NITTANY LIONS MAKE FIRST TRIP TO MARIUCCI

• Penn State will make its final road trip of the regular season when it visits Minnesota and Mariucci Arena for the first time Feb. 28-March 1.

LAST TIME VS. MINNESOTA

• Penn State fell to then-No. 1 Minnesota by 3-2 and 5-2 scores at Pegula Ice Arena Jan. 12-13, respectively. Sophomores **David Glen** and **Curtis Loik**, who collected his first career-multi-point game Jan. 13, led the Nittany Lions with a goal and an assist each in the series, while sophomore **Kenny Brooks** and junior **Taylor Holstrom** added one goal each.

• Freshman **Eamon McAdam** collected a combined 62 saves, including a career-high 42 stops Jan. 12, as he started both games against the Gophers.

• Penn State out shot Minnesota by a 38-25 margin Jan. 13 as the Gophers failed to out shoot a team for just the fourth time in 2013-14.

MINNESOTA NATIVES

• The Nittany Lions boast three Minnesota natives - **Max Gardiner** (Deephaven), **Nate Jensen** (Shorewood), **Eric Scheid** (Blaine) - on the 2013-14 roster.

SKATING THE GAUNTLET

- Penn State is facing some of the best teams in the nation during its second NCAA season.
- Based on the current USCHO.com rankings, the Nittany Lions have faced the Nos. 1, 2, 3, 7, 13 and 17 ranked teams in the country.

LIONS SPLIT WITH WOLVERINES

- Despite falling to then-No. 10 Michigan, 5-2, in the series finale Feb. 22, Penn State earned a season split with the Wolverines at 2-2-0.
- Backed by a 32-save shutout by **Matthew Skoff**, Penn State earned its first conference victory with a 4-0 win vs. Michigan at Pegula Ice Arena Feb. 8.
- The Nittany Lions then earned their first league road victory with a 5-4 overtime win at Michigan Feb. 21. Freshman forward **David Goodwin** netted the game-winning goal after **Casey Bailey** evened the score with five seconds remaining.
- With the road win, Penn State became the first Big Ten team to defeat the Wolverines both at home and on the road.
- Based on the current league standings, Penn State and Michigan would face each other in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

COUNTING THE WAYS

- In the Feb. 21 matchup against Michigan, Penn State netted even strength (twice), power-play, shorthanded and extra-attacker markers in the same game for the first time in program history.

FIGHTING 'TIL THE END

- Penn State twice erased two-goal deficits before defeating Michigan Feb. 21, matching the team's largest comeback in its two-year history.
- The Nittany Lions erased a two-goal deficit against then-No. 16 Wisconsin before edging the Badgers, 3-2, in overtime Feb. 25, 2013.

BAILEY AT HIS BEST

- Sophomore **Casey Bailey**, who recorded four points through the first 19 games of the season, has accumulated six points in the last seven games.
- The Anchorage, Alaska, native scored two goals against Michigan Feb. 21 for his first two-goal game since Dec. 29, 2012.

GOODWIN GROOVING

- Goodwin netted his first two-goal and third multi-point game of the season against Michigan Feb. 21.
- The Des Peres, Mo., native was named Big Ten Third Star of the Week after recording a three-point weekend (2g, 1a) vs. Michigan.

PLAYING THEM TIGHT

- The Nittany Lions have played in 12 one-goal games (4-8-0) in 2013-14, tying sixth in the country.
- Clarkson leads the nation with 20 one-goal games.

SHORTHANDED SUCCESS

- The Nittany Lions have scored five shorthanded goals - the most by a Big Ten team - in 2013-14.

SCHEID SURGING

- Forward **Eric Scheid** is tied for fifth in the conference in goals (11) and power-play goals (4).

FRESHMAN SUCCESS

- **David Goodwin** is tied for sixth in the league among rookies in points (7-8--15), while **Ricky DeRosa** (5-12-7) is tied for 10th.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

- Penn State underclassmen have accounted for more than 76 percent of the team's offense.

SACRIFICING THE BODY

- Junior defenseman **Patrick Koudys** is fourth in the Big Ten with 58 blocked shots.

JOINING THE FUN

- Twenty-one players on the 26-man roster have notched at least one point during the 2013-14 season.

IN THE CIRCLE

- Sophomore **David Glen** ranks sixth in the Big Ten with a .574 winning percentage in the faceoff circle.
- **David Goodwin** ranks 10th (.559), while **Taylor Holstrom** is 11th (.552).

PACKING PEGULA

- Nittany Lions fans have packed Pegula Ice Arena during the facility's inaugural season, filling the 5,782-seat arena with an average of 6,049 fans per game.
- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 13 of 14 home games, with the Dec. 1 matchup against Union the lone exception.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 10 occasions.

JUHA AMONG NATION'S BEST

- Sophomore defenseman **Luke Juha** is tied for 11th among NCAA blueliners with four power-play goals.
- His four extra-man markers lead Big Ten defensemen while his eight power-play points place him third.
- The Mississauga, Ont., native's 14 total points place him in a tie for sixth among Big Ten defensemen.

SKOFF STANDS TALL

- Sophomore goaltender **Matthew Skoff** earned Big Ten Second Star of the Week honors after his shutout performance against Michigan Feb. 8. The McKees Rocks, Pa., native became the first Nittany Lion honoree this season.

DÉJÀ VU

- Including his shutout against Michigan Feb. 8, all three of **Matthew Skoff's** career shutouts have come in 4-0 victories.
- Skoff has led Penn State to shutout wins against Fredonia State (Dec. 11, 2012), Alabama Huntsville (Feb. 8, 2013) and Michigan (Feb. 8, 2014).
- The netminder's last two whitewashes came exactly one year apart.

GLEN BACK IN THE LINEUP

- Sophomore **David Glen**, who returned to the lineup Feb. 7 after missing three games, scored in Penn State's 4-0 win vs. Michigan.
- The forward missed the games after undergoing a bone marrow donation procedure.

GLEN'S MATCH MEANS SECOND CHANCE FOR SOMEONE ELSE

- On Jan. 28, sophomore forward **David Glen** concluded a five-day bone marrow donation procedure after learning he was a match through Be The Match, a National Marrow Donation Program.
- The assistant captain participated in the Be The Match-facilitated Match4Kim Drive, which was held in support of Penn State men's lacrosse player's Drew Roper's mother, on campus November 2012. Glen does not know the identity of who will receive the donation.
- According to Be The Match, the five-day peripheral blood stem cell (PBSC) donation is a non-surgical

procedure and is one of two methods of collecting blood-forming cells for bone marrow transplants. A 7-10 day timetable is typical for recovery for most PBSC donors and mild bone pain can result due to the excessive stem cell crowding within the bone marrow.

- Glen missed the Nittany Lions' games against Boston College (Jan. 25) and Ohio State (Jan. 31, Feb. 1) for the procedure and recovery.

FIRING AT WILL

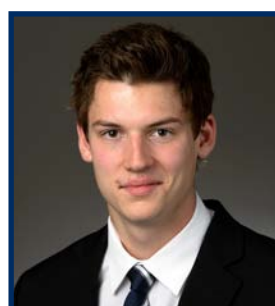
