**Delaware State Head Coach Stan Waterman** (Delaware, '88): 3-35 at DSU and career (second season); 0-0 vs. Penn State; 0-14 MEAC regular season; 0-1 MEAC Tournament

#### **THE GAME**

Delaware State (1-11; 0-0 MEAC) closes out the 2022 calendar year with a visit to Penn State of the Big 10 Conference. The Hornets are looking to snap a string of 10 straight losses since their lone win of the season, 104-67 vs. Immaculata (Pa.), on Nov. 10. Delaware State has been idle since a 58-51 home loss to Wagner on Dec. 20. The Seahawks scored the last nine points of the game to secure the seesaw affair. Delaware State led 51-49 when Brandon Stone knocked down a three-point field goal with 2:27 left to play. After Wagner pulled to within a point, the Seahawks scored a basket with 1:41left to take the lead for good. Wagner scored on its next position to pull ahead 54-51, and hit four free throws in the final 19 seconds to seal the win. The loss overshadowed a solid performance by Delaware State's Stone, who led all players with 23 points on nine-for-14 shooting from the field, including two three-pointers on five attempts. Hornet forward Kyle Johnson also had a strong game, tallying 10 points, and season-highs of 10 rebounds and five blocks. The blocks were the most by a Hornet since Chris Sodom had a school-record nine vs. Morgan State last season. For the season, Stone is tops on the Hornets in scoring at 12.2 points per game and in rebounding with 5.1 per contest. He is in his first season with Delaware State after previously attending Robert Morris University (Pa.). Khyrie Staten Is second on the Hornets in scoring at 10.2 points per game. He's also tied for the team lead with 12 three-point field goals. Guard Jevin Muniz (fr.) has climbed to third on the Hornets in scoring at 7.7 points per game. Muniz is also tied for second on the club with 12 three-pointers. O'Koye Parker is number four on the team with a 7.4 point-per-game average. He's also knocked down a team-high 15 three-point field goals. Guard Martaz Robinson leads the Hornets with 36 assists and is third in rebounding at 3.3 per game. Corey Perkins (so.), a Preseason All-MEAC Third Team selection, averages 3.8 points per game and is second on the Hornets with 31 assists.

Penn State (9-3; 1-1 BIG10) brings a three-game win streak into the contest, highlighted by a 74 -59 Big 10 road victory at #17 Illinois on Dec. 10. The Nittany Lions are coming off a 77-68 home win over Quinnipiac on Dec. 22. Jalen Pickett led four double-figure scorers for Penn State with a game-high 21 points and also topped all players with 12 rebounds and nine assists. Pickett also leads the Lions in scoring (16.6 ppg), rebounding (7.7 pg) and assists (93) for the season. Andrew Funk is Penn State's third-leading scorer (11.8 ppg) and has a team-high 35 three-point field goals (35-83; .422). As a team, the Lions have 136 three-pointers on 342 attempts for a .398 percentage this season.

#### THE SERIES (Penn State leads 2-0)

The Hornets and Lions are meeting for the third time. Penn State won the previous two contests, each on its home court, topping Delaware State 80-76 in overtime during the 2012-13 season, and 105-52 during the 2017-18 campaign.

The Delaware State men's basketball team will have plenty of motivation heading into the Despite its recent woes, Delaware State has 2022-23 season. The Hornets have been picked to finish in a tie with South Carolina State for seventh in the eight-team Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference regular season race. according to a poll of league head coaches and sports information representatives. Defending champ Norfolk State is the voters' choice to win the regular season title. The

Spartans collected 15 of 16 possible first place votes and 127 total points. North Carolina Central is second in the poll. The Eagles received one first place votes and 102 total points in the poll. The MEAC also announced its preseason teams for the upcoming season. Delaware State guard Corey Perkins (so.; Wilmington, Del.) has been selected to the Preseason All-MEAC Third Team. Perkins was a MEAC All-Rookie selection as a



freshman during the 2021-22 season. He was tops on the team and fifth in the MEAC in assists at 3.3 per game (74 total). Perkins also ranked eighth in the MEAC with a 1.1 assist-to-turnover ratio, and was eighth in the league in steals at 1.5 per game.

