BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Purdue, Illinois, and Wisconsin continue to represent the Big Ten in this week's top-25 polls. The Boilermakers fell one spot to No. 2 in both polls, while Wisconsin moved up to No. 11 in the AP rankings and No. 8 in the Coaches Poll. Illinois enters this week's action at No. 14 in both listings. Nebraska was the only other Big Ten team to earn weekly recognition, as the Huskers received votes in the Coaches Poll.
- Maryland guard Jahmir Young was named Big Ten Player of the Week, presented by Air National Guard, for the week of Jan. 8-14, the guard's second honor in three weeks. Young averaged 20.0 points, 6.5 assists, 3.5 rebounds, and 1.5 steals, as the Terrapins scored a pair of wins. Young scored a game-high 28 points, including 16 in the second half, and recorded eight assists, two rebounds, a steal, and a blocked shot to lead Maryland to a 76-67 win at then-No. 10 Illinois. Young also recorded 10 of his 12 points in the second half a 64-57 win over Michigan, posting a +19 after the halftime break.
- Iowa freshman big man Owen Freeman collected his sixth Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor. Freeman paired a career-high 22 points and 10 rebounds in a victory over Nebraska. The double-double was the freshman's second in three games. The three double-doubles are the most by a Hawkeye freshman since Luka Garza in 2017-18.
- On Wednesday, Jan. 10, the Los Angeles Athletic Club announced the John R. Wooden Award® presented by Principal® Midseason Top 25 Watch List. Purdue's Zach Edey and Michigan State's Tyson Walker were listed among those considered strong candidates for the honor which will be announced following the NCAA Tournament in April.
- MILESTONE WATCH... Congratulations to Iowa head coach Fran McCaffery, who earned his 272nd victory at Iowa on Monday, moving into first place on the program's all-time wins list. The Hawkeyes' 86-77 win at Minnesota gave McCaffery 272 victories, breaking a tie with Tom Davis... Michigan State head coach Tom Izzo enters Sunday's game with 697 wins. Izzo is on the verge of becoming the 10th active coach in Div. I to record 700 career victories. Thursday's home contest against Minnesota will also mark Izzo's 500th career Big Ten game, making him just the second coach in conference history to reach the mark, joining the late Bobby Knight (504)... Ohio State head coach Chris Holtmann will carry 249 career wins into Saturday's home game against Penn State. His 135 victories in Columbus are fifth most in program history.
- Eight Big Ten teams rank in the top-70 in Tuesday's NET rankings, including four in the top 25. Purdue's No. 3 ranking is tops in the league, while Wisconsin and Illinois sit at Nos. 11 and 16, respectively, followed by No. 22 Michigan State, No. 48 Iowa, No. 51 Ohio State, No. 54 Nebraska, and No. 69 Northwestern. The Big 12 and Big East lead the nation with 10 top-70 entrants each, one more than the SEC and ACC.
- The Big Ten's 25 Quad 1 wins are tied with the Big East for the most in the country, three north of the Big 12 and four clear of the ACC. The Big Ten's 45 combined Quad 1 and 2 victories rank second behind the SEC's 47 (16 Q1, 31 Q2). The Big East owns 44 combined Quad 1 and 2 wins (25 Q1, 19 Q2), one more than the AC (21 Q1, 22 Q2).
- The Big Ten ranks among the nation's best conferences on both sides of the hardwood. Offensively, 10 teams average north of 75.0 points per game, led by Iowa's Big Ten-best 87.1 points, which ranks sixth in the country, eight spots north of Purdue (85.0 points). Eight teams also rank in the top-70 in the country in field goal percentage, led by Purdue at 49.4 percent. Minnesota (48.2 percent), Indiana (48.0 percent), Michigan State (47.8), and Iowa (47.8) also rank in the nation's top 50. Much of that offensive efficiency stems from taking care of the ball, as five team lists in the top-25 in assists/turnover ratio. Iowa leads the nation with a 1.98 ratio, while Northwestern's 1.72 is good for eighth. Michigan State checks in at 13th (1.68), followed by Purdue (1.57) and Minnesota (1.55) in 18th and 25th.
- Defensively, the Big Ten boasts 10 teams that hold their opponents to below 70 points per game, led by Maryland, who surrenders just 63.5 points per outing, good for 20th nationally, followed by Rutgers, who ranks 27th, allowing just 64.3 points. Four Big Ten teams also rank in the nation's top 30 in field goal percentage defense. Illinois and Michigan State top the conference, holding their opponents to 39.0 percent shooting. 15th and 17th in the country, respectively. Rutgers ranks 22nd at 39.2 percent. The Scarlet Knights also rank 10th in the country with 5.8 blocked shots per contest, while Penn State forces a league-best 16.59 turnovers per game, 13th in the country.
- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks fifth in the country with 22.3 points per game, fifth in rebounds per game (10.9), eighth in field goal percentage (64.5 percent), and fourth in double-doubles (10), while his 168 free throw attempts and 125 free throw makes rank first and fourth in the NCAA. Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins leads the nation with 7.7 assists per contest, while Purdue's

