TERRIERS BRING IN FIVE TRANSFERS

Tedrick Wilcox Jr. (Dominican College) - 15.4 ppg | 5.6 rpg | 2.6 apg ('20-'21)

- Started all eight games for Division II Dominican College in the 2020-2021 season, finishing his final season there as the team's second leading scorer, and averaging the second-most minutes per game of his teammates. Wilcox was named to CACC All-Conference Team after his sophomore season. He was CACC Rookie of the Year in 2020 in his first season at Dominican.

Patrick Emilien (Western Michigan) - 5.2 ppg, 3.5 rpg, 1.3 apg ('20-'21)

- Comes to St. Francis Brooklyn after three seasons at Western Michigan. Emilien ended his time with the Broncos on a high note averaging a career high in points per game, including a single-game career high of 18 points on 7-10 shooting against Buffalo on 1/12/21. He averaged a career high 19.6 minutes per game as a junior for the Broncos. During his first season at WMU, he was one of five players to play in all 32 games, starting 12 of them.

Michael Cabbage (Marist) - 11.0 ppg, 5.3 rpg, 4 games, 4 starts ('20-'21)

- The Marist transfer joins the Terriers looking to rebound from an injury-shortened red-shirt senior season in which he played just four games. In his single full season at Marist (2018-2019), Cabbage led Red Foxes in scoring (9.3 ppg), rebounds (6.1 rpg), assists (3.4 apg) and double-doubles (two). He started his collegiate career at Paris Junior College in Texas.

Bahaïde Haïdara (George Mason) - 2.3 ppg, 2.9 rpg, 21 games ('20-'21)

- Appeared in a total of 23 games at George Mason before transferring to Brooklyn Heights. Haïdara averaged 8.7 minutes per game in 2020-2021. He appeared in two games during his freshman season, before a wrist injury. Entered his college career as the No. 11 Canadian prospect, per North Pole Hoops.

Jack Hemphill (Boston University) - 6.4 ppg, 3.4 rpg, 1.2 apg ('20-'21)

- Hemphill comes south to Brooklyn Heights from BU off the best statistical season of his college career. He scored in double figures four times during his junior season, recording a career-high 16 points against Holy Cross (1/5/21). He appeared in all 34 games in the '19-'20 season, helping BU to its first Patriot League title, and NCAA tournament since 2011.

TERRIERS SIGN SEVEN FRESHMAN TO 2021-22 ROSTER

G Di'Andre Howell-South (Paterson, NJ/Immaculate Conception)

Attended Immaculate Conception High School in Montclair, NJ. He averaged 14.6 points, 10 rebounds, and 1.2 assists per game for the Lions. He led the team in rebounds in his senior season, helping them go undefeated in the SEC-American Conference.

G Nick Folk (Coney Island, NY/Xaverian)

Attended Xaverian High School in Bay Ridge, Brooklyn. He was a member of the Clippers' varsity boys' basketball team, helping them to the Catholic High School Athletic Association this spring. He was named to the All-CHSAA team for his efforts. Folk turned down a number of other offers to stay home and play in his native Brooklyn.

F Max Egner (Woodside, NY/Brewster Academy)

Joins the Terriers after a prep year at the highly respected Brewster Academy in Wolfeboro, NH; a program that has produced 19 NBA players and won 7 national championships since 2010. Prior to his time at Brewster, the Queens native was the all-time leading scorer at Mas-peth High School, averaging 29.9 ppg, and would become the first D1 commit from the school. Egner has also played internationally with the U20 Polish National Team.

G Cameron Jones (Hudson, NH/IMG Academy)

Arrives at St. Francis after a prep season at IMG Academy in Bradenton, FL. Prior to his time in Florida, Jones graduated from Alvirne High School in Hudson, NH, where he averaged 15 points per game. The guard found success on the travel circuit, finishing out with NEXT, averaging 21.3 points per game.

F Michael Parrotta (Armonk, NY/St. Thomas More)

Joins the Terriers program after a detour to St. Thomas More for a prep season in Oakdale, CT. He graduated from Byram Hills High School, where he was a Class A all-state standout, earning numerous Player of the Week awards from The Journal News in the Lower Hudson Valley. Michael is the son of former Canisius head coach, and current Hofstra assistant coach, Tom Parrotta.

