HOME OPENER IN REVIEW

Last weekend, Penn State opened an 11-match homestand with a pair of victories to improve to 3-2 on the year. The Nittany Lions powered past No. 14 IPFW in straight sets, before rallying from behind by one set to defeat Ball State in four.

NITTANY LIONS IN THE AVCA COACHES POLL - WEEK FOUR UPDATE

Following a week without competition, PSU remains No. 12 in the latest AVCA DI-II Top 15 Poll. The Nittany Lions have now spent the last three weeks at the No. 12 position. Additionally, Penn State is the only EIVA team to be represented in the AVCA poll.

PENN STATE VS. MOUNT OLIVE

The Nittany Lions own a perfect 6-0 record in the all-time series against the Trojans. In the short six-match series between the two teams, Penn State has swept Mount Olive in each outing. The Trojans are also a fairly familiar opponent, having faced off against the Nittany Lions in the last three consecutive seasons.

SCOUTING THE TROJANS

Mount Olive enters the weekend looking to snap a four-match losing streak, having lost to Limestone and Erskine last weekend at home. Angel Dache is the center of the Trojan offensive, averaging 4.84 kills per set on .326 hitting. He's also averaging 0.37 blocks per set, which is tied for third on the team. Josh Donahue is anchoring the defense, averaging 2.53 digs per frame.

PENN STATE VS. SAINT FRANCIS

The Nittany Lions hold an unblemished 32-0 mark in the all-time series against the Red Flash. The series stretches back to 1995, when the two teams first met in the Hall of Fame Classic in Springfield, Mass. Penn State claimed a 3-0 win in the first outing. Within the last 10 years, the NIttany Lions have dropped just five sets to Saint Francis.

SCOUTING THE RED FLASH

Saint Francis dropped to an even 2-2 on the year after losing a close five-setter at Lees-Mcrae last weekend. Offensively, the Red Flash is led by Colin Sherwin, Kyle Beatty and Logan Patterson, who are all averaging at least two kills per set. Patterson is at the helm of the talented trio, hitting at .276, while also averaging 0.67 aces per set, which leads the squad.

RUSSELL EARNS EIVA OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK NOD

After helping the Penn State men's volleyball team to an undefeated opening weekend at home, junior Aaron Russell was named the EIVA Offensive Player of the Week.

In the season home opener against then-No. 14 IPFW, Russell registered his first double-double of the season, posting 12 kills and 10 digs in the victory. The next evening, Russell returned to the court to lead the Nittany Lions to a 3-1 comeback victory against Ball State. He led the offense with a season-high 21 kills, adding four digs and one block. Russell averaged 4.71 kills per set on the week, hitting higher than .425 in each match.

Penn State returns a core group of 11 letterwinners and five starters this year, while welcoming five freshmen to the roster. The new additions include 6-8 opposite Aiden Albrecht from Old Bridge, N.J., Joey Farrell, a 6-5 outside from Lombard, Ill., Kevin Gear, a 6-7 middle blocker from Rochester, N.Y., Chris Nugent, a 6-4 outside from Fair Lawn, N.J., and Jalen Penrose, a 6-7 outside from Cambridge, Mass.

PENN STATE VOTED EIVA PRESEASON FAVORITE

The defending EVIA champion Penn State men's volleyball team has been picked as the preseason favorite in the 2014 Eastern Intercollegiate Volleyball Association (EIVA) preseason poll. The Nittany Lions received seven of eight first-place votes from the league's eight head coaches. PSU also earned the No. 1 preseason EIVA ranking heading into the 2013 season. Princeton was picked to finish second in the league, earning one first-place vote, while Harvard and George Mason were slotted as the No. 3 and No. 4 schools, respectively. St. Francis, NJIT, Sacred Heart and Rutgers-Newark rounded out the remaining positions, claiming spots five through eight.

NITTANY LIONS PICKED 9TH IN PRESEASON POLL

Penn State was the only EIVA school to earn a spot on the 2014 AVCA DI-II Men's Volleyball Preseason Poll, coming in a No. 9. Despite not competing last week, the Nittany Lions dropped to No. 11 in the first poll of the 2014 season.

PSU TO HOST 2016 NCAA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

HOSACK AND RUSSELL SPEND TIME WITH TEAM U.S.A.


