**Nittany Lions Host Purdue in Big Ten Home Opener:** The Penn State baseball team will host its first Big Ten series of the season, taking on conference foe Purdue this weekend. The Nittany Lions enter with a 5-15 mark after falling 10-8 to Pittsburgh on Wednesday, while the Boilermakers sit at 7-14 after dropping three games to Ohio State last weekend. Both squads are looking for their first Big Ten wins of the season.

**Last Time Out:** Penn State opened the 2013 home season against the Panthers, falling 10-8 in a back-and-forth offensive match. The Lions outhit the opposition 10-9, posting a .278 team batting average to trump Pitt's team average of .250. Freshman **James Coates** led the squad at the plate, going 2-for-3 and collecting two hits, two RBIs and a run scored. The rookie has now posted five multiple-hit games and sits with 11 runs, 17 hits and nine RBIs. Leading the Lions with a .364 batting average, redshirt senior **Elliot Searer** went 2-for-4 and drove in two runs with one run scored. Redshirt junior **Steve Snyder** also batted .500, and now sits with a team-best 24 hits and 12 runs following his performance against Pittsburgh. Sophomore **Taylor Skerpon**, batting .328, and sophomore **J.C. Coban** each posted an RBI in the contest to lead the squad with 11 a piece, while senior **Luis Montesinos** earned the 50th RBI of his career against the Panthers.

**Lion Rotation:** Redshirt sophomore **T.J. Jann** is expected to make the start on Friday after recently taking on Indiana in Penn State's Big Ten opener. Jann struck out a career-best four batters in a career-high 6.2 innings, and currently holds a 5.19 ERA. Making his sixth start of the season on Saturday, senior **Steven Hill** is 1-4 on the season, despite not allowing an earned run in two of the four losses. The veteran improved to a 3.48 ERA following the 2-0 loss to the Hoosiers and has allowed 36 hits and 13 earned runs in 33.2 innings. Hill leads the team with 26 strikeouts. Junior **Greg Welsh**, who currently holds a 3.68 ERA, will close out the series on Sunday. Welsh has fired 7.1 innings in two appearances, allowing seven hits and three earned runs while striking out four.

**Scouting the Boilers:** Purdue was most recently swept in its Big Ten opening weekend, falling 10-1, 8-3 and 7-0 to Ohio State. The Boilermakers are led by **Jake Hansen**, who holds a .361 batting average and has scored a team-best 10 runs. **Sean McHugh** leads the squad with 23 hits and 12 RBIs, while **Conner Hudnall** has hit two home runs. Hansen, Hudnall, McHugh and **Josh Estell** have combined for 79 hits, 29 RBIs and 29 runs this season. Left-handed pitcher **Jordan Minch** will face off against Jann on Friday, currently holding a 6.30 ERA and a 2-3 record. Minch has pitched 30.0 innings, allowing 34 hits and 21 earned runs while striking out a team-best 27. Making the start on Saturday, **Robert Ramer** sits with a 4.82 ERA after allowing 52 hits and 20 earned runs. The redshirt senior has struck out 21 and walked just four in 37.1 innings. **Brad Schreiber** is expected to make the start on Sunday, holding a 5.52 ERA in six appearances.

**All-Time Series:** Purdue holds the advantage in the all-time series with a 38-27 record against Penn State. The Lions won the most recent contest in the 18-year rivalry, topping the Boilermakers 16-6 on April 1, 2012 at Purdue. The Boilers have won the last eight of 10 contests, while Penn State holds a 15-14 advantage on home turf.

**Up Next:** Penn State will travel to Kent State on Wednesday, April 3 before returning home to host Wright State for a weekend series. Action will kick off between the Lions and the Raiders on Friday, April 5 at 6:05 p.m. at Medlar Field.

**AS A SOPHOMORE IN 2012:** Redshirt season.

**AS A FRESHMAN IN 2011:** Appeared in one game before being shut down with an injury during the first week of the season ... Made his collegiate debut against Notre Dame during the Big East/Big Ten Challenge on February 20 ... Fired 1.2 innings and did not allow a hit to the Fighting Irish.

**HIGH SCHOOL:** Excelled as a member of the Westford Academy baseball team ... Led the Grey Ghosts to the Massachusetts Division I State Tournament for three straight seasons while capturing the school's first Dual County League Title in 18 years in 2009 ... Earned first team DCL All-Star status as a pitcher and infielder ... Selected to the first team Eastern Massachusetts squad as chosen by the Lowell Sun ... Also served as a captain ... Received MVP honors after batting .388 with three home runs, 28 RBI and 31 runs scored as a senior ... Also finished with a 4-0 mark and a 0.87 ERA while averaging 1.6 strikeouts-per-nine-innings on the mound ... Competed for the Northeast Mudhens and led the squad to a top-50 national ranking and the Final 16 of the WWBA 18u Championships ... **AS A JUNIOR IN 2012:** Appeared in 15 games, starting each with nine Big Ten appearances ... Fired a total of 100.2 innings during the 2012 season, the sixth-highest single-season total in program history ... Posted a 3.84 ERA ... Made season debut against Cincinnati on Feb. 19, throwing six innings with five strikeouts and three earned runs ... Recorded his first win of the season at Purdue on April 1, striking out three batters and allowing just three earned runs in 6.2 innings ... Pitched his first complete game of the season, and the fifth of his career, on April 8 against Canisius ... Threw 122 pitches, striking out eight with just seven hits and three earned runs for the win over the Golden Griffins ... Earned his second consecutive and third overall win against Michigan on April 15, striking out four batters while walking one and allowing three earned runs ... Pitched the game of his career on April 21 against Iowa, where he threw the first Penn State no-hitter since 1995 ... Struck out three batters and walked just one to earn the no-hitter ... Named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week on April 23 and NCBWA National Co-Pitcher of the Week on April 24 ... Recorded his final win of the season on May 5 against Minnesota, striking out seven while holding the Gophers without an earned run ... Struck out three in the final game of the season against Nebraska on May 24 ... Posted ten starts in 2012 of pitching at least six innings while giving up no more than three earned runs.

**AS A SOPHOMORE IN 2011:** Pieced together a breakout sophomore campaign, earning second-team All-Big Ten honors while receiving the Charles Medlar Award as Penn State's top pitcher ... Surrendered just 12 walks during the season and ranked 17th in the nation with a 1.06 walks-per-nine-innings rate ... Finished the year with a 2.08 ERA in conference action, which was the lowest in the league ... Anchored the starting rotation throughout the year, starting 15 games while leading all conference pitchers with a 2.57 ERA ... Fired 101.2 innings, which led the squad and ranked second in the Big Ten ... Tossed at least six innings in 12 starts, including a league-high four complete games ... Opened the year with a season-high eight strikeouts while scattering five hits over 7.2 innings of work against West Virginia during the Big East/Big Ten Challenge on Feb. 19 ... Limited N.C. State to six hits in 6.2 innings of work while posting five strikeouts on March 5 ... Tossed his first complete game of the season and earned the victory after striking out five while allowing just one unearned run during the second game of a doubleheader against Norfolk State on March 19 ... Continued his hot streak with 7.1 innings of work against No. 26 Wichita State, which earned him his second straight victory ... Picked up another win after surrendering just five hits and two runs while striking out seven during a complete game effort against Le Moyne on March 26 ... Tossed his first shutout of the season after blanking Northwestern during a 12-0 victory in Evanston ... Limited the Wildcats to seven hits while striking out two without allowing a walk ... Fired at least six innings in each of his next three starts, highlighted by an eight-inning effort against Michigan State on April 29 ...