G Michael Gonzalez (Brooklyn, NY/Xaverian)

One of three Xaverian alumni on the 2021-22 roster for the Terriers, competed alongside fellow freshman Nick Folk for the Clippers last season.

G Kasper Suurorg (Tallinn, Harjumaa, Estonia/Audentese e-gymnasium)

Comes to Brooklyn Heights with a wealth of experience in European competition. Suurorg most recently competed for Pärnu Sadam in his home country of Estonia, averaging 5.1 points per game in 21 games during the 2020-2021 EMKL season. He also competed for the U18 Estonian national team during the 2019 FIBA U18 European Championships, averaging 3.6 points per game.

NEWS & NOTES

2021-22 NEC PRESEASON POLL & HONORS

The Northeast Conference released its preseason coaches poll on October 26, 2021, with St. Francis Brooklyn selected to finish seventh in the conference. Wagner was tabbed as the preseason conference favorite by the NEC coaches, with Bryant and Mount St. Mary's being selected second and third, respectively, also receiving first place votes. LIU was selected fourth, Merrimack was selected fifth, Sacred Heart was selected sixth, with Saint Francis U (PA), Fairleigh Dickinson, and Central Connecticut State rounding out the rankings.

TERRIERS COACHING RECORDS

St. Francis Brooklyn men's basketball head coach Glenn Braica passed Rody Cooney for third place on the program all-time wins list for victories by a head coach on November 18, 2018, vs. Lafayette. Braica eclipsed the 150-win mark with St. Francis Brooklyn on February 11, 2021, with a 70-67 win over Saint Francis (PA). He is just one of four Terriers' head coaches to win over 150 games in their career. Braica currently holds a 154-180 all time record with the Terriers.

NEC COACHING VETERANS

Head Coach Glenn Braica is the longest-tenured current Head Coach in the NEC as he took over the Terriers' men's basketball program before the 2010-11 season. Braica is the active leader for overall wins at an NEC institution with 154. LIU's Derek Kellogg has the most career wins of any coach in the NEC with 213 (nine years at UMass, three years at LIU). Braica has an 8-3 all-time record in NEC openers. Braica leads all current NEC Head Coaches with 102 league wins, Wagner's Bashir Mason is second with 93, followed by Saint Francis (PA)'s Rob Krimmel with 83.

150 WIN CLUB

Coach Braica collected his 150th career win at Saint Francis (PA) on February 11. Braica became just the third coach in program history to win 150 or more games joining Daniel Lynch (283 wins) and Ron Ganulin (187 wins). Braica has the most overall wins of any NEC Coach at its current institution. LIU's Derrick Kellogg is the career leader with 213 wins (nine years at UMass, three years at LIU).

100 NEC WINS

On February 17, at FDU, Coach Braica earned his 100th career win in NEC play, which are the most by an active Head Coach in the league. He became just the 10th coach in conference history to reach the 100-win plateau in league play and just the second coach in program history to do so. Braica joined former Terriers' Head Coach Ron Ganulin who picked up 129 wins in NEC play, which are the third-most in conference history. With 101 NEC wins, Braica sits in 10th-place on the all-time regular season NEC wins list.

COACHING TENURE IN MET AREA

Terriers' Head Coach Glenn Braica and Seton Hall's Head Coach Kevin Willard are the two longest tenured Division I Head Coaches in the Metropolitan area. Both Braica and Willard were hired to take over the helm of their respective programs prior to the 2010-11 season.

NEW LOOK ST. FRANCIS

The Terriers return just five of their fifteen letter winners from a season ago, which accounted for just over 34 percent of their scoring. St. Francis looks to replace three of its top five scorers from the 2019-20 season in Chauncey Hawkins (15.1 ppg), Unique McLean (11.4 ppg), and Stevan Krtnic (6.0 ppg). Hawkins led the Terriers in points, assists, steals, field goals made, field goals attempted, free-throws made, and free-throws attempted in 2019-20. Last season, McLean led the Terriers in rebounding (8.0 rpg). Rob Higgins is the top returning scorer from last season (11.2 ppg). He also led the team in minutes during the 2020-21 season.

