LEADING OFF

- Penn State hosts St. Bonaventure for a midweek contest on Tuesday.
- The Nittany Lions are playing their fourth game of an eight-game homestand.
- The blue and white is 32-6-1 all-time against St. Bonaventure and has won seven of the last eight meetings.
- Penn State is coming off a series win over UMass Lowell.
- On Thursday, PSU earned a 3-2 win behind six strong innings by Travis Luensmann and a solo homer by Billy Gerlott.
- On Saturday, the Nittany Lions overcame a 9-run deficit after the Top 1st and posted their own 9-run inning in the eighth to claim a 21-14 win.
- J.T. Marr leads the Big Ten with a .465 average, ranking 11th in the country, while sitting fourth in the nation in hits per game (1.94) and 20th in total hits (33).
- Marr had three hits in Thursday's game and four hits in Saturday's game and now has nine multi-hit games this season.
- Adam Cecere launched two homers in Friday's game against UML and now has five this season to raise his career total to 37 homers.

The Marr-Chine Keeps Hitting

- Grad student J.T. Marr is off to an incredible start to begin the 2024 campaign.
- After going 8-of-14 at the plate in the series against UMass Lowell, Marr raised his season average to .465 with a team-best 33 hits.
- Marr leads the Big Ten with his .465 average, while ranking 11th in the country.
- He also ranks fourth in the nation, and second in the Big Ten, averaging 1.94 hits per game.
- Marr holds 20th in the country, and fourth in the conference, with 33 total hits.
- This past weekend, he had three hits on Thursday and four hits on Saturday, raising his season total to nine multi-hit games. He also has four multi-RBI games.
- On the year, Marr has two games with four hits and four games with three hits.
- Among his 33 knocks, he has three doubles and a homer to go with 16 RBI and 16 runs.

Newcomers Leading Balanced Lineup

- The Nittany Lions sit among the Top 5 in the Big Ten in batting average (.303; 4th), runs per game (7.9; 4th), home runs per game (1.12; 5th), slugging percentage (.463; 5th) and OPS (.875: 5th).
- Penn State has five players with a .302 or better average, six with a .400+ on-base percentage and seven with a .400+ slugging percentage.
- Graduate student J.T. Marr paces the squad with a .465 average and 33 hits. He owns three doubles, a homer, 16 RBI and 16 runs.
- Redshirt junior Billy Gerlott is hitting .344 with four doubles, a homer, three RBI and 13 runs.
- Junior Matt Maloney is batting .341 with a team-high 18 RBI along with three doubles and a homer.
- Maloney leads the Big Ten in RBI per game (1.38).
- Bobby Marsh is hitting .340 with 18 hits, including three doubles, nine RBI and nine runs.
- Graduate student Adam Cecere is hitting .302 with 16 hits, including four doubles and a team-high five homers, 15 RBI and 20 runs. He has a team-high 18 walks and seven hit-by-pitches.
- He hit two homers in Saturday's game against UMass Lowell, his sixth career multihomer game.
- Cecere paces the team with a .660 slugging percentage and a .519 on-base percentage.
- He ranks fifth in Big Ten with a 1.179 OPS and slugging percentage (.660) and third in on-base percentage (.519). He's also tied-first in the conference in total walks (18) and first in walks per game (1.06).
- Cecere is one of 16 current Division I players with 37+ homers and 131+ RBI in their career.
- Among active DI players, Cecere is 17th in homers (37).
- Joe Jaconski is fifth in the Big Ten in walks (16) and owns 15 hits and 12 runs, while Grant Norris has 15 hits, including five doubles and four homers, and 14 RBI.
- Bryce Molinaro owns two homers, among 18 hits, and 14 RBI, while Kyle Hannon has 14 hits, one homer and 14 runs.

Nittany Lions Earns Series Win Over UMass Lowell

- Penn State picked up a 3-2 win on Thursday and a 21-14 win on Saturday to claim a series victory over the River Hawks.
- In the series, PSU batted .352 with 33 runs, 37 hits, eight doubles and five homers.
- J.T. Marr led the Nittany Lions with a .571 average (8-of-14) with three RBI and six runs, including three hits in game one and four knocks in game three.
- Adam Cecere launched two homers to go with four RBI and four runs, while Billy Gerlott had a double, a homer and three RBI. Grant Norris added a double and a homer.
- In game one, Matt Maloney had a two-run double and Gerlott homered, while Travis Luensmann fired six innings, allowing one run.
- In game three, PSU overcame a 9-run deficit in the first inning and put together a 9-run eighth inning to take the lead. Marr and Bobby Marsh each had four hits and three RBI, while Marr scored four times. Bryce Molinaro added three hits, an RBI and four runs.

Hannon, Kelley, Norris Climb Records Lists

- · Senior Kyle Hannon already has nine steals in 2024, including four in the series vs. Harvard.
- With 10 steals this year, Hannon has moved up to fourth all-time at Penn State with 44 career steals. He is currently six steals behind Doug Keener (50, 1984-87) for third place.
- Hannon ranks second in the Big Ten in total steals (10) and steals per game (0.62).
- Senior+ Tayven Kelley owns 12 career triples, tied third all-time at Penn State. He is tied with Michael Campo (1997-00) and Jordan Steranka (2009-12).
- Graduate student Grant Norris' .534 career slugging percentage sits seventh all-time at Penn State.

