## LEADING OFF

- Penn State welcomes Northwestern for a three-game Big Ten series at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park.
- The Nittany Lions and Wildcats meet for the first time in Happy Valley since 2018.
- The teams last played in 2022 with Northwestern winning the series.
- Penn State looks to bounce back after falling in all three games at Illinois.
- The Nittany Lions had 24 runs, 36 hits and eight homers over the three games against the Illini.
- J.T. Marr brings a Big Ten-best .437 average into Friday's contest.
- Marr also paces the Big Ten in hits per game (1.8) and ranks third in total hits (45), while ranking 13th in OPS (1.061).
- Marr has 14 multi-hit games, including each of the last five contests.
- Adam Cecere launched two homers last weekend at Illinois and paces PSU with seven this season to go with a team-best 27 runs and 26 walks. He is second in the conference with a 1.180 OPS.
- Bobby Marsh leads PSU with a .391 average in Big Ten play.

**The Marr-Chine Keeps Hitting**

- Grad student J.T. Marr is off to an incredible start to begin the 2024 campaign.
- Marr's season average sits at .437 with a team-best 45 hits and 26 RBI.
- Marr leads the Big Ten with his .437 average, while ranking 16th in the country.
- He also ranks seventh in the nation, and first in the Big Ten, averaging 1.8 hits per game.
- Marr holds 25th in the country, and third in the conference, with 45 total hits.
- Marr tallied two hits in each game against Illinois and has two hits in each of the last five games, including a pair of hits against Michigan (3/24) and Pitt (3/26).
- He owns 14 multi-hit games and seven multi-RBI games.
- On the year, Marr has two games with four hits and four games with three hits.
- Among his 45 knocks, he has six doubles and three homers to go with 24 runs and a 1.061 OPS, good for 13th in the Big Ten.

**Newcomers Leading Balanced Lineup**

- The Nittany Lions sit among the Top 5 in the Big Ten in sac flies (19; 2nd), batting average (.298; 4th), on-base percentage (.405; 5th), runs per game (7.6; 5th) and OPS (.856; 5th).
- Penn State has four players with a .300 or better average, five with a .400+ on-base percentage and eight with a .400+ slugging percentage.
- Seven Nittany Lions have at least 21 hits and nine Nittany Lions have at least 11 RBI.
- Penn State, Indiana and Iowa are the only Big Ten teams with five players owning at least 20 RBI.
- Graduate student J.T. Marr paces the squad with a .437 average and 45 hits. He owns six doubles, three homers, 26 RBI and 24 runs.
- With a 9-of-23 start (.391) at the plate in conference play, Bobby Marsh is hitting .321 with 27 hits, including five doubles, one homer, 17 RBI and 17 runs.
- Junior Matt Maloney is batting .313 with 25 RBI along with six doubles and a homer.
- Graduate student Adam Cecere is hitting .329 with 27 hits, including six doubles and a team-high seven homers, 20 RBI and a team-best 27 runs. He has a team-high 26 walks and eight hit-by-pitches.
- He is hitting .360 in Big Ten play with two homers and five RBI.
- The Pennsylvania native hit two homers on March 15 against UMass Lowell, his sixth career multi-homer game, and launched a three-run homer at Illinois (3/30).
- Cecere paces the team with a .659 slugging percentage and a .521 on-base percentage.
- He ranks second in Big Ten with a 1.180 OPS, fifth in slugging percentage (.659) and second in on-base percentage (.521). He's also third in the conference in total walks (26) and walks per game (1.04).
- Cecere is one of 21 current Division I players with 39+ homers and 136+ RBI in their career.
- Among active DI players, Cecere is 24th in homers (39).
- Joe Jaconski is fifth in the Big Ten in walks (22) and owns 26 hits and 21 runs, while Grant Norris has 24 hits, including five doubles and five homers, and 21 RBI.
- Bryce Molinaro owns three homers, among 28 hits, and 20 RBI. In Big Ten play, Molinaro has hitting .381 (8-of-21) with one double and one homer.

