## LEADING OFF

- Penn State hosts Pitt on Tuesday evening to close out an eight-game homestand.
- The Nittany Lions are 90-47-1 all-time against Pitt after splitting a pair of games last season.
- Penn State won 16-8 in Happy Valley last year, but fell 11-3 at PNC Park.
- The Nittany Lions look to bounce back after dropping the final two games of their series against Michigan.
- Penn State won Friday's game, 4-3, after four no-hit innings by Travis Luensmann.
- Following the outing, Luensmann is now 16th in the country allowing only 4.55 hits per nine innings.
- J.T. Marr collected four hits against Michigan to bring a .430 average into Tuesday's contest.
- Marr ranks second in the Big Ten in average, third in hits per game (1.76) and fourth in total hits (37).
- Penn State's balanced lineup features five players with at least 20 hits and nine players with at least 10 RBI this season.

**The Marr-Chine Keeps Hitting**

- Grad student J.T. Marr is off to an incredible start to begin the 2024 campaign.
- Marr's season average sits at .430 with a team-best 37 hits.
- Marr ranks second in the Big Ten with his .430 average, while ranking 31st in the country.
- He also ranks 14th in the nation, and third in the Big Ten, averaging 1.76 hits per game.
- Marr holds 38th in the country, and fourth in the conference, with 37 total hits.
- This past weekend, Marr tallied four hits.
- He owns 10 multi-hit games and four multi-RBI games.
- On the year, Marr has two games with four hits and four games with three hits.
- Among his 37 knocks, he has three doubles and a homer to go with 19 RBI and 19 runs.

**Newcomers Leading Balanced Lineup**

- The Nittany Lions sit among the Top 5 in the Big Ten in batting average (.290; 5th), runs per game (7.5; 5th) and sac flies (17; 2nd).
- Penn State has five players with a .300 or better average, six with a .400+ on-base percentage and six with a .400+ slugging percentage.
- Five Nittany Lions have at least 20 hits and nine Nittany Lions have at least 10 RBI.
- Penn State joins Iowa and Rutgers as the only Big Ten teams with at least nine players owning at least 10 RBI.
- Graduate student J.T. Marr paces the squad with a .430 average and 37 hits. He owns three doubles, a homer, 19 RBI and 19 runs.
- After going 4-of-10 at the plate vs. Michigan, Bobby Marsh is hitting .328 with 22 hits, including four doubles, 13 RBI and 11 runs.
- Junior Matt Maloney is batting .310 with a team-high 24 RBI along with five doubles and a homer.
- Maloney ranks second in the Big Ten in RBI per game (1.41).
- Redshirt junior Billy Gerlott is hitting .308 with five doubles, a homer, three RBI and 14 runs.
- Graduate student Adam Cecere is hitting .300 with 21 hits, including five doubles and a team-high five homers, 15 RBI and 23 runs. He has a team-high 20 walks and seven hit-by-pitches.
- He hit two homers on March 15 against UMass Lowell, his sixth career multi-homer game.
- Cecere paces the team with a .586 slugging percentage and a .490 on-base percentage.
- He ranks ninth in Big Ten with a 1.076 OPS, 12th in slugging percentage (.586) and eighth in on-base percentage (.490). He's also tied-third in the conference in total walks (20) and tied-fourth in walks per game (0.95).
- Cecere is one of 23 current Division I players with 37+ homers and 131+ RBI in their career.
- Among active DI players, Cecere is 24th in homers (37).
- Joe Jaconski is tied with Cecere for third in the Big Ten in walks (20) and owns 20 hits and 17 runs, while Grant Norris has 19 hits, including five doubles and four homers, and 16 RBI.
- Bryce Molinaro owns two homers, among 23 hits, and 15 RBI, while Kyle Hannon has 15 hits, one homer and 17 runs.

**Michigan Series Recap**

- Penn State earned a 4-3 win on Friday but dropped the final two contests of the series against Michigan.
- On Friday, Travis Luensmann fired four no-hit innings, while striking out six.
- Will Perkowski threw 2.2 strong innings in relief, allowing no runs and recording five strikeouts.
- PSU walked it off in the ninth as a grounder by Grant Norris was misplayed.
- On Saturday, PSU overcame an early 3-1 deficit to take a 6-5 lead in the third, including a two-run double by Matt Maloney and RBI singles by Bobby Marsh and Bryce Molinaro, but the Wolverines scored four in the top of the seventh to re-take the lead.
- On Sunday, four Nittany Lions had multi-hit days. The game was tied 1-1 into the seventh, but Michigan rallied for nine runs in the seventh and one in the eighth. Penn State plated five runs in the eighth but couldn't complete the comeback.

**Hannon, Kelley, Norris Climb Records Lists**

- Senior Kyle Hannon already has 10 steals in 2024, including four in the series vs. Harvard.
- With 10 steals this year, Hannon has moved up to fourth all-time at Penn State with 44 career steals. He is currently six steals behind Doug Keener (50, 1984-87) for third place.
- Hannon ranks fifth in the Big Ten in total steals (10) and fourth in steals per game (0.50).
- Senior+ Tayven Kelley owns 12 career triples, tied third all-time at Penn State. He is tied with Michael Campo (1997-00) and Jordan Steranka (2009-12).
- Graduate student Grant Norris' .516 career slugging percentage sits seventh all-time at Penn State.

