
LEADING OFF

- Penn State travels to Davidson to begin its Spring Break week with a four-game series against the Wildcats.
- The Nittany Lions and Wildcats will meet for the first time in school history.
- Penn State is 88-42-1 all-time against current members of the Atlantic 10.
- The Nittany Lions are receiving votes in the NCBWA Poll.
- The Blue and White is coming off a series win at Stanford last weekend.
- Penn State earned a 15-4 win over the Cardinal on Friday and a 13-2 victory, in seven innings, on Saturday.
- Adam Cecere and Grant Norris both batted .500 on the weekend, with Norris
 contributing two homers and six RBI and Cecere collecting a homer and five RBI.
 Bryce Molinaro added five hits, two homers and drove in five runs.
- On the season, Cecere is batting .412 with a Big Ten-best 1.549 OPS.
- Matt Maloney leads the team with a .467 average and 12 RBI, while J.T. Marr has a .455 average with a team-best 15 hits.
- The Nittany Lions lead the Big Ten with a .439 team on-base percentage.



Nittany Lions Show Off Power, Patience At Stanford

- Penn State averaged 11 runs, 10.3 hits and 9.3 walks per game in the series at Stanford.
- The Nittany Lions displayed their power at the plate with four doubles, a triple and six homers among 31 hits.
- Bryce Molinaro and Grant Norris each launched two homers, while Adam Cecere and Joe Jaconski each hit one.
- Cecere and Norris each posted a .500 average. Cecere drew four walks and was hit by four pitches, while Norris worked four walks. Jaconski walked six times out of the leadoff spot.
- In Friday's 15-4 win, Penn State collected 13 hits and 17 walks. Five Nittany Lions reached base at least four times and eight Nittany Lion reached at least twice. Seven PSU players recorded at least one RBI.
- The 17 walks are Penn State's most in a game since at least 2004 and are the fourth-most in Division I this season.
- Penn State plated 13 runs on 11 hits on Saturday.
- The Nittany Lions' wins marked the first time Stanford lost back-to-back home games by 10+ runs to the same opponent since at least 1959 and was the first time Stanford lost back-to-back games by 10+ runs since its 2012 Super Regional at Florida State.
- With Friday and Saturday's wins, Penn State won back-to-back games by a 10+ run margin for the first time since April 30-May 1, 2010 against Michigan State (18-7, 22-5). The Nittany Lions also won by a 10+ run margin in back-to-back road games for the first time since March 29-30, 2003 at Purdue (13-3, 14-4).
- Including a 12-4 win against Army on February 18, Penn State scored 12+ runs in threestraight games for the first time since April 4-7, 2000 (13 vs. Cornell, 12 vs. Cornell, 19 at Michigan State).
- The Nittany Lions scored 12+ runs in three-straight non-home games for the first time since March 23-25, 1986 (21 at Towson, 13 at Gettysburg, 12 at Gettysburg).

Newcomers Leading Balanced Lineup

- As a team, Penn State leads the Big Ten in on-base percentage (.439) and sac flies (5).
- The Nittany Lions rank second in the conference in walks (44), while sitting third in OPS (.917), batting average (.307), home runs (10), home runs per game (1.43), total runs (58), runs per game (8.3) and slugging percentage (.481).
- Penn State has five players with a .333 or better average, five with a .500+ on-base percentage and five with a .500+ slugging percentage.
- Junior Matt Maloney leads the Nittany Lions with a .467 average and 12 RBI to go with seven hits, a homer and five runs.
- Maloney paces the Big Ten in RBI, ranking 48th nationally.
- Graduate student J.T. Marr is batting .455 with a team-high 15 hits along with four RBI and six runs.
- Marr ranks third in the Big Ten (21st nationally) with 15 hits, second in hits per game (2.14) and fifth in batting average (.455).
- Graduate student Adam Cecere is hitting .412 with an .833 slugging percentage and a .667 on-base percentage with two doubles, two homers and seven RBI.
- Cecere leads the Big Ten in OPS (1.549; 43rd nationally), on-base percentage (.667; 13th), hit-by-pitches (6) and walks per game (1.29), while holding second in total walks (9) and third in slugging percentage (.882).
- Cecere is one of 15 current Division I players with 34+ homers and 123+ RBI in their career.
- Among active DI players, Cecere is 16th in homers (34) and 46th in RBI (123).
- Joe Jaconski is hitting .381 with a homer and four RBI, while Bobby Marsh is hitting .333.
- Jaconski is third in the Big Ten in walks (8), walks per game (1.14) and on-base percentage (.567).
- Tayven Kelley, Bryce Molinaro and Grant Norris each have two homers, while Molinaro has eight RBI and Norris has seven.
- Kyle Hannon is tied for the Big Ten lead with one triple.

Hannon, Kelley, Norris Climb Records Lists

- Senior Kyle Hannon already has three steals in 2024, all coming against Monmouth.
- With three steals this year, Hannon has moved up to a tie for sixth all-time at Penn State with 37 career steals. He is currently tied with Dave Hall (1990-94).
- Hannon ranked second in the Big Ten in steals per game (0.55) and total steals (27) last season.
- The Harrisburg native is one of 14 Division I players, and the only Big Ten player, returning for the 2024 season who posted 7+ homers and 27+ steals last season.
- Senior+ Tayven Kelley owns 11 career triples, tied fifth all-time at Penn State. He is one triple away from tying third place.
- Graduate student Grant Norris' .539 career slugging percentage sits seventh all-time at Penn State.

