• Penn State went 0-2-0 against the Colonials last season, dropping a 3-2 game in State College Dec. 15 before falling, 6-0, in the Three Rivers Classic Dec. 28.
• Forwards **Curtis Loik** and **Tommy Olczyk** scored one goal each against Robert Morris in 2012-13, while defenseman **Nate Jensen**, who played two games against RMU at Mercyhurst in addition to the two games last season, has notched three career assists vs. the Colonials.

BACK IN THE BURGH

• McKees Rocks, Pa., native **Matthew Skoff** is the lone Pittsburgh-area native on the squad. Skoff appeared in both games against the Colonials last season, going 0-1-0 with a 3.02 goals-against average and an .898 save percentage.

SCOUTING THE COLONIALS

- Robert Morris boasts the nation's 15th-ranked power play, connecting on 6-of-26 chances (.231).

- Junior Cody Wydo paces the team with three goals and is one of three Colonials with four points.

- Following the graduation of Eric Levine, sophomore Terry Shafer has assumed the starting goaltender role. The netminder has gone 0-4-1 on the season with a 4.17 goals-against average and an .888 save percentage.

TRIP ALONG THE ATLANTIC

- The Nittany Lions (1-2-1 vs. AHA teams) are opening the season with four straight games and six of their first seven contests against teams from Atlantic Hockey.

- Penn State, which previously played Army, Air Force and RIT to start the season, will face Sacred Heart (Nov. 8) and Robert Morris once again (Dec. 27) in 2013-14.

LAST TIME OUT

- Juniors **Taylor Holstrom** and **Tommy Olczyk** (SHG) gave the Nittany Lions a 2-0 lead, but Penn State surrendered five unanswered goals in a 5-2 loss vs. Vermont at Wells Fargo Center Oct. 26.

- Olczyk scored for the first time since netting a shorthanded marker against Michigan State Jan. 25, 2013.

NEWEST NCAA DIVISION I TEAMS

- Penn State (2012-13) and Robert Morris (2004-05) are the two most recent schools to add NCAA Division I hockey.

PENNSYLVANIA D-I HOCKEY

- The Nittany Lions and Colonials are two of the three (Mercyhurst) Pennsylvania schools that sponsor NCAA Division I hockey.

RICHARD LIGHTS THE LAMP

- Freshman **Dylan Richard** netted his first career goal with a highlight-reel tally in Penn State's 3-3 tie against RIT Oct. 25.

LIONS EARN FIRST DRAW

- Penn State skated to its first tie in the NCAA era with a 3-3 draw against RIT Oct. 25.

STEADY SKOFF

- Dating back to last season, goaltender **Matthew Skoff** is 7-3-1 in his last 11 games.

DeROSA MAKES IMPACT

- Freshman forward **Ricky DeRosa** tallied a goal in his first career game when he scored with 2:46 left in the third period in PSU's 3-1 loss to Air Force Oct. 19.

McADAM, WILLIAMSON MAKE PENN STATE DEBUTS

- Freshman goaltender **Eamon McAdam** and rookie defenseman **Mike Williamson** played in their first career games against Air Force Friday, Oct. 18. McAdam turned aside 27 shots in his collegiate debut.

BACK ON THE SCORESHEET

- With a goal against Air Force Oct. 18, **Luke Juha** reached the back of the net for the first time since scoring in a 5-1 win vs. the Falcons Nov. 10, 2012.
- Sophomore forward **Jonathan Milley**, who missed 18 games due to injury in 2012-13, recorded a helper for his first point since registering a three-point outing vs. Holy Cross Dec. 7, 2012.

LIONS OPEN PEGULA WITH WIN

- The Nittany Lions opened Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win over Army in front of a standing-room only crowd of 6,370.
- Four different Nittany Lions scored, including **David Goodwin** and **Eric Scheid**, who scored in their Penn State debuts.
- Sophomore **Matthew Skoff** made 25 saves.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS

- Redshirt junior defenseman **Nate Jensen** etched his name in the Pegula Ice Arena record books as the first player to score in the facility.
- Jensen's slapshot through traffic 3:02 into the first period gave the Nittany Lions the early 1-0 lead.

FRESHMEN SHINE

- Several freshmen shined in their Penn State debuts vs. Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- Forward **David Goodwin** led Penn State with a goal and an assist, while linemate **Zach Saar** tallied an assist.
- Forward **Dylan Richard** and defenseman **David Thompson** also logged significant minutes in the victory.

GETTING IT DONE EARLY

- In the team's first game, sophomore **Curtis Loik** tallied a shorthanded goal for Penn State, which only scored three shorthanded markers last season.
- The Nittany Lions scored their first shorthanded marker in their eighth

WELCOME HOME

- Penn State opened the 5,782-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

- The arena was brought to fruition through an \$88 million donation - the largest in University history - in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim.

- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

TIME TO GO BIG

- The Nittany Lions will begin competition in the Big Ten for the league's first season.

- Each team will play the other five schools four times - twice at home and twice on the road.

- The Big Ten championship will be held March 20-22, 2014 at the Xcel Energy Center in Saint Paul, Minn.

KEYSTONE STATE NATIVES

- Penn State boasts six Pennsylvania natives - the most from any state or province.

- Keystone state natives include: **Ricky DeRosa** (Aston), **Eamon McAdam** (Perkasie), **Matthew Skoff** (McKees Rocks), **Peter Sweetland** (Newtown), **David Thompson** (Glen Mills) and **Connor Varley** (Lansdale).

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

- Junior **Tommy Olczyk** will serve as team captain for the second straight year, while redshirt junior defenseman **Nate Jensen** (second year) and sophomore forward **David Glen** (first year) will serve as assistant captains.

EARNING SILVER

- Junior forward **Jacob Friedman** earned a silver medal with Team USA at the 19th Maccabiah Games in Metulla, Israel, in July.

- The Maccabiah Games are the third-largest international sporting event in the world.

- Approximately 9,000 Jewish athletes from 76 countries complete in the event.

EYES OF A NATION

- Penn State will appear on national TV at least 12 times (34 percent) during the 2013-14 season.
- The Nittany Lions will appear on the BTN at least seven times, the ESPN networks three times and NBC Sports Network twice.

TOUGH ROAD AHEAD

- Penn State will face six opponents, including three Big Ten foes, ranked in the preseason USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine and USCHO.com polls.

SCHEDULE BREAKDOWN

- The Nittany Lions will play at least 19 games against teams that have reached the NCAA Frozen Four since 2009.
- In all, Penn State will battle five teams that qualified for the 2013 NCAA tournament.

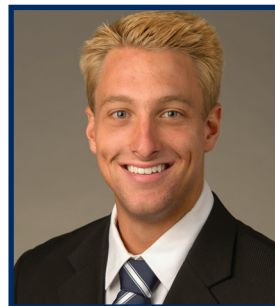
