OPENING TIP: Northwestern closes out its 2-game regular season series with Penn State, and will look to sweep the Nittany Lions for the first time since 2012.

- Northwestern is 6-0 in Big Ten home games this season, its best start at home in conference play since the 1967-68 team went a perfect 7-0. Dating back to last season, the Wildcats have won 9 of their last 10 conference home games, equaling their best stretch since winning 9 of 10 games over the 1965-66 and 1966-67 seasons. The 'Cats last won 10 of 11 conference home games over the 1965-66 and 1966-67 seasons.
- Over the last 2 seasons, the Wildcats have won 19 Big Ten Conference games, their most in back-to-back seasons in school history since winning 19 games over the 1931-32 and 1932-33 seasons.
- Northwestern is averaging 78.9 points per game (3rd in B1G) in Big Ten play, its highest in a season since 1970-71 (81.3).
- The Wildcats defeated their second AP Top 10 team of the season for the first time in school history, with a 96-91 OT win over No. 10 Illinois on Jan. 24.
- Northwestern has played 4 total OT games this year (2-2), its 2nd most in a season in school history, trailing the 2015-16 team which played 5 and went 3-2. The 'Cats have played 4 Big Ten OT games in a season for the first time in program history.
- The 'Cats played back-to-back OT games for the 2nd time in program history, and the first time since 1983-84 (Jan. 19 vs. Wisconsin L, 61-60 & Jan. 21 vs. Minnesota W, 52-50). This season marks the first time Northwestern has played OT in back-to-back road games.

- NU has 2 OT wins or more in a season for the first time since 2015-16.
- The 'Cats have scored 88 or more points in 4 or more B1G games in a season for the first time since 1975-76 (4x).
- NU's four NET Quad 1 wins (Purdue, Dayton, Michigan State, Illinois) rank t-2nd most in the Big Ten.
- Northwestern's 7.7 steals per game since the 2022-23 season are the 2nd-most in the Big Ten, trailing Rutgers (8.1).
- Boo Buie** (1,978 career points) is 22 points away from becoming the 2nd Northwestern player in program history to reach 2,000 career points. He is 60 points away from tying **John Shurna** (2,038) for the school's career scoring record.
- Head coach **Chris Collins** has won 16 games against ranked opponents in his career, the most by any head coach in program history.
- NU and Penn State will meet for the 60th time with the Nittany Lions holding a 38-21 lead in the all-time series (More on Page 3). Northwestern won this season's earlier meeting 76-72 in State College, despite committing a season-high 18 turnovers. Head coach **Chris Collins** is 6-11 in his career against Penn State.
- NU ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 8th nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (39.6%, 197-498), last year NU shot 32.1% (172-544) in its first 23 games of 2022-23. NU's 39.6% mark is its highest in a season since the 1990-91 team shot 43.4% (109-251) from downtown, which ranks 2nd in a single-season in program history. 1990-91 was the fourth year of the college 3-point arc. During conference-only games,

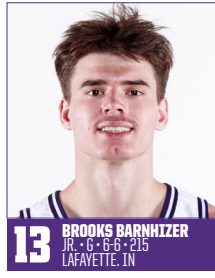

MORE NOTES...

Northwestern is shooting 44.1%, the best mark in conference action by any team in the country. The Wildcats have made 10 or more 3-pointers in 6 straight games for the first time since at least 2010-11.

- **Boo Buie** has recorded 9 consecutive 20+ point games against AP Top 25 teams, the 2nd longest streak in the country by any high-major player since 1996-97 behind Luka Garza (Iowa, 11). For the second time this season and fourth time in his career, he was named Big Ten Player of the Week (Jan. 29) as he averaged 24.0 points and 6.0 assists per game in wins over Ohio State and Illinois. Buie is averaging 25.4 points per game against ranked foes, the 5th-highest mark by any player in the country (min. 3 games).
- **Ty Berry** (55), **Boo Buie** (53) and **Ryan Langborg** (48) are the only trio of teammates in the Big Ten to each connect on 45+ 3-pointers this season, and the first NU trio to post those numbers (through 23 games) since at least 2010-11. They are the only high-major trio in the country posting those numbers, and one of just four sets of teammates in the country. Berry was especially efficient during January, shooting 48.0% (24-50) from behind the arc, which ranked tied for 7th-best in the country (min. 50 attempts). Buie connected on 7 made 3-pointers against Purdue (Jan. 31) the most treys by Wildcat against a BIG opponent since **Scottie Lindsey** made 9 against Iowa on Feb. 25, 2018.

