NITTANY LIONS HEAD TO BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Penn State women's gymnastics team heads to Lincoln, Neb., for the 2016 Big Ten Women's Gymnastics Championships Saturday inside the Bob Devaney Sports Center. Penn State will compete in the evening session at 5 p.m. EDT along with Michigan, Michigan State, Minnesota, Nebraska and Ohio State. Illinois, Iowa, Maryland and Rutgers compete in the morning session at noon EDT.

Both sessions are live on the Big Ten Network with Shawn Johnson and Dean Linke on the call.

The rotation order for Penn State follows as: bye, floor exercise, vault, bye, uneven bars and balance beam.

The Nittany Lions recently recorded a second-place finish at the Big Five Qualifier with the fourth-best score in program history (197.125). At the meet, junior Nicole Medvitz tied the fifth-best score on the balance beam in school history with her career-best 9.975.

Minnesota captured the top spot at the Big Five Qualifier, and the 2016 Big Ten Women's Gymnastics regular season title, with its score of 197.425. The Golden Gophers secured the meet title with their program-best 49.675 on the balance beam.

Overall, Minnesota finished first with a 197.425, followed by Penn State (197.125), Michigan (196.875), Iowa (196.650) and Rutgers (194.550).

Following the meet, a trio of Nittany Lions received All-Big Ten honors. Kiera Brown and Briannah Tsang received All-Big Ten First Team plaudits, while Nicole Medvitz garnered All-Big Ten Second Team honors.

2015 BIG TEN RECAP

The No. 11 Penn State women's gymnastics team posted the highest Big Ten Championships score in program history at 196.725 to claim a fourth place finish at the event on Saturday inside the Crisler Center. Freshman Briannah Tsang (Vancouver, British Columbia) was named Co-Big Ten Freshman of the Year following the event.

Michigan won the Big Ten title with a score of 197.825 and was followed by Illinois (197.350), Nebraska (196.875) and Penn State. Iowa finished fifth (196.500), Minnesota sixth (196.450) and Maryland claimed seventh (196.075). The standings were rounded out by Michigan State (195.650), Ohio State (195.250) and Rutgers (193.125), who finished 8-10, respectively. The team score of 196.725 is the highest in Penn State history at the Big Ten summit, topping the 196.675 score by the 2000 squad. It is the 11th time in 24 championship appearances the Nittany Lions scored better than 196.000 at the conference summit.

Tsang finished the Big Ten Championships tied for 10th in the all-around and earned Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Year, sharing the honor with Michigan's Briannah Brown. The rookie becomes the fourth Penn Stater to win the B1G Freshman of the Year award, joining Sharaya Musser (2010), Brandi Personett (2007) and Nikki Bongiovanni (1999), after claiming a school-record four Big Ten Freshman of the Week awards during the regular season. It is the first shared Freshman of the Year honor since it was first awarded in 1988.

The freshman, who earned second-team All-Big Ten earlier this week, scored 39.350 to tie with Iowa's Sydney Hoerr for 10th in the all-around. She posted her highest finish on the uneven bars with a career-high-tying 9.900 on the apparatus to finish tied for fifth. Tsang tied for 18th on the floor exercise at 9.850. She also scored 9.800 on the vault and the balance beam.

In her final Big Ten Championships appearance, senior Sidney Sanabria-Robles (Caguas, Puerto Rico) placed among the top-20 on three of the four apparatus and claimed a seventh place showing in the all-around. Her total of 39.375 included a 9.900 on the vault, 9.850 on both the uneven bars and floor exercise, and a 9.775 on the balance beam. She tied for fifth on the vault, finished tied for 20th on the uneven bars and was tied for 18th on the floor exercise.

The Nittany Lions Big Ten Sportsmanship Award recipient, senior Krystal Welsh (Bowie, Md.), also recorded a solid showing in the all-around with a 39.300. It was her fourth highest score of the year in the all-around. She posted her highest finish on the uneven bars with a 12th place showing at 9.875. She scored 9.825 on the vault and floor exercise, and scored 9.775 on the balance beam.