DSU has reached double figures in MEAC wins 10 times since 2000-01 season. Delaware State claimed three consecutive MEAC regular season titles from 2004-07. During that span, the Hornets were 46-8 in league games. Delaware State captured its only MEAC Tournament title and NCAA Tournament berth in 2005. The Hornets have competed in six MEAC Tournament championship games, the last in 2015.

Four players on the 2022-23 roster call Delaware home, second to next door Pennsylvania among the states. In addition, head coach **Stan Waterman** is a Wilmington, Del., native and former University of Delaware player, while assistant coaches Shahid Perkins and Vernon DuPree, Jr. are Wilmington natives. Perkins was a standout player and former head boys basketball coach at Glasgow High School. DuPree, Jr. was a star player at Concord High School in Wilming-

#### TRANSFER STATION

Delaware State head coach Stan Waterman is hoping the addition of players with previous college experience will help key a turnaround for the Hornets this season. Among the Hornets' 2022-23 transfers are big men Brandon Stone (sr.; 6-11; Scottsdale, Pa.) and Raymond Somerville (so.; 6 -11; Media, Pa.). Stone most recently attended Robert Morris University in Pittsburgh. His last season with the Colonials, he appeared in 23 games, averaging 6.5 points and 3.5 rebounds in 16 minutes per game. He 18-for-21 from the free throw line (85.7%), 13-for-29 on three-point shots (44/8%) and 59-of-116 (50.9%) overall from the field during the 2020-21 season. Somerville comes to the Hornets by way of Cal State Bakersfield, where he competed in 16 games as a reserve during the 2021-22 season. Kyle Johnson (gr.; 6-8; San Diego, Cal.) previously attended Cal State Monterey before joining the Hornets. Johnson appeared in 22 games, averaging 4.9 points and 6.8 rebounds per game, ranking second on the team in rebounds and blocks (13) during the 2021-22 season. Cameron Stitt (so.; 6-8; Charlotte, N.C.) played a season at Florida Southwestern before joining the Hornets, and O'Koye Parker (sr.; 6-3; Wilmington, Del.) previously competed at Livingstone University in North Carolina.

#### <u>HORNETS TO AGAIN COMPETE IN MICHAEL B. JORDAN-LED HBCU LE</u>GACY HOOPS CLASSIC

For the second year in a row, Delaware State will compete in the premier in-season Black College men's basketball classic. The Hornets are one of four teams invited to compete in actor and producer Michael B. Jordan's Invesco QQQ Legacy Classic, a college showcase featuring historically Black Colleges and Universities, set for Feb. 4, 2023 at the Prudential Center in Newark, N.J., and aired world-wide on Turner Network Television (TNT). Delaware State will face off against Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) rival Morgan State, while Norfolk State of the MEAC will take on long-



time Hampton of the Colonial Athletic Association in this year's HBCU Legacy Classic doubleheader airing on TNT. The Delaware State / Morgan State classic game will not count in the 2022-23 MEAC regular season standings. Last year, Turner Sports, Invesco QQQ and WME Sports joined with Jordan to support historically Black colleges and universities and their studentathletes. Part of the proceeds from the basketball showcase will once again help support organizations focused on advancing the Black educational institutions and the local Newark community. The event was previously named the Hoop Dreams Classic when Jordan launched it in 2020.

Delaware State University is honored to once again accept an invitation to compete in the exciting Invesco QQQ HBCU Legacy Men's Basketball Invitational," said Delaware State Director of Athletics Alecia-Shields-Gadson. "This event is promoted by some of the biggest names in sports, business and entertainment, and DSU is excited to help share in the proud and meaningful legacy of Historically Black Colleges and Universities. This event also provides another major platform to promote Delaware State University and its role in providing educational access and opportunity to all."

