- The sixth-ranked Wisconsin men's hockey team (12-4-0, 6-2-0 Big Ten) welcomes No. 17 Penn State (9-5-3, 2-3-3 Big Ten) to the Kohl Center for a Friday-Saturday series to close out the fall semester. The teams meet Friday at 8 p.m. and Saturday at 7 p.m.
- Friday's game airs on BTN, while Saturday's will stream on B1G+. The games broadcast on 1310 WIBA in the Madison area, 97.3 The Game in the Milwaukee area and across the Badger Radio Network. Also listen on the Badgers App or The Varsity Network App.
- For Friday's radio broadcast, longtime play-by-play announcer Paul Braun will team with former Badger radio analyst and goaltending coach Bill Howard to call the action.
- The Badgers enter their series against No. 17 Penn State with a modest three-game winning streak after posting 3-0 and 6-1 victories at home over Ohio State last weekend.
- Penn State arrives in Madison after splitting at home with then No. 6/7 Minnesota. The Nittany Lions dropped a 4-1 game before responding with a 6-3 victory last weekend.
- UW will hold the annual UW Teddy Toss presented by BMO on Saturday. Fans are encouraged to toss new stuffed animals on the ice following the conclusion of Saturday's game to benefit Toys for Tots and area children.
- As part of its 75th season celebration, Friday is 'Wisconsin Night' to celebrate hockey in the state. The highlight will be a display of high school jerseys from around the state outside Section 107.

- Senior goaltender Kyle McClellan stopped 50 of 51 shots last weekend in a sweep over Ohio State at the Kohl Center. Named Big Ten First Star of the Week for the effort, he won 3-0 with 29 saves last Saturday and 6-1 with 21 saves last Saturday.
- The shutout marked his third of the season to tie for the national lead. The one goal allowed on Saturday was challenged for offsides, which replays showed it was, but the official replay

- UW freshmen forwards Quinn Finley and William Whitelaw were named to the 2024 U.S. National Junior Team Preliminary Roster. They'll attend camp in Plymouth, Michigan, from Dec. 14-16 looking to make final roster. The 2024 IIHF World Junior Championship runs Dec. 26, 2023 – Jan. 5, 2024, in Sweden.
- The Badgers scored five different ways in their 6-1 win over Ohio State last Saturday. That includes two power-play goals, a short-handed goal, on a penalty shot, fouron-four and five-on five.
- Freshman forward Quinn Finley scored his fourth goal and first in six games with a penalty-shot tally last Saturday. The penalty shot was the first attempt for UW since Jan. 17, 2020, when Tarek Baker attempted one on Michigan State's John Lethemon. Finley's successful attempt marked UW's first penalty-shot goal since Jan. 19, 2018, when Trent Frederic scored on Notre Dame's Cale Morris.
- Sophomore forward Christian Fitzgerald scored last Friday for his first goal since he scored UW's first goal of the year in the season opener on Oct. 7 against Augustana. The goal ended a 13-game goal-scoring drought. He had 16 goals as a freshman for Minnesota State last year.
- Senior assistant captain and forward David Silye also scored his second goal of the season last weekend, connecting for a power-play goal last Saturday. Silye went 10 games between goals. He had 23 goals last season at Minnesota State.
- Graduate forward Owen Lindmark tallied the eventual game-winning goal in last Saturday's 6-1 win, scoring his first short-handed goal of the year and his national-best seventh career short-handed goal. He finished the night with a goal and three points.
- Lindmark's seven goals this season are a career high and rank second on the Badgers.

- His 0.64 goals per game mark (7 in 11 GP) ranks second in the Big Ten behind only Notre Dame's Landon Slaggert.
- Lindmark's 0.83 goals per game (5 in 6 GP) in Big Ten play shares the Conference lead with Badger teammate **Cruz Lucius**, who also has five goals in six Big Ten contests.
- Lucius scored his team-leading eighth goal last Saturday after scoring into an empty net last Friday. He finished the weekend with two goal and four points. He had a goal and two assists for a three-point night last Saturday.
- Lucius leads the Badgers in scoring for the first time this season with eight goals and 14 points in 14 games. He led UW with 34 points in 34 games last season.
- After going 22 games without a goal dating back to last season, sophomore forward **Jack Horbach** now has two goals in his last three games, including last Saturday.
- Horbach finished last Saturday with a goal and an assist for his second multi-point game of the season and third of his career.
- Senior forward Owen Lindmark leads the Big Ten with a 63.1 faceoff win percentage (123-72) in the faceoff dot. Senior teammate and forward David Silye ranks second at 60.2 percent (207-137). Silye's 207 wins are tops in the Big Ten and rank third in the nation.
- Silye leads the Big Ten in conference games at 59.6 percent (99-67).
- The Badgers scored four goals in the second period last Saturday against Ohio State, its first four-goal period since the third period against Notre Dame on Jan. 7.
- Sophomore defenseman Ben Dexheimer went his first 48 career games without scoring a goal, but then scored twice in three games before recording just one assist last weekend against Ohio State. Dexheimer shares second on the Badgers with 13 points on two goals and 11 assists.
- Dexheimer's 13 points through 16 games are already two more than his freshman season's total.



