In its final regular season game of 2014, the No. 5 Penn State field hockey team hosts No. 8 Northwestern at the Field Hockey Complex Friday at 3:30 p.m. The game is scheduled to be broadcast live on the Big Ten Network.

Northwestern Notes

- The Wildcats, ranked No. 8 in the most recent NFHCA Poll, are 12-5 this season with a 6-1 mark in conference play. Northwestern is tied with Maryland atop the Big Ten standings.
- Northwestern's only league loss came to No. 14 Michigan on Oct. 17. The Wildcats are the only team in the conference to beat Maryland, downing the second-ranked Terrapins, 3-2, on Sept. 20.
- Offensively, Northwestern is 11th nationally with 8.65 points per game. Dominique Masters and Isabel Flens are tied for the team lead with 28 points apiece. Masters has 11 goals and six assists, while Flens has 10 goals and eight assists. Charlotte Martin is 12th nationally, averaging 0.76 assists per game.
- Defensively, the Wildcats rank 11th nationally with a 1.30 goals against average.
- Tracey Fuchs is in her sixth season as the head coach.

Series History

Penn State is 27-5-1 all-time against Northwestern. Last season, the Nittany Lions picked up a 2-0 win against the 10th-ranked Wildcats. Penn State has won three of the last four matchups in a series that dates back to 1992.

Last Time Out

Despite holding an advantage in shots and corners, the No. 4 Penn State field hockey team fell at No. 15 Iowa, 4-0, on Oct. 25. The Nittany Lions outshot the Hawkeyes, 16-11, and held an 8-6 advantage in penalty corners, but couldn't capitalize on the opportunities.

Herold Moving up Goals List

Herold reached the 100-point mark with a goal and two assists at Ohio State (Sept. 28), to reach the 100 career point mark. She now has 50 goals and 16 assists for her career, giving her 116 career points. Her 50 goals are tied for ninth on Penn State's all-time list with head coach **Charlene Morett-Curtiss**. Herold is five goals away from being tied for eighth with 55.

Herold's Heroics

Herold posted three goals, all in the second half, against No. 14 Princeton on Sept. 12. It marked her first career hat trick. Against Ohio State (Sept. 28), she

had a career-high two assists. Scoring a goal in nine of the last 11 games, she is first on the team with 39 points, 16 goals and seven assists. Herold has four multi-goal games this season. The senior ranks seventh nationally in goals per game (0.94).

Gebhart with the Hat Trick

Gebhart has started all 80 games she has played in since arriving on campus as a freshman. Against Bucknell (Oct. 14), the senior had her first career hat trick, scoring all three goals in the first 18:46 of the game.

Gebhart on the Assist

Currently, Gebhart has 44 assists, which are two away from tying her for seventh on Penn State's all-time list and three from tying her for sixth. She is second on the team with six assists.

The Katies Hold Down the Defense

Senior backs **Katie Andrews** (Lancaster, Pa.) and **Katie Breneman** (Washington Boro, Pa.) lead a defense that is 13th nationally with a 1.34 goals against average. Breneman has started 58 games in her career and Andrews has started 47. This season, Andrews has played 70-plus minutes on 16 occasions, while Breneman has done it 15 times in 17 games.

Atop the Attendance List

Penn State is third nationally in total attendance this season, having 3,879 fans watch its home games, averaging 431 per contest. The only teams ahead of Penn State are Michigan at No. 2 and Maryland at No. 1.

Coming up with Corners

The Nittany Lions ranked seventh nationally with 8.06 penalty corners per game. The squad has had 12 or more on four separate occasions, including a season-high 16 against Lock Haven.

Big Ten Honors

Redshirt senior goalkeeper **Kylie Licata** (Mountain Top, Pa.) was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week twice this season. Most recently, she made a career-high 14 saves at No. 3 UConn and shut out Quinnipiac to earn the honor on Sept. 9. Licata earned Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week (Sept. 2), while back **Cori Conley** (Oak Park, Ill.)

was named Freshman of the Week following the season-opening wins. Licata made a career-high nine saves against the Lady Monarchs and shut out the Cavaliers. Conley played a key role defensively, helping a unit that held Virginia scoreless in a game for the first time since 2011.

Chrismer Capitalizing

Senior **Jenna Chrismer** (Mountain Top, Pa.) has been impressive offensively. Most recently, Chrismer tallied two goals at Ohio State. Prior to that, she posted a career-high two assists against No. 14 Princeton (Sept. 12) before tying her personal best with two goals vs. Lafayette (Sept. 14). She scored each of the team's goals in the 2-1 win over Old Dominion (Aug. 29), before tallying an assist against Virginia (Aug. 31) and at Quinnipiac (Sept. 7). She is second on the team with nine goals and tied for second with 23 points.

Solid in the Cage

Licata has been a force between the posts, making nine saves against Old Dominion and holding Virginia scoreless, the first time the Cavaliers were blanked since 2011. Then, at No. 3 Connecticut, she stopped a career-high 14 shots. Most recently, she made 10 saves against No. 18 Michigan. She ranks second fourth nationally with a .791 save percentage.

Ehret Making Noise

Sophomore **Emilee Ehret** (Philadelphia, Pa.) has scored four goals on just seven shots this season. She has played a key role in penalty corner chances, being the primary player to insert for the Nittany Lions.