Penn State opened session two with a solid showing on the uneven bars and logged its second highest score of the season at 49.275. Tsang posted the team's top score at 9.900 to tie her career high, which she set at West Virginia on March 8, and finish tied for fifth on the apparatus. Welsh scored 9.875 and Sanabria-Robles anchored the rotation with a 9.850. Senior Alex Witt (Odessa, Fla.) and sophomore Christina Postiglione (Selden, N.Y.) both collected scores of 9.825 to round out the scoring. Freshman Chanen Raygoza (Upland, Calif.) also had a solid effort on the uneven bars at 9.800.

The second rotation featured a 49.000 on the balance beam for the Blue and White, led by Postiglione's career-high-tying 9.850 to finish tied for ninth overall on the event. Nicole Medvitz (Paramus, N.J.) and Tsang both totaled 9.800 scores, and Sanabria-Robles and Welsh each tallied a 9.775 to round out the scoring routines. Their team score through the first two rotations sat at 98.275.

After a bye in the third rotation, Penn State headed to the floor exercise and scored 49.175 to run the team total to 147.450. A trio of Nittany Lions scored 9.850, with Sanabria-Robles, Emma Sibson (Allen, Texas) and Tsang all logging the score to finish tied for 18th overall. A 9.825 from Welsh was the fourth best score on the squad, while senior Lexi Carroll (Olney, Md.) and freshman Oni Timothy (Rochester, N.Y.) each scored 9.800.

The fourth rotation featured a 49.275 score for the Nittany Lions to the vault before they headed to their second bye rotation to close out the meet. Sanabria-Robles and Sibson led the squad on the rotation with matching 9.900 scores to tie for fifth on the apparatus. A 9.850 from Timothy, a 9.825 by Welsh and a 9.800 from Tsang rounded out the scoring gymnasts for Penn State.

HEAD COACH JEFF THOMPSON



Entering his sixth season at the helm of the Penn State women's gymnastics program, Jeff Thompson has led the Nittany Lions program back on to the national scene. Named the ninth head coach in program history on July 15, 2010, Thompson helped the Nittany Lions end a four-year drought and return to the NCAA Championships in 2014.

In 2015, Thompson and his staff helped Briannah Tsang earn the honor of Big Ten Freshman of the Year. Tsang is the fourth Nittany Lion in program history to receive the accolade.

As a team, Penn State finished the regular season with a record of 14-3. The Nittany Lions ended the 2015 season ranked No. 22 in the NCAA to mark the 13th straight season the program has finished among the top-25 nationally.

During the 2014-15 academic year, the Penn State women's gymnastics team won its fifth-straight Champs Cup [Penn State Team Community Service Award] for work in the community.

It was memorable 2014 campaign, as the Blue and White posted one of its most consistent seasons in the gym and in the classroom. The Lions set a school record for the highest score in a road meet – ranking third all-time – and recorded the highest postseason score in school history to place second at the NCAA Regional and earn their 17th trip to the NCAA Championships in school history.

A trip to the NCAA Championships, hosting the NCAA Regional and Big Ten Championships in Rec Hall, eight Penn State all-time top-10 performances, five Academic All-Big Ten, five Big Ten weekly award winners, four NACGC/W Scholastic All-Americans, three All-Big Ten honorees and one All-American highlighted the successful campaign.

Kassidy Stauder capped one of the most remarkable seasons in Penn State history with regular-season All-America honors on the balance beam. It was the first honor of her career and came on the heels of being named first team All-Big Ten and Big Ten All-Championship. Stauder won 16 individual titles, including three all-around, six balance beam and seven uneven bar crowns in 2014.

Sidney Sanabria-Robles and Krystal Welsh were named second team All-Big Ten, while freshman Emma Sibson posted two of the top-10 vaults in school history during her rookie campaign and was a two-time Big Ten Freshman of the Week award winner.

As a team, Penn State finished the season ranked No. 12 nationally and owned a 20-3 regular season record, including a third place finish in the Big Ten

regular season standings. For the fourth straight year, the women's gymnastics program was awarded the Penn State Team Community Service Award for their work in the community during the 2013-14 academic year.