The six-time NCAA champion Wisconsin men's hockey program will celebrate their 75th season in program history during the 2023-24 campaign. UW's varsity history began in 1921 and ran until 1935. UW restarted its program in 1963, which has run through the present day.

UW will celebrate during six conference games, with three Friday and three Saturdays spread across all six Big Ten home series.

- Freshman goaltender William Gramme became the fifth Badger in school history to record a shutout in his first NCAA start, stopping 25 shots on Nov. 25 against Alaska Anchorage in a 5-0 victory over the Seawolves at the Kohl Center. (Jack Berry – Nov. 5, 2016; Bernd Bruckler - Oct. 20, 2001; Jim Carey - Nov. 1, 1992 and Wayne Thomas - Nov. 16, 1968).
- Seven Badgers have at least 10 points on the season.
- Senior goaltender Kyle McClellan's .925 career save percentage ranks second among all current NCAA goaltenders with his combined numbers as a Badger and at Mercyhurst.
- UW's 5-4 victory over Michigan on Nov. 3 marked its first when allowing four goals or more since a 7-6 win over Arizona State on Feb. 21, 2020.
- Wisconsin's 5-3-0 road record so far this season gives the Badgers same or more road wins than it has had in all but two of the past 10 seasons.
- Senior forward Carson Bantle has four goals this season. Three out of the four have been game-winning goals, which is tied for third in the nation, one behind the national leaders.
- Beginning Oct. 13 at Bemidji State and Oct. 14 at North Dakota, UW played 12 consecutive games against former WCHA clubs. That closed out on Nov. 25 against Alaska Anchorage.
- Head Coach Mike Hastings earned his 300th career NCAA victory in his first game behind the UW bench on Saturday, Oct. 7 at the Kohl Center. He now sits at 311-113-25 record and a national-best .720 winning percentage among active coaches through 449 games.
- Hastings' .720 winning percentage ranks him No. 3 all-time in NCAA men's hockey history behind Ned Harkness' .729 mark (RPI, Cornell, Union) and Bill Harrison's .722 win percentage (Clarkson). Denver's head coach, David Carle, ranks second among active coaches with a .677 win percentage.
- Wisconsin's No. 1 ranking on Nov. 13 marked its first time as the top-ranked team in the country since the 2006-07 USCHO.com Preseason Poll when it shared the No. 1 ranking with Boston College. UW's women's team was also ranked No. 1 making UW's men's and women's the top team in the country at the same time for the first time since that same 2006-07 poll week.
- UW's two victories against Augustana and win at Bemidji State to open the season made head coach Mike Hastings the first Badger men's hockey coach to win his first two games, and first three games, behind the UW bench.
- The Badger penalty kill has been perfect in eight of its last 10 games, allowing just two power-play goals during that time. UW's kill sits 28-for-30 during that stretch (93.3 percent). For the season, UW's penalty kill ranks fifth in the nation at 89.8 percent (53-for-59).
- UW's power play has room for improvement this season with it's 17.9 percent success rate (12-for-67), which ranks 32nd in the country and fifth in the Big Ten. The Badgers had just

one power-play goal in five games (1-for-23) before going 2-for-4 with the man advantage last Saturday against Ohio State.

