## OPENING TIP-OFF

- Columbia tied a program record with 16 3-pointers made en route to an 87-77 victory at Longwood Tuesday night.
- Quinton Adlesh posted a career-high 23 points, Mike Smith added 22 while Lukas Meisner grabbed 16 boards to go with 12 points against the Lancers
- Penn State improved to 3-0 after a 70-57 win over Montana Wednesday evening. Sophomore Lamar Stevens had 25 points, seven rebounds and two steals in the triumph.
- Columbia and Penn State are meeting for the first time since the 1993 season and ninth time overall. The all-time series is tied at 4-4.
- The Lions are in the midst of a seven-game road swing to start the 2017-18 campaign.

## PENN STATE'S STATUS

The Nittany Lions wrap up a four-game homestand Friday night when they welcome Columbia to the Bryce Jordan Center. Penn State has won its games by an average of 16 points. Tony Carr is averaging a team-best 20.0 points to go with 5.3 assists and has knocked down 22-of-24 from the charity stripe. The Lions will have to watch out for the hands of Josh Reaves, who has compiled seven steals in three games.

### COLUMBIA VS. THE BIG TEN

The Lions are 30-34 all-time against teams currently in the Big 10. Columbia's most common opponent is Rutgers, who they hold a 26-21 record against, including their last win against a Big Ten foe, an 85-75 win on the road on Dec. 2, 1976. The Lions most recently played against the conference on Nov. 20, 2015, an 83-80 overtime defeat at Northwestern.

### AVENUE Q

In his first career start, Quinton Adlesh dropped a career-high 23 points, going 9-of-14 from the floor and 5-of-9 from 3-point range at Longwood.

### LUKAS LEGEND

Lukas Meisner notched his second career double-double at Longwood, notching 12 points and 16 rebounds. The rebound total was the most for a Lion since Mark Cisco '13CC pulled down 20 rebounds against Cornell on Jan. 21, 2012. Meisner is the early Ivy League leader in rebounds, pulling down 8.5 per contest.

### JAKE THE SNAKE

Sophomore Jake Killingsworth came off the bench in the second half and buried a trio of key 3-pointers in just eight minutes to help the Lions hang on to beat Longwood. His first shot brought Columbia's lead from two to five with 9:38 on the clock and his final treys extended the lead from four to seven.

### FIRST-YEAR IMPRESSIONS

Head coach Jim Engles had no problem showing off a talented class of first-years at Villanova Friday. Tai Bibbs, Jaron Faulds, Myles Hanson and Gabe Stefanini all played more than 10 minutes and found their way onto the scoresheet against the No. 6 team in the nation. Faulds registered seven points on 3-of-4 shooting. He and Hanson each logged 19 minutes of action off the bench.

### SUPER SOPHOMORE

After a summer training with NBA All-Star Jimmy Butler, sophomore point guard Mike Smith has started off 2017-18 strong, averaging 20.5 points through the first two games of the year - good for third in the Ivy League. Smith will look to build on a stellar rookie season where he scored 368 points, a Columbia record for a first-year. Smith started every game in 2016-17 and scored in double-figures in 19 of 27 games on his way to averaging 13.6 points per contest. He was named Ivy League Rookie of the Week on January 16 and led all Ivy League freshmen, dishing out 3.5 assists per game.

### AGENT "O" OUT AGAIN

After missing all of the 2016-17 campaign due to a toe injury, guard Kyle Castlin returned at Villanova, netting 10 points, six rebounds and dishing out four assists at Villanova. However, his comeback was stalled due to an elbow injury that occurred in the final two minutes. He is considered week-to-week. The Marietta, Georgia, native has started 43 career games and averaged 10.3 points per game as a first-year to lead all Ivy League rookies in 2014-15.

### BAIN ELEVATED TO ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

Jean Bain was elevated to associate head coach in July 2017. Bain served in the same capacity at Dartmouth from 2012-16. Bain, a 2002 graduate of Northeastern, works with Columbia's perimeter players and serves as the program's recruiting coordinator. He is also responsible for scouting opponents and player development.

### COACHING STAFF IVY LEAGUE "EDUCATED"

In addition to head coach Jim Engles and Bain, assistant coach Jesse Agel is also familiar with the Ivy League. Agel served as the head coach at Brown from 2008-12.

### CJ DAVIS OUT FOR SEASON

Junior guard CJ Davis will miss the entire 2017-18 campaign while recovering from a back injury. Davis remains enrolled at Columbia.

### LIONS PICKED FIFTH IN PRESEASON IVY LEAGUE POLL

The Lions were predicted to finish fifth in the preseason Ivy League poll, conducted by selected members of the media. Columbia received 55 voting points. All four teams that qualified for the inaugural Ivy League Tournament were selected in the top-four in 2017-18. Harvard edged out Yale as the early favorites, with the Crimson receiving 121 points and six first-place votes. The Bulldogs garnered more first-place votes (8), but finished three points behind Harvard overall. Defending Ancient Eight Champions Princeton was selected third, while Penn was tabbed fourth.

Each home game and the full Ivy League regular season slate will also be available via the Ivy League Network.

