QUICK HITS

Penn State will face its Regular Season Co-Champions Indiana in the B1GT Championship for the sixth time in both team's history and third in the last three years.

Penn State clinched a share of the Big Ten regular season title on Sunday with a 1-1 draw at Wisconsin. This is the second time in three years the Nittany Lions claimed the regular season title.

Penn State owns the most Big Ten Player of the Week accolades with seven selections, including two sweeps.

Peter Mangione ranks first in the Big Ten in goals and 25th nationally. He has also scored a goal in six out of the last seven games.

Kris Shakes ranks eighth nationally in save percentage (.814) and is tied for 10th in shutouts (7). He's earned B1G Defensive Player of the Week honors three times this season.

Shakes moved into the top-three all-time at Penn State in career saves against Penn (9/8) and Peter Mangione moved into the top-15 all-time at PSU in goals against Michigan (10/22).



NOTES AND HEADLINES

PENN STATE ADVANCES TO BIG TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP

The Big Ten regular season co-champions, Penn State men's soccer will face off against the team it shares the title with, Indiana, in a battle for the tournament title. The Nittany Lions and Hoosiers will face off on Sunday, Nov. 12 in Bloomington, Ind. Kick off is set for noon and will be nationally televised on the Big Ten Network.

Penn State dominated Big Ten postseason awards with Peter Mangione as the Offensive Player of the Year, Femi Awodesu as Defensive Player of the Year, Kris Shakes as Goalkeeper of the Year and head coach Jeff Cook as Coach of the Year. The trio of major award winners also earned spots on first team All-Big Ten and Caden Grabfelder was named to the All-Freshman Team.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State and Ohio State endured a double overtime, penalty shootout thriller in the semifinals. After the score hung at 1-1 through regulation and two periods of overtime, the teams battled in a penalty shootout. Samson Kpardeh scored the goal during the first half.
- » Peter Mangione made the first shot followed by a Buckeyes goal.
- » Femi Awodesu scored the second and Kris Shakes made a stop between the pipes.
- » After Freddie Bell's shot was saved, Ohio State made one.
- » Matthew Henderson scored next followed by a Buckeyes goal.
- » Ben Liscum notched the fourth goal and Shakes made a game-winning save to advance his team to the Championship and make the penalty shootout score 4-3.
- »

NITTANY LIONS IN THE RANKS

- » Penn State ranks first in the Big Ten in goals scored with 33, six more than the next highest number. It also ranks first in points with 94.
- » Peter Mangione's ten goals is the most scored in the conference and sixth highest scored nationally.
- » Kris Shakes ranks 12th in the nation in save percentage (.808) and first in the conference. Shakes' seven shutouts are good for first in the conference and 14th in the nation.

LIONS' ACCOLADES

- » Penn State nearly swept major Big Ten Awards: Peter Mangione is the Offensive Player of the Year, Femi Awodesu is the Defensive Player of the Year, Kris Shakes is the Goalkeeper of the Year and head coach Jeff Cook is Coach of the Year.
- » The three "Of the Year" award winners also garnered first team All-Big Ten. Caden Grabfelder earned a spot on the All-Freshman Team. Sam Ovesen earned the Sportsmanship Award.
- » Peter Mangione earned his second Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week nod after two goals and one assist last week (10/24).
- » Kris Shakes earned the first Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week (8/29). In back-to-back weeks Shakes earned B1G Defensive Player of the Week again as well as NCAA Player of the Week (9/5).
- » Alex Stevenson rounded out a Penn State sweep of weekly awards in week two, winning Offensive Player of the Week for his goal against St. John's and his assist in the Nittany Lions'

goal against Syracuse (9/5).

- » Liam Butts was named Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week after his hat trick against Ohio State (9/19). He also earned a spot on the College Soccer News National Team of the Week.
- » Peter Mangione, Femi Awodesu and Kris Shakes were named Big Ten Players to Watch ahead of the 2023 campaign.
- » Mangione was also selected to the United Soccer Coaches Forwards to Watch List.

2023 PREVIEW

NO PLACE LIKE HAPPY VALLEY

- » Four Nittany Lions return home to use their fifth year of eligibility at Penn State; Kris Shakes, Liam Butts, Owen Elliott and Alex Stevenson.

2022 NEWCOMERS

- » Penn State welcomed ten incoming freshmen throughout the off season. Among the ten newcomers is no. 6 ranked Mohamed Cisset. He joins the rest of head coach Jeff Cook's recruiting class as the no. 10 ranked recruiting class in the country this year.
- » In addition to the new athletes, Cook added two new faces to his staff. Assistant Coach Sean Lawlor joins the Nittany Lions coaching staff after his four-year stint at the 2022 National Champions Syracuse. Oscar Umar, a Villanova graduate, came to Penn State this spring after spending two seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Washington University in St. Louis.

2023 CAPTAINS

- » Seniors Peter Mangione and Femi Awodesu were named the 2022 captains.

ALL ROADS LEAD TO PENN STATE

- » The 2023 Penn State men's soccer roster is the most diverse group of athletes the program has seen in its existence.
- » Seven countries across the world are represented in addition to America including: Argentina, Mali, Mexico, Kenya, England, Scotland and Sweden.

2023 MLS SuperDraft

- » Three Penn State men's soccer alumni were selected in the 2023 MLS SuperDraft.
- » Jalen Watson was drafted 32nd overall to Toronto FC, his home team and inked his contract in March.
- » Liam Butts was selected 33rd by the San Jose Earthquakes.
- » Andrew Privett was drafted 69th overall to Charlotte FC and signed his contract in March.
- » Privett saw major success playing for Charlotte's MLS Next Pro team and was called up to its first team in early summer. By July, he made his first start at the professional level and scored his first goal on August 3rd in a shootout win against Houston. Privett and the team advanced to the playoffs.

- » Penn State is 1-2-2 in Big Ten Tournament Championship games played against Indiana and 4-11-5 in Big Ten Tournament games with seven of those matches going into overtime and five being decided in penalty shootouts. The Hoosiers have advanced twice and won the Championship twice in PKs and Penn State advanced once in a shootout.
- » After getting off to a slow start in the early weeks of the 2023 campaign, the Hoosiers win over Penn State sparked a four-game winning streak including three conference games.
- » Indiana defeated Rutgers 4-1 in the final game of the regular season to earn a share of the regular season title with Penn State to match it in points with 14.
- » IU won a tight 2-1 match against Wisconsin in the quarterfinals and won a thriller of a semifinal game against Michigan. After leading by two goals, 3-1, the Wolverines came back to tie the score at 3-3. Indiana put a goal across while Michigan was down a man to earn a 4-3 win to send them to the Championship.
- » Due to their win over Penn State in the regular season, Indiana will host the Championship game on Sunday.
