Nittany Lion Preview

The No. 13 Penn State men's volleyball team concludes its month-long road trip with visits to Princeton and George Mason on March 29-30. Both matches are set for 7 p.m. starts.

The Nittany Lions were last in action on March 23 at Saint Francis. Junior Peter Russell (Ellicott City, Md.) led the Nittany Lions with 4.33 kills per set, while sophomore Aaron Russell (Ellicott City, Md.) averaged 4.00. Senior Tom Comfort (Orchard Park, N.Y.) added 3.67 kills per set. Redshirt freshman Taylor Hammond (Mission Vieio, Calif.) paced the offense with 12.00 assists, 0.67 aces and 1.00 blocks per set. On defense, redshirt sophomore Connor Curry (Newport Beach, Calif.) recorded a match-best 4.00 digs per set and redshirt freshman Matt Seifert (Reading, Pa.) put up 1.00 blocks per set.

At Saint Francis, Penn State hit .412 and averaged 15.00 kills, 13.67 assists, 1.00 aces, 8.00 digs per set and 2.17 blocks per set.

Penn State vs. Princeton

Penn State owns a 47-2 all-time record against the Tigers. The teams met earlier this season with the Lions coming away with a 3-1 (25-23, 19-25, 25-22, 27-25) win. Princeton has not won a match against PSU since the 1998 EIVA Semifinal.

Scouting the Tigers

Princeton has secured a 9-6 overall record this season and is 7-2 in the EIVA to sit at second place in the standings behind the Nittany Lions. Princeton hosts Saint Francis on Thursday before welcoming the Nittany Lions to its own Dillon Gym.

The Tigers are led by junior outside Pat Schwagler who is averaging 3.84 kills per set this season. Junior setter Davis Waddell guides the offense with 10.04 assists per set, while sophomore libero Tony Ensbury is the team's top passer with 2.22 digs per set. Senior middle Michael Dye leads the Tigers at the net with 1.05 blocks per set.

Penn State vs. George Mason

The Nittany Lions are 91-14 all-time against the Patriots. This is their second meeting in 2013. Penn State hosted George Mason on Feb. 22 and earned a 3-1 (25-21, 25-20, 21-25, 25-22) victory. George Mason hosts Saint Francis on March 22 before taking on the Nittany Lions.

Scouting the Patriots

George Mason is 11-10 overall and 7-2 in the EIVA. The Patriots have won four of their last six matches, including a 3-1 win against Juniata and a 3-0 sweep of Lees-McRae most recently. Top players to watch for GMU include senior outside Mark Jones, who averages 3.50 kills per set, as well as senior outsides Michael Kvidahl and Andrew Dentler who each hit 3.17 kills per set. Senior setter Javier Perez paces the offense with 10.35 assists per set and senior outside Max McFarland is the Patriots top passer with 2.56 digs per set. Senior middle Piotr Dabrowski is impressive at the net with an average of 1.25 blocks per set.

Weekend Recap

The Nittany Lions snapped a three-match losing streak with a 3-0 sweep of Saint Francis on March 23. Three Nittany Lions posted double-digit kills, including junior Peter Russell with 13, sophomore Aaron Russell with 12 and senior Tom Comfort who pounded 11. Redshirt freshman Taylor Hammond dished out 36 assists and two aces, while redshirt sophomore Connor Curry had a match-high 12 digs. Hammond and redshirt freshman Matt Seifert had three blocks apiece.

What's Next?

For the first time in more than a month the Nittany Lions will be back in action in their home gym on April 5. Penn State hosts Lees-McRae at 7 p.m. on Senior Night. This is the final regular season match in the main gym. Penn State's home matches on April 19-20 will be played in the South Gym of Rec Hall.

Seifert Pounds Career High in Kills

Redshirt freshman Matt Seifert was one of three Nittany Lions to post double-digit kills at IPFW on March 9. He finished third on the team with 11 kills, a personal best, and also tied for first on the team with three blocks. Seifert went on to post six kills and two blocks at Ball State on March 10.

Russell and Seifert Garner EIVA Weekly Awards

Sophomore Aaron Russell and redshirt freshman Matt Seifert picked up EIVA Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week awards, respectively. The duo helped guide the Nittany Lions to EIVA wins against George Mason and Princeton on Feb. 22-23. Russell led the Nittany Lions with 35 kills with a .329 hitting percentage. He was second on the team in blocks with eight, averaging 1.00 per set and tallied three aces and nine digs. Seifert was unstoppable at the net combining for 13 total blocks for the weekend. He averaged 1.86 blocks per set. Seifert also posted 12 kills on .350 hitting, with two digs and an ace.

Nittany Lions Sweep EIVA Awards

Junior Peter Russell and redshirt sophomore Connor Curry earned EIVA Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week laurels, respectively, on Jan. 28. The pair led Penn State to wins against Loyola-Chicago, Sacred Heart and Harvard. Russell hit .358 for the week and totaled 26 kills, four aces, 13 digs and eight blocks. Curry combined for 29 digs, averaging 2.64 digs per set. His effective passing helped Penn State hit .240 for the week.

Russell and Curry Earn EIVA Weekly Honors

Two Nittany Lions were named EIVA Players of the Week. Redshirt sophomore Connor Curry was named the EIVA Defensive Player of the Week, while sophomore Aaron Russell was named the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week on Jan. 14. The duo helped Penn State to a 2-1 record in the Outrigger Invitational.

Russell, who was named to the Outrigger All-Tournament Team, led the Lions offensively with 42 kills and 45.0 points. He finished second on the team with 22 digs, averaging 1.69 per set and had a team-best 3.23 kills per set on .295 hitting. Curry was the starting libero for all three matches in Honolulu. He posted a team-high 29 digs (2.23 per set) and also had six assists. His effective passing helped Penn State hit .296 for the week.

Outrigger Invitational All-Tournament Team

Two members of the Penn State men's volleyball team earned spots on the Outrigger Invitational All-Tournament Team. Sophomore Aaron Russell and redshirt-freshman Taylor Hammond were Penn State's honorees. Russell Named Off the Block Preseason All-American

Sophomore Aaron Russel was named to the Off the Block Preseason First Team All-America Team for Division I-II. He was one of 20 players nationwide selected to the teams. A total of 10 players were named Preseason First Team and Preseason Second Team All-Americans. Players from 11 different programs were picked. Russell helped guide Penn STate to a 23-6 overall record in 2012, including a 14-0 record in EIVA action. He was a 2012 Third Team Volleyball Magazine All-American, a First Team All-EIVA honoree and was named to the EIVA Championship All-Tournament team.






