Nittany Lion Preview

The Nittany Lions improved to 16-3 overall and remain undefeated in EIVA action at 9-0 after defeating NJIT and Rutgers-Newark on the road on March 23-24.

Redshirt senior Joe Sunder (Greensburg, Pa.) led Penn State with 4.29 kills per set, while junior Tom Comfort (Orchard Park, N.Y.) posted 3.67 kills per set. Redshirt senior Edgardo Goas (San Juan, Puerto Rico) dished out 10.43 assists per set, while junior Nick Turko (Lewisberry, Pa.) had a team-best 1.00 aces per set. Redshirt freshman Connor Curry (Newport Beach, Calif.) registered 2.57 digs per set and Sunder led the team in blocks with 0.71 blocks per set.

For the weekend Penn State hit .339 and averaged 13.00 kills per set, 12.00 assists per set, 1.57 aces per set, 9.00 digs per set and 2.36 blocks per set.

Penn State vs. Princeton

The Nittany Lions are 44-2 all-time against the Tigers dating back to 1977. The teams met previously this season in Rec Hall with Penn State earning a 3-0 (25-18, 25-15, 25-18) win. Of the EIVA opponents Penn State has played this season, Princeton recorded the highest hitting percentage of any other league team against the Nittany Lions at .234.

Scouting the Tigers

Princeton is currently sitting in fifth place in the EIVA with a 5-5 league record and a 7-7 overall record. After a three-match winning streak from Feb. 25-March 2, the Tigers went on to lose their next three matches before rebounding with a 3-2 victory against Juniata on March 24.

Penn State vs. George Mason

The Nittany Lions own an 88-14 series record with the Patriots dating back to 1977. Penn State and George Mason met earlier this season on Feb. 25 where the Nittany Lions walked away with a 3-0 sweep at home in Rec Hall.

Scouting the Patriots

The Patriots will face Saint Francis on Friday, March 30 before taking on Penn State.

Weekly Recap

The Nittany Lions are 16-3 overall and 9-0 in league play after defeating NJIT, 3-1, on March 23 and Rutgers-Newark, 3-0, on March 24.. Redshirt senior Joe Sunder had a team-best 30 kills, while redshirt senior Edgardo Goas posted 73 assists. Junior Nick Turko had a team-leading six aces, while redshirt freshman Connor Curry was dependable on defense with 18 digs. Sunder had a team-high five blocks, while junior Tom Comfort, Turko and freshman Aaron Russell had four blocks apiece.

Curry Picks Up EIVA Defensive Player of the Week Honors

Redshirt freshman Connor Curry was named the EIVA Defensive Player of the Week on March 26. It was the third honor of his career. Curry was the starting libero for the Nittany Lions against both NJIT and Rutgers-Newark on March 23-24. Curry led the team in digs with 18, averaging 2.57 digs per set. His effective passing aided Penn State to a .339 hitting percentage for the week. Against NJIT, Curry matched his personal best with 13 digs, and he had zero reception errors in 16 attempts. Against Rutgers-Newark, Curry was second on the team in digs with five and had only two reception errors in 10 attempts.

Sunder Garners EIVA Offensive Player of the Week Laurels

Redshirt senior Joe Sunder earned EIVA Offensive Player of the Week honors on March 19. Sunder helped Penn State remain undefeated in EIVA play with a 3-0 win at Saint Francis on March 17. He posted a team-best 13 kills on .500 hitting, while also tallying a squad-best five digs. He totaled 16 points for the match after also serving three aces. Sunder averaged 4.33 kills, 1.00 aces, 1.67 digs and 5.33 points per set.

Curry Selected EIVA Defensive Player of the Week

Redshirt freshman Connor Curry was named the EIVA Defensive Player of the Week on March 12. It was his second honor of the season. Curry aided the Nittany Lions in battles against two top 15 teams, including No. 10 Pepperdine on March 8 and No. 4 USC on March 9. Against the Waves, Curry was second on the team with seven digs and had zero reception errors in 35 attempts. Against the Trojans, Curry had a team-high 10 digs and just one error in 20 reception attempts. He averaged 2.12 digs per set in the two matches.

Goas Named EIVA Offensive Player of the Week

Redshirt senior Edgardo Goas was named the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week on Feb. 27. It was the first conference honor of the season for Goas.

Goas led the Nittany Lions to two wins against EIVA foes Princeton and George Mason. He averaged 11.17 assists per set and guided Penn State to a .389 hitting percentage for the weekend. In addition, three of his primary hitters had hitting percentages of .364 or higher.

