in three, 26-24, 25-19, 25-20. The weekend closed out with Michigan State sweeping then-No. 1 Minnesota in three, 25-18, 25-23, 25-22, on the Gophers' home court.

>> In the week five American Volleyball Coaches poll, Penn State rolled in tied for the No. 3 spot with fellow Big Ten member Minnesota. Wisconsin and Nebraska rounded out the Big Ten top-10 teams as they were ranked No. 7 and 8 respectively. After their brilliant weekend of play, Michigan State catapulted to No. 16 from unranked, and Purdue pick up a No. 19 ranking. Michigan was the final Big Ten team ranked at No. 23, while Illinois and Ohio State both are receiving votes.

>> Simone Lee has racked up a team-best 175 kills so far this season and is just 29 kills from the elusive 1,000 kills club. She is on pace to join teammate Ali Frantti as active members of the club. Currently Missouri State, Jacksonville State, Kansas, Fairfield, and Sam Houston State are the only squads to have two active 1,000 kill hitters.

>> Since 1979 under Coach Russ Rose, the Nittany Lions have had a 389-56 (.874) record during September. However, since 1995, the Lions are 231-22 for a 91.3-percent mark.

LAST TIME OUT VS. ILLINOIS

-No. 15 Penn State pushed past Illinois in four sets (25-18, 26-24, 19-25, 25-21), to close out the regular season Saturday evening.

-Four Nittany Lions recorded double figure kills in tonight's match. Junior Simone Lee led the offense posting 20 kills and junior Ali Frantti finished second on the team with 16 kills. Junior Haleigh Washington and junior Heidi Thelen each tallied 10 kills apiece.

-The Nittany Lions out-dug the Fighting Illini 46-45, led by a match-high 16 digs from freshman Kendall White.

-Penn State out-aced Illinois, 6-3, thanks to service aces by three Nittany Lions. Junior Abby Detering and freshman Kendall White led the way registering a pair of aces each.

LAST TIME OUT VS. NORTHWESTERN

- Then-ranked No. 15 Penn State defeated Northwestern in three sets (25-23, 25-23, 25-16) Friday evening.

- Five Nittany Lions recorded five or more kills in tonight's match. Junior Ali Frantti led the offense posting 11 kills. Lee (9), Washington (8) Gorrell (6) and Thelen (5) each hit the benchmark as well.

- The Nittany Lions out-blocked the Wildcats in tonight's match 6.0-4.0. Four Nittany Lions had multi-block nights. Thelen led the team with four, while Washington (3), Gorrell (3) and Frantti (2) each had multiple stuffs as well.

- Penn State hit .379 on the night. It marks the 19th time that PSU has hit over .300 this season.

- With her seventh kill of the night, junior Simone Lee surpassed Deja McClendon for fifth place in single season kills during the 25-point rally scoring era.

- With 11 kills in the match, junior Ali Frantti is just now 64 kills shy of becoming the 26th member of Penn State's 1,000 kill club.

LEE POSTS RECORD DAY IN WIN OVER TEXAS A&M

Simone Lee put down 30 kills for just the second time in her career as she helped the Nittany Lions to a 3-2 win over Texas A&M in the Aggies' home arena. Lee (Menomonee Falls, Wis.) found her offensive rhythm early against the Aggies and tallied 12 kills through the first two sets alone. The senior finished the match with 30 at a clip of .456. She was reliable through each set, providing offense both in the front row and with a thundering back row attack.

AVCA POLL: RELEASE #5

Penn State dropped to No. 3 team in the nation with the AVCA Poll released Sept. 25.

RECORD AGAINST 2017 OPPONENTS

Penn State owns a 600-115 (.839) combined series record against its 2017 opponents, including a 454-66 (.873) mark in Big Ten matches since joining the conference in 1991. The Nittany Lions own a 539-104-1 (.840) mark all-time against current Big Ten opponents.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Including a 16-2 mark in 2016, Penn State owns a 611-38 (.942) all-time record at home in Rec Hall. Penn State is 269-22 all-time against current Big Ten opponents at Rec Hall. Only the Buckeyes have defeated the Nittany Lions on their home court more than three times in program history, having topped PSU five times. Illinois, Minnesota, Michigan State and Nebraska are the only four teams to beat PSU at home more than once.

