TONIGHT'S GAME

• After both teams enjoyed idle weekends, the Nittany Lions and Union will play the front end of a two-game series at Pegula Ice Arena Saturday night. The teams are facing off during Thanksgiving weekend for the second straight season.

INSIDE PEGULA ICE ARENA

- Freshman **David Goodwin** leads Penn State with five points and three goals at home. The Des Peres, Mo., native is also tied with classmate **Zach Saar** for most assists (2).
- In the faceoff circle, junior **Taylor Holstrom** paces the team with a .667 winning percentage, while **David Goodwin** (.643), **David Glen** (.568), **Casey Bailey** (.538) and **Dylan Richard** (.524) all boast faceoff winning percentages above .500.
- Sophomore **Matthew Skoff** has posted a 2-1-1 record with a 2.20 goals-against average and .910 save percentage.

PENN STATE AMONG BIG TEN LEADERS

- Sophomore defenseman **Luke Juha** leads all Big Ten blueliners with three power-play goals and is tied for third among defensemen in power-play points (4). The Mississauga, Ont., native is tied for fourth among the league's defensemen with six points (3g, 3a).
- Freshman **David Goodwin's** six points (3g, 3a) place him in a tie for eighth among Big Ten rookies, while **Ricky DeRosa** is tied for 11th with four points (2g, 2a).
- Penn State boasts the conference's top penalty kill (.849) and is one of two schools (Wisconsin) with two shorthanded goals.

LAST YEAR VS. THE DUTCHMEN

- Penn State dropped both its games at Union, falling by 2-0 and 4-1 scores, in 2012-13.
- Forward **David Glen** scored the lone Nittany Lion goal of the weekend, while **Matthew Skoff** set then-career highs with 40 and 42 saves.

SCOUTING UNION

- The Dutchmen, who are 5-1-1 in their last seven games, will enter the weekend on a three-game winning streak.
- Three players - Daniel Carr (1.27), Shayne Gostisbehere (1.09) and Mat Bodie (1.00) - average at least one point per game.
- Michael Pontarelli and Daniel Carr are tied for third in the NCAA with four power-play goals.
- Gostisbehere is tied for first among defensemen in points per game.
- Union, which is fifth in the NCAA in scoring offense (3.82), boasts the nation's 11th best power play (.230).

PENN STATE VS. RANKED FOES

- The Nittany Lions will play their third straight game against a ranked opponent Saturday night.
- Penn State is 1-5-0 all-time and 0-2-0 in 2013-14 against ranked foes.
- The Nittany Lions' lone win against a ranked team came in a 3-2 OT win at No. 16 Wisconsin (Feb. 25, 2012).

ALL-TIME VS. ECAC HOCKEY

- Penn State's lone matchups against ECAC Hockey teams have come against Union.
- The Dutchmen are the only ECAC squad on the Nittany Lions' schedule.

- After allowing a pair of first-period goals, McAdam stopped all 31 shots he faced during the final two periods.

- Sophomore goaltender **Matthew Skoff** is 9-4-1 with a 2.63 goals-against average and .916 save percentage in his last 14 games.

- The McKees Rocks, Pa., native has collected at least 31 saves -- including a career-high 48 stops against Robert Morris. Nov. 1, 2013 -- six times (5-1-0).

TRIP ALONG THE ATLANTIC

- The Nittany Lions (3-2-1 vs. AHA teams) opened the season with four straight games and six of their first seven contests against teams from Atlantic Hockey.

- Penn State will play its final game against an Atlantic Hockey team Dec. 27 when it faces Robert Morris at the Three Rivers Classic.

POWER PLAY FINDS SUCCESS

- The Nittany Lions recorded more than one power-play goal for the first time in their NCAA history, going 3-for-7 vs. Robert Morris Nov. 1.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- Five Nittany Lions reached the back of the net in a 5-4 win vs. Robert Morris Nov. 1.

- Penn State produced five unique goal scorers for the first time since a 5-1 win vs. Air Force Nov. 10, 2012.

- Freshman defenseman **Mike Williamson** scored his first career goal, which proved to be the game-winner.

• Penn State skated to its first tie in the NCAA era with a 3-3 draw against RIT Oct. 25.

DeROSA MAKES IMPACT

• Freshman forward **Ricky DeRosa** tallied a goal in his first career game when he scored with 2:46 left in the third period in PSU's 3-1 loss to Air Force Oct. 19.

McADAM, WILLIAMSON DEBUT

• Freshman goaltender **Eamon McAdam** and rookie defenseman **Mike Williamson** played in their first career games against Air Force Friday, Oct. 18. McAdam turned aside 27 shots in his collegiate debut.

BACK ON THE SCORESHEET

• With a goal against Air Force Oct. 18, **Luke Juha** reached the back of the net for the first time since scoring in a 5-1 win vs. the Falcons Nov. 10, 2012.

• Sophomore forward **Jonathan Milley**, who missed 18 games due to injury in 2012-13, recorded a helper for his first point since registering a three-point outing vs. Holy Cross Dec. 7, 2012.

LIONS OPEN PEGULA WITH WIN

• The Nittany Lions opened Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win over Army in front of a standing-room only crowd of 6,370.

• Four different Nittany Lions scored, including **David Goodwin** and **Eric Scheid**, who scored in their Penn State debuts.

• Sophomore **Matthew Skoff** made 25 saves.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS

• Redshirt junior defenseman **Nate Jensen** etched his name in the Pegula Ice Arena record books as the first player to score in the facility.

• Jensen's slapshot through traffic 3:02 into the first period gave the Nittany Lions the early 1-0 lead.

FRESHMEN SHINE

• Several freshmen shined in their Penn State debuts vs. Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• Forward **David Goodwin** led Penn State with a goal and an assist, while linemate **Zach Saar** tallied an assist.

• Forward **Dylan Richard** and defenseman **David Thompson** also logged significant minutes in the victory.

GETTING IT DONE EARLY

• In the team's first game, sophomore **Curtis Loik** tallied a shorthanded goal for Penn State, which only scored three shorthanded markers last season.

• The Nittany Lions scored their first shorthanded marker in their eighth game in 2012-13.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,782-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an \$88 million donation - the largest in University history - in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

TIME TO GO B1G

• The Nittany Lions will begin competition in the Big Ten for the league's first season.

• Each team will play the other five schools four times - twice at home and twice on the road.

• The Big Ten championship will be held March 20-22, 2014 at the Xcel Energy Center in Saint Paul, Minn.

KEYSTONE STATE NATIVES

• Penn State boasts six Pennsylvania natives - the most from any state or province.

• Keystone state natives include: **Ricky DeRosa** (Aston), **Eamon McAdam** (Perkasie), **Matthew Skoff** (McKees Rocks), **Peter Sweetland** (Newtown), **David Thompson** (Glen Mills) and **Connor Varley** (Lansdale).

• Junior **Tommy Olczyk** will serve as team captain for the second straight year, while redshirt junior defenseman **Nate Jensen** (second year) and sophomore forward **David Glen** (first year) will serve as assistant captains.
