TONIGHT'S GAME

- The Nittany Lions return to Big Ten action with a weekend series against Ohio State. Penn State will meet the Buckeyes for the third and fourth times in program history after the teams faced off in the 2012 Three Rivers Classic consolation game.

GLEN'S MATCH MEANS SECOND CHANCE FOR SOMEONE ELSE

- On Tuesday, sophomore forward **David Glen** concluded a five-day bone marrow donation procedure after learning he was a match through Be The Match, a National Marrow Donation Program.
- The assistant captain participated in the Be The Match-facilitated Match4Kim Drive, which was held in support of Penn State men's lacrosse player's Drew Roper's mother, on campus November 2012. Glen does not know the identity of who will receive the donation. The Ropers are Columbus natives.
- According to Be The Match, the five-day peripheral blood stem cell (PBSC) donation is a non-surgical procedure and is one of two methods of collecting blood-forming cells for bone marrow transplants. A 7-10 day timetable is typical for recovery for most PBSC donors and mild bone pain can result due to the excessive stem cell crowding within the bone marrow.
- Glen, who missed the Nittany Lions' game against Boston College due to the procedure, will not play against Ohio State (Jan. 31, Feb. 1) as he recovers.

LAST TIME VS. OHIO STATE

• Forward **Casey Bailey** recorded a career-high four points (2g, 2a) as Penn State edged Ohio State, 5-4, in the Three Rivers Classic consolation game Dec. 29, 2012.

• Three additional Nittany Lions - **Max Gardiner** (3a), **Taylor Holstrom** (2g), **Luke Juha** (2a) - collected multi-point games.

• Ohio State out shot Penn State, 40-37, but went 0-for-2 on the power play. The Nittany Lions finished 1-for-2.

• The matchup was Penn State's first against a future Big Ten opponent.

FIRING AT WILL

• Penn State's 27 second-period shots against Robert Morris Dec. 27 were the most attempts in a period in program history. The team's 62 total shots ranked second, trailing the 63 attempts against AIC in the Nittany Lions' first NCAA game Oct. 12, 2012.

• The 79 total shots fired against Michigan State Jan. 17-18 were the most this year against any opponent during a two-game stretch.

• PSU out shot No. 1 Minnesota by a 38-25 margin Monday, Jan. 13 as the Gophers failed to out shoot a team for just the fourth time in 2013-14.

• Penn State out shot their second straight ranked opponent Jan. 25 vs. No. 2 Boston College (35-30).

JUHA AMONG NATION'S BEST

• Sophomore defenseman **Luke Juha** is tied for sixth among NCAA blueliners with four power-play goals.

• His four extra-man markers lead Big Ten defensemen while his eight power-play points place him second.

• The Mississauga, Ont., native's 13 points place him fourth among Big Ten defensemen.

SHORTHANDED SUCCESS

• The Nittany Lions have scored four shorthanded goals - the most by a Big Ten team - in 2013-14.

LEADING THE WAY

• Redshirt sophomore **Eric Scheid** (10-5--15), sophomore **Luke Juha** (4-9--13) and freshman **David Goodwin** (4-6--10) lead the Nittany Lions with double-digit points.

• Scheid and Juha are among seven Nittany Lions who have appeared in all 20 games.

CAREER YEARS

• Several Nittany Lions have posted or are close to posting career years.

• Defenseman **Luke Juha** (4-9--13) and forward **Tommy Olczyk** (4-3--7) have posted career highs in goals, assists and points.

- **David Goodwin** is tied for sixth among league rookies with 10 points.

- Penn State underclassmen have accounted for more than 75 percent of the team's offense.
- The Nittany Lions' top three scorers are either freshmen or sophomores, with redshirt sophomore **Eric Scheid** leading the way with 15 points (10g, 5a).

SACRIFICING THE BODY

- Junior defenseman **Patrick Koudys** ranks third in the the Big Ten with 45 blocked shots.