BIG TEN COACHES SELECT PENN STATE TO WIN 2017 CONFERENCE TITLE

Penn State opens the season ranked No. 1 in the Big Ten Preseason Poll, released by the conference early this week. The Big Ten Preseason poll is selected by votes from all 14 conference head coaches.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN NITTANY LIONS

Seniors Ali Frantti, Simone Lee and Haleigh Washington have been named to the 2017 Preseason Big Ten Volleyball Team. It's the third time Frantti and Washington have earned the preseason honors and the first year for Lee to be included on the list.

MR. 1,200

With a 3-0 win over Michigan State on Sept. 30, 2016, Russ Rose became the first active Division I volleyball coach to reach the 1,200-win mark. Rose holds the title of winningest coach in Division I, tallying a 1,213-196 record to date. Following the retirement of Hawaii's Dave Shoji, Rose is the only active coach with 1,200 or more Division I wins. Along with Shoji and former UCLA head coach Andy Banachowski, the three are the only DI coaches in NCAA women's volleyball coaching history to total 1,100 or more DI victories.

AVCA ALL-AMERICANS

Two Nittany Lions were selected to the AVCA DI All-America teams in 2016. Haleigh Washington and Simone Lee both landed on the first team, marking Washington's second selection and Lee's first.

Penn State has earned at least three selections to one of the three AVCA All-America teams in 10 of the last 11 seasons, bolstering the Nittany Lions' total number of All-America honors to 91 since 1979. Hall of Fame head coach Russ Rose has also mentored at least one All-American in 37 of his 38 seasons at Penn State.

LEE, WASHINGTON, FRANTTI GARNER AVCA ALL-REGION RECOGNITION

A trio Penn State women's volleyball juniors were named to the AVCA Northeast Region team. Outside hitter Simone Lee and middle blocker Haleigh Washington were both named to the regional team with Lee earning her first honors and Washington her second consecutive nod. Classmate Ali Frantti was named an honorable mention. The three all-region honors brings Penn State's total number of selections to 93 in program history.

FOUR NITTANY LIONS GARNER POSTSEASON BIG TEN HONORS

Penn State saw four members of the team land postseason Big Ten honors, with Simone Lee and Haleigh Washington both earning unanimous All-Big Ten honors as juniors, while Tori Gorrell and Kendall White made the All-Freshmen Team.

The honor marked Lee's first time being named to the All-Big Ten Team. Washington's selection marks her fourth annual Big Ten honor – she was a unanimous All-Big Ten selection in 2015 and named B1G Freshman of the Year as well as a member of the All-Big Ten Team in 2014. Lee and Washington became Penn State's 80th and 81st All-Big Ten performers. The duo were two of 10 unanimous selections. Gorrell and White were the 18th and 19th Big Ten All-Freshman Team selections.

RUSS ROSE AT A GLANCE

It's been nearly four decades since Russ Rose arrived on campus. Entering his 39th season, the AVCA Hall of Fame head coaches' record-setting seven NCAA national titles and 16 Big

Ten championships speak directly to the confidence and character he's passed along throughout his career.

As each year passes, his list of accomplishments continue to swell, but a quick snapshot of his legendary tenure might read something like this: The leader of a women's volleyball powerhouse who's kept his program among the nation's elite for nearly 40 years, guiding his teams to a record-setting seven NCAA national titles, including an unprecedented four consecutive championships from 2007-10. Along with 16 Big Ten titles, his program is one of only two women's volleyball schools to compete in all 36 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball National Championship events. He's produced four AVCA National Players of the Year, 13 Big Ten Conference Players of the Year and at least one AVCA All-American in 37 of 38 seasons. His student-athletes excel in the classroom as well, with an outstanding 182 Academic All-Big Ten selections and 12 Academic All-Americans who have earned 18 selections.

WASHINGTON A COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

Penn State's Haleigh Washington earned third-team CoSIDA Academic All-America honors during the 2016 season for her second overall Academic All-America selection after being named to the second team in 2015.