LAST TIME OUT: Northwestern snapped a 2-game losing skid by defeating Nebraska 80-68 in a wire-to-wire win on Wednesday (Feb. 7) night inside Welsh-Ryan Arena.

- **Boo Buie** led the team scoring 22 points, and went 4-of-7 from 3-point range.
- **Brooks Barnhizer** logged second double-double in as many games with 14 points and 10 rebounds.
- **Ryan Langborg** played a complete game, posting 18 points, 7 rebounds, a career-high 6 assists and 0 turnovers. He is the only Big Ten player to post those numbers in a game all season.
- Nick Martinelli scored 15 points (all in the second half), his most in a conference game.
- The Wildcats outrebounded the Cornhuskers 36-29, marking the second consecutive game they have outrebounded their opponent.
- The Wildcats shot 44.0% (11-25) from behind the 3-point arc, and were 8-16 in the 1st half.
- Northwestern forced Nebraska into 17 turnovers.

BALL SECURITY: Northwestern has been one of the best teams in the country at taking care of the ball this year, leading the Big Ten and ranking 8th in the country, averaging just 9.2 turnovers per game.

- NU's assist/turnover ratio of 1.78 ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 6th in the country.

- Northwestern forces an average of 13.4 turnovers per game, which ranks 3rd in the Big Ten.
- NU's turnover margin of +4.3 is 2nd in the BIG and ranks 13th nationally. Last year the Wildcats held the Big Ten's best turnover margin at +4.3, which ranked 9th nationally.

GIMME THAT: NU's 7.5 steals per game rank 3rd in the BIG. **Brooks Barnhizer** (1.9, 4th), **Boo Buie** (1.5, 9th) and **Ty Berry** (1.4, 12th) rank among the Big Ten's leaders. Last season, Northwestern ranked second in the Big Ten forcing 7.9 steals per game, and set the single-season program record by recording 267 total thefts.

BOO BACK: Graduate guard **Boo Buie** returns for his fifth season in Evanston in 2023-24, and heading into this season was named Preseason All-Big Ten, Preseason All-American and garnered NABC Division I Player of the Year and Bob Cousy Award Watch List recognition.

- Buie was named Big Ten Player of the Week for the third time in his career on Dec. 4, averaging 27.0 points, 8.0 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game in wins over NIU and Purdue. He won his second Big Ten Player of the Week award on Jan. 29, averaging 24.0 points and 5.0 assists in wins over No. 10 Illinois and Ohio State.
- Buie is 2nd in the school's career scoring record book with 1,978 career points, passing **Drew Crawford** (2010-14) at Purdue (Jan. 31). Buie is the only player in program history with career marks of at least 1,800 points and 500 assists. He has recorded five games of 15+ points and 8+ assists, tied for 2nd in the country. He is just 22 points away from becoming the 2nd 2,000 point scorer in program history.
- He is averaging 19.0 points per game this year (3rd in BIG) and 5.4 assists per game (3rd in BIG). He is the only high-major player in the country averaging 18+ points and 5+ assists this year. In conference-only games, he ranks 3rd in both points (21.1) and assists (6.2) per game, and is the only player to rank in the top 5 in each category. Illinois' Ayo Dosunmo was the last Big Ten player to post season averages of 18+ points and 5+ assists per game in 2020-21. His 21.1 points per game in Big Ten play is the most by a Northwestern player since John Shurna averaged 20.0 points per game in 2011-12.
- Buie has shown why he was named a preseason All-American by averaging 29 points, 8 assists, 2.5 steals with just 2 total turnovers in wins over No. 1 Purdue and No. 10 Illinois.
- Buie is also playing the most minutes in the Big Ten and the 12th most in the country averaging 36:22 minutes per game.
- Against Purdue (Dec. 1), Buie scored 31 points and dished out 9 assists with a turnover, becoming the first high-major conference player to post those

numbers since Oklahoma State's James On Curry (2005-07) on Nov. 29, 2006.

LET BROOKS COOK: After an expanded role late last season, junior guard **Brooks Barnhizer** has continued on his upward trajectory in 2023-24.

