FINDING FORSTER

· Senior attackman Jack Forster, who leads the team in goals (24), assists (11) and points (35), surpassed his 2011 point total (15) with a twopoint performance against Lehigh.

Forster missed the 2008 and 2010 seasons due to injury, and ranked second on the team with 34 points (22g, 12a) as a redshirt freshman in 2009.

PENN STATE IN THE CAA

· Penn State, which joined the CAA for the 2010 season, is 8-7 all-time in conference games.