TRANSFER PORTAL GIVETH AND TAKETH AWAY

St. Francis welcomes five transfers this season: Tedrick Wilcox Jr. (Dominican College), Patrick Emilien (Western Michigan), Michael Cabbage (Marist), Bahaïde Haïdara (George Mason), and Jack Hemphill (Boston University). Four of the transfers come in from Division I institutions, one comes from a Division II institution (Wilcox Jr.) Four of those five led their previous teams in at least one statistical category during their careers.

METROPOLITAN AREA ROOTS

62.5 percent of the Terriers' roster is comprised of student-athletes from the Metropolitan area. 43.8 percent of the St. Francis' roster hails from the state of New York. Five of the seven native New Yorkers hail from the borough of Brooklyn. The Terriers' Brooklynites include Larry Moreno, Nick Folk, Elijah Hardison, Matthew Gonzalez, and Angel Lopez. Folk and Gonzalez both featured for a high-powered Xaverian Clippers team during the 2020-21 season. Rob Higgins, Michael Cabbage, and Di'Andre Howell South are from New Jersey.

LIGHT CHEESE LARRY

Following the 2019-20 season, Larry Moreno became a viral social media sensation for his trick shots that he posts to his personal Instagram page (@lcf_larry). Has been featured on ESPN.com, ESPN SportsCenter, Overtime, House of Highlights, Complex, FIBA, SLAM, Reuters, ABC News, NBC Access Hollywood, NBC 4 New York, FOX 5 New York, PIX 11 New York, 1010 WINS, New York Post, News 12 Brooklyn. Since he first went viral on March 25, 2020, his Instagram following has grown to over 79K followers.

SERBIAN TIES

The Terriers have had at least one student-athlete on their roster who has hailed from Serbia in 13 out of the last 14 seasons (2014-15 they did not have a Serbian on the roster). Stefan Perunicic (2008-12), Milos Trivic (2010-13), Aleksandar Isailovic (2012-14), Jagos Lasic (2015-18), Milija Cosic (2017-20), Stevan Krtnic (2019-Present), and Vuk Stevanic (2020-Present).

NEWS & NOTES

HAWKINS RECORD BOOK WATCH

Chauncey Hawkins became the 33rd member of the Terriers' 1,000 Point Club against Robert Morris on March 4, 2020, in the NEC Quarterfinals. He became the first Terrier to reach the 1,000-point plateau since former teammate Glenn Sanabria did so during the 2018-19 season. With 1,231 career points, he is currently in 17th-place on the all-time scoring list. He is just 12 points away from tying Robert Jackson for 16th-place with 1,243 career points. Hawkins currently sits in second-place on the Terriers' all-time made free-throws list with 351 made free-throws. Jalen Cannon is the Terriers' all-time leader in made free-throws with 416.

19 GAME SCHEDULE

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic the Terriers played 19 games during the 2020-21 season. 18 of the 19 games were NEC contests, with the one lone non-conference game being against Tri-state area foe Saint Peter's on December 23. The 19-game schedule marks the fewest games that the Terriers have played in a single-season since the 1945-46 season when they played 18 games and posted an overall record of 12-6.

CB RANKED AS A TOP FIVE ASSISTANT IN NEC

Associate Head Coach Clive Bentick was ranked as one of the top five Assistants in the NEC by Stadium this past Summer. Bentick enters his 14th season on staff at St. Francis and his second as Associate Head Coach. He has helped guide the Terriers to 11 NEC Tournament appearances during his tenure.

HOME COOKIN'

Over the past four seasons, the Terriers have collected an impressive 34-17 record at the Daniel Lynch '38 Gymnasium. In 2019-20, St. Francis was tied for the fourth-most home wins in the NEC with nine. Over the past four seasons, St. Francis is 14-2 at home in non-conference games and 11-1 since the start of 2018-19. In 2018-19, St. Francis went 11-3 at home; the 11 wins were the most since the 2014-15 season when it won 13 contests at the Daniel Lynch '38 Gymnasium. In 2017-18, the Terriers put together a 10-3 record in Brooklyn Heights.

2020-21 NCAA NET RANKINGS

The NET rankings are a sorting tool the NCAA will use to evaluate teams in contention for at-large bids into the NCAA Tournament. The rankings will rely on five factors — team value index, net efficiency, winning percentage, adjusted win percentage, and scoring margin.