- Barnhizer is averaging 14.5 points per game (2nd on the

team, 17th in BIG), a team-best 6.7 rebounds per game (12th in the BIG) and 1.9 steals per game, which leads the team and ranks 4th in the BIG in his first season starting for the Wildcats. His 6.7 rebounds per game lead the league among guards.

- Barnhizer is one of two high-major players in the country posting 14.0+ points, 6.3+ rebounds and 1.5+ steals per game. (Kadary Richmond, Seton Hall). Since 1992-93, only two Big Ten players have posted those numbers for an entire season: Glenn Robinson (Purdue, 1992-93) and Ryan Bowen (Iowa, 1997-98).
- He recorded a double-double in back-to-back games against Binghamton and Dayton becoming the first Northwestern player to do so since **Vic Law** in 2018-19, and accomplished the feat again later in the year against Minnesota and Nebraska.
- His 4 double-doubles this season are the most in a campaign by a Northwestern guard since at least 2010-11.
- Barnhizer is averaging 36:20 minutes played per game, which ranks 2nd in the Big Ten. He is playing 89.0% of Northwestern's minutes, which ranks 27th in the country.

BORG BUCKETS: Princeton transfer guard **Ryan Langborg** has provided an offensive spark to the Wildcats this season, after leading the Tigers to an NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearance last year.

- Langborg reached the 1,000 career-point mark by tallying 12 points at Nebraska (Jan. 20).
- Langborg is averaging 2.1 made 3-pointers per game this season, which ranks 8th in the Big Ten.
- He became the first Wildcat to make 29 or more 3-pointers over the season's first 12 games since **Scottie Lindsey** made 34 in 2017-18.
- Over a five-game stretch from 11/27 through 12/16, Langborg made 19 total 3-pointers, shooting 65.0% (19-of-29). He is the first Northwestern player to hit 19+ threes and shoot 60%+ from deep in a five game stretch since at least 2010-11. During the stretch, he averaged 17.8 points per game, and over the last 13 games, dating back to last year's NCAA Tournament, he posted 14.8 points per game.

TB3: Senior guard **Ty Berry** is posting the best numbers of his career in 2023-24.

- This season he is averaging career-highs in points (11.6) and field goal percentage (44.9) and 3-point field goal percentage (43.3).
- Berry is second in the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage (min. 100 attempts) behind Ohio State's Jamison Battle (44.4). He is 3rd in the Big Ten averaging 2.4 made 3-pointers per game.
- **Berry's 3-point field goal percentage is the best by a Wildcat (min. 100 attempts) since John Shurna shot 44.0% (95-216) in 2011-12.**

- He saw a 5-game double-digit scoring steak end against Wisconsin, but averaged 16.8 points, 5.8 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game, while shooting 59.2% from the field and 58.1% from behind the arc during the stretch, the highest scoring span of his career. He has scored in double-figures for a 5 game stretch 3 times in his career.
- He notched his first double-double of the season and the third of his career with 12 points and 10 rebounds against Arizona State (Dec. 20).
- NU is 31-10 in his career when scoring in double-figures
- Berry reached 100 career assists and steals on Dec. 13.

MARTINELLI MINUTES: Sophomore guard **Nick Martinelli**, from nearby Glenview, Ill. (9 miles from Welsh-Ryan Arena), has been a huge lift of the bench for the 'Cats this year.

- He posted career-highs of 22 points, 6 rebounds and 3 assists off the bench on Dec. 10 against Detroit Mercy. Martinelli scored the most points by a Northwestern bench player since **Boo Buie** had 26 points against Michigan State on December 18, 2019.
- Martinelli's 22 points off the bench in a non-conference game were the most by a Northwestern player since **Scottie Lindsey** posted 26 against New Orleans in 2015.
- Martinelli made his first eight shots from the field before finishing the game 10-of-12 from the field. It is the highest shooting percentage by a NU player while making 10+ field goals since **John Shurna** shot 10-of-11 from the field on Dec. 13, 2010, against Long Island.
- Martinelli was named the Fisher-McGrath Award Winner, given to the MVP of the Northwestern/DePaul game, for scoring a game-high 16 points and grabbing 5 rebounds off the bench.
- Martinelli has scored in double-figures in 3 of the last 4 games and scored 15 second half points in a win over Nebraska.