**Illinois Series Recap**

- Penn State dropped all three games of the series at Illinois.
- The Nittany Lions took leads into the seventh on Friday, sixth in Saturday's first game and fifth in Saturday's second game.
- In three games, Penn State combined for 24 runs, 36 hits, seven doubles and eight homers.
- Adam Cecere (.500), Kevin Michaels (.500), J.T. Marr (.462), Bryce Molinaro (.400), Bobby Marsh (.385), Matt Maloney (.333) and Joe Jaconski (.308) all hit above .300 in the series.
- On Friday, PSU launched four homers with Cecere, Marr, Marsh and Norris each going yard. Cecere, Marr and Jaconski each had two hits, while Marr, Marsh, Molinaro and Norris all drove in two runs.
- In Saturday's first game, Marr, Michaels and Molinaro all homered with Marr adding an RBI double.
- In Saturday's second game, Cecere recorded three hits, including a three-run homer, and a career high-tying four RBI. Marsh and Maloney each had three hits with Marsh driving in two runs.

**Hannon, Kelley, Norris Climb Records Lists**

- Senior Kyle Hannon already has 10 steals in 2024, including four in the series vs. Harvard.
- With 10 steals this year, Hannon has moved up to fourth all-time at Penn State with 44 career steals. He is currently six steals behind Doug Keener (50, 1984-87) for third place.
- Hannon ranks seventh in the Big Ten in total steals (10) and steals per game (0.42).
- Senior+ Tayven Kelley owns 12 career triples, tied third all-time at Penn State. He is tied with Michael Campo (1997-00) and Jordan Steranka (2009-12).
- Graduate student Grant Norris' .515 career slugging percentage sits seventh all-time at Penn State.

**Dollar Dog Night Returns**

- Penn State's Dollar Dog Nights became popular in 2023 and have returned with strong numbers in 2024.
- Tuesday's contest against Lehigh will be the Nittany Lions' third Dollar Dog Night of the 2024 campaign.
- The first Dollar Dog Night of the year, on March 19 against St. Bonaventure, featured 880 fans consuming 2,010 hot dogs.
- On March 26 against Pitt, the Nittany Lions welcomed 3,505 fans to Medlar Field at Lubrano Park, Penn State baseball's third-largest attendance and largest midweek attendance.
- The 3,505 fans downed 5,021 hot dogs.
- The Dollar Dog Night record stands at 5,287 consumed against West Virginia (4/11/23).
- Across seven Dollar Dog Nights in 2023 and 2024, Penn State fans have consumed 20,435 hot dogs, averaging 2,919 per Dollar Dog Night.

**THE OPPOSITION**

**Scouting Northwestern**

- Northwestern is playing its first season under Ben Greenspan, who was named head coach on August 18, 2023.
- Greenspan served as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Michigan in 2023.
- Before his time in Ann Arbor, Greenspan spent time on the staffs at Cal Poly (2022), Arizona State (2015-21) and Indiana (2009-14).
- The Wildcats are 10-15 overall and 0-3 in Big Ten play after falling in three games against Nebraska last weekend.
- Northwestern ranks 13th in the Big Ten with a .255 team average and six runs per game.
- Owen McElfatrick paces the team with 36 hits, 10 doubles and four homers to go with a .350 average and 19 RBI.
- Bennett Markinson is also hitting .350 while owning 35 hits and 20 RBI.
- Jackson Freeman has a .302 average, four homers and 19 RBI.
- On the mound, Northwestern has a 6.54 team ERA, sitting ninth in the conference.
- Nolan Morr is fourth in the Big Ten with a 5.17 strikeout-to-walk ratio and has 31 strikeouts in 36 innings.
- Northwestern paces the Big Ten with a .977 fielding percentage.

**Against The Wildcats**

- Penn State is 45-44 all-time against Northwestern.
- In the last series, Penn State took one of three games, all with tight results.
- Northwestern will make its first time to Happy Valley since April 28-29, 2018.