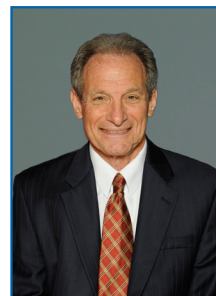

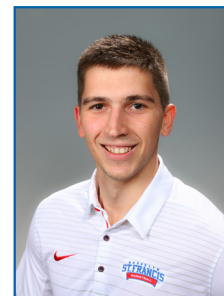

Glenn Braica was named the 17th head coach of the St. Francis Brooklyn men's basketball program on May 20, 2010. In 10 seasons at the helm of the Terriers, Braica has recorded the third-most wins by a head coach in program history.

Braica has a stellar 102-94 (.520) mark in Northeast Conference (NEC) action and has guided the Terriers to the NEC Tournament nine times. His 2020-21 team finished with an even 9-9 record in an abbreviated NEC slate.

In 2018-19, the Terriers won 17 games, their most since the historic 2014-15 season and earned a bid to the CollegelInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT). St. Francis collected eight non-conference victories in 2018-19, which were one shy of tying the NEC non-conference wins record which the Terriers set back in 2013-14.

Through his 10 seasons as head coach, Braica has had at least one player from his team receive NEC accolades in each season. In 2010-11, Akeem Bennett was named the Defensive Player of the Year and selected to the Second Team. Bennett's teammate Ricky Cade'll also earned a spot on the Second Team that season. In 2011-12, Jalen Cannon was picked to the Rookie Team, and the following season he was tabbed to the Second Team.

In 2013-14, Cannon earned First Team honors, while Wayne Martin was picked to the Rookie Team. In 2014-15, one of the most historic seasons in program history, Cannon won the Player of the Year honor and was a member of the First Team. Amdy Fall picked up the Defensive Player of the Year honor, and Brent Jones was selected to the First Team alongside Cannon.

The following season, Fall took home his second-straight Defensive Player of the Year award. That year, the Terriers had a trio on the Third Team (Chris Hooper, Yunus Hopkinson, and Tyreek Jewell). In 2016-17, Rasheem Dunn made the All-NEC Rookie Team. In 2017-18, Dunn was rewarded with Second Team honors, while Jalen Jordan was named to the Rookie Team. In 2018-19, Jordan earned Second Team honors, while Glenn Sanabria was named to the Third Team. Last season, Chauncey Hawkins and Deniz Gelen were named to the All-NEC Third Team, while Rob Higgins was selected to the NEC All-Rookie Team.

In total, Braica has coached one NEC Player of the Year (Cannon), two NEC Defensive Players of the Year (Bennett & Fall, twice), and 14 All-Conference players.

In 2014-15 St. Francis Brooklyn tied a school record with 23 victories and won its first NEC Regular Season Championship since the 2003-04 campaign. The Terriers earned a berth in the NIT, which marked the program's first national postseason appearance since 1963.

One of Braica's first recruits, Cannon was named the NEC Player of the Year and was a First Team All-Metropolitan Sports Writers Association selection. Cannon had a record-breaking year in 2014-15, as he became the Terriers' all-time leading scorer (1,720 points) and rebounder (1,159 rebounds). His 1,159 rebounds made him the All-Time leader in the NEC. Cannon became the first St. Francis Brooklyn player to be named to the All-Met Division I First Team and also the first Terrier to become an AP Honorable Mention All-American. Before his graduation in May 2015, Cannon was the NCAA Division I active rebound leader.

In addition, Jones earned First Team All-Conference accolades and Fall was named the Defensive Player of the Year. Braica earned the NEC Coach of the Year honor for the second time in his career and was the Metropolitan Sports Writers Association's Co-Coach of the Year. He also was named the District 18 NABC Coach of the Year.

COACHING STAFF

Braica has developed a reputation as one of the good guys in the industry and was named a finalist for the prestigious Skip Prosser "Man of the Year" Award in 2013-14 and 2014-15. In 2013-14, the Terriers opened up the season with a 66-62 overtime win against the reigning ACG Champions Miami. That year, St. Francis set the NEC record for non-conference wins with nine and posted an overall mark of 18-14.