On the coaching front, Thompson guided the Lions to the first 20-win regular season in school history and became just the third head coach in NCAA history to lead two different programs to the NCAA Championships. He joined K.J. Kindler (Iowa State & Oklahoma) and Judi Avener-Markell (Penn State & Florida).

The 2013 season concluded with senior Sharaya Musser earning regular-season All-America honors on balance beam and in the all-around and also All-America honors on balance beam and in the all-around at the NCAA Championships to push her career total to eight All-America certificates. The Lions were ranked as high as No. 14 in the national rankings and ended the season at No. 15 with a National Qualifying Score of 392.375.

Musser was also a first team All-Big Ten selection, Big Ten All-Championship Team pick and joined Lindsay Musgrove on the Big Ten Distinguished Scholars ledger. Madison Merriam was a first team All-Big Ten selection, as well.

Five gymnasts earned Academic All-Big Ten accolades for their work in the classroom, including Alex Witt, along with Merriam, Musgrove, Musser and Stauder. In 2013, the team was awarded the Penn State Team Community Service Award for the third straight year.

In 2012, Thompson and his staff helped Musser earn the distinction of Big Ten Gymnast of the Year, marking the seventh time in program history a Nittany Lion was bestowed the award. Musser's award marked the third time in a four year span that a Penn State gymnast won the Big Ten Gymnast of the Year award. Additionally, Musser advanced to the NCAA Championships where she was named an All-American on floor exercise and balance beam. Thompson also produced six Academic All-Big Ten selections and two NACGC/W

scholar athletes. Also in 2012, the team was awarded the Penn State Team Community Service Award for the second straight year.

A two-time SEC Coach of the Year, Thompson joined the Penn State family in 2010 after 11 successful years at Auburn University.

In his first season at the helm of the Nittany Lion program, Thompson guided the Nittany Lions to a second place finish at the 2011 Big Ten Championships, with Natalie Ettl and Musser earning individual event titles on uneven bars and in the all-around, respectively. Penn State earned a berth to the NCAA Regional Championships as the No. 2 seed and narrowly missed advancing to the NCAA Championships.

Three Nittany Lions were selected to the 2011 All-Big Ten team, and Musser, a Honda Award nominee, advanced to the NCAA National Championships to represent Penn State. Outside the gym, the Nittany Lions excelled in the classroom and community. Five gymnasts earned Academic All-Big Ten laurels and the team was awarded the Penn State Team Community Service Award.

In 11 years as the head of the Auburn University women's gymnastics program, Thompson was named both the SEC Coach of the Year and NCAA Regional Head Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2008. The Tigers qualified for NCAA Regionals under Thompson for the first time in 2003 and advanced to the NCAA Championship that same year. Auburn's women's gymnastics team continued to improve each year and qualified for the NCAA Regionals for eight consecutive years. In 2005, Auburn hosted the NCAA Women's Gymnastics Championships.

With the exception of the University of Alabama, Thompson's teams posted victories over every SEC team during his tenure. In his final season in 2010, Thompson led Auburn to upset victories over No. 8 Arkansas, No. 12 Kentucky and finally defeated 10-time National Champion and five-time defending SEC Champion Georgia for the first time in program history.

Thompson and his wife, Rachelle, helped produced four NCAA All-Americans, four All-SEC selections, three SEC Gymnast of the Year winners and one SEC Freshman of the Year during their time at Auburn. They coached nine NCAA Championship individual qualifiers and four NCAA Regional Event Champions. Their gymnasts also excelled in the classroom and in the community in their 11 years with the program. There were three SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year winners, three CoSIDA Academic All-District members, 41 NACGC/W Academic All-Americans and 53 SEC Academic Honor Roll selections.

Prior to arriving at Auburn, Thompson was the assistant coach at Louisiana State University from 1994-99 and was the Junior Olympic Program Director at the Cincinnati Gymnastics Academy in Fairfield, Ohio from 1993-94. Thompson also held assistant coaching positions at two Big Ten institutions, Illinois and Wisconsin, as well as serving as a graduate assistant coach at Kentucky.

Thompson earned a bachelor of arts in education with an emphasis in Physical Education from Kentucky in 1985. He went on to receive a Master of Science in Biomechanics in 1995.