Washington was selected from a group of more than 40 student-athletes who earned academic all-district honors earlier this season. Washington was the 18th Nittany Lion in program history to earn Academic All-America honors and Penn State's 195th overall selection. Penn State's 195 All-America selections rank fifth among all programs and fourth among Division I schools.

VOLLEYBALL MAGAZINE ALL-AMERICANS

Penn State earned two Volleyball Magazine All-America selections for the third consecutive year. Simone Lee was named to the second team, while Haleigh Washington took home third-team honors.

15-STRAIGHT

After opening the season at 2-3, the Nittany Lions put together its longest win streak of the past two seasons, winning 15 straight matches spanning from Sept. 9 until Oct. 22, when Penn State dropped a tough five-setter to then-No. 16 Michigan. The 15-match win streak was the second longest in the country during the span, topped only by No. 5 San Diego (16 straight). During the win streak, Penn State dropped only three total sets, knocking off five ranked opponents during the span including then-No. 1 Minnesota. Additionally, the streak beat the team's longest win streak in 2015, in which Penn State won its first 13 matches.

LEE ETCHES MARKS IN SINGLE-SEASON RECORDS

With her seventh kill against Northwestern on Nov. 25, junior Simone Lee etched her name in the Penn State record books, cracking the top-five for single season kills in the 25-point rally scoring era. Lee finished the season with 503 total kills following a 20-kill outing in the NCAA regional semifinal against Nebraska. With 14 kills against Pitt in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Lee sprang into third place on the single-season leaderboard. Her kills per set (4.16) also ranks third on Penn State's single-season chart.

NITTANY LIONS AMONG NATION'S ELITE IN EFFICIENCY IN 2016

Penn State has been extremely successful keeping its offense among the top in the country. The Nittany Lions ranked first in the Big Ten and fourth in Division I in hitting efficiency, attacking a .290 clip. Junior Haleigh Washington continued to be one of the most consistent offensive threats in the country in 2016, ranked among the best in the nation in hitting efficiency. Hitting at a .430 clip in all matches in 2016, the Colorado Springs, Colorado, product led the Big Ten and ranked third among NCAA Division I players in hitting percentage.

The Nittany Lions not only excelled at having one of the most efficient offenses in the country, but also at limiting those of the opposition. PSU ranks 48th nationally and ranks second in the Big Ten in limiting opponents hitting, holding foes to a .173 clip. The team also has contributed an impressive blocking performance thus far, finishing regular season action averaging 2.53 blocks per set, good for fourth in the conference and 35th nationally.

SWEEPING VICTORIES

Penn State earned 19 of its 24 (79%) victories during the 2016 season by way of a 3-0 sweep. Penn State also limited five teams in Georgia Southern, Siena, Rhode Island, Rutgers and LIU Brooklyn to under 40 total points. The Nittany Lions limited LIU Brooklyn to just 30 points in the first round of the NCAA tournament, marking a season low for Penn State's points against.

STREAKING!

Penn State holds the four of the top-five winning streaks in Big Ten history. Penn State's most recent record-setting streak of 65 consecutive matches began on Nov. 11, 2006 and ended on Sept. 24, 2010 at Illinois, the longest streak in league history. Penn State's other two conference winning streaks were 49 matches and 41. Penn State's 33-match winning streak, dating back to Oct. 17, 2014 was snapped during the 2015 season in a 3-2 loss to then-fourth-ranked Nebraska.

Penn State closed out the regular season as one of the nation's leaders in attendance, ranking top five in the country with an average of 3,385 fans per match at the end of the regular season with other Big Ten schools, Nebraska, Wisconsin and Minnesota. (Figures provided by the NCAA at the end of the 2016 regular season) Penn State highlighted the year with a sold out crowd of 5,564 against Nebraska.

The Big Ten led all Division I conferences in overall and average attendance, averaging 2,770 fans per match with the Pac-12 ranking second with an average of 1,399 followed by the Big 12 in third at 1,370.

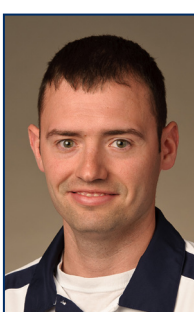
