#### **WEEK SIX IN REVIEW**

The No. 12 Penn State men's volleyball team recorded two more straight-set victories last weekend to remain unbeaten in EIVA conference action. The Nittany Lions powered past NJIT and Rutgers-Newark to extend the PSU winning streak to 10 consecutive matches. The stretch of victories stands as the longest active men's volleyball winning streak nationally.

#### NITTANY LIONS IN THE AVCA COACHES POLL - WEEK SEVEN UPDATE

Following the 2-0 weekend at home, PSU remains No. 12 in the latest AVCA DI-II Top 15 Poll. The Lions have now spent the last six consecutive weeks at the No. 12 position. Additionally, Penn State is the only EIVA team to be ranked within the top 15.

#### PENN STATE VS. SACRED HEART

The Nittany Lions own a 6-0 advantage in the all-time series against the Pioneers. In the short history between the two squads that dates back to 2004, Penn State has not surrendered a single set to Sacred Heart.

#### **SCOUTING THE PIONEERS**

Sacred Heart improved to 5-6 overall and an even 2-2 in the conference after splitting a pair of EIVA matches last weekend. After registering double digit kills in both matches, outside Brad Borsay was selected as this week's EIVA Offensive Player of the Week. Borsay's 3.38 kills per set ranks fourth in the conference. As a team, Sacred Heart is leading the conference from behind the service line, averaging 1.71 aces per frame, which also ranks second nationally.

#### PENN STATE VS. HARVARD

PSU holds a 7-1 lead in the all-time series against the Crimson. In 2013 the Nittany Lions gave up their first loss to Harvard in the 13-year history between the two teams that dates back to the first meeting in 2000. Penn State earned a close five-set victory against the Crimson last season before being upended by Harvard in the final regular-season outing. The Nittany Lions rebounded with a straight-set victory in the EIVA tournament to claim the conference title.

#### **SCOUTING THE CRIMSON**

Harvard steps on to the court in Rec Hall looking to keep its conference winning streak alive, as the only other undefeated team in the EIVA other than PSU. Dj White, Casey White and Nick Madden are all leading the offense, averaging more than 2.20 kills per set. Chris Gibbons is anchoring the defense with 1.77 digs per frame, which ranks seventh in the conference.

#### CALLAWAY TABBED OFF THE BLOCK FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

After helping Penn State to its 10th consecutive victory over the weekend, redshirt freshman Matt Callaway was selected as the Off The Block/Springbak, Inc. National Freshman of the Week. Callaway closed out last week with a team-high 10 blocks, averaging 1.67 per frame.

Callaway opened the weekend with a team-high eight kills and six blocks against NJIT, putting up three solo stuffs. He returned to the court the next evening to lead the Nittany Lions blocking unit for the second consecutive match. He tallied four blocks, including two solo stops to go along with two kills in the win against Rutgers-Newark.



Pavlik donned a fedora in the Nittany Lions' matchup against travel partner, Saint Francis, Saturday, Feb. 1 to show his support. He will put on the hat once more, when PSU visits the Red Flash Saturday, April 12. The annual campaign benefits the Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. The organization is one of the largest and oldest private cancer centers and has dedicated more than 100 years to patient care and innovative research.

#### **GOODELL EARNS OUTRIGGER ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS**

Redshirt-junior Nick Goodell earned a spot on the 2014 Outrigger Invitational All-Tournament team. The outside hitter recorded three consecutive double-digit kill performances last week, while leading the team in the category twice. Within the three matches, Goodell set a season-high mark with 19 kills on .455 hitting at Hawaii.

#### FRESH FACES ON THE COURT IN 2014

Penn State returns a core group of 11 letterwinners and five starters this year, while welcoming five freshmen to the roster. The new additions include 6-8 opposite Aiden Albrecht from Old Bridge, N.J., Joey Farrell, a 6-5 outside from Lombard, Ill., Kevin Gear, a 6-7 middle blocker from Rochester, N.Y., Chris Nugent, a 6-4 outside from Fair Lawn, N.J., and Jalen Penrose, a 6-7 outside from Cambridge, Mass.