Henline, Luensmann Post Solid Starts On Mound Against Stanford

- Penn State's veteran arms in the rotation helped to win Friday and Saturday games at Stanford.
- On Friday, Travis Luensmann tossed five innings, allowing two runs, to earn his first win of the season.
- · Jaden Henline followed on Saturday, in his season debut, throwing four innings, giving up two runs, to pick up a win in a seven-inning game.
- On the season, Luensmann has a 3.27 ERA and is allowing a .184 opponent batting average in 11 innings over two starts.
- Frankie Sanchez is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA in seven innings over two starts.
- · In the bullpen, Anthony Steele is 1-0 and has not allowed a run on 6.2 innings, while striking out eight.
- David Lee is also 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 4.1 innings over three appearances.
- Matt Morash has a 1.69 ERA in 5.1 innings over two appearances.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Davidson

- Davidson is led by head coach Rucker Taylor in his sixth season.
- The Wildcats are 145-91 under Taylor, who has the third-most wins in program history.
- Taylor was the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year in 2022.
- The Wildcats are 3-5 this season.
- As a team, Davidson is batting .248 and averaging 5.25 runs per game.
- Michael O'Shaughnessy leads the squad with a .429 average, 12 hits, eight runs, two homers and 12 RBI.
- Eli Putnam is batting .385 with two homers and six RBI.
- On the mound, the Wildcats have an 11.18 ERA and allow a .306 opponent batting average.
- In two starts, Cooper Cavanaugh has a 2.89 ERA and 16 strikeouts in 9.1 innings.
- Wilson Perkins owns 13 strikeouts in eight innings over two starts.

Against The Wildcats

- Penn State and Davidson are meeting for the first time in school history.
- The Nittany Lions have an 88-42-1 all-time record against current members of the Atlantic 10.
- Penn State's last meeting against an Atlantic 10 opponent was a 3-2 win over St. Bonaventure on March 30, 2022.

PAGE 22 | PENN STATE VS. DAVIDSON HEAD COACH MIKE GAMBINO



Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino takes over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect Game.

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the D1Baseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting pitcher.

Gambino's pitching staff ranked 26th in the country in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.54) and 26th in walks allowed per nine innings (3.58). Boston College held fifth in the country, and led the ACC, with a .982 fielding percentage.

The 2022 MLB Draft saw four of Gambino's student-athletes be chosen, led by second baseman Luke Gold, who was selected in the fifth round by the Detroit Tigers. Pitchers Mason Pelio (Reds – 12th round), Joe Mancini (Astros – 15th round) and Max Gieg (Angels – 18th round) were also chosen in the draft.

In 2021, an impressive three players were selected in the first six rounds of the MLB Draft headlined by outfielder Sal Frelick, who was the 15th overall pick by the Milwaukee Brewers. Shortstop Cody Morissette was picked in the second round by the Miami Marlins and pitcher Emmet Sheehan was selected in the sixth round by the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Gambino led BC to a 31-27 record in 2019 and the Eagles reached the ACC semifinals as the 12th seed with wins over Clemson and top-seeded Louisville. A program-record five Eagles earned All-ACC, led by All-ACC first team pitcher Dan Metzdorf, who was a fifth-round pick for the Chicago White Sox and led the ACC with a 2.30 ERA. Jake Alu (Nationals - 24th round) and Matt Gill (Reds - 27th round) were also chosen during the 2019 MLB Draft.

In 2018, outfielder Chris Galland earned All-ACC third team accolades and Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-America honors. The 2018 MLB Draft had four of Gambino's players selected with Jake Palomaki (Rays – 18th round), Jacob Stevens (Diamondbacks - 21st round), Brian Rapp (Twins - 26th round) and Dan Metzdorf (Yankees - 38th round).

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship Tournament for the first time since 2010. BC won 10 of its last 15 ACC games with sweeps over Notre Dame and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005 and third-highest total in program history. They also tallied 13 ACC wins, the most since 2010, while their six conference series victories set a school record. Gambino led the Eagles to a sweep in the Oxford Regional as the third seed to advance to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. BC finished the season in the Top 25 of all four major polls for the first time in program history (15th – D1Baseball, 16th – Baseball America, NCBWA and 21st – USA Today/Coaches Poll).

For his efforts, Gambino was named the 2016 American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year, a finalist for D1Baseball Coach of the Year and earned a spot on the website's top-10 coaching performances of the season.

Gambino proteges were selected in the first round of the MLB Draft in back-to-back years for the first time in program history in 2015 and 2016. Chris Shaw was selected 31st overall by the San Francisco Giants in 2015 and Justin Dunn was taken 19th overall by the New York Mets in 2016. Overall, five players were drafted in 2016: Dunn, Michael King (12th round), Jesse Adams (14th round), Nick Sciortino (19th round) and Joe Cronin (34th round).

Gambino was an assistant coach for four seasons at Virginia Tech prior to his move to Boston College. He served as the Hokies' recruiting coordinator and worked with the hitters and infielders. In his four years, he saw 15 players get drafted in the MLB Draft, including nine in 2010.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny and Callahan.