Big Ten Conference

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Braden Smith (6.9) stands seventh. Ohio State's Jamison Battle's 46.8 three-point percentage ranks ninth, while two Big Ten players, Michigan State's Tre Holloman and Ohio State's Bruce Thornton sit first and third in the nation with 5.70 and 4.73 assist/turnover ratios. Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.38 blocked shots per game are good for second, while Penn State's Ace Baldwin Jr.'s 3.00 steals per game rank fourth.

- Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 in today's Kenpom rankings, including six in the top-20. Purdue leads the way at No. 3, followed by Illinois (#13), Wisconsin (#9), Michigan State (#16), Iowa (#43), Ohio State (#47), Nebraska (#49), and Northwestern (#54). The Big Ten leads the nation with 11 teams in the top-60, three more than the Big Ten and Big East, while the SEC has seven and ACC six.

- Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-55 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 3, followed by No. 10 Illinois, No. 14 Wisconsin, No. 17 Michigan State, No. 44 Ohio State, No. 50 Iowa, No. 51 Northwestern, and No. 55 Nebraska. Eleven Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-50 Remaining Strength of Schedule listing.

- More than 2.5 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including more than 1.6 million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-20 in total attendance, including five in the top 10. Indiana leads the Big Ten with 176,791 fans through 11 home games, one sport north of Nebraska (169,282), while Michigan State (162,767) and Illinois (161,019) sit fifth and sixth. Wisconsin rounds out the top-10 with 151,443 fans. In total, 13 Big Ten schools rank in the top 60 in total home attendance.

- The Big Ten closed its nonconference slate with a combined 117-37 record. The Big 12 (144-34), SEC (132-47), Atlantic 10 (131-60), and ACC (119-46) collected more wins, but the Big Ten's .760-win percentage falls behind only the Big 12 (.809). Among the B1G's 117 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents.

- For the sixth consecutive year, each Big Ten Conference member institution will compete in a 20-game conference schedule. The Big Ten Conference season begins Friday, Dec. 1, when Maryland visits Indiana and Northwestern hosts Purdue, the first of 12 conference games played between Dec. 1-10. Following a break in conference play, Big Ten action will resume on Jan. 2. During the conference season, schools will play seven teams twice -- once at home and once on the road and six teams once, with three of those games being at home and the other three away.

- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.

- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.

- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: The Illini lead the Big Ten in both total rebounds per game (43.2) and defensive rebounds per game (30.2), figures that are fifth and seventh in the NCAA, respectively. The Illini also rank second in the Big Ten in rebounding margin (+9.1), which is 15th nationally, and are fourth in offensive rebounds per game (13.0), 35th in the NCAA.

Indiana: The Hoosiers hold a record of 29-27 against Top-5 opponents in Bloomington, including a 4-1 mark against Purdue at Simon Skjoldt Assembly Hall. Rob Phinisee scored a team-high 20 points on 8-of-13 shooting off the bench, including the go-ahead 3-pointer with 17 seconds on the clock to defeat No. 4 Purdue 68-65 on Jan. 20, 2022. In last season's victory, Tayce Jackson-Davis totaled 25 points, seven rebounds, and five blocks in the Hoosiers' 79-74 win over then-No. 1 Purdue.