A native of Highland Heights, Ky., Jeff is married to the former Rachelle Fruge, who is the associate head coach for the Nittany Lions, and they have two sons, Parker and Griffin.

Heading into the meet, Michigan ranks seventh in the regional qualifying score (RQS) rankings, Nebraska is 12th, Minnesota is 16th, Iowa is 18th, Illinois is 25th, Penn State ranks 28th, Ohio State is 29th, Michigan State is 36th, Maryland is 38th and Rutgers ranks 40th.

Individually, Michigan's Olivia Karas and Minnesota's Lindsay Mable lead the Big Ten in the all-around with their RQS of 39.500, Karas leads the Big Ten on the vault (9.935), Penn State's Kiera Brown leads the Big Ten on the uneven bars (9.905), Illinois' Sunny Kato leads the Big Ten on the balance beam (9.915) and Michigan's Nicole Artz' leads the Big Ten on the floor exercise (9.940).

During the regular season, the Nittany Lions went 6-3 against the Big Ten.

Penn State opened up the Big Ten regular season with a pair of losses to Nebraska (196.150-194.575) and Illinois (195.725-195.025) before winning three-straight Big Ten meets.

Following the pair of Big Ten losses, the Blue and White recorded three-straight Big Ten wins to improve to 3-2 on the year.

Penn State tallied wins at Michigan State (195.700-195.175), Ohio State (195.925-195.675) and Maryland (196.350-195.350).

The Nittany Lions capped off the 2016 Big Ten regular season with a second-place finish at the Big Five Qualifier.

Minnesota finished first with a 197.425, followed by Penn State (197.125), Michigan (196.875), Iowa (196.650) and Rutgers (194.550).

In 2013, the Big Ten began crowning a regular season Big Ten Champion based on conference standings.

ALL-BIG TEN HONORS

Kiera Brown, Nicole Medvitz and Briannah Tsang garnered All-Big Ten honors following the Big Five Qualifier.

Brown and Tsang were named to the All-Big Ten First Team, while Medvitz was named to the All-Big Ten Second Team.

Brown and Tsang are the 27th and 28th Nittany Lions to receive the honor of All-Big Ten First Team.

Brown, in her first year with Penn State women's gymnastics, leads the Big Ten on the uneven bars with her regional qualifying score (RQS) of 9.905 and she also ranks seventh in the all-around (39.290).

Medvitz collects her first All-Big Ten honor as a Nittany Lion for her work on the balance beam during her junior year. She currently ranks seventh in the Big Ten on the balance beam with her RQS of 9.885. Throughout the 2016 season, Medvitz has led the Nittany Lions on the balance beam. Medvitz has tallied six of the top-12 scores for Penn State on the balance beam this season. Tsang, the 2015 Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Year and second team honoree, joins Brown on the All-Big Ten First Team. On the year, Tsang has won the floor exercise title four times, the vault title three times and the all-around title once.

In the Big Ten rankings heading into the Big Ten Women's Gymnastics Championships, Tsang ranks eighth on the floor exercise (9.885), is tied for ninth on the vault (9.845) and ranks 10th in the all-around (39.260).

IMPROVING ON THE BEAM

On the balance beam, Penn State opened the year with a 47.950 against North Carolina State then a 48.150 against Nebraska and then a 49.025 against Illinois.

Junior Nicole Medvitz has claimed two balance beam titles and shared one balance beam title within a six-day span. Medvitz has finished first or tied for first during a span of four-straight meets.

She won her first of four balance beam titles with a then-career-best 9.900 against Alabama, Cornell and Denver. Two days later, Medvitz captured the balance beam title at Maryland with a 9.875 and tied for the balance beam title at the Unite for Her meet with a

9.900.

Against Arizona State, freshman Jessica Jones and Medvitz tied for the balance beam title with their scores of 9.875.

Most recently at the Big Five Qualifier, Medvitz and the Nittany Lions hit a 49.375, which tied the fourth-best balance beam score in program history.

Though she didn't collect her fifth-straight balance beam title, Medvitz placed second with her career-best 9.975, which is tied for fifth-best in school history.