Luensmann Posts Back-To-Back Solid Starts

- · Senior Travis Luensmann picked up his second win of the season on Thursday against UMass Lowell.
- Luensmann fired six innings, giving up one run on two hits, while striking out five.
- He did not allow a run until a solo homer in the sixth.
- Luensmann has thrown six innings in back-to-back starts, including a six-inning, two-run outing against Harvard on March 8.
- He has 16 strikeouts in five starts and is allowing a .177 opponent average.
- Frankie Sanchez returned to the mound against UMass Lowell and has a 1.93 ERA over three appearances (two starts) with 11 strikeouts in 9.1 innings.
- Anthony Steele is 2-0 with a 3.14 ERA and 15 strikeouts in eight appearances.
- David Lee earned his third save of the season on Thursday and ranks fourth in the Big Ten in saves.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting St. Bonaventure

- Head Coach Jason Rathbun is in his second season leading the St. Bonaventure program.
- The Bonnies have 15 wins over the last two seasons.
- In 2024, they are 7-11 with wins over The Citadel, Louisville, Presbyterian, MTSU and Mount St. Mary's (3).
- The Bonnies are batting .267 as a team and averaging 6.6 runs per game.
- · Antonio Cordeiro leads the squad with a .320 average to go with four doubles, three homers and 15 RBI.
- Adam Rankie has a .317 average with eight doubles, two triples, a homer and 16 RBI.
- Jack Putney leads the team with five homers to go with 15 RBI.
- The St. Bonaventure pitching staff has an 8.05 team ERA and allows a .330 opponent batting average.
- Tristan Ciampa leads the team with seven appearances (three starts).

Against The Bonnies

- Penn State is 32-6-1 all-time against St. Bonaventure.
- The Nittany Lions have won seven of the last eight games in the series.
- Penn State earned a 3-2 win in 10 innings in 2022 on a walk-off single by Jay Harry.
- The PSU pitching staff tallied 13 strikeouts in the 2022 game.



PAGE 22 | PENN STATE VS. ST. BONAVENTURE HEAD COACH MIKE GAMBINO



Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino takes over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect Game.

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the D1Baseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting pitcher.

Gambino's pitching staff ranked 26th in the country in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.54) and 26th in walks allowed per nine innings (3.58). Boston College held fifth in the country, and led the ACC, with a .982 fielding percentage.

The 2022 MLB Draft saw four of Gambino's student-athletes be chosen, led by second baseman Luke Gold, who was selected in the fifth round by the Detroit Tigers. Pitchers Mason Pelio (Reds – 12th round), Joe Mancini (Astros – 15th round) and Max Gieg (Angels – 18th round) were also chosen in the draft.

In 2021, an impressive three players were selected in the first six rounds of the MLB Draft headlined by outfielder Sal Frelick, who was the 15th overall pick by the Milwaukee Brewers. Shortstop Cody Morissette was picked in the second round by the Miami Marlins and pitcher Emmet Sheehan was selected in the sixth round by the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Gambino led BC to a 31-27 record in 2019 and the Eagles reached the ACC semifinals as the 12th seed with wins over Clemson and top-seeded Louisville. A program-record five Eagles earned All-ACC, led by All-ACC first team pitcher Dan Metzdorf, who was a fifth-round pick for the Chicago White Sox and led the ACC with a 2.30 ERA. Jake Alu (Nationals - 24th round) and Matt Gill (Reds - 27th round) were also chosen during the 2019 MLB Draft.

In 2018, outfielder Chris Galland earned All-ACC third team accolades and Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-America honors. The 2018 MLB Draft had four of Gambino's players selected with Jake Palomaki (Rays – 18th round), Jacob Stevens (Diamondbacks - 21st round), Brian Rapp (Twins - 26th round) and Dan Metzdorf (Yankees - 38th round).

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship Tournament for the first time since 2010. BC won 10 of its last 15 ACC games with sweeps over Notre Dame and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005 and third-highest total in program history. They also tallied 13 ACC wins, the most since 2010, while their six conference series victories set a school record. Gambino led the Eagles to a sweep in the Oxford Regional as the third seed to advance to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. BC finished the season in the Top 25 of all four major polls for the first time in program history (15th – D1Baseball, 16th – Baseball America, NCBWA and 21st – USA Today/Coaches Poll).

For his efforts, Gambino was named the 2016 American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year, a finalist for D1Baseball Coach of the Year and earned a spot on the website's top-10 coaching performances of the season.

Gambino proteges were selected in the first round of the MLB Draft in back-to-back years for the first time in program history in 2015 and 2016. Chris Shaw was selected 31st overall by the San Francisco Giants in 2015 and Justin Dunn was taken 19th overall by the New York Mets in 2016. Overall, five players were drafted in 2016: Dunn, Michael King (12th round), Jesse Adams (14th round), Nick Sciortino (19th round) and Joe Cronin (34th round).

Gambino was an assistant coach for four seasons at Virginia Tech prior to his move to Boston College. He served as the Hokies' recruiting coordinator and worked with the hitters and infielders. In his four years, he saw 15 players get drafted in the MLB Draft, including nine in 2010.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny and Callahan.