On the court, Braica's student-athletes exude the same intensity as their leader does on the sidelines and it's easy to tell why recruits sign up to play for him. A born-and-raised Brooklynite, Braica has spent his entire career in New York City, which began after his playing days at Queens College. He was an assistant at St. Francis Brooklyn from 1990-2004 before a stint at St. John's as an assistant from 2004-10. That experience has helped Braica navigate through a crowded recruiting scene to thrust the Terriers back in contention in the NEC.

It didn't take long for Braica to get the program back on track. In his first season on the sidelines in 2010-11, Braica led the Terriers to a 15-15 campaign and the No. 5 seed in the Northeast Conference Tournament. It was the program's best record since the 2003-04 season when the Terriers finished 15-13 and won a share of the NEC Regular Season title.

In 2011-12, St. Francis Brooklyn hosted their first home conference tournament game since 1997, after placing fourth in the league standings. Braica's focus on strong defense certainly paid off. That season, his team was one of the best in the nation at guarding the three-point line. The Terriers ranked second in the NEC and 17th in the country in defensive three-point field goal percentage. Braica was named the Jim Phelan NEC Coach of the Year as well as the NABC District 18 Co-Coach of the Year.

In his first stint at St. Francis Brooklyn, Braica was with the Terriers for 15 years and was the associate head coach from the 2000-01 season until his departure for St. John's following the 2003-04 season under his current assistant coach Ron Ganulin.

During Braica's last seven years as an assistant at St. Francis Brooklyn, the Terriers posted a 118-83 record, including an 88-42 mark in the NEC and captured two Regular Season Championships. They finished with a .500 or better record in the league seven-straight years, at that time the longest active streak in the conference. They also reached the NEC semifinals five times and had two Championship game appearances in Braica's last five seasons. Braica helped Ganulin orchestrate the Terriers' offensive system, which ranked first or second in the NEC in each of the last five seasons he was on staff. During his tenure, the squad emerged from the league's lower tier and went on to become one of the conference's elite programs.

From 1998-2004, the Terriers had one player named the league's Player of the Year, six First-Team All-NEC selections, five Second-Team All-NEC honorees, two players that led the league in scoring, two NEC Rookies of the Year, and a NEC Defensive Player of the Year. Braica recruited and coached several student-athletes that would go on to pro basketball careers during his time with the Terriers.

Following his first stint at the college, Braica spent six seasons as an assistant at St. John's under Norm Roberts. When Roberts became head coach at St. John's, Braica, a teammate at Queens College, was his first hire.

Braica was also praised by Roberts for his ability to reach out to the community and Red Storm alumni, bringing former players back into the fold. He was also one of the co-directors of the Norm Roberts basketball camp, helping to increase enrollment from 75 campers in 2004 to 260 kids per session in 2009.

While at St. John's, Braica recruited and helped develop First Team All-Big East guard Dwight Hardy, Sixth Man of the Year Justin Burrell, as well as NBA players D.J. Kennedy and Cedric Jackson.

From 2001-03, Braica was the head coach for the Empire State Games New York City men's open team, which won gold medals in 2001 and 2002, as well as a silver medal in 2003. The teams included former Terriers Cliff Strong, Sean Dantzer, Damien Herard, Devon Neckles, Karl Sanders, and Tristan Smith, as well as current NBA coach and former NBA player Royal Ivey.

Braica has also coached numerous players that participated in the NBA Summer League, including Dwight Hardy (Miami Heat), Justin Burrell (Golden State Warriors), D.J. Kennedy (Cleveland Cavaliers), Paris Horne (Charlotte Hornets), Justin Brownlee (New York Knicks & Charlotte Hornets), and Anthony Mason Jr. (Miami Heat). Kennedy went on to play for the Cavaliers in the 2011-12 season, while Jackson spent time with the Cavaliers, Spurs, and Wizards in 2009-10.

Since taking over as head coach, a large number of Braica's student-athletes have gone on to sign professional contracts on the international circuit. Akeem Bennett '11, Ricky Cadell '11, Alex Harrington '11, Stefan Perunicic '12, Akeem Johnson '13, Aleksandar Isailovic '14, Ben Mockford '14, Kevin Douglas '15, Jalen Cannon '15, Lowell Ulmer '15, Brent Jones '15, Chris Hooper '16, Tyreek Jewell '16, and Gunnar Olafsson '18 have all enjoyed successful careers overseas.