CAREER DAY FOR GARCIA

Against Maryland, freshman Sabrina Garcia had a banner evening for the Nittany Lions.

In the meet, Garcia tallied a second-place finish in the all-around with a career-best 39.325. En route to her score, Garcia tallied a career-best on the vault (9.800), tied a career-best on the uneven bars (9.875), hit a career-best 9.850 on the balance beam and posted a career-best 9.800 on the floor exercise.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

The 2016 roster is comprised of 14 student-athletes, which includes seven freshmen. Eight of the 14 Nittany Lions are newcomers to the program, as Kiera Brown will be a junior this season for Penn State. Brown joins the Nittany Lions after transferring from the University of Georgia.

The 2016 Nittany Lions do not feature any seniors, but will be led by a quartet of juniors. The Nittany Lions also return Briannah Tsang, who was the 2015 Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Year.

RAISING THE BAR

Over the first seven meets of the season, the Nittany Lions have improved their team score from the previous meet all but once.

The Nittany Lions started the year with a 194.125 (NC State), followed that up with a 194.575 (Nebraska), posted a 195.025 (Illinois), tallied a 195.700 (Michigan State) recorded a 195.925 against Ohio State, finished with a 195.100 in the Penn State Quad and posted a then-season-high 196.350 in a win over Maryland (Feb. 22).



Four days after the Maryland meet, Penn State posted its fourth-best score of the year (195.675).

The Nittany Lions are coming off their fourth-best score in program history (197.125), which was set at the Big Five Qualifier.

NITTANY LION DEBUTS

Six Nittany Lions made their debut on Jan. 9, 2016 against North Carolina State. Five of the seven freshmen competed along with junior transfer Kiera Brown.

In their debuts, freshman Jessica Jones won the floor exercise title with her score of 9.850 and Brown won the uneven bars with a score of 9.950. Brown's score of 9.950 tied the number three performance in school history.

THE FIRST TEAM TO TWENTY

The 2014 edition of the Nittany Lions became the first group of gymnasts to crack the 20-win plateau during the regular season in school history.

With two victories at the Big Ten Quad in Ann Arbor, Mich., the team moved past the 2007 squad for the most regular season victories in school history.

The 2007 team finished the year with a 19-4 overall mark and finished third at the NCAA Regional Championships.

In 2014, Penn State finished fifth at the Big Ten Championships, but followed that up with a second place showing, behind eventual co-national champion Florida, at the NCAA Regional and advanced to the NCAA Championships for the 17th time in program history.

NITTANY LIONS ON BTN

The Penn State women's gymnastics team will be featured twice on the Big Ten Network during the 2016 season.

The women's program enters the 2016 campaign ranked 17th in the NCAA and was picked fourth in the Big Ten Preseason Coaches' Poll. The Nittany Lions are slated to host Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota and Rutgers on Saturday, March 12 live on BTN starting at 1 p.m.

The 2016 Big Ten Women's Gymnastics Championships are hosted by the University of Nebraska inside the Devaney Center on March 19 in two sessions, starting at noon and 5 p.m. Both sessions will be live on BTN.

THOMPSON CAPTURES WIN NO. 150

Head coach Jeff Thompson is in his 17th season as a collegiate head coach and recently captured win No. 150. In his career, Thompson has compiled a 157-107 record.

On Feb. 22, 2016, Penn State defeated Maryland, 196.350-195.350, for Coach Thompson's 150th career win.

In his sixth season at the helm of Penn State, Thompson has a record of 85-25. Prior to Penn State, the Highland Heights, Ky., native tallied a record of 72-82 at Auburn.

In 2014, the Nittany Lions owned a 20-3 regular season record and set a school record for regular season victories on March 15 in the Big Ten Quad in Ann Arbor.

The previous school record was held by the 2007 squad, which finished 19-4 and placed third at the NCAA Regional Championships.

THOMPSON IN ELITE COMPANY

Head coach Jeff Thompson headed back to the NCAA Championships for the second time as a head coach and his first as the leader of the Nittany Lions in 2014.

Thompson's first appearance at the national meet came with Auburn in 2003 and he led the Nittany Lions back to the national summit for the first time since the program went in 2009.