- Freshman forward Quinn Finley's two-goal debut on Oct. 7 against Augustana made him the first Badger to score two goals in a debut since freshman Cole Caufield scored two goals at Boston College on Oct. 11, 2019.
- Sophomore transfer Christian Fitzgerald scored the season's first goal on Oct. 7 against Augustana at the 1:10 mark of the season for his first goal as a Badger. He scored 16 times as a freshman last season at Minnesota State.
- Thirteen Badgers made NHL opening-night rosters, fifth-most in the NCAA. Among those, three Wisconsin natives made the Dallas Stars (Joe Pavelski, Ryan Suter, Craig Smith), while Luke Kunin joined defenseman and Eau Claire, Wisconsin, native Ty Emberson on the San Jose Sharks. Others on NHL rosters include Trent Frederic (Boston), Dylan Holloway (Edmonton), Cole Caufield (Montreal), Ryan McDonagh (Nashville), Brendan Smith (New Jersey), K'Andre Miller (NY Rangers), Justin Schultz (Seattle) and Jake McCabe (Toronto).
- Ty Emberson made his NHL debut for the San Jose Sharks on Saturday, Oct. 21 in Nashville. He collected his first career point with the primary assist on a goal by former Badger Luke Kunin against Washington on Oct. 29.
- Twelve of Wisconsin's 26-man roster is new, as is UW's coaching staff.
- That includes eight freshmen and four transfers (Minnesota State - 3; UMass - 1).
- The 12 newcomers include 2023 CCHA Forward of the Year **David Silye**, a senior forward from Minnesota State. He tallied 23 goals, 16 assists and 39 points last season. He ranked fifth in the NCAA 0.59 goals per game and tied for second with 12 power-play goals
- Former MSU teammates in sophomore forwards Christian Fitzgerald (16 goals) and Simon Tassy also join the Badgers.
- Incoming freshmen include Clark Cupchampion forward William Whitelaw (Youngstown, USHL), U.S. National Team Development Program defensemen Brady Cleveland and Zach Schulz, New York Islanders draft pick Quinn Finley, internationally-experienced defender Joe Palodichuk and goalie William Gramme, among others.
- The new staff includes head coach Mike Hastings, who directed Minnesota State's program the past 11 seasons. Associate head coach Todd Knott also came from Minnesota State, while assistant coach Nick Oliver directed the USHL's Fargo Force as head coach to the league regular-season title. Finally, assistant coach Kevin Murdock arrived in Madison after spending last year as an assistant coach at Alaska Anchorage.
- Graduate student defenseman Mike Vorlicky serves as team captain for the 2023-24 season, while senior forwards Mathieu De St. Phalle and David Silye serve as alternate captains.
- The Badgers' top-two scorers return in sophomore forward Cruz Lucius (11 goals, 34 points) and senior forward Mathieu De St.
 Phalle (13 goals, 30 points).

HEAD COACH MIKE HASTINGS

whike Hastings became the sixth Wisconsin men's hockey coach of the modern era (since 1962) on March 30, 2023.

Hastings brings a remarkable level of consistent excellence to Wisconsin, directing his teams to winning marks in all 25 seasons he's served as a head coach. That record includes the last 11 seasons at Minnesota State, where he directed the Mavericks to eight NCAA tournament appearances (2013, 2014, 2015, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023), a pair of Frozen Fours (2021, 2022) and the NCAA title game (2022). The COVID-19 pandemic prevented a ninth NCAA appearance in 2020. The winning also spans 14 seasons as head coach of the USHL's Omaha Lancers.

A three-time Spencer Penrose Award winner as NCAA coach of the year, his Mavericks captured eight conference regular-season championships during his 11 seasons behind the bench to help him earn league coach of the year five times while at MSU.

His MSU run includes regular-season conference titles in each of the last six seasons, winning the CCHA in 2022 and 2023, while conquering the WCHA four times from 2018-21. Minnesota State twice won the Mason Cup as CCHA tourney champions (2022, 2023) and a pair of Broadmoor Trophies as the WCHA tournament winners (2014, 2015) under Hastings direction.

Minnesota State won 20 games in a season twice during its first 16 years of NCAA Division I play, but surpassed the mark in all 11 seasons of Hastings' tenure. MSU set its school mark with 38 victories during its run to the 2022 NCAA Championship game, its third 30-win season in a four-year stretch.

The Mavericks went 299-109-25 during his 11 years leading the program for a .719 win percentage which ranks him as the nation's active leader in win percentage and gives him the third-highest mark in NCAA men's hockey history. While at Minnesota State, seven players under Hastings skated to All-America seasons including Dryden McKay, the 2022 Hobey Baker Memorial Award winner as the nation's top player. McKay was also a threetime top-three finalist for the Mike Richter Award given to the nation's top goaltender. In addition, nine of his MSU players have skated in the NHL thus far.

On the international stage, Hastings directed Team USA to a silver medal at the 2019 International Ice Hockey Federation World Junior Championship and served as an assistant coach for the 2022 U.S. Olympic Team in Beijing and the 2022 U.S. National Team at the world championship. He also served as an assistant coach for Team USA's National Junior Team at World Juniors in 2005 and 2003.

His collegiate coaching career began in 2008 with one year as an assistant at Minnesota, before he moved on for three seasons as associate head coach at Omaha (2009-12).