Braica attended St. Agnes High School and Bishop Ford High School in Brooklyn in the early 1980s and graduated from Queens College in 1989. Braica began his coaching career at New York City Tech as an assistant in 1988. He also served as a teacher at The Reece School and in the New York City Board of Education from 1989-94. He currently serves on the NCAA Division I USA Today Coaches'

PRIOR TO ST. FRANCIS BROOKLYN: Wilcox Jr. is a 6-foot-6, guard from Pawtucket, RI. He comes to St. Francis after playing the last two seasons at Dominican College on the NCAA Division II level. Over two seasons at Dominican he averaged 11.7 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 1.3 assists per game in 39 games (38 starts). In 2019-20, he was named the CACC Rookie of the Year, took home two CACC Rookie of the Week honors, and was tabbed to the CACC Weekly Honor Roll once. As a sophomore in 2020-21, he earned CACC All-Conference Team honors, and was selected to the CACC Weekly Honor Roll twice.

In a shortened 2020-21 campaign, Wilcox Jr. tallied 15.4 points, 5.6 rebounds, 2.6 assists, and 1.0 steals per contest in eight games. He scored a season-high 20 points on 7-of-11 shooting from the field at Nyack on February 23, 2021. He scored in double figures in all eight games for the Charges during his sophomore season and scored 15 or more points in a game five times. He shot a blistering 52.8 percent from the field and 47.2 percent from three-point range. Following his freshman season in 2019-20, he was named the league's Rookie of the Year as he recorded 10.7 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 1.0 assists per game. The guard also shot 57.0 percent from the field, 35.9 percent from three, and 77.9 percent from the free-throw line in 2019-20.

Before Wilcox Jr. began his collegiate career at Dominican, he attended William E. Tolman Senior High School where he played three years of varsity basketball and one year of varsity soccer. He is a member of the 1,000-point club at William E. Tolman Senior High School, and was named the SENE 2018 Player of the Year. Additionally, he was tabbed to the All-SENE First Team, and All-NEPSAC Class D First Team in 2018. He also was a 2018 NEPSAC Class D Finalist.

LAST TIME OUT

BROOKLYN HEIGHTS, N.Y. - For the first time in 629 days, the St. Francis men's basketball team got the opportunity to take the court in Daniel Lynch '38 Gymnasium at the Pope Physical Education Center in front of fans. A passionate crowd packed the Pope for their first look at the Terriers on Remsen Street this season.

In the first home game for 12 of the 17 players on the roster, the Terriers fell to St. Thomas (MN), 91-73. The win was the first for the Tommies since making the historic jump from NCAA Division III competition to Division I.

The Terriers worked from behind for the entirety of regulation, after St. Thomas opened the game on a 13-5 run and did not relinquish the lead. The Tommies first half lead climbed to as many as 12, but leading scorer Michael Cabbage and the Terriers pulled to within 4 points and 5 points on two different occasions in the first half.

They faced at 45-37 deficit at halftime.

Despite being down, the Terriers returned to the court motivated in the second half, opening the frame on a 13-9 run and eventually cutting the Tommies lead to 4 with 16:15 to play. Junior guard Rob Higgins scored 12 of his season-best 16 points in the second half. Higgins added a team-leading 4 assists, as well as 2 steals and 2 rebounds.

Higgins was only bested in the scoring column by Marist transfer Michael Cabbage, who recorded a career shooting day: 20 points (8-15 FG, 1-5 3PT), adding 7 rebounds (lead the team), 2 steals and one assist.

Junior guard Trey Quartlebaum also posted a career-best shooting performance, dropping 14 points (5-9 FG, 3-7 3PT) and 3 rebounds.

Fellow junior guard Larry Moreno scored his first points of the season, contributing 8 points, 5 rebounds, and 2 assists in 25 minutes off the bench.

In his first home game in Brooklyn Heights, transfer forward Patrick Emilien lead the Terriers with three steals; adding 5 points, 6 rebounds, 3 assists and 1 block.

Three other Terriers made their way on the score sheet: freshman guard Di'Andre Howell-South (4 points, 4 rebounds, 1 assist), junior transfer guard Di'Andre Howell-South (4 points, 1 rebound), and graduate transfer Jack Hemphill (2 points, 1 rebound).