#### PENN STATE VOTED EIVA PRESEASON FAVORITE

The defending EVIA champion Penn State men's volleyball team has been picked as the preseason favorite in the 2014 Eastern Intercollegiate Volleyball Association (EIVA) preseason poll. The Nittany Lions received seven of eight first-place votes from the league's eight head coaches. PSU also earned the No. 1 preseason EIVA ranking heading into the 2013 season. Princeton was picked to finish second in the league, earning one first-place vote, while Harvard and George Mason were slotted as the No. 3 and No. 4 schools, respectively. St. Francis, NJIT, Sacred Heart and Rutgers-Newark rounded out the remaining positions, claiming spots five through eight.

#### RUSSELL TABBED OFF THE BLOCK PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

2013 Co-Eastern Intercollegiate Volleyball Association Player of the Year Aaron Russell earned 2014 Off the Block/Springbak Inc. Preseason First Team All-America honors earlier this month. He is one of 21 student-athletes to earn the honor, which is selected by a nationwide voting committee comprised of coaches from around the country. The Off the Block Preseason All-American teams recognizes the NCAA Division I-II men's volleyball players predicted to perform best in the country during the upcoming season. Off the Block is a national award winning website that is among the nation's leaders in college men's volleyball coverage.

#### HOSACK AND RUSSELL SPEND TIME WITH TEAM U.S.A.

Penn State assistant coach Jay Hosack and junior Aaron Russell both competed on the USA Men's Junior National Team in the FIVB Men's Volleyball U21 World Championship in Izmir and Ankara, Turkey this summer. Hosack served as an assistant coach of the squad, while Russell played outside hitter on the squad. Hosack, Russell and the rest of team U.S.A finished 11th in the 11-day tournament that featured 20 different teams from around the world.

#### **A CLEAN SWEEP**

Penn State has earned seven of its victories in straight-sets this season, putting together a 7-0 mark in three-set matches. Having swept its last four consecutive opponents, PSU is looking to extend its streak of straight-set wins this weekend at home. In 2013, the Nittany Lions recorded 15 3-0 wins.

#### STREAKING!

Following a pair of wins against NJIT and Rutgers-Newark, the Nittany Lions stretched their current winning streak to 10 consecutive matches, which presently stands as the longest active men's volleyball winning streak in the nation. Penn State is eight wins shy of matching the longest winning streak in program history. In 2008, Penn State shot out to an 18-match winning streak, tying the longest streak in PSU history that was originally set by the 1981 squad, and matched again by the 1982 team.

#### **GOODELL NAMED EIVA OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

After guiding Penn State to its eighth consecutive victory, redshirt junior Nick Goodell has earned his first EIVA Offensive Player of the Week honor of the season. Goodell closed out last week ranked second on the team with 45 kills, averaging 4.50 per set on a team-high .468 hitting clip. He also led the squad with eight aces, while also ranking second on the team with six blocks.

In a midweek Big Ten matchup against Ohio State, Goodell fueled the offense with a season-high 20 kills on .533 efficiency. He also added a season-high four aces to go along with three digs and three blocks. He opened the weekend with a double-digit performance against Erskine, tallying 10 kills, one ace, four digs and two blocks in the win.


#### **RUSSELL EARNS ANOTHER EIVA WEEKLY HONOR**

After helping the Penn State men's volleyball team to an undefeated weekend at home, junior Aaron Russell was named the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week. The honor is his second conference offensive player of the week award of the 2014 season.

Against Mount Olive, he registered five kills, two digs, two blocks and two aces. The next night, Russell played a key role in the Nittany Lions' 3-1 EIVA conference opening victory against Saint Francis. Russell notched his second double-double of the season with 16 kills and 11 digs. He also added a team-high four aces in the win.






