#### **WOLVERINE STORYLINES**

After picking up a 3-0 road sweep of No. 14 Ohio State, the Michigan volleyball team (17-10, 7-9) will hit the road for a Wednesday night (Nov. 18) match at No. 4 Penn State, then return home for a Saturday evening (Nov. 21) matchup against No. 6 Nebraska in the Crisler Center.

#### The Schedule

Prior to last week's match against No. 11 Wisconsin (Nov. 11), U-M spent four matches on the road, going 3-1 against top-ranked Big Ten teams. The Wolverines then returned home for a contest against Wisconsin before hitting the road for No. 14 Ohio State (Nov. 14), where U-M picked up its first victory over a top-25 team in a 3-0 sweep of the Buckeyes. With a Wednesday night (Nov. 18) matchup at Penn State, U-M will play its 14th road match of the year, returning home Saturday (Nov. 21) for a home match in the Crisler Center against Nebraska.

### **Scouting Penn State**

Ranked No.1 in last week's AVCA poll, the No. 4 Penn State Nittany Lions are coming off a 3-0 sweep at the hands of Big Ten Conference leader Minnesota. Prior to the loss, Penn State was on a 9-match win streak. The Nittany Lions currently lead the B1G in hitting percentage with a .295 average, as well as opponent hitting percentage, holding opponents to just a .149 average. The top-ranked squad also leads the B1G in blocking with 3.15 blocks/set. Sophomore middle blocker Haleigh Washington is the conference leader with a .445 hitting percentage, ranking second in the B1G Ten with 1.41 blocks/set. R-Freshman setter Bryanna Weiskircher also leads the conference in service aces, tallying 0.34/set.

#### **Scouting Nebraska**

The No. 6 Nebraska Cornuskers are currently tied with Penn State for a second-place standing in the Big Ten Conference, boasting a 22-4 overall record and a 13-3 record in Big Ten play. Despite dropping sets to Michigan State (Nov. 11) and Maryland (Nov. 14), the Huskers are on a six-match win streak. Nebraska currently leads the Big Ten Conference in digs with 15.77/set, ranking second among conference teams in kills with an average of 14.26/set. Husker middle blocker Amber Rolfzen leads the Big Ten in blocks, tallying 1.57/set for 127 on the year. Additionally, sophomore outside hitter Annika Albrecht ranks second among conference players with 0.33 service aces/set.

### **History against Penn State**

The first matchup between Michigan and Penn State came in 1981, and the squads have met every year since 1991. In their 34 year history, Michigan trails Penn State by a 3-37 all-time record, and U-M has not defeated the Nittany Lions since a five-set victory in 2002. The two teams last met earlier this season, which Michigan took the No. 5-ranked Penn State team to five sets in a 3-2 loss on Oct. 24.

#### History against Nebraska

Michigan trails Nebraska in the all-time series, 3-10, after a 3-1 loss earlier this season at the Huskers' home court in Lincoln, Neb. Prior to that loss, the Wolverines defeated the Huskers by a 3-0 score at home in their first Big Ten meeting of the 2014 season, wrapping up the 2014 year with a 3-0 loss at the Huskers' home arena. In their 13-game history, the majority of contests have occurred in three sets, with only two five-set matches.

#### **Knop leads the Charge**

14 NCAA APPEARANCES

Prior to an injury that sidelined her for four-straight games, sophomore Caroline Knop was one of three Wolverines to play in every set this season. The outside hitter currently ranks second on the team in kills per set (2.77), points (256.5) and digs per set (2.82). CK has seven kill-dig doubledoubles on the season, including a pair in Michigan's matches against Michigan State. She has registered at least ten kills in 13 matches on the season, recording doubledigit digs 12 times. Finally, the sophomore has led the Wolverines in kills in the last four matches.

#### Middle Blockers Step Up

The middle blocker pair of senior Krystalyn Goode and sophomore Claire Kieffer-Wright have made a large impact at the net as of late. The duo has led Michigan in blocking for the last ten matches, holding all but one opponent to attack averages under .270, even in matches that Michigan has lost. Despite U-M's loss at Illinois (Oct. 31), Kieffer-Wright ended the night with a career-high .571 attack average; she also registered a career-high 15 kills in Michigan's loss against Minnesota and a career-high 7 blocks against No. 14 Ohio State. In addition, Goode has recorded 34 blocks over the last ten matches.