SPEED LIMIT, 65

- Northwestern is 8-0 when holding opponents to 65 or fewer points this season, after going 20-2 last year when doing so.
- During the Chris Collins era, Northwestern is 126-35 (.781) when holding its opponent to 65 or fewer points.

RANKED 'CATS: Northwestern earned a No. 25 ranking in Week 6 of the Associated Press Poll (Dec. 11). Below are some facts about when the Wildcats are ranked.

- The Wildcats have been ranked in back-to-back seasons after earning a No. 21 ranking in Week 15 last year.
- With a 56-46 win over DePaul on Dec. 16, Northwestern

snapped a six-game losing skid while ranked.

- Northwestern won its first road game as a ranked team at DePaul since Jan. 4, 1969, when the No. 19 ranked Wildcats defeated Michigan State 85-71 inside Jenison Field House. NU won its first road game as a ranked team against a non-conference opponent against DePaul for the first time since the No. 6 'Cats defeated Louisville 73-68 on Dec. 19, 1958.
- Northwestern is 13-19 all-time as a ranked team.
- The Wildcats won eight games as a ranked team during the 1958-59 season, a single-season program record.
- Northwestern hasn't won a Big Ten game as a ranked team since defeating Michigan State 85-71 on Jan. 4, 1969, when the 'Cats were ranked No. 19.
- NU's highest all-time ranking is No. 6, which happened two times during the 1958-59 season.

SCORING 'CATS: Northwestern is averaging 75.0 points per game this season. If the mark holds for the season, it would be Northwestern's second-highest scoring output in the last 50 seasons. The 2020-21 team averaged 73.0 points and the 1989-90 team averaged 78.2 points per game.

RETURNING PRODUCTION: Northwestern returns 61.7% of its points from last season, which ranks fourth in the conference. The Wildcats rank in the top half of the Big Ten in percentage of minutes returning (57.2%, fifth), percentage of rebounds (57.0%, sixth) and percentage of assists (63.4%, fifth).

O CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN(S): Northwestern's Boo Buie, Brooks Barnhizer and Ty Berry were named team captains for the 2023-24 season ... Buie is serving as a captain for the second consecutive season, while Barnhizer and Berry take on the leadership role for the first time.

BEATING NO. 1: Northwestern became the seventh program in the country to defeat an AP No. 1 ranked team in back-to-back seasons since 2010-11 with a 92-88 overtime win over then-No. 1 Purdue on Dec. 1. Only Rutgers was unranked in both wins.

- Northwestern is the 25th program to record two wins against an AP No. 1 team since 2010-11 and the sixth Big Ten team to do so, joining Rutgers, Indiana, Michigan State, Ohio State and Wisconsin.
- The Wildcats are the third program to ever defeat the same AP No. 1 team at home in consecutive season. Butler defeated Villanova in 2016-17 and 2017-18 and Maryland defeated Duke in 2001-02 and 2002-03. NU would be the first to do so while unranked.
- **Boo Buie** led the way for NU with 31 points, the second-highest mark of his career, and 9 assists. He did not turn the ball over and tallied 7 points in OT. He became the first major conference player to post those numbers in a single game since Oklahoma State's JameSon Curry vs. Texas A&M-CC on Nov. 29, 2006 (35/9/0).
- **Ty Berry** tallied 21 points, with 7 points coming in OT. **Ryan Langborg** had a season-high 20 points, as the trio combined for 72 of the team's 92 points.
- NU was 0-19 against the AP No. 1 until the last two years against Purdue. It was the Wildcats first overtime win over an AP top 5 team since Dec. 27, 1959, a 118-109 OT win over a Jerry West led and No. 5 ranked West Virginia team.
- It was head coach **Chris Collins** 15th win over a ranked opponent, tied for the program lead with Bill Carmody.
- NU has won 5 of its last 8 games against ranked opponents.

OT WIN AGAINST ILLINOIS: In a back-and-forth affair that featured 18 lead changes and 15 ties, Northwestern defeated Illinois at home for the second straight season, 96-91, in OT on Jan. 24.