His impressive success began in the USHL when he served as head coach and general manager of the Omaha Lancers for 14 seasons (1994-2008). His teams won three Anderson Cups as regular-season champions (2002, 2005, 2008) and three Clark Cups as playoff winners (1998, 2001, 2008).

That all helped him win two USHL Coach of the Year honors (1997, 2002) and five USHL General Manager of the Year accolades (1997, 2002, 2005, 2007, 2008).

He left for the college ranks in 2008 as the USHL's all-time winningest coach at 529-210-56 at the time.

A 1993 St. Cloud State graduate, he skated two seasons with the Huskies (1986-88) before injury cut his playing career short.

Hastings and his wife, Jean Ann, are the parents of two grown children, Hannah and Hudson.



KOHL CENTER

- The Kohl Center, which opened in 1998, is the second largest on-campus rink in the nation (15,359). The only on-campus facility with a larger capacity is Value City Arena (17,500) in Columbus, Ohio
- Wisconsin has won at least 11 games in a season at the Kohl Center on 10 occasions.
- The Kohl Center played host to NCAA regional action for the first time in 2008 when the NCAA Midwest Regional took place on March 29-30. The building had previously played host to the 1998 NCAA Women's Volleyball Championships, a 2002 NCAA Men's Basketball Regional and a 2007 NCAA Women's Ice Hockey Quarterfinal contest.
- The Kohl Center cost \$76.4 million to construct and is named after U.S. Senator Herb Kohl, a 1956 UW graduate who donated \$25 million towards the project.
- The Kohl Center ice sheet is 200 feet long by 97 feet wide.
- Some of the names of players from opposing teams who have played in the building include Patrick Kane, Jonathan Toews, David Backes, Duncan Keith, Ryan Miller, Carl Hagelin, T.J. Oshie, Paul Stastny, Matt Carle, Kyle Okposo, Jack Eichel and Auston Matthews, among others.


BADGERS AND THE NHL

- Sophmore forward Charlie Stramel became the 18th all-time Badger drafted in the first round of the NHL draft when the Minnesota Wild picked him 21st overall in the 2023 draft. He was the sixth Badger in eight years picked in the first round (Corson Ceulemans, K'Andre Miller, Alex Turcotte, Cole Caufield, Dylan Holloway) and the eigth in 10 drafts (Luke Kunin, Trent Frederic).
- UW boasts 13 NHL draft picks on its roster, including freshman forward Brady Cleveland, who went to the Detroit Red Wings in the second round of the 2023 draft with the 47th pick.
- UW boasts 181 NHL draft picks all-time, including three in the supplemental draft, and have had at least one player drafted in each draft since 1970 except for 1983 and 1997.
- Eight Badgers selected in 1982 are the most for one year.
- Former Wisconsin captain Ryan McDonagh became the 14th Badger to get his name engraved on the Stanley Cup as a player when he helped the Tampa Bay Lightning to the 2020 Stanley Cup. That is the most among NCAA schools. He won again in 2021.
- All time, a Badger is on the Cup 22 times as a player, also the most of any NCAA school.
- Ryan McDonagh's Tampa Bay Lightning defeated Joe Pavelski's Dallas Stars to win the Stanley Cup in 2020, then defeated Cole Caufield's Montreal Canadiens in 2021. That made him the fourth Badger to win consecutive Cups (Justin Schultz, Paul Stanton, Brian Engblom).
- McDonagh now plays for the Nashville Predators.
- The 2023-24 season ended a 33-year streak with at least one UW goaltender playing in the NHL. Brian Elliott played the 2022-23 season with the Tampa Bay Lightning.
- San Jose Sharks forward Luke Kunin recorded his 100th career NHL point on Nov. 15, 2022, to become the 33rd Badger all-time with 100 career NHL points. Toronto Maple Leafs defenseman Jake McCabe reached the mark earlier in the 2022-23 season.
- Joe Pavelski became the Wisconsin's all-time NHL leading scorer on Dec. 1, 2022, with his 949th career point in the NHL regular season, surpassing Chris Chelios for the honor.
- Pavelski became the first Badger to reach 1,000 career NHL points on April 10, 2023. He began the 2023-24 season with 1,001 points.
- San Jose Sharks' defenseman Ty Emberson made his NHL debut on Saturday, Oct. 21, when the Sharks skated at Nashville. He became the 92nd Badger in the NHL all-time. He scored his first career goal on Nov. 25 against the Vancouver Canucks.
- Montreal Canadiens forward Cole Caufield tallied ihs 100th career point on Nov. 24 against the San Jose Sharks. He also added a goal in the game. He scored his 60th career goal in his 145th career game on Nov. 29 against Columbus.
