FIRST SERVE

» The 2016 regular season home slate comes to an end as Penn State host its final home matches this weekend welcoming Harvard (Apr. 8) and Sacred Heart (Apr. 9) to Rec Hall with both matches scheduled to begin at 7 p.m.

» The Nittany Lions will honor the senior members on this season squad (Ethan Huhn, Taylor Hammond, Zack Parik, Andrew Roberts, Spencer Sauter, Matt Seifert) following pre-game warm-ups Saturday April 9 vs. Sacred Heart.

» Penn State dropped its eighth match of the season this past Tuesday on the road against Ohio State (22-25, 20-25, 18-25) holding steady at 9-1 in EIVA play dropping to 16-8 overall on the season.

» Penn State checked in at No. 11 in the latest AVCA Top 15 Coaches Poll. PSU has been in the top 15 the last 12 consecutive weeks since debuting at No. 10 in the AVCA DI-II pre-season poll. The Nittany Lions have now seen or will see a total of nine teams from the top 15 at some point during the regular season.

» Penn State currently leads the EIVA with a 9-1 record in conference play. Harvard is second in the EIVA with a record of 7-3 in conference play and 11-8 overall. NJIT is third with an EIVA record of 7-4 while Saint Francis (Pa.) rounds out the top-four with a 6-4 record in conference play.

» The Nittany Lions wrapped up its February slate with a record of 7-0 during the month.

» The Nittany Lions lead the Crimson in the all-time series 12-1 since their first matchup in 2000. Penn State last faced Harvard on Feb. 12 pulling out the win in a sweep 3-0. The Nittany Lions lead Sacred Heart in the all-time series 11-0 since first playing the Pioneers in 2004. In their last matchup, Penn State downed Sacred Heart in four winning 3-1 back on Feb. 13.

» The magic number to claim the EIVA championship is 11. Penn State can outright win the EIVA with two more conference wins, and will be entitled to at least a share with one more conference win. Penn State has won 17-consecutive EIVA championships and 31 overall in program history.

» Following a 2015 season that featured Penn State men's volleyball's 17th consecutive trip the NCAA national semifinals, the Nittany Lions return a core group of nine letterwinners and three starters this year, while welcoming four freshmen to the roster

» Penn State is ranked in the top-25 in five different team categories including top-10 rankings in Kills Per Set - 13.19 (3rd), Blocks Per Set - 2.42 (8th) and Assists Per Set - 12.43 (3rd). Individually, Chris Nugent is ranked 11th in the nation in Points Per Set (4.44) and 12th in the nation in Kills Per Set (3.81), while Matt Callaway is currently 17th in the nation in Blocks Per Set averaging 1.06. Taylor Hammond is fourth in the nation in Assists Per Set currently averaging 10.99.

» The 27-time defending EIVA champion Penn State men's volleyball team was selected as this year's EIVA preseason favorite. The Nittany Lions were voted to capture this year's championship crown by the league's seven head coaches, receiving six of a possible eight first-place votes in the preseason poll.

» The Nittany Lions will square off a total of nine teams featured in the this season's AVCA preseason poll including eight teams ranked within the top 15 and two receiving votes.

» University Park will be the site of the 2016 National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Championship, marking the sixth time in school history that Rec Hall has hosted the event. Penn State will serve as the host of the vaunted event on May 5-7, 2016. Penn State men's volleyball was selected as one of two Nittany Lion programs to host an NCAA national championship.

PENN STATE VOTED EIVA PRESEASON FAVORITE

The 17-time defending EIVA champion Penn State men's volleyball team has been selected as the 2016 EIVA preseason favorite. The Nittany Lions were voted to capture this year's championship crown by the league's eight head coaches. Penn State received six of a possible eight first-place votes in the preseason poll, while George Mason picked up two. The Patriots are slotted to finish second, while Princeton, NJIT and St. Francis (Pa.) round out the top five in spots three through five.

NITTANY LIONS PICKED 10TH IN AVCA PRESEASON POLL

Penn State, along with No. 6 Ohio State and No. 14 George Mason were the only EIVA schools to earn a spot on this year's AVCA DI-II Men's Volleyball Preseason Poll. The Nittany Lions checked in at No.10. BYU earned this year's No. 1 overall spot, while UC-Irvine grabbed the No. 2 position. Defending NCAA national champion Loyola-Chicago checked in at No. 3, while Long Beach State and UCLA rounded out the top five at No. 4 and No. 5, respectively.

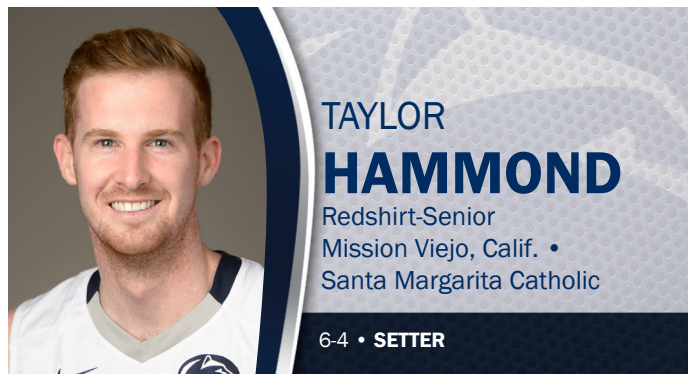

Led the team with five blocks at Saint Francis (4/25) ... Had six kills on seven perfect swings in the EIVA semis against Princeton (4/29) ... Posted four kills in the EIVA finals vs. GMU (5/1) ... Posted three kills, two digs and a team-high four blocks in the NCAA play-in against No. 4 Hawaii (5/5) ... Had three kills and a team-high four blocks in the NCAA national semifinals against No. 1 Lewis (5/7).

Had 24 assists, two digs and a block at No. 10 Hawaii (1/9) ... Dished out a career-high 60 assists to go along with five digs at Ball State (1/16) ... Recorded a double-double with 47 assists and a career-high 14 digs vs. No. 1 Loyola (1/23) ... Paced the team to a season-high .425 hitting clip vs. Mount Olive (1/30), adding a team-high nine digs ... Directed the team to a .500 hitting percentage against Erskine (2/6), matching a career-high mark with three blocks ... Recorded a career-high five blocks at No. 12 Ohio State (2/10) ... 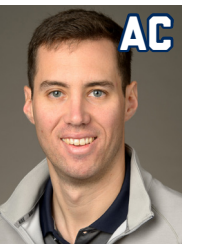
