NOTES AND HEADLINES

LADY LIONS TRAVEL TO ST. JOHN'S

The Lady Lions set off on their first road trip of the 2023-24 campaign as they travel to Queens, N.Y. to take on St. John's. The battle in the Carnesecca Arena will be streamed on FloSports with a tip time of 7 p.m.

In the second all-time meeting between Penn State and St. John's, the Lady Lions look to build on their strong opening record with a fourth win. The team has started the season 3-0 for the fourth consecutive season.

LAST TIME OUT

- » The Lady Lions earned their third straight victory to open the season 3-0 for their fourth consecutive year.
- » Penn State cruised to another 90-plus-point outing with a 91-85 victory over the reigning WNIT Champions Kansas.
- » The three score lines mark the most consecutive 90-plus-point team performances in a row since the opening three games of the 2010-11 season when the Lady Lions between Dayton 112-107 in double overtime followed by a 95-21 win over Rider and a 96-89 overtime win against Oakland.
- » Makenna Marisa led the offense with her eighth 30-point performance of her career, matching her career high 34 points. Her eight 30-point performances ties her for second in program history.
- » Marisa logged a 61.1% shooting percentage from the field including four of those from beyond the arc. The graduate student also notched a team high seven assists.
- » Four Lady Lions cracked double figures: Marisa with 34, Jayla Oden with 14, Ali Brigham with 10 and Shay Ciezki with 10. Marisa and Ciezki hit double digits for third consecutive contest.
- » Chanaya Pinto and Leilani Kapinus both notched a team high seven boards.
- » Penn State passed the ball well for the third game in a row with 21 assists.
- » The team continued to thrive off of their depth, capturing 27 bench points.
- » Five Lady Lions shot over 50% on the night to lead to a team percentage of .464.
- » Penn State outrebounded its opponent for the third straight game, winning 40 boards to Kansas' 33. The team won both the offensive and defensive rebound battle.
- » The Lady Lions defense held six-foot-six center Taiyanna Jackson to no offensive rebounds and no blocks, a category she frequents multiple a game.
- » Penn State led for the majority of the contest (33:03 minutes).

TEAM EFFORT

- » The Lady Lions have produced 101 points off the bench in the last two games. Three players that came in as subs in the first game scored in double figures: Jayla Oden, Kylie Lavelle and Moriah Murray and two scored 10 or more in the second game: Murray and Chanaya Pinto. Oden logged 14 points in her third game as a Nittany Lions as a sub.

- » Penn State has also produced three back-to-back games with 20 or more assists, a test to its passing effort and ability to share the ball and find an open teammate.
- » The Lady Lions have played nearly every available player on their bench in the first three games, showing their depth. The entire team has the ability to produce on both sides of the ball with every player to step on the court in the first three games scoring at least two points.

LADY LIONS IN THE RANKS

- » Makenna Marisa sits sixth in the conference in scoring average (21.3) and second in total points scored (64) behind Caitlin Clark. Marisa also ranks 22nd nationally in total points.
- » Shay Ciezki ranks 12th in the Big Ten, averaging 15 points per game. Her total of 45 points through three games sits at a rank of eight.
- » The Lady Lions rank first in the conference in points scored with 292 through three games. Iowa owns the next highest total at 276 in its three appearances. Penn State's 37.3 margin is good for third in the Big Ten behind Minnesota and Nebraska. The team also sits ninth nationally in scoring offense with 97.3 ppg and eighth in total points giving them the 12th best margin in the country.
- » Penn State's field goal percentage of 53.5% is second best in the conference and sixth best in the country along with its 44.0% from three-point range. The team's 33 three pointers made is at the top of the league and eighth in the national rankings.
- » The Lady Lions also lead the conference in assists with 68 total and an average of 22.67 per game and sit at ninth in the country.

2023-24 LADY LIONS' ACCOLADES

- » Marisa was named to the Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List for the second consecutive season. She also earned a spot on the All-Big Ten preseason team.
- » Owusu repeats on the Ann Meyers-Drysdale Award Watch List.

NOTES AND HEADLINES

2023-24 PREVIEW

NO PLACE LIKE HAPPY VALLEY

- » Makenna Marisa uses her fifth season of eligibility to play one final season at Penn State. As one of the leaders of the Lady Lions, she has played in 114 games and started in 113 so far throughout her career.

ALL ROADS LEAD TO PENN STATE

- » The 2023-24 Lady Lions have players from all over the country. This squad has representation from two countries and seven states.

MARISA MILESTONES

- » Marisa became the only Lady Lion to acheive 1,750 points, 500 rebounds, 400 assits and 175 three-pointers in her career.
- » The PA native has acheived 29 double-digit performances including two in the Big Ten Tournament last season and three to open this year's campaign.
- » Marisa ranks 9th all-time in career points at Penn State. She is also tied for second all-time in career 30-point performances (8) and fourth in career three-pointers (193).

REPRESENTING ROOTS

- » Leilani Kapinus and Chanaya Pinto played for their home country's teams this summer. Kapinus earned a spot on the USA Basketball 3X3 U23 Nations Leau Roster. She helped the team to a second-place finish at the Montreal Stop from Sept. 2-3. Pinto competed in the 2023 FIBA Women's AfroBasket Tournament for her home country Mozambique. She played in six games and accumulated 40 points, 13 rebounds and 12 assists.