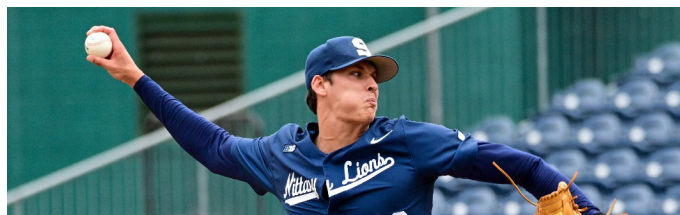

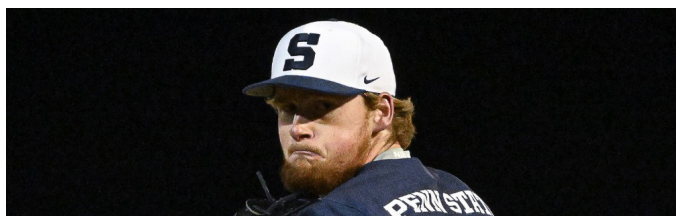

**Head Coach**

Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino takes over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect Game.

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the D1Baseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting pitcher.

Gambino's pitching staff ranked 26th in the country in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.54) and 26th in walks allowed per nine innings (3.58). Boston College held fifth in the country, and led the ACC, with a .982 fielding percentage.

The 2022 MLB Draft saw four of Gambino's student-athletes be chosen, led by second baseman Luke Gold, who was selected in the fifth round by the Detroit Tigers. Pitchers Mason Pelio (Reds - 12th round), Joe Mancini (Astros - 15th round) and Max Gieg (Angels - 18th round) were also chosen in the draft.

In 2021, an impressive three players were selected in the first six rounds of the MLB Draft headlined by outfielder Sal Frelick, who was the 15th overall pick by the Milwaukee Brewers. Shortstop Cody Morissette was picked in the second round by the Miami Marlins and pitcher Emmet Sheehan was selected in the sixth round by the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Gambino led BC to a 31-27 record in 2019 and the Eagles reached the ACC semifinals as the 12th seed with wins over Clemson and top-seeded Louisville. A program-record five Eagles earned All-ACC, led by All-ACC first team pitcher Dan Metzdorf, who was a fifth-round pick for the Chicago White Sox and led the ACC with a 2.30 ERA. Jake Alu (Nationals - 24th round) and Matt Gill (Reds - 27th round) were also chosen during the 2019 MLB Draft.

In 2018, outfielder Chris Galland earned All-ACC third team accolades and Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-America honors. The 2018 MLB Draft had four of Gambino's players selected with Jake Palomaki (Rays - 18th round), Jacob Stevens (Diamondbacks - 21st round), Brian Rapp (Twins - 26th round) and Dan Metzdorf (Yankees - 38th round).

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship Tournament for the first time since 2010. BC won 10 of its last 15 ACC games with sweeps over Notre Dame and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005 and third-highest total in program history. They also tallied 13 ACC wins, the most since 2010, while their six conference series victories set a school record. Gambino led the Eagles to a sweep in the Oxford Regional as the third seed to advance to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. BC finished the season in the Top 25 of all four major polls for the first time in program history (15th - D1Baseball, 16th - Baseball America, NCBWA and 21st - USA Today/Coaches Poll).

For his efforts, Gambino was named the 2016 American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year, a finalist for D1Baseball Coach of the Year and earned a spot on the website's top-10 coaching performances of the season.

Gambino proteges were selected in the first round of the MLB Draft in back-to-back years for the first time in program history in 2015 and 2016. Chris Shaw was selected 31st overall by the San Francisco Giants in 2015 and Justin Dunn was taken 19th overall by the New York Mets in 2016. Overall, five players were drafted in 2016: Dunn, Michael King (12th round), Jesse Adams (14th round), Nick Sciortino (19th round) and Joe Cronin (34th round).

Gambino was an assistant coach for four seasons at Virginia Tech prior to his move to Boston College. He served as the Hokies' recruiting coordinator and worked with the hitters and infielders. In his four years, he saw 15 players get drafted in the MLB Draft, including nine in 2010.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny and Callahan.