- **Boo Buie** put on a clinic and scored a game-high 29 points (8 in OT) and dished out 7 assists with 3 steals. He scored the game-tying bucket on a driving layup with 23 seconds left in regulation. Buie has shown why he was named a preseason All-American by averaging 30 points, 8 assists, 2.5 steals with just 2 total turnovers in wins over No. 1 Purdue and No. 10 Illinois.
- **Brooks Barnhizer** scored 23 points and hit a season-high 4 treys, including a 4-point play in OT. NU is 11-3 in his career when Barnhizer scores 15+ points.
- NU had just 5 turnovers, its 3rd straight home game with 5 or fewer turnovers.
- NU shot 61.1% (11-18) from behind the arc, its highest in a game since shooting 63.2% (12-19) against Georgia Tech in 2010.
- The Wildcats scored 20 points in OT, tying a Welsh-Ryan Arena record (since 1983-84) when NU scored

20 in a 77-74 win over Minnesota on Feb. 14, 2010.

- KenPom ranked the game with the 13th-highest tension rating (3.13) of any game in CBB this year. Tension is a measure of how close the win probability is to 50% throughout the game.

RECAPPING LAST YEAR: Northwestern won its second most games in a single-season in program history and finished tied for second place in the Big Ten Conference standings for the first time since 1958-59 by finishing 22-12 with a 12-8 conference mark.

- Northwestern reached the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history, earning a No. 7 seed, its highest in program history.
- The Wildcats advanced to the second round defeating Boise State 75-67, before falling to No. 7 UCLA, 68-63.
- The 'Cats 12 Big Ten wins were the most in school history, ahead of the 1930-31 (11-1) team, the school's only outright Big Ten championship squad.
- Head coach **Chris Collins** was named Big Ten Coach of the Year, becoming the first Northwestern coach to win the award since 2004. Following the conclusion of the season he signed a contract extension through 2028.
- Guard **Boo Buie** was named an All-Big Ten First Team selection, Northwestern's first since **John Shurna** in 2012.
- NU posted an over .500 road record (7-4) for the first time in a season since 1958-59 (7-2). The team's six BIG road wins last year tied the program benchmark for most in a single-season in school history (1930-31, 6-0).

LEARNING FROM THE BEST: Northwestern's coaching staff scored 6,212 career collegiate points, the most among coaching staffs in the Big Ten.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN: Northwestern returns three starters from last year's team (**Ty Berry**, **Boo Buie**, **Matthew Nicholson**), and **Brooks Barnhizer**, who played starters minutes coming off the bench. Four of the top six scorers from last season are back.

- The Wildcats added three transfers through the portal for 2023-24: Graduate guard **Ryan Langborg** from Princeton, graduate forward **Blake Preston** from Liberty and sophomore guard **Justin Mullins** from Denver.
- NU added three first-years in guards **Jordan Clayton** and **Parker Strauss** and forward **Blake Barkley**.

HEAD COACH CHRIS COLLINS: Sullivan-Ubben Head Men's Basketball Coach Chris Collins is in his 11th season as the

program's head coach, the third-longest coaching tenure in program history.

- Collins is the fourth-longest tenured coach in the Big Ten, trailing Michigan State's Tom Izzo (29), Purdue's Matt Painter (19) and Iowa's Fran McCaffery (14).
- Collins has guided Northwestern to 20 wins or more in a season three times. Northwestern had two 20 win seasons in its first 111 seasons of basketball. Collins has guided the team to three 20 or more win seasons in the last eight campaigns.
- His 75 Big Ten wins are second in school history behind **Arthur "Dutch" Longborg** (138, 1927-50).

TRANSFER ADDITIONS: Northwestern added three transfers to its roster for the 2023-24 season:

- Grad transfer guard **Ryan Langborg** comes to Northwestern from Princeton, where he was pivotal in leading the Tigers to a Sweet 16 appearance last season. Over 81 games in his career, the San Diego, Calif. native is averaging 9.9 points, 2.9 rebounds and 1.4 assists per game, and last season posted averages of 12.7 points, 3.1 rebounds and 1.6 assists per game.
- Grad transfer forward **Blake Preston** joins the roster after playing 109 career games at Liberty, and averaged 6.7 points and a team-high 5.1 rebounds per game last season on Liberty teams that went a combined 102-30 during his career in Lynchburg.
- Sophomore guard **Justin Mullins** is a local product from Oak Park, Ill. (12 miles from Welsh-Ryan Arena), that comes by way of Denver, where he led the Pioneers and ranked third in the Summit League averaging 1.5 steals per game last season.