Iowa: Sophomore Josh Dix scored a career-high 21 points in the Hawkeyes' 86-77 win at Minnesota on Monday. The sophomore, who came into the game averaging just 5.7 points per game, became the sixth Hawkeye to score at least 20 points in a game this season. Iowa has also had five players record at least one double-double.

Maryland: Freshman DeShawn Harris-Smith has started every game for Maryland this year and, at 7.8 points per game, has been the program's top rookie scorer since the trio of Jalen Smith (11.7 ppg), Eric Ayala (8.6), and Aaron Wiggins (8.3) in 2018-19. Harris-Smith was the first true freshman to start a season-opener for the Terps since Jalen Smith and Aaron Wiggins both did so against Delaware in 2018.

Michigan: After pairing 20 points and six rebounds in Mondays win over Ohio State, Olivia Nkamhoua has scored in double figures and grabbed at least five rebounds in 11 consecutive games and 16 of 17 games this season. The graduate student ranks second on the Wolverines with 17.1 points and grabs team-high 7.5 rebounds per outing.

Michigan State: Tyson Walker scored 13 points in the Spartans' win over Rutgers, his 14th game in double figures this year and the 88th of his career. Dating back to last season, Walker has scored in double figures in 28-straight games.

Minnesota: Their 11 home victories are tied for the most of any Div. I entering this past Friday and mark their best start at Williams Arena since 2020-21 when they began the season 14-1. In the 12 home matches, they've scored at least 80 points 7 times, 97 or more 3 times and given up more than 70 only once. Most notably, they assist on nearly 73% of their made buckets at home – the top mark in Div. I.

Nebraska: The Huskers lead the Big Ten with 9.2 3-pointers per game as of Jan. 15. Nebraska has averaged more than 8.0 3-pointers/game just twice in program history (2001-02 and 2020-21). The Huskers are 8-1 this season when hitting at least 10 3-pointers.

Northwestern: Northwestern averages a Big Ten-best 9.4 turnovers per game, ninth in the country. The Cats also rank second in the Big Ten with a 1.78 assists/turnover ratio and +4.5 turnover margin, good for eighth and 12th in the nation, respectively.

Ohio State: Sophomore guard Bruce Thornton has started each of the first 51 games of his career. In research done by Adam Jardy of the Columbus Dispatch, Thornton is the first Buckeye to start each of the first 51 games of his career without missing a game since Michael Redd started all 96 games in his three-year career from 1998-2000.

Penn State: Penn State's defense has been its biggest predictor of success so far this season. The Nittany Lions have allowed 60.6 points per game in their eight wins, compared to 85.0 points per game in their nine losses. Penn State owns a +7.8 turnover margin and has held its opponents to a 38.3 FG% in its eight wins. The Nittany Lions have allowed their opponents to shoot 53.0% from the field in their nine losses, with a slim +3.0 turnover margin.

Purdue: Sophomore Braden Smith dished out a career-high 11 assists in the Boilermakers' win over Penn State, his third game this year of 10 or more assists, tied for the second most in the country. His three games of 10 or more assists are the most for a Purdue player since 1987 (Everette Stephens – 4).

Rutgers: After suffering a torn ACL last season, senior Mawout Mag returned to the floor on Dec. 9 and has found his footing over the Scarlet Knights' last four games. The senior is averaging 15.0 points on 41.7 percent shooting and 6.3 rebounds, while playing nearly 34 minutes per game over Rutgers' last four contests.

Wisconsin: The Badgers held Northwestern to 23-for-54 (42.6%) shooting from the field in Saturday's win, including no field goals for the final 4:16, outscoring the Wildcats 10-2 in that closing stretch. Northwestern's 42.6% percentage was the lowest the Badgers have allowed this season in Big Ten play.

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - b. If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

All-Big Ten awards, as determined by the coaches and media, will be announced on March 12, 2024. Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
