**Penn State was the only Big Ten team to earn a win on the opening day of conference competition on Friday, Sept. 15.**

**Liam Butts scored a hat trick for the first time in his career and the first of a Nittany Lion since Peter Mangione scored three goals against Villanova in 2021.**

**Kris Shakes earned his second clean sheet of the season and 18th of his career with his season high six saves against the Buckeyes**

**Head coach Jeff Cook is one win away from 50 wins at Penn State in his sixth season.**

**Kris Shakes moved into the top-three all-time at Penn State in career saves in the game against Penn with 230 career saves on Sept. 8.**

**The highest attendance record at Jeffrey Field since 2014 was seen on Friday, Sept. 1 against Syracuse.**



## NOTES AND HEADLINES

### PENN STATE HOSTS MARYLAND FOR MACK BRADY MATCH

The Penn State men's soccer team is set to host Maryland in not only the team's Big Ten opener but their 11th annual Mack Brady match as well. The Nittany Lions look to add their eighth win and seventh in a row in their Mack Brady Match record.

The Nittany Lions help celebrate the life, legacy, and love for soccer, specifically goalkeeping, of one of their biggest fans, Mack Brady. At age eight, Brady passed away on Dec. 31, 2012, following an unexpected blood infection. To honor his life and love for soccer, Mack's parents, Christian and Elizabeth, created the "Mack Brady Memorial Soccer Fund." The fund is an endowment for Penn State goalkeepers to assist with recruiting, equipment and other needs.

### LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State opened Big Ten competition with a 3-0 victory over Ohio State on Friday, Sept. 15 in Columbus..
- » With the win, the Nittany Lions moved to a 19-12-2 record in conference openers with six consecutive wins.
- » Butts owns all three Penn State goals, with all being unassisted and two coming off rebounds.
- » His hat trick was the first of a Penn State player since Peter Mangione scored three goals against Villanova in 2021.
- » Shakes earned his second shutout of the season and 18th of his career,

### NITTANY LIONS IN THE RANKS

- » Penn State was the only team in the Big Ten to earn a win on opening day on Friday, Sept. 15.
- » Butts' hat trick is the second in the conference this season and first in a Big Ten match.
- » Shakes sits at the top of the Big Ten in saves with 27.
- » Butts is one of 23 players across the country to have scored a hat trick so far this season.

### 2023 PREVIEW

#### NO PLACE LIKE HAPPY VALLEY

- » Four Nittany Lions return home to use their fifth year of eligibility at Penn State.
- » Starting goalkeeper Kris Shakes makes his return for a final season with eyes from the Big Ten on him as he was named a Preseason Player to Watch.
- » 2023 MLS SuperDraft pick Liam Butts made the decision to return for a fifth season in Happy Valley while pursuing a second undergraduate degree. Butts is a major component of the Nittany Lions offense and brings strength and speed to the attack.
- » Alex Stevenson, a key to the Nittany Lions in both the defense and midfield, joins the blue & white one last time while he completes a second undergraduate degree.
- » Owen Elliott will graduate this fall while playing a fifth season at Penn State. The keeper brings experience and leadership to the program as a veteran player.

### 2022 NEWCOMERS

- » Penn State welcomed ten incoming freshmen throughout the off season. Among the ten newcomers is no. 6 ranked

Mohamed Cisset. He joins the rest of head coach Jeff Cook's recruiting class as the no. 10 ranked recruiting class in the country this year.

- » In addition to the new athletes, Cook added two new faces to his staff. Assistant Coach Sean Lawlor joins the Nittany Lions coaching staff after his four-year stint at the 2022 National Champions Syracuse. Oscar Umar, a Villanova graduate, came to Penn State this spring after spending two seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Washington University in St. Louis.

### 2023 CAPTAINS

- » Seniors Peter Mangione and Femi Awodesu were named the 2022 captains.

### ALL ROADS LEAD TO PENN STATE

- » The 2023 Penn State men's soccer roster is the most diverse group of athletes the program has seen in its existence.
- » Seven countries across the world are represented in addition to America including: Argentina, Mali, Mexico, Kenya, England, Scotland and Sweden.

### 2022 IN REVIEW

- » The Nittany Lions finished the 2022 campaign ranked fifth in the Big Ten with an overall record of 6-4-4 and a conference record of 3-2-3.
- » Penn State earned ranked wins against no. 18 West Virginia and no. 15 Akron on Senior Day.
- » Six Nittany Lions received Big Ten postseason honors. Mangione and Kuhn earned first team All-Big Ten, Awodesu and Butts earned second team and Liscum and Henderson landed on the All-Freshman team.
- » Mangione (second team), Kuhn (third team) and Awodesu (third team) garnered All-North Region as well.
- » Mangione led the team in goals with eight and points with 18 for the second time in his career as a Nittany Lion.

### 2023 MLS SuperDraft

- » Three Penn State men's soccer alumni were selected in the 2023 MLS SuperDraft.
- » Jalen Watson was drafted 32nd overall to Toronto FC, his home team and inked his contract in March.
- » Liam Butts was selected 33rd by the San Jose Earthquakes.
- » Andrew Privett was drafted 69th overall to Charlotte FC and signed his contract in March.
- » Privett saw major success playing for Charlotte's MLS Next Pro team and was called up to its first team in early summer. By July, he made his first start at the professional level and scored his first goal on August 3rd in a shootout win against Houston. Privett and the team advanced to the playoffs.

## SCOUTING MARYLAND

- » Maryland tied Wisconsin in its Big Ten opener on Thursday, Sept. 14. The final score was 2-2.
- » The Terrapins are 1-2-2 with only one win over UNCG earlier this season.
- » In 2022, Maryland won the Big Ten regular season title and fell to Indiana in the semifinals. The Terrapins made a run in the NCAA Tournament, falling to Cornell in the second round.
- » Five different Maryland players are responsible for the team's five goals this season. Kimani Stewart-Baynes leads the team in points with five using one goal and three assists.
