#### **LEADING OFF**

- Penn State travels to Bloomington to take on Indiana in a three-game series.
- The Nittany Lions are 43-47 all-time against the Hoosiers.
- Last season, Penn State won one of three games in Happy Valley.
- Penn State enters the series on a four-game win streak.
- Penn State is coming off a 12-2 win over FDU on Tuesday.
- The top four hitters in the lineup each had at least three hits.
- In Big Ten play, Bobby Marsh is hitting .486 with 14 RBI, while Bryce Molinaro is batting .469.
- Marsh has multiple hits and multiple RBI in each of the last five games.
- J.T. Marr ranks second in the Big Ten with a .421 average and 51 total hits.
- Adam Cecere enters the weekend leading the Big Ten in OPS (1.211), slugging percentage (.704) and on-base percentage (.507), while tying for the Big Ten lead with nine homers.
- As a team, Penn State paces the Big Ten in slugging percentage (.499) and is one
  of two Big Ten teams, joining Indiana, with seven players owning 21+ RBI.

#### The Marr-Chine Keeps Hitting

- Grad student J.T. Marr's season average sits at .421 with a team-best 51 hits and 30 RBI.
- Marr ranks second in the Big Ten with his .421 average, while ranking 18th in the country.
- He also ranks eighth in the nation, and second in the Big Ten, averaging 1.76 hits per game.
- Marr holds 27th in the country, and second in the conference, with 51 total hits.
- He owns 16 multi-hit games, including five against Big Ten opponents, and nine multi-RBI games. Marr has two games with four hits and five games with three hits.
- Marr tied a PSU game record with three doubles against FDU on Tuesday.
- Among his 51 knocks, he has 10 doubles and four homers to go with 27 runs and a 1.062
   OPS, good for ninth in the Big Ten. He has three homers and 11 RBI in conference play.

#### **Newcomers Leading Balanced Lineup**

- The Nittany Lions lead the Big Ten in slugging percentage (.499; 1st) and sac flies (23; 1st) and rank Top 5 in the conference in on-base percentage (.415; 2nd), runs per game (8.2; 3rd), batting average (.315; 3rd), home runs per game (1.24; 3rd), total home runs (36; 4th), doubles per game (2.14; 5th) and total runs (238; 5th).
- Penn State has six players with a .312 or better average, six with a .400+ on-base percentage and seven with a .400+ slugging percentage.
- Penn State and Indiana are the only Big Ten teams with seven players owning at least 21 RBI.
- Graduate student J.T. Marr paces the squad with a .421 average and 51 hits. He owns 10 doubles, four homers, 30 RBI and 27 runs.
- With a 17-of-35 start (.486) and 14 RBI at the plate in conference play, Bobby Marsh is hitting .380 with 38 hits, including eight doubles, one triple, two homers, 27 RBI and 22 runs. His .486 average in conference play ranks seventh in the Big Ten.
- Marsh has multiple hits and multiple RBI in each of the last five games.
- Riding a 13-game hit streak and holding a .469 average (15-of-32) in Big Ten play, Bryce Molinaro owns four homers, among 36 hits, and 25 RBI to go with a .324 average.
- Graduate student Adam Cecere is hitting .347 with 34 hits, including eight doubles and nine homers, 29 RBI and a team-best 30 runs. He has a team-high 27 walks and eight hitby-pitches. He is hitting .351 in Big Ten play with three homers and 10 RBI.
- The Pennsylvania native hit two homers on March 15 against UMass Lowell, his sixth career multi-homer game, launched a three-run homer at Illinois (3/30) and hit a solo homer against Northwestern (4/5) and a solo homer vs. FDU (4/9).
- Cecere paces the team with a .704 slugging percentage and a .507 on-base percentage.
- He ranks first in Big Ten with a 1.211 OPS, slugging percentage (.704) and on-base percentage (.507). He's tied first in homers (9) and homers per game (0.31). He's also fourth in the conference in total walks (27) and third in walks per game (0.93).
- Cecere is one of 16 current Division I players with 41+ homers and 144+ RBI in their career. Among active DI players, Cecere is 17 in homers (41).
- Grant Norris has 31 hits, including six doubles and eight homers, 27 RBI and 22 runs.
- Norris collected his first career multi-homer game against Northwestern (4/6).
- Norris is tied fifth in the Big Ten with eight homers.
- Joe Jaconski is ninth in the Big Ten in walks (23) and owns 34 hits and 28 runs. He crushed a grand slam in the series finale against Northwestern (4/7).
- Junior Matt Maloney is batting .312 with 25 RBI along with seven doubles and a homer.