He is just the third head coach in NCAA history to navigate two different programs to the NCAA Championships, joining K.J. Kindler (Iowa State & Oklahoma) and Judi Markell (Penn State and Florida).

Thompson took Auburn to the championships during his fourth season at the helm of the program. The Tigers finished 12th at the 2003 NCAA Championships, posting a team score of 193.525.

The Highland Heights, Kentucky, native guided Penn State to their 17th appearance at the NCAA Championships in his fourth year, as well. The Blue and White finished 12th with a team score of 194.825.

BIG TEN GYMNASTS TO WATCH

Penn State's Kiera Brown and Briannah Tsang were selected by the Big Ten women's gymnastics coaches as "Gymnasts to Watch" for the upcoming season.

Brown, a transfer from Georgia, will be a junior this year for the Nittany Lions. At Georgia, Brown was named All-SEC after she finished tied for second on the uneven bars at the 2014 SEC Championships. She also finished the 2014 season tied for 19th nationally on the uneven bars.

Tsang enters her sophomore season with the Nittany Lions after being named the 2015 Big Ten Freshman of the Year. Tsang was also named to the All-Big Ten second team. Last season, she competed in all 12 of the team's meets, including the NCAA Regional Championships. In 2015, she won at least one event title in each of her first seven career meets and posted at least one event win in eight of her 12 competitions.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Penn State enjoys one of the most historic collegiate gymnastics venues in the country and they take pride in giving the home crowd something to cheer for, including a lot of wins.

Since 1975, Penn State owns a 227-58 overall record in home meets. The Nittany Lions are 224-58 at Rec Hall and are 3-0 in meets contested inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The loss to North Carolina State on Jan. 9, 2016, snapped a seven-meet winning streak inside Rec Hall. The seven-meet winning streak was the fourth-best in program history.

Penn State swept its last two home meets in 2014 and was unblemished in its five home dates in 2015.

NITTANY LIONS WELCOME THREE IN 2017

Tess McCracken, Kristen Politz and Mikayla Waddell have signed their National Letters of Intent to attend Penn State University and participate in women's gymnastics for the 2017 season, head coach Jeff Thompson announced on Nov. 11, 2015.

McCracken, who trains at World Olympic Gymnastics Academy (WOGA) in Plano, Texas, has been coached by Laurent Landi, Cecile Canqueteau-Landi and Natasha Boyarskaya.

She was the 2012 Texas level 10 state champion on balance beam as well as second place on uneven bars while tallying a third place in the all-around. McCracken went on to compete in the USA Junior Olympic National Championships where she finished in the top-10 in the nation on uneven bars and balance beam.

Politz currently trains at Rebound Gymnastics in Marlboro, New Jersey, and is coached by Bob and Diane Ferrell.

Politz is a five-time consecutive Junior Olympic National Championship qualifier where she first qualified at the age of 12 and placed first on floor exercise and first in the all-around at the National Invitational Tournament.

In 2015, she finished sixth in the nation on the uneven bars at the USA Gymnastics Junior Olympic National Championships. During the same season, she was third on the balance beam at the Region Seven Championships and earned the title of New Jersey State champion in the all-around several weeks earlier by sweeping the titles on all four events.

In 2014, she finished first in the region on floor exercise and followed it up with a fourth place finish at the Junior Olympic National Championships.

Waddell, who trains at ENA Gymnastics in Paramus, New Jersey, is coached by Craig and Jennifer Zappa and John Wojtczuk and she, too, comes to Penn State with a great history.

In 2014, Waddell finished fourth in the nation on balance beam and seventh in the nation on Vault at the Junior Olympic National Championships.

She was also named the Region Seven vault, balance beam and all-around champion in 2014 as well as the state champion on balance beam. In 2013, she was the Region Seven champion on balance beam and in 2012, as a Level 9, she was the national champion on vault and balance beam at Eastern Nationals.

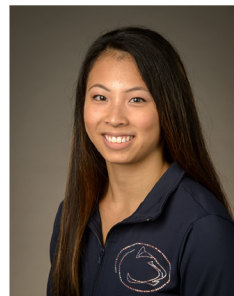