FIRST-YEAR ADDITIONS: Northwestern added three first-year players to its roster for the 2023-24 season:

- Guard **Jordan Clayton** (Medford, Mass.) is a three-star prospect rated as the No. 28 point guard in the nation by 247Sports.
- Guard **Parker Strauss** (Costa Mesa, Calif.) was rated a three-star prospect by 247Sports and averaged 11.3 points, 7.1 rebounds, 5.0 rebounds and 2.8 steals per game as a senior.
- Forward **Blake Barkley** is rated a three-star prospect from Morgantown, W.Va., but prepped at Putnam Science Academy (Conn.). He averaged 13.5 points and 8.2 rebounds per game on the Adidas 3SSB circuit.

CHRIS COLLINS

SULLIVAN-UBBEN HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Sullivan-Ubben Head Coach Chris Collins is in his 11th season at Northwestern and ranks third in school history in wins. He was named the University's 24th head men's basketball coach on March 27, 2013, and this offseason signed a contract extension through 2028.

Collins guided the Wildcats to heights never before reached during his tenure, including the first two NCAA Tournament appearances in program history. Through 10 seasons at NU, Collins is 155-162 and guided the program to its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2016-17, and guided the program to its second appearance in 2022.

Most recently in 2022-23, Collins led the Wildcats to the school's second NCAA Tournament berth, a 22-12 overall record, and a second-place finish in the Big Ten Conference standings with a 12-8 league ledger. For the first time since 1958-59, Northwestern finished second in the league standings, while also setting a school record for conference wins in a single-season. For the first time in his career, Collins was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year, the second time in Northwestern history a coach has earned the award. Additionally, he received national recognition as the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year and a Naismith Coach of the Year Semifinalist.

The regular season was highlighted by a school-record four wins over AP ranked opponents and the program's first victory against the nation's No. 1 team, on Feb. 12 against No. 1 Purdue, 64-58, inside Welsh-Ryan Arena. Playing away from home, the team went 7-4 in true road contests, winning the school's most road games in a season since 1958-59. The 'Cats captured their first win over a ranked Indiana team since 1988 by downing the No. 15 Hoosiers, 84-83, at Assembly Hall on Jan. 8. Northwestern won back-to-back road games over ranked opponents for the first time in school history as it defeated No. 20 Michigan State 70-63 in East Lansing.

Northwestern earned a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, the highest in school history, and defeated Boise State 75-67 in the First Round in Sacramento, Calif., before falling to No. 2 UCLA, 68-63. The 'Cats improved to 2-0 all-time in NCAA Tournament First Round games.

Under his coaching, Northwestern's senior guards of Chase Audige and Boo Buie combined to form one of the best backcourts in the country and in school history. Audige was named co-Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, a first at NU since 1994, and an All-Big Ten Second Team selection. Buie posted one of the best seasons by a point guard in program history and became the first Wildcat named All-Big Ten First Team since John Shurna in 2012. Buie was also a finalist for the Bob Cousy Award, which is awarded to the nation's best point guard. The duo became the first Northwestern teammates to earn first and second team All-Big Ten honors

since 1963-64.

In 2021-22, the team went 15-16. He guided the program to seven Big Ten wins, the program's most in a year since the 2016-17 season. Forward Pete Nance earned All-Big Ten Honorable Mention recognition, averaging 14.6 points and 6.5 rebounds per game. The Wildcats tallied a 64-62 road win at No. 10 Michigan State on Jan. 15, Collins' third triumph over an AP-Top 10 opponent as head coach. Northwestern defeated Nebraska 71-69 in the Big Ten Tournament, earning the team's first postseason win since 2016-17.

In 2020-21, the 'Cats opened Big Ten play 3-0 for the first time since the 1967-68 season and earned a No. 19 ranking from the AP. NU recorded a 79-65 win over No. 4 Michigan State on Dec. 20, it's first win over a top-five opponent since beating the Spartans in 1979. Later that week, the Wildcats knocked off No. 23 Ohio State, 71-70.

During his sixth campaign at the helm of the program, Collins saw program greats Vic Law and Dererk Pardon complete their college careers. Both were named All-Big Ten honorable mention and both finished with over 1,000-career points. Law finished his career in the top-10 at Northwestern for 3-pointers made (10th; 193), rebounds (9th; 710), and double-doubles (7th; 8). As a senior, Pardon averaged a career-high 13.9 points per game, a single-season high 244 rebounds and was the only Wildcat to start and play in all 31 games throughout 2018-19. Collins mentored Pardon to become Northwestern's all-time leader in career field goal percentage (60.2%). He ranks second all-time at NU in blocks (149), fifth in rebounds (785) and fourth in double-doubles (18).