#### **Northwestern Series Recap**

- Penn State earned its first series sweep of the 2024 season and picked up its first Big Ten sweep since April 21-23, 2023 against Ohio State.
- In the series, the Blue and White batted .408 at the plate with 42 hits, including nine doubles, three triples and seven homers, and 35 runs in 25 innings.
- On the mound, Penn State's starting pitchers, Travis Luensmann, Jaden Henline and Frankie Sanchez, earned the win in each game and combined for 18 innings.
- Bobby Marsh went 8-of-12 (.667), with two doubles, a triple and seven RBI, while Bryce Molinaro hit .636 (7-of-11) with three extra-base hits and three RBI. Grant Norris launched three homers and drove in five runs.
- In game one, Norris, Adam Cecere and J.T. Marr each homered.
- On Saturday, Norris blasted a pair of two-run homers.
- On Sunday, Joe Jaconski launched a grand slam and drove in six runs, while Molinaro

#### **Nittany Lions Climb Records Lists**

- Senior Kyle Hannon already has 10 steals in 2024, including four in the series vs. Harvard.
- With 10 steals this year, Hannon has moved up to fourth all-time at Penn State with 44 career steals. He is currently six steals behind Doug Keener (50, 1984-87) for third place.
- Hannon ranks eighth in the Big Ten in total steals (10).
- Senior+ Tayven Kelley owns 12 career triples, tied third all-time at Penn State. He is tied with Michael Campo (1997-00) and Jordan Steranka (2009-12).
- Graduate student Grant Norris' .547 career slugging percentage sits sixth all-time at Penn State, while sophomore Bobby Marsh's .531 slugging percentage is eighth all-time.

#### **Dollar Dog Night Returns**

- Penn State's Dollar Dog Nights became popular in 2023 and have returned with strong numbers in 2024.
- Tuesday's contest against Kent State will be the Nittany Lions' fourth Dollar Dog Night of the 2024 campaign.
- On April 9 against FDU, Penn State set a new attendance record with 4,902 fans, bettering the previous record of 3,946 vs. Northwestern in 2007, and a new Dollar Dog record as fans consumed 6,151 hot dogs. That previous record was 5,287 against West Virginia in 2023.
- On March 26 against Pitt, the Nittany Lions welcomed 3,505 fans to Medlar Field at Lubrano Park, Penn State baseball's fourth-largest attendance. The 3,505 fans downed 5,021 hot dogs.
- Across eight Dollar Dog Nights in 2023 and 2024, Penn State fans have consumed 26,586 hot dogs, averaging 3,323 per Dollar Dog Night.

### THE OPPOSITION

#### **Scouting Indiana**

- Indiana is led by head coach Jeff Mercer, in his sixth season.
- Under Mercer, Indiana is 160-114 and has played in three NCAA Tournaments.
- In 2024, Indiana is 18-15 overall and 3-3 in the Big Ten after taking two of three at Maryland last weekend.
- Indiana ranks fourth in the Big Ten with a .299 team average, second with 43 homers and second in runs per game (8.5).
- Devin Taylor leads the Hoosiers with a .359 average and seven homers to go with 26 RBI and 34 runs.
- Tyler Cerny paces the squad with 60 hits, 14 doubles, 38 RBI and 38 runs, while posting a .350 average and six homers.
- Carter Mathison also has seven homers along with 21 RBI.
- Indiana is 12th in the Big Ten with a 6.68 team ERA and sits second averaging 10.3 strikeouts per nine innings.
- Connor Foley ranks second in the Big Ten with 64 strikeouts to go with a 4-1 record and 3.21 ERA.
- Ty Bothwell is 4-1 with a 4.87 ERA and 40 strikeouts in 40.2 innings.