Goodell & Curry Nab EIVA Weekly Awards

Redshirt freshmen Nick Goodell and Connor Curry were named the EIVA Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 20. The pair guided Penn State to wins against Harvard and Sacred Heart. Goodell hit .750 against Harvard with 15 kills on 20 errorless swings before tallying eight kills on .429 hitting. Curry was the starting libero in both matches. He averaged 3.67 digs per set, posting nine digs vs. Harvard and a career-high 13 vs. SHU.

In honor of All-American MAtt Anderson's father Mike Anderson, who passed away unexpectedly in 2010, the Penn State volleyball family has chosen to honor one Nittany Lion at the conclusion of each match in honor of Mike.

Russell Tabbed EIVA Offensive Player of the Week

Sophomore Peter Russell was named the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week on Feb. 6. Russell started both matches of the weekend at outside hitter. Against the Trojans, Russell posted a team-high nine kills on 14 errorless swings for a .643 hitting percentage. He also tallied an ace and two blocks. The following night against the Lancers, Russell tied for first on the team with eight kills with three digs and a block. For the weekend, Russell had a team-high 17 kills, averaging 2.83 kills per set on .474 hitting. He also contributed five digs and three blocks.

Goas Named Primetime Performer of the Week

Redshirt senior setter Edgardo Goas was named a Prime-time Performer of the Week for men's volleyball. Goas was one of 16 honorees across 21 Division I sports. Goas guided the Nittany Lions to 3-1 victories against No.4 Stanford and No. 12 Pacific on the Ken and Dave Dunlap Invitational hosted by Ohio State on Feb. 27-28. As the starting setter in both matches, Goas paced the Penn State offense to a .377 hitting percentage for the weekend and averaged 13.50 assists per set. His five primary hitters had .333 attack percentages or better. Goas also contributed defensively with 1.62 digs per set and 0.50 blocks per set.

Goodell Earns EIVA Offensive Player of the Week Laurels

Redshirt freshman Nick Goodell (Ambridge, Pa.) was named the EIVA Player of the Week on Jan. 30. This is the first honor of Goodell's career.

Goodell was integral to Penn State's wins against No.4 Stanford and No. 12 Pacific at the Ken and Dave Dunlap Invitational hosted by Ohio State on Jan. 27-28. Against the Cardinal, Goodell played three sets tallying 10 kills on .333 hitting and contributed two blocks. The following night against the Tigers, Goodell made his first start. Goodell led the team with 17 kills on .382 hitting. He also had a team-high three aces, as well as six digs and five blocks. For the weekend, Goodell was second on the team with 27 kills and had a .364 hitting percentage. He was also second on the squad with seven total blocks.

Season Opening Record

The Nittany Lions opened the 2012 season in Columbus, Ohio with a 3-0 sweep of the defending national champion Ohio State Buckeyes. Under head coach Mark Pavlik the Nittany Lions improved to 10-8 in season openers since 1995.

Penn State Newcomers

The Nittany Lions welcome the addition of four newcomers to this year's squad, including 6-4 setter Taylor Hammond, 6-9 middle hitter Aaron Russell, 6-8 middle hitter Kyle Grehan and 6-9 middle hitter Matt Seifert. In addition, redshirt freshmen Connor Curry (6-0, Libero) and Nick Goodell (6-4, Outside Hitter) will also have the opportunity to see time on the court this season.

Season-Opening Change

For the first time in five years, the Nittany Lion men's volleyball team will not open its season at the Hawaiian Outrigger Invitational in Honolulu, Hawaii. Penn State heads to Ohio State on Jan. 14 to take on the Buckeyes, who are 1-2 so far this season. The Nittany Lions last opened their season at Ohio State in both 2001 and 2002.

Men's Volleyball Debuts at No. 7 in AVCA Div. I-II Preseason Coaches Poll

The Penn State men's volleyball team debuts in the 2012 AVCA Division I-II Preseason Coaches Poll at No. 7. The Nittany Lions face eight teams in 2012 that are ranked in this year's preseason poll, including No. 8 Ohio State, No. 10 Loyola, No. 13 Lewis, No. 4 Stanford, No. 15 Pacific, No. 9 Pepperdine, No. 5 USC and No. 1 BYU.

Two Nittany Lions Named Off The Block Preseason All-Americans

Two members of the Penn State men's volleyball team were named to the Off the Block Preseason All-America Teams for Division I-II. Seniors Edgardo Goas and Joe Sunder were each selected. Penn State was one of five teams with multiple Preseason All-Americans selected. BYU, Stanford, UCLA and USC each had three players honored as First or Second Team honorees.