In 2017-18, Collins saw his first Northwestern recruiting class wrap up their collegiate careers. Bryant McIntosh left NU with more than 1,600 points and 700 career assists, becoming one of only three players in Big Ten history to reach both milestones. His 700 career assists are a program record, while ranking seventh in league history. Scottie Lindsey finished his time in Evanston ranking eighth in school history in career three-point field goals and in the top 20 in scoring.

In 2016-17, he guided the Wildcats to a school-record 24 wins while earning the program's first NCAA tournament berth and victory in school history NU captured the nation's attention with its outstanding start to the season. An 18-4 start, including a six-game winning streak in Big Ten Conference play – the program's first since 1933 – saw the team crack the top 25 of the AP poll on Jan. 30, the team's first national ranking in seven years. NU went on to record 10 wins in league play, its most since the 1932-33 campaign.

NU was rewarded with an NCAA tournament berth on Selection Sunday and the Wildcats earned a 68-66 victory over Vanderbilt in an opening-round contest in Salt Lake City. Northwestern pushed second-ranked and eventual national runner-up Gonzaga to the limits in the second round before eventually suffering a narrow loss.

Collins' contributions to the program were rewarded by being named one of four national finalists for the Naismith Men's Coach of the Year award.

Collins came to Evanston after serving on the coaching staff at Duke since July 22, 2000. He was promoted to Associate Head Coach in the summer of 2008. During Collins' 13 seasons on the Blue Devils' staff, Duke posted an overall record of 385-77 while recording eight ACC tournament championships, four ACC regular season titles, eight in-season tournament titles and national championships in 2001 and 2010.

Collins worked primarily with backcourt players during his time at Duke and tutored All-Americans Jason Williams, Mike Dunleavy, Chris Duhon, J.J. Redick, Gerald Henderson, DeMarcus Nelson, Jon Scheyer, Nolan Smith and Austin Rivers, in addition to NBA draft picks Daniel Ewing, Kyrie Irving and Kyle Singler.

Collins also served as a court coach and scout for Mike Krzyzewski, assisting the USA Basketball Senior National Team staff with on-court duties as well as game preparation from 2006-12, including during the program's gold-medal performances at the 2008 Beijing Olympics, 2010 FIBA World Championships and 2012 London Olympics. Before returning to his alma mater, Collins served as an assistant coach at Seton Hall for two years with Tommy Amaker. In 1999-2000, Collins was part of a staff that guided the Pirates to a 22-10 record and the Sweet 16 of the NCAA tournament. Prior to Seton Hall, Collins spent the 1997-98 season as an assistant with the WNBA's Detroit Shock.

As a player, Collins played professional basketball in Finland during the 1996-97 season, leading the league in scoring.

While at Duke, Collins was a team captain as a senior and four-year letterman from 1993-96. He ranks 11th among Duke's all-time leaders in three-point field goals (209) and 10th in three-point field goal attempts (539). Collins averaged 9.1 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.4 assists as a collegian. He earned second-team All-ACC honors as a senior.

Collins was a member of a Duke senior class that had 83 total victories, three NCAA tournament bids, one Final Four appearance, two ACC regular season championships, an ACC tournament title, and two in-season tournament championships (the 1992 Maui Classic and the 1995 Carrs Great Alaska Shootout).

As a senior in 1996, Collins had his most productive season, leading the Blue Devils in three-point field goals (79), three-point percentage (.441), free throws made (83) and attempted (115), assists (132) and steals (37). Collins also ranked second on the team by averaging 16.3 points per game. He was among the ACC leaders in scoring (10th), assists (fourth), field goal percentage (.467, seventh) and free throw percentage (.722, 10th).

Collins is the son of former NBA All-Star, Doug Collins, who is currently a senior advisor for the Chicago Bulls. A native of nearby Northbrook, Illinois, Collins is a 1996 graduate of Duke with a bachelor's degree in sociology.

Collins and his wife, Kim, have two children: Ryan, who is a student manager for the Wildcats and Kate.