**Luensmann Posts Consecutive Solid Starts**

- Senior Travis Luensmann made his third-straight solid start against Michigan on Friday.
- He gave up no hits or runs in four innings of work, while striking out six. He struck out multiple batters in the first and third innings.
- The Altoona native picked up his second win of the season on March 14 against UMass Lowell.
- Luensmann fired six innings, giving up one run on two hits, while striking out five. He did not allow a run until a solo homer in the sixth.
- Luensmann has thrown six innings in back-to-back starts, including a six-inning, two-run outing against Harvard on March 8.
- He has 22 strikeouts in six starts and is allowing a .157 opponent average.
- He ranks second in the Big Ten and 16th in the country allowing 4.55 hits per nine innings.
- Frankie Sanchez made a start on Sunday against Michigan and has a 1.46 ERA over four appearances (three starts) with 14 strikeouts in 12.1 innings.

**THE OPPOSITION**

**Scouting Pitt**

- Head Coach Mike Bell is in his sixth season leading the Pitt baseball program.
- Pitt is 118-128 under Bell, including an 11-10 mark this season.
- The Panthers dropped three games at No. 14 Virginia last weekend.
- Pitt has a .308 team average and averages eight runs per game.
- Tyler Bischke leads the squad with a .349 average and 30 hits, while tying for a team-high 18 RBI.
- Jake Kendro is hitting .346 with three homers and 12 RBI, while Luke Cantwell is hitting .333 with four homers and 18 RBI.
- Jayden Melendez has launched six homers to go with 16 RBI.
- Pitt's pitching staff has a 6.42 ERA and allows a .286 opposing average.
- Phil Fox leads Pitt with a 1.12 ERA in eight appearances with a 2-1 and a save. He has 19 strikeouts and no walks in 16 innings.
- Ethan Firoved has 25 strikeouts in 21.1 innings over seven appearances.

**Against The Panthers**

- Penn State is 90-47-1 all-time against Pitt.
- The Nittany Lions split two games against the Panthers in 2023.
- On March 28, 2023, Penn State earned a 16-8 win at home, highlighted by a five-run sixth inning and a six-run eighth inning
- On May 16, 2023, PSU fell 11-3 against Pitt at PNC Park. Bobby Marsh had two hits and an RBI.

**Head Coach**

Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino takes over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect Game.

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the D1Baseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting pitcher.

Gambino's pitching staff ranked 26th in the country in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.54) and 26th in walks allowed per nine innings (3.58). Boston College held fifth in the country, and led the ACC, with a .982 fielding percentage.

The 2022 MLB Draft saw four of Gambino's student-athletes be chosen, led by second baseman Luke Gold, who was selected in the fifth round by the Detroit Tigers. Pitchers Mason Pelio (Reds - 12th round), Joe Mancini (Astros - 15th round) and Max Gieg (Angels - 18th round) were also chosen in the draft.

In 2021, an impressive three players were selected in the first six rounds of the MLB Draft headlined by outfielder Sal Frelick, who was the 15th overall pick by the Milwaukee Brewers. Shortstop Cody Morissette was picked in the second round by the Miami Marlins and pitcher Emmet Sheehan was selected in the sixth round by the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Gambino led BC to a 31-27 record in 2019 and the Eagles reached the ACC semifinals as the 12th seed with wins over Clemson and top-seeded Louisville. A program-record five Eagles earned All-ACC, led by All-ACC first team pitcher Dan Metzdorf, who was a fifth-round pick for the Chicago White Sox and led the ACC with a 2.30 ERA. Jake Alu (Nationals - 24th round) and Matt Gill (Reds - 27th round) were also chosen during the 2019 MLB Draft.

In 2018, outfielder Chris Galland earned All-ACC third team accolades and Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-America honors. The 2018 MLB Draft had four of Gambino's players selected with Jake Palomaki (Rays - 18th round), Jacob Stevens (Diamondbacks - 21st round), Brian Rapp (Twins - 26th round) and Dan Metzdorf (Yankees - 38th round).

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship Tournament for the first time since 2010. BC won 10 of its last 15 ACC games with sweeps over Notre Dame and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005 and third-highest total in program history. They also tallied 13 ACC wins, the most since 2010, while their six conference series victories set a school record. Gambino led the Eagles to a sweep in the Oxford Regional as the third seed to advance to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. BC finished the season in the Top 25 of all four major polls for the first time in program history (15th - D1Baseball, 16th - Baseball America, NCBWA and 21st - USA Today/Coaches Poll).

For his efforts, Gambino was named the 2016 American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year, a finalist for D1Baseball Coach of the Year and earned a spot on the website's top-10 coaching performances of the season.

Gambino proteges were selected in the first round of the MLB Draft in back-to-back years for the first time in program history in 2015 and 2016. Chris Shaw was selected 31st overall by the San Francisco Giants in 2015 and Justin Dunn was taken 19th overall by the New York Mets in 2016. Overall, five players were drafted in 2016: Dunn, Michael King (12th round), Jesse Adams (14th round), Nick Sciortino (19th round) and Joe Cronin (34th round).

Gambino was an assistant coach for four seasons at Virginia Tech prior to his move to Boston College. He served as the Hokies' recruiting coordinator and worked with the hitters and infielders. In his four years, he saw 15 players get drafted in the MLB Draft, including nine in 2010.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny and Callahan.