Michigan's sister duo of Jenna Lerg and Lindsey Lerg have become a staple in Michigan's back row, helping to propel U-M to numerous wins both at home and on the road. Jenna made her first career-start at libero in Michigan's 3-0 upset win over Ohio State, matching her career-high 14 digs in the victory. Lindsey has registered double-digit digs in nine matches this year, recording a career high 18 digs against No. 6 Ohio State earlier in the season, while Jenna has tallied double-digit digs in eleven matches thus far.

#### Wins vs. Losses

Michigan is putting down 14.25 kills per set on a .262 attack percentage in wins, while managing just 12.94 kills a set on a .170 attack percentage in losses. U-M's blocking is also a difference-maker in determining the outcome of the match. The Wolverines are averaging 2.37 blocks per set in wins, while recording just 1.69 in losses.

#### **Skjodt Earns Weekly Honor**

After committing no errors during contests against Rutgers (Oct. 14) and Maryland (Oct. 15), freshman outside hitter Carly Skjodt was named the Big Ten Conference Freshman Player of the Week. She also claimed her first career doubledouble in a 3-1 victory over Rutgers (Oct. 14), and her second against No. 6 Ohio State (Oct. 24). In Knop's absence, Skjodt filled a large role on defense, earning a career-high 16 digs in Michigan's 3-0 loss against No.4-ranked Nebraska.

#### **Rallies in Big Ten Play**

Michigan is 3-1 in five-set matches this season after rallying from an 0-2 deficit on Oct. 7 for a 3-2 win over lowa. The Wolverines also rallied for three-straight set wins against Michigan State for a 3-2 victory the weekend before (Oct. 3). In addition, Michigan won a five-setter earlier this season against Ohio (Sept. 5), and Michigan's only five-set loss came to Penn State (Oct. 21).

#### 6-2 Offensive System

For the first time since the 2006 season, Michigan's starting setter is not named "Lexi". After four years of three-time All-American Lexi Zimmerman (2007-10), followed by four seasons of setting by Lexi Dannemiller (2011-14), Michigan has moved to a 6-2 offensive system in 2015. Senior Carly Warner has gotten the starting nod through the first 15, setting from the back row, while freshman Maddy Abbott takes care of the other three rotations, coming off the bench for U-M. Warner is averaging 7.40 assists per set, while Abbott has averaged 4.39 helpers per frame.

#### **Morales Keeps Digging**

With 174 digs through the first 15 matches of the season,

senior libero Tiffany Morales became the third Wolverine to eclipse 1,500 in a career. She now has 1,718 digs, putting her at third place behind leader Stesha Selsky (2,178) and runner-up Sloane Donhoff (1,918). Morales has recorded at least 10 digs in ten matches this year, including a pair of 20-dig performances.

#### 20-20

Seniors Tiffany Morales and Carly Warner anchored Michigan's backline defense in a 3-0 weekend at Ohio (Sept. 4-5). The duo combined for 111 digs over the three matches. Against both LSU (Sept. 4) and Ohio (Sept. 5), Morales and Warner each recorded at least 20 digs. It was the first time since Nov. 18, 2011, that Michigan had teammates with at least 20 digs. The last time that happened was when Sloane Donhoff (30), Ally Sabol (23) and Lexi Dannemiller (20) each recorded at least 20 digs against Northwestern.

#### Cole Named Big Ten Player of the Week

After averaging 4.22 kills per set on a .567 attack percentage in three wins, junior middle blocker Abby Cole was named the Big Ten Co-Player of the Week on Sept. 14. It is her first weekly honor of the season and third of her career. In just two sets played against WMU (Sept. 11), Cole put down 12 kills on 16 swings with just one error for a .688 attack percentage. She added four digs in the match as U-M swept the Broncos to start the tournament. Cole was back in the starting lineup against South Carolina (Sept. 11), going for a team-best 12 kills with no errors in a U-M sweep of the Gamecocks. In the tournament finale against Pitt (Sept. 12), the junior recorded 14 kills, four blocks, an assist and a dig to help Michigan to a 3-1 win. In nine sets played, Cole had 38 kills with just four errors on 60 attempts (.567).