2023 NEWCOMERS

- » Penn State welcomes six transfers into the program.
- » Ashley Owusu comes to Happy Valley after spending three years at Maryland and one year at Virginia Tech, but missed a portion of the season there to due injury. Owusu earned the Ann Meyers-Drysdale Award in 2021 and has found herself on the watch list every season since. During her time in College Park, she was also named an All-American according to Associate Press and College Basketball Writers Association. Also in 2021, she garnered first team All-Big Ten after earning second team following both her freshman and sophomore season. The Virginia native also led the Terrapins to two consecutive Big Ten titles in 2020 and 2021.
- » Tay Valladay transfers from Virginia for her fifth season. Valladay was originally recruited by Lady Lions Coach Kieger during her time at Marquette. The Iguard out of Illinois spent two seasons there before making the move to Virginia. She averaged 8.7 points, 3.7 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 1.4 steals as a Cavalier. Valladay concluded her 2022-23 season with fivev-straight 10+ point games.
- » Grace Hall tranfers to Penn State after spending one season at LSU and one season at Wabash where she redshirted last season. Hall was a four-star prospect out of high school and was on the ESPNU HoopGuriz Top-100 list.
- » Kylie Lavelle knows the Pennsylvania scene, making the move from Drexel where she spent her freshman season. She helped lead the Dragons to a CAA Regular Season Championship and was named the CAA Rookie of the Week four times and earned a spot on the All-Rookie Team. Lavelle averaged 13.3 ppg, 3.7 rpg and accumulated 13 double-digit performances. The PA native accumulated 16 points in the first round of the WNIT game against Fordham.
- » Jayla Oden comes to the Lady Lions from a fellow Big Ten team, Illinois, where she spent two seasons. She played in 55 total games for the Fighting Illini and totaled 11 double-digit scoring performances.
- » Moriah Murray joined the Lady Lions after the fall semester last year but sat out due to NCAA transfer regulations.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting St. John's

- St. John's is off to a 1-1 start this season with a win over LIU in its home opener and a loss to Monmouth on the road.
- Unique Drake leads the team in scoring, totaling 51 points and averaging 25.5 in two games so far.
- Jillian Archer follows behind Drake with 26 total points. She leads the team on defense with 20 total rebounds for a 10.0 average.
- The Redstorm have turned the ball over 28 times throughout two appearances.
- St. John's had a short stint in the NCAA Tournament last year, making it to the second round after defeating no. 11 Purdue 66-64. The Redstorm lost to no. 6 North Carolina by another tight score of 61-59.

Against The Redstorm

- This will be only the second all-time meeting between Penn State and St. John's.
- When the teams met in 2021, Penn State came away victorious with a final score of 80-75.
- The one match-up was played at the Gulf Coach Showcase in Estero, Fla. on Nov. 26, 2021.

2022-23 IN REVIEW

- » Penn State finished the season last year 14-17, 4-14 Big Ten.
- » The Lady Lions lost four games in overtime.
- » Makenna Marisa led the offense in total scoring with 541 points and free throw percentage, .763.
- » Leilani Kapinus led the Lady Lions defense, averaging 6.7 rpg to total 208 on the season. She also led the team in steals, 97 and blocks, 31. The redshirt-junior totaled 348 points during her redshirt-sophomore campaign.
- » Freshman at the time Shay Ciezki had a standout rookie season totaling 353 points. The New York native was lethal beyond the arc leading the Lady Lions offense in three-point percentage (.416) and total three-point baskets made with 64.
- » Penn State completed the biggest comeback in program history against Syracuse on Nov. 21, 2022, rallying back from a 45-24 third quarter deficit to a 82-69 final score.

2022-23 ALL-BIG TEN HONORS

MAKENNA MARISA: ALL-BIG TEN - FIRST TEAM (media); SECOND TEAM (coaches)

- Earned selection to the All-Big Ten team for a second straight season, after earning First Team honors as a junior. She became the 12th Lady Lion to repeat as a first team selection.
- Led the Lady Lions in scoring (17.5 ppg) and assists (4.2 per game) in addition to 60 made three-point baskets, 4.1 rebounds and 1.6 steals per game.
- Finished the 2022-23 season ranked 58th nationally in points per game, 59th in minutes per game (35.5), 77th in total points scored (541), 95th in assists per game (4.2) and 96th in total assists (129), and 99th in field goals (189). In the B1G, Marisa finished second in minutes played, seventh in scoring, 11th in assists, 13th in three-point field goals made.
- Ranks 10th in career scoring in program history, currently standing at 1,785 points, needing 215 points to become the seventh player in program history to achieve 2,000 or more career points (Mazzante, Lucas, Robinson, Page, Grant, Herbert).
- In addition to her scoring rank, Marisa stands fifth in career three-pointers made (187), seventh in career free throw percentage (.812, 342-421), and eighth in scoring average (15.7).
- Cracked the 500-rebound club in the B1G Tournament win over Minnesota, becoming the 34th member from Penn State to join.
- Recorded 12 games scoring 20 or more and twice scored more than 30, including a career-high 34 points at Minnesota last December 2. Has logged seven games of 30 or more points, tying Maggie Lucas for third on the Penn State list.

- Also gained recognition for the second straight year following an All-Freshman nod in her first season in Happy Valley.

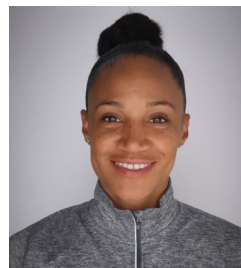
