BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Big Ten teams went 9-9 in nonconference play last week, moving to 81-24 in nonconference action this season. Only the SEC has collected more non-league wins at 91-24. The ACC (77-40), Atlantic 10 (75-49) and Sun Belt (74-47) complete the five conferences with at least 70 wins.
- Of the 12 remaining undefeated teams in Division I, two reside in the Big Ten, as #4 Purdue and #10 Maryland sport identical 8-0 records. The SEC and Mountain West lead the conference tally with three unbeaten teams each, while one team from the BIG EAST, American, ACC and Big 12 is included in the list.
- Five Big Ten Conference teams found their ways into this week's AP Top 25 poll, while six are listed in the USA Today Top 25 poll. Purdue (#4/4), Maryland (#13/13), Indiana (#14/11), Illinois (#17/17) and Ohio State (#25/23) are included in both polls, while Iowa checks in a #24 in the USA Today rankings. The Big Ten is one of three conferences with at least five ranked teams. The SEC leads the way with six, one more than the Big Ten and the Big 12. Michigan State, Rutgers and Wisconsin are also receiving votes in one of both polls.
- A pair of big Ten teams will head to the Big Apple tonight for the 2022 Jimmy V Classic in Madison Square Garden. #14/11 Illinois will look bounce back from Friday's loss, as it faces #2 Texas, while #24 Iowa will meet #15 Duke. The Illini will be making their fourth appearance at the annual event, while Iowa will be making its debut. The Big Ten is 8-6 in the Classic's 28-year history.
- Wisconsin will also play host to #13 Maryland in Tuesday's other action. Maryland enters the game with a perfect 8-0 record. Since 2000, six teams have come to the Kohl Center with a mark of 8-0 or better. All but one have left with a loss. In fact, the Badgers have won their last five home games against teams with a record of 8-0 or better.
- In a total of 320 game minutes played this season, Maryland has trailed a total of 8:07. The largest deficit of the year has been three points against both Coppin State and Illinois. Illinois held the lead for a total of 4:44; prior to that, the Terps had only trailed a combined 3:23 through seven games. The Terps have won seven of eight games this year by double-figures including by 20-plus points for the first four straight.
- With a win tonight over #15 Duke at the Jimmy V Classic in New York City, RV/#24 Iowa head coach Fran McCaffery will collect his 500th career victory. McCaffery has claimed 248 wins at Iowa, 112 at Siena, 90 at UNC Greensboro, and 49 at Lehigh. With Iowa's next win, McCaffery will become the second active coach in the Big Ten and 24th in NCAA Division I to reach the 500-win plateau. Several other Big Ten coaches stand on the verge of career milestones: Purdue's Matt Painter - 391 wins at Purdue; Rutgers' Steve Pikiell - 296 career wins.
- Illinois senior Terrence Shannon Jr. is one of only four players in the country – and one of just two high-major players – averaging at least 19 points, six rebounds and three assists on the season (Jalen Wilson-Kansas, Freddy Hicks-Tarleton State, Elijah Pepper-UC Davis).
- Northwestern opened the second half with an 8-3 spurt and scored the final six points of the game to earn a 70-63 win at Michigan State on Sunday in the Big Ten Conference opener for both clubs. The Wildcats have now won three of their last four meetings with the Spartans, including victories in three consecutive years. Northwestern shot a blistering 21-24 from the free throw line, the program's most made free throws against a ranked opponent since going 21-27 against UCLA on Nov. 29, 2013.
- Nebraska scored its third straight road win over a ranked team on Sunday, as the Huskers downed #7 Creighton in Omaha. Paired with last season's wins at then-#23 Ohio State and then-#10 Wisconsin, this marked the first time in program history that Nebraska has won three consecutive road games against ranked opponents. It also marks the fifth road win over a top-10 ranked team and second under head coach Fred Hoiberg.
- Senior Zach Edey had a monster effort in #5 Purdue's 89-70 win at Minnesota on Sunday, pairing career highs of 31 points and 22 rebounds. Edey singlehandedly outrebounded the Gopher Gophers 21-20 and shot more free throws (10-8), making him the only players in the last 25 years to accomplish both feats in the same game. Edey's string of seven straight games of 20 or more points are the second most for a 7-footer nationally in the last 25 years, behind Utah's Andrew Bogut in 2004-05 (8).

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