JOINING THE FUN

- Twenty players on the 26-man roster have notched at least one point during the 2013-14 season.

IN THE CIRCLE

- Redshirt junior **Taylor Holstrom** ranks fifth in the conference with a .584 faceoff winning percentage.
- Sophomore **David Glen** is 10th with a .554 percentage.

STAYING OUT OF THE BOX

- Penn State, which earlier in the season ranked second in the NCAA with more than 20 penalty minutes per game, stayed out of the box for the first time in its 45-game NCAA history vs. Michigan State Jan. 17.

LOIK SETS PERSONAL FIRST

- With a goal and an assist against Minnesota Monday, Jan. 13, sophomore forward **Curtis Loik** notched his first career multi-point game.

PACKING PEGULA

- Nittany Lions fans have packed Pegula Ice Arena during the facility's inaugural season, filling the 5,782-seat arena with an average of 6,020 fans per game. Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in nine of 10 home games, with the Dec. 1 matchup against Union the lone exception.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on six occasions, including the season opener against Army (6,370) and the Nittany Lions' last home game against No. 2 Boston College (6,214).

BEST TEAMS IN HOCKEY VALLEY

- Penn State's game vs. Boston College was its seventh home game of the season against a ranked team. Including their matchup against the Eagles, the Nittany Lions last three home contests were against the No. 1 and No. 2 ranked teams in the country.

SKATING THE GAUNTLET

- Penn State is facing some of the best teams in the nation during its second NCAA season.
- The Jan. 25 matchup against Boston College Jan. 25 marked the Nittany Lions' 10th game against a ranked opponent in a 13-game span.

LIONS PLAY FIRST B1G SERIES

- Penn State dropped both of its games to then-No. 17 Wisconsin in its first Big Ten series, falling 7-1 Friday, Dec. 6 before dropping a 4-3 game Dec. 7.

- In the finale, freshmen **Ricky DeRosa** (1g, 1a) and **Zach Saar** (1g, 1a) notched their first multi-point games.

- The Nittany Lions, who took a 1-0 following **Eric Scheid's** marker, twice erased one-goal deficits before allowing the game-winning goal with 8:08 left in the third.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- In league action, each Big Ten team will play 20 league games, including 10 home contests.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a shootout win and one point for a shootout loss.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only BCS conference to sponsor men's hockey.
- The league tournament will take place at Saint Paul's Xcel Energy Center March 20-22 with the tournament champion earning the league's automatic big to the NCAA tournament.

BACK OF THE NET

- With seven goals against Union Nov. 30-Dec. 1, Penn State scored its most goals in a series since netting eight markers against Alabama Huntsville Feb. 8-9, 2013.

RICHARD LIGHTS THE LAMP

- Freshman **Dylan Richard** netted his first career goal in Penn State's 3-3 tie against RIT Oct. 25.

LIONS EARN FIRST DRAW

- Penn State skated to its first tie in the NCAA era with a 3-3 draw against RIT Oct. 25.

DeROSA MAKES IMPACT

- Freshman forward **Ricky DeRosa** tallied a goal in his first career game when he scored with 2:46 left in the third period in PSU's 3-1 loss to Air Force Oct. 19.

McADAM, WILLIAMSON DEBUT

- Freshman goaltender **Eamon McAdam** and rookie defenseman **Mike Williamson** played in their first career games against Air Force Friday, Oct. 18. McAdam turned

LIONS OPEN PEGULA WITH WIN

- The Nittany Lions opened Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win over Army in front of a standing-room only crowd of 6,370.

- Four different Nittany Lions scored, including **David Goodwin** and **Eric Scheid**, who scored in their Penn State debuts.

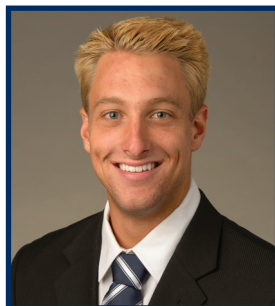