#### **HORNET GREAT TO JOIN MEAC HALL OF FAME**

Delaware State basketball legend Jahsha Bluntt (2003-07) is among the newest selections to the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Hall of Fame. The MEAC announced this

week the five members of the 2023 Hall of Fame Class. The inductees will be officially enshrined during the week of the 2023 MEAC Basketball Tournament in Norfolk, Va. A two-time MEAC Player of the Year (2006 and 2007), Bluntt was also the MEAC Basketball Tournament's Most Outstanding Performer in 2005. During his career with the Hornets, Delaware State won the its lone MEAC tournament championship - and corresponding NCAA Tournament berth - in 2005, while also making two NIT appearances. Bluntt led Delaware State to MEAC regular-season titles in three straight seasons: 2004-05, 2005-06 and 2006-07, and he was a twotime First Team All-MEAC honoree. One of the MEAC's most prolific scorers. Bluntt currently ranks third in conference history in career made threepointers (303) and 20th all-time in scoring with 1,721 career points, third in Delaware State men's basketball history.



#### **NEWCOMER O'KOYE PARKER OPENING EYES**

First-year Hornet O'Koye Parker (sr.; Wilmington, Del.) is establishing himself as the team's top outside shooting threat. Parker, a former First State high school star, transferred to Delaware State from Div. II Livingstone of the CIAA this season. On Dec. 10, in the Hornets' 75-69 loss to Georgian Court, Parker came off the bench to lead all players with a career-high 24 points on eight-for-13 shooting from the field, including six-of-nine on three-point shots. The six threes were the most by a Hornet since the 2019-20 season. Parker has climbed to fourth on the Hornets in scoring at 7.4 points per game, and is tops on the team with 15 three-pointers on 31 attempts (.484). He was 4-for-7 on three-point shots vs. Columbia on Nov. 16, and is 9-for-10 at the free throw line this season.

#### **HEAD COACH STAN WATERMAN - SECOND SEASON**



Stan Waterman, a legendary First State high school coach and administrator, USA Basketball coach and former college player, was announced as Delaware State University head men's basketball coach on June 4, 2021.

In 30 seasons, Waterman led the Sanford School (Del.) boy's basketball program to 571 wins, 10 state championship games and eight titles, including the last two in 2021 and 2019. His 2020 team reached the state semifinals before the tournament was shut down due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Waterman has also served as Sanford's Dean of Students since 1993 and is the assistant director of athletics at the school.

In 2016, after leading the Warriors to its sixth state championship, he was honored by the Delaware Sportswriters and Broadcasters Association as the recipient of the Tubby Raymond Delaware Coach of the Year Award.

Waterman also led Sanford to state titles in his inaugural campaign in 1992, 2002 and for three straight years from 2010-2012.

He has also served as a member of the USA Basketball coaching staff.

Waterman was an assistant coach for the 2020 USA Nike Hoop Summit Team (which did not compete due to the worldwide pandemic), and he was an assistant coach for the 2019 USA Nike Hoop Summit Team, which he helped to a 93-87 win over the World Select, in Portland, Oregon.

He was a court coach at the 2018 USA Basketball Men's Junior National Team October Minicamp, and a gold medal winning assistant coach for the 2018 USA Men's U17 World Cup Team and the 2017 USA Men's U16 National Team.

Waterman played Division I basketball at the University of Delaware under head coaches Ron Rainey and Steve Steinwedel. He earned a degree in Sociology (1988) before becoming an assistant coach at Sanford and Wilmington University for one season.

As a player at Howard Career Center High School (Del.), he helped his team reach the state championship game in 1981 and the semifinals in 1983.

Waterman is widely recognized for his success in producing student-athletes who have succeeded in sports and the classroom throughout his career.

"Stan is well prepared for this challenge," said Villanova Head Men's Basketball Coach Jay Wright, a two-time NCAA champion and 2021 Basketball Hall of Fame inductee. "I respect him as an outstanding leader in our game. His basketball knowledge and experiences are elite.

Wright added," Stan's leadership and inspirational skills have produced winning teams and outstanding collegiate players throughout his career. His passion for the game and to the state is unmatched. Delaware State University has made a great choice in Stan Waterman."