Dazzling Dinunzio

Senior **Amanda Dinunzio** (State College, Pa.) posted the first multi-goal game of her career against Lock Haven, scoring two in the contest. It was a career-high four points for the senior. In back-to-back games at No. 2 Maryland (Oct. 10) and vs. Bucknell (Oct. 14), she posted her first two assists of the season.

Buttinger Breaks Out

Redshirt senior **Natalie Buttinger** (Kitchener, Ontario) scored the first two goals of her career in the 3-0 win over No. 6 Virginia.

Postseason Fixture

The Nittany Lions return after making the

NCAA Tournament field each of the last four seasons. Penn State has been at the top of the Big Ten in those seasons as well, being named co-conference regular season champions in 2013 and the outright winner in 2012. The squad won the Big Ten Tournament in 2011 and 2012.

Excelling with Experience

Penn State brings back six starters and three of its top six scorers from a season ago. The squad returns two 2013 Big Ten first team members in **Laura Gebhart (Mount Joy, Pa.)** and **Kylie Licata (Mountain Top, Pa.)**, while **Taylor Herold (Fredericksburg, Va.)**, who garnered second team honors, also returns. Herold led Penn State with 30 points (13 goals, four assists) last year. Gebhart was a 2013 Longstreth/NFHCA Division I second team All-American.

Preseason Accolades

Seniors **Katie Breneman (Washington Boro, Pa.)**, Gebhart and Herold were each named to the 2014 Big Ten Field Hockey Players to Watch List.

Remaining Elite in the Rankings

The Nittany Lions were selected No. 8 in the 2014 Penn Metro/NFHCA Division I Preseason Poll. The squad was the second-highest ranked of any Big Ten team in the top 20. Maryland (No. 1) was the only conference foe ranked higher. Penn State plays nine teams ranked that are ranked in the preseason poll.

Gebhart on the National Stage

Gebhart has been competing for the U.S. National Team each of the last two summers. She competed internation-

Challenging Schedule

Penn State has again put together a top-tier schedule, facing nine teams that were ranked in the 2014 NFHCA Preseason Poll, including conference-foes Maryland (1), Northwestern (14), Michigan State (16), Michigan (17) and Iowa (20). Along with the conference opponents, the squad also has matchups against Connecticut (3), Virginia (6), Princeton (7) and Old Dominion (9). Seven teams (ODU, Virginia, Connecticut, Quinnipiac, Princeton, Michigan State and Maryland) each made the 2013 NCAA Tournament.

The longest tenured coach in the Big Ten and the sixth-longest tenured at a single school in Division I field hockey history, Charlene Morett-Curtiss enters her 28th season as head coach of the Penn State field hockey program in 2014. Morett-Curtiss boasts a remarkable resume covering her time as the leader of the Nittany Lions. Over the last six years, Morett-Curtiss has led the Nittany Lions to three Big Ten regular season titles, two Big Ten Tournament championships and five NCAA Tournament appearances.

Morett-Curtiss currently ranks fifth all-time in Division I history in wins with 458 and is one of just six DI coaches to accumulate 400 career wins. She has led the Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 24 of her 27 years as head coach of Penn State and has helped maintain Penn State's distinction as the No. 3 ranked school in all-time NCAA Tournament appearances with 29.

A seven-time NFHCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year, Morett-Curtiss is an excellent teacher of field hockey. Her players earn national recognition on a yearly basis, 11 of whom have been named two-time first team All-Americans with Kelsey Amy being the most recent. Her teams dominate the national scene, consistently ranking among the Top 10 in the national polls. Penn State was ranked in the Top 10 of the STX/NFHCA poll for 32 consecutive weeks from the first poll of the 2005 season ending with the second poll of 2008. The squad achieved a No. 1 ranking in the STX/NFHCA poll for the first time in program history. From 2005-08, Penn State finished eighth, sixth, ninth and 11th respectively, in the final poll of the season.

Under Morett-Curtiss' tutelage, five of her players have been named Big Ten Athlete of the Year -- Traci Anselmo, Jen Coletta, Heather Gorlaski, Tracey Larson and Kiley Kulina. Six players have been voted the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year -- Natalie Berrena, Dawn Lammey, Larson, Tara Maguire, Allison Scola and Kelsey Amy. In 2012 and 2013, Brittany Grzywacz was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, earning the ninth and 10th Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors from Penn State, joining Anselmo, Gorlaski, Becca Main, Jill Martz, Jill Pearsall and Jen Long. Long, Anselmo and Grzywacz are the only Lions to be named Defensive Player of the Year twice.

Since Penn State's entry into the Big Ten in 1992, Morett's program has produced more First Team All-Big Ten selections, Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year, Big Ten Athletes of the Year and Big Ten Freshmen of the Year than any other program. Penn State's 10 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honorees are five more than any other school.

With Laura Gebhart, Brittany Grzywacz, Taylor Herold, Ashton Klingler and Kylie Licata earning All-Big Ten laurels last season, Penn State has now totaled 94 All-Big Ten selections since 1992, including 65 first team All-Conference choices, the most of any Big Ten school since Penn State moved to the Big Ten in 1992.

Overall, Penn State has had at least one first team All-American in 26 of the last 30 years, including every year from 1975-08. In 2007, for the first time since 2002, Penn State had two first team All-Americans in Long and Kiersten Wood.