#### Rosen In 17th Season

Head coach Mark Rosen enters his 17th season as head coach of the Michigan volleyball program. Since taking over in Ann Arbor, Rosen has led U-M to 13 NCAA berths, five Sweet 16's, two Elite Eight appearances, a Final Four berth and a 331-211 record. His wife, Leisa Rosen, joins him on the sidelines for the 17th consecutive season while assistant coach Erin Virtue starts her fifth season. Volunteer assistant coach Skylar Lopas enters his second season on Michigan's bench while director of volleyball operations Ben Belanger begins his third campaign.

#### **Wolverine Recruiting Class Earns High Ranking**

Michigan's four-member incoming recruiting class of Maddy Abbott, Cori Crocker, Jenna Lerg and Carly Skjodt has been ranked as the 15th-best class in the country by PrepVolleyball.com. Skjodt was named PrepVolleyball.com's National Senior Player of the Year while Crocker was named the website's No. 46 Senior Ace. The website also named Lerg as one of the best liberos in the country coming out of high school and Abbott as a high-level setter.

#### Quintet Spends Summer with USA Volleyball, B1G

Five members of the Michigan volleyball program spent time this summer with various teams associated with USA Volleyball and the Big Ten. Senior Tiffany Morales and junior **Abby Cole** were on the roster for the USA Collegiate National Team China Tour while sophomore Caroline Knop visited Europe as part of the USA Women's National Junior Team. Knop was joined by assistant coach Erin Virtue, who was coach on that squad. Senior Krystalyn Goode participated in the Collegiate National Team program in New Orleans while sophomore Adeja Lambert was on the inaugural Big Ten Foreign Tour team in Europe.

#### Oh Captain, My Captain

Michigan announced its captains for the 2015 season this week. Fifth-year senior Olivia Reed will be Michigan's captain, while senior/junior Kelly Murphy and senior Tiffany Morales will be the assistant captains.

### **MARK ROSEN • 17TH YEAR** 545-255 OVERALL 336-218 AT MICHIGAN

#### Rosen Enters His 17th Year at Michigan

Mark Rosen enters his 17th year at Michigan in 2015, compiling a 331-211 mark in Ann Arbor. He has coached five All-Americans in Erin Moore, Lexi Zimmerman, Juliana Paz, Alex Hunt and Jennifer Cross. Rosen is joined on the sidelines by his wife and associate head coach, Leisa Rosen, and assistants Erin Virtue and Skylar Lopas (volunteer).

#### Winningest Coach at Michigan

With a 3-1 win over Purdue during the 2008 season, Mark Rosen became the program's winningest coach. The victory was his 178th at Michigan, passing Sandy Vong's previous mark of 177 triumphs. With a 3-0 win over Marquette during 2009, Rosen became the first coach at Michigan to win 200 matches.

#### **How He Stacks Up**

With his 528 career wins at four-year colleges to enter the 2014 season, Mark Rosen ranks 22nd among the winningest active coaches. He is the third Big Ten coach on the list behind Penn State head coach Russ Rose and Nebraska head coach John Cook. Rosen also is 35th by all-time winning percentage (.683) in Division I.

#### 500-Win Club

Mark Rosen picked up his 500th career win on Aug. 31, 2013, in a 3-0 win over Northern Kentucky. Rosen has 528 wins at Northern Michigan, Cal State Bakersfield, Boise State and Michigan and is one of 23 active coaches in Division I with 500 career wins.

#### First Final Four in 2012

Mark Rosen became the first coach in history to lead the Wolverines to the NCAA Final Four when U-M reached the national semifinals in 2012. Michigan knocked off No. 2 Stanford in four sets in the regional final in Berkeley, Calif., to advance to the national semifinal against Texas in Louisville, Ky. The Wolverines were the only team to take sets off the Longhorns in the NCAA Tournament, falling to Texas in a five-set thriller.

#### **Big Ten Honors**

Mark Rosen has had at least one player earn All-Big Ten honors in seven of the last nine seasons, led by Lexi Zimmerman's three consecutive first team honors (2008, 2009, 2010). In his 16 years at Michigan, Rosen has coached players to 14 All-Big Ten citations, in addition to Stesha Selsky's Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honor in 2007.

#### 300 at Michigan

Head coach Mark Rosen won the 300th match of his tenure at Michigan with a 3-1 win over lowa on Oct. 12, 2013. He is the sixth active coach to record 300 wins at Michigan, joining Carol Hutchins (softball), Red Berenson (ice hockey), Bev Plocki (women's gymnastics), Matt Anderson (water polo) and Kurt Golder (men's gymnastics).