Waterman and wife Robin are the proud parents of daughter Paris

Dupree and son-in-law Vernon Dupree, along with grandson Cairo Dupree.

Dupree is in his second season on the Delaware State staff, joining the program in July 2021. Since 2010, he has been an assistant men's basketball coach at Wilmington University (Del.).


Dupree started his collegiate playing career at American International College in Springfield, Mass., in 2005 before transferring to Wilmington University in 2008.

As a senior at Wilmington, Dupree started all 26 games, helping the team earn its first playoff appearance in the Central Athletic Collegiate Conference (CACC). For his efforts as a senior, Dupree received All-CACC honors and the Sam Cozen award. In addition, he ranked third in the conference in assists during his senior season.

A Delaware native, Dupree was a threeyear starter at Concord High School in Wilmington. He was named First-Team All -Conference during his sophomore, junior and senior years, and All-State in his junior and senior seasons.

Dupree graduated from Wilmington University in 2010 with a Bachelor's of Science degree in Accounting. He earned a MBA in Organizational Leadership from Wilmington in 2014.

His father, Vernon, Sr., was a Delaware State track and field standout in the 1970s.



**Horace Owens** 

Horace "Pappy" Owens, a former National Basketball Association draft pick and McDonald's collegiate All-America joined the Delaware State staff in July 2021.

Owens previously spent 14 years is as an assistant coach at La Salle University before shifting roles in the 2019-20 season to serve as a special assistant, contributing to game preparation, player development and mentoring.

Owens was instrumental in La Salle's 2012-13 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 season. The Explorers won 24 games that season, including three in the NCAA Tournament (vs. Boise State, Kansas State and Ole Miss).

Owens stands as one of the all-time greats at the University of Rhode Island ('79-'83) where he is seventh on the all-time scoring list (1,750) and is second all-time in field goals. He averaged 22.3 points per game as a senior to earn honorable mention All-America citation and first team All-Atlantic 10. He was inducted into the school's hall of fame in 1996.

Owens was the 44th pick of the NBA Draft by the New Jersey Nets in 1983 and was traded to the Philadelphia 76ers where he spent one season at the professional level.

An outstanding player at Philadelphia's Dobbins Tech, he was named First Team All-City in 1979 and Second Team in 1978. Owens was the *Daily News* and Markward Club Player of the Year in 1979 after averaging 29.3 ppg. He averaged 25.0 ppg as a junior. His 1,420 career points rank second in Dobbins history behind Bo Kimble.

Owens was named to the Second Team All-City in the Daily News look back at the past 35 years. He was also First Team All-Public in 1978 and in 1979 he was First Team All-Public, First Team All-City, Player of the year in the area, and First Team All-State.



Shahid Perkins

Shahid Perkins joined the Delaware State men's basketball staff in July 21. A high school and college standout player, Perkins also competed professionally in Europe before a successful career as a high school teacher and coach in the First State.

In addition to teaching, Perkins was a key member of new Delaware State head coach Stan Waterman's staff at Sanford School (Del.) from 2015 to '21, helping lead the team to three state championships during his tenure.

Perkins played collegiately at Hagerstown Community College in Maryland before enrolling at NAA Division I East Tennessee State. While at Hagerstown, he earned J All-America honors and was nominated for the school's Hall of Fame.

Perkins was team captain and ETSU's leading scorer in his senior season. He earned a bachelor's in Physical Education from East Tennessee State in 1996.

Perkins played professional basketball in Iceland and England before returning to the United States to begin a career in public education.

He also returned to his alma mater, Glasgow High School in Delaware, where he was varsity boys head basketball coach for 15 years before joining Waterman at Sanford.

While at Glasgow, Perkins earned four Blue Hen Flight A Coach of the Year honors, in addition to leading the program to one state tournament final four berth and four final eight appearances.

He is also the founder and executive director of the Perkins Basketball Camp, a summer for up to 100 youngsters, aged 7-17 at Glasgow High School.