#### **Against The Hoosiers**

- Penn State is 43-47 all-time against Indiana.
- In 2023, the Nittany Lions took the first game of the series, but dropped the final two.
- In a wild series finale last season, Penn State held an early 6-4 lead, but Indiana posted 10 runs over the next four innings to hold a 14-6 lead. Penn State chipped away with five runs in the seventh, to cut the deficit to three, before Indiana exploded for eight runs in the ninth.

### PAGE 22 | PENN STATE VS. INDIANA HEAD COACH MIKE GAMBINO



Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino takes over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect Game.

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the D1Baseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting pitcher.

Gambino's pitching staff ranked 26th in the country in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.54) and 26th in walks allowed per nine innings (3.58). Boston College held fifth in the country, and led the ACC, with a .982 fielding percentage.

The 2022 MLB Draft saw four of Gambino's student-athletes be chosen, led by second baseman Luke Gold, who was selected in the fifth round by the Detroit Tigers. Pitchers Mason Pelio (Reds – 12th round), Joe Mancini (Astros – 15th round) and Max Gieg (Angels – 18th round) were also chosen in the draft.

In 2021, an impressive three players were selected in the first six rounds of the MLB Draft headlined by outfielder Sal Frelick, who was the 15th overall pick by the Milwaukee Brewers. Shortstop Cody Morissette was picked in the second round by the Miami Marlins and pitcher Emmet Sheehan was selected in the sixth round by the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Gambino led BC to a 31-27 record in 2019 and the Eagles reached the ACC semifinals as the 12th seed with wins over Clemson and top-seeded Louisville. A program-record five Eagles earned All-ACC, led by All-ACC first team pitcher Dan Metzdorf, who was a fifth-round pick for the Chicago White Sox and led the ACC with a 2.30 ERA. Jake Alu (Nationals - 24th round) and Matt Gill (Reds - 27th round) were also chosen during the 2019 MLB Draft.

In 2018, outfielder Chris Galland earned All-ACC third team accolades and Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-America honors. The 2018 MLB Draft had four of Gambino's players selected with Jake Palomaki (Rays – 18th round), Jacob Stevens (Diamondbacks - 21st round), Brian Rapp (Twins - 26th round) and Dan Metzdorf (Yankees - 38th round).

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship Tournament for the first time since 2010. BC won 10 of its last 15 ACC games with sweeps over Notre Dame and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005 and third-highest total in program history. They also tallied 13 ACC wins, the most since 2010, while their six conference series victories set a school record. Gambino led the Eagles to a sweep in the Oxford Regional as the third seed to advance to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. BC finished the season in the Top 25 of all four major polls for the first time in program history (15th – D1Baseball, 16th – Baseball America, NCBWA and 21st – USA Today/Coaches Poll).

For his efforts, Gambino was named the 2016 American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year, a finalist for D1Baseball Coach of the Year and earned a spot on the website's top-10 coaching performances of the season.

Gambino proteges were selected in the first round of the MLB Draft in back-to-back years for the first time in program history in 2015 and 2016. Chris Shaw was selected 31st overall by the San Francisco Giants in 2015 and Justin Dunn was taken 19th overall by the New York Mets in 2016. Overall, five players were drafted in 2016: Dunn, Michael King (12th round), Jesse Adams (14th round), Nick Sciortino (19th round) and Joe Cronin (34th round).

Gambino was an assistant coach for four seasons at Virginia Tech prior to his move to Boston College. He served as the Hokies' recruiting coordinator and worked with the hitters and infielders. In his four years, he saw 15 players get drafted in the MLB Draft, including nine in 2010.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny and Callahan.