The Ivy League network is the multimedia home for all things Columbia men's basketball. Live games, highlights, and on-demand content can be viewed at [ivyleague.tv/columbia](http://ivyleague.tv/columbia) for computer, mobile and tablet devices. ILN is available on Apple TV and Roku and a mobile app is available in the App Store of Google Play.

Pricing starts as low as \$9.95 for a one-day pass, and subscription options include monthly, 4-month and annual packages, both single-school and league-wide.

Lance Medow is the men's basketball play-by-play announcer. Since 2006, he's called games in various sports for both Columbia and the Ivy League including baseball, football, soccer and women's basketball. Medow performs a variety of on-air work for several sports and media organizations. He hosts various shows on Sirius XM's numerous sports channels including Mad Dog Sports Radio, NFL Radio, NBA Radio and Bleacher Report Radio and has also called play-by-play of the McDonald's All-American Game High School Boys Basketball Game for SiriusXM. In addition to his work on satellite radio, since 2013, Medow serves as the Pre/Half/Post Game Host on the WFAN Giants Radio Network.

## GOLDEN ANNIVERSARY

The 2017-18 season marks the 50th Anniversary of Columbia's Ivy League Championship Squad. Under the direction of head coach Jack Rohan, Lions posted an overall record of 23-5 overall and 12-2 in Ivy League play, clinching the NCAA auto-bid by defeating Princeton, 92-74, in a playoff game. Columbia defeated La Salle before falling to Davidson, 61-59, in the East Region Semifinal. Future NBA standout Jim McMillian averaged 22.3 points and 9.8 rebounds to lead the Lions.

**JIM ENGLS**  
 HEAD COACH • SECOND SEASON

2015 Metropolitan and Mid-Major Coach of the Year Jim Engles became the 23rd head coach in the 116-year history of its men's basketball program in April 2016.

In 2016-17, the Lions won Engles' Columbia debut at Stony Brook, becoming the first non-conference opponent to defeat the Seawolves at Island Federal Credit Union Arena.

Several players also enjoyed breakout seasons under the direction of Engles. Senior forward Luke Petrasek '17CC garnered second team All-Ivy League and third team All-Met honors after averaging 15.1 points. First-year point guard Mike Smith set a Columbia rookie scoring record with 368 points and Nate Hickman started all 27 games, averaging 11.8 points, and earning Ivy League Player of the Week honors on November 28.

Engles returned to Columbia after spending eight years as head coach for the New Jersey Institute of Technology. Over his final six seasons at NJIT, Engles compiled a 100-88 record, including back-to-back 20-win seasons in 2014-15 and 2016-17. Prior to leading the Highlanders, Engles served as an assistant coach at Columbia under former head coach Joe Jones from 2003 to 2008.

NJIT had competed at the Division I level for only two seasons when Engles arrived in 2008, and in three years he turned them into a 15-win program. In 2014-15, he directed the Highlanders to a 21-12 record, including an upset at No. 16 Michigan and a postseason berth, advancing to the semifinals of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT).

At the conclusion of the 2014-15 season, Engles was named John McLendon National Coach of the Year honors from CollegeInsider.com, received the Peter A. Carlesimo Division I co-Coach of the Year from the Metropolitan Writers Association and was a finalist for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year and Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year awards.

In 2015-16, Engles once again led the Highlanders to the semifinals of the CIT, where they faced the eventual champions, Columbia, at Levien Gym last week. His team also finished tied for second place in the America Sun Conference in its first year in the league.

In addition to the tremendous success over the past two years, Engles won a Great West regular season championship and was selected the Great West Conference Coach of the Year in 2012-13. In 2010-11, he picked up a vote for AP National Coach of the Year after NJIT posted a 15-15 record.

The success of Engles' Highlanders squads culminated with NJIT committing to build a new \$100 million Wellness and Events Center and receiving an invitation to join the Atlantic Sun Conference after spending two years without any conference affiliation.

In his first stint with the Lions, Engles helped Joe Jones turn around the Columbia program from a last-place finish in The Ivy League, into a consistent competitor in non-conference and league play, including the first .500 finish in league play since 1992-93.

Prior to joining Columbia as an assistant in 2003, Engles spent the previous six seasons at Rider University, where he was the top assistant coach for the Broncs under Don Harnum, as well as their recruiting coordinator. Rider's basketball program enjoyed great success with Engles on staff, including winning the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference regular-season title during the 2001-02 season and making the school's first appearance in the postseason NIT in 1998.

Before joining Rider, Engles spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at Wagner College. He assisted Tim Capstraw in guiding the Seahawks to the best winning-percentage turnaround in Division I basketball, going from four wins in 1991-92 to 16 in 1992-93. Wagner also recorded the most Division I wins in school history during that time, and competed against Rider for the Northeast Conference Championship in 1993 on national television.

A Staten Island native, from St. Peter's High School, Engles played college basketball for Dickinson College, where he was a three-year letterwinner. He helped lead the Red Devils to the second-most single-season victories in school history at the time during the 1989-90 season. After graduating from Dickinson in 1990 with a B.A. in political science, he earned his M.B.A. from Wagner College in 1997.

His grandfather, Ken Engles, was a player and coach at Georgetown University, while his uncle, John Engles, was a high school All-American who went on to play at Penn under the direction of Hall of Fame coach Chuck Daly.
