### BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Saturday's Big Ten action features a quartet of games with #13/16 Maryland facing Illinois in Big Ten Super Saturday at Madison Square Garden at noon on BTN. Also at noon, Nebraska hosts Ohio State on FS1. At 2:15 p.m., Wisconsin welcomes Northwestern on BTN followed by Rutgers at Penn State at 4:30 p.m., also on BTN.
- Of 58 conference games played thus far, 53.4 percent (31 games) of the match-ups have been decided by 10 points or fewer including 10 games separated by one possession including Michigan's buzzer-beater win over Minnesota Tuesday night.
- Home teams are winning 61.4 percent of Big Ten conference games, with a record of 35-22.
- Big Ten programs are playing a 20-game conference schedule for the first time this season. Each team will play seven opponents both home and away and six teams once. The 2019 Big Ten Tournament will be held from March 13-17 at the United Center in Chicago for the 10th time in conference history, equaling the number of events also held in Indianapolis.
- Non-conference play wrapped up for Big Ten schools as the conference's 14 programs compiled a 121-30 overall record in non-conference games for a 79.1 win percentage. The Big Ten totaled 33 wins against power conference opponents.
- Four different Big Ten programs are ranked in the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches polls this week. Overall, eight Big Ten programs are ranked or receiving votes in a poll this week: Michigan (No. 5 AP/No. 6 USAT), Michigan State (No. 6/5), Maryland (No. 13/16) and Iowa (No. 19/21). Nebraska, Ohio State, Purdue and Wisconsin are among others receiving votes.
- For a seven-week span from Nov. 19-Dec. 31, at least six Big Ten programs were ranked in each poll. A season-best eight Big Ten teams were ranked in the Dec. 3 USA Today/Coaches Poll. Seven teams were ranked in the AP Poll in four different weeks (most recently Dec. 31), the most for the Big Ten since the 1998-99 season.
- Michigan State (18-2, 9-0) has won 13 games in row overall and 21 consecutive Big Ten games dating to last season. The 21-game conference win streak is the longest in the nation and longest in MSU history. The Spartans rank in the Top 10 nationally in several categories: assists per game (20.4/first), rebound margin (+11.8/second), field goal percentage defense (36.7/third), rebounds per game (40.4/third), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.53/fifth), scoring margin (+17.7/fifth) and blocks per game (5.6/ninth). Junior guard Cassius Winston earned his third Big Ten Player of the Week Honor on Monday after a career-high 29 points at Nebraska last week. He is fourth nationally with a Big Ten-best 7.3 assists per game.
- Michigan (19-1, 8-1) began the season with their best start in program history, surpassing 16-0 starts in 2012-13 and 1985-86. It was the best start to a season for a Big Ten program since Ohio State started the 2010-11 season at 24-0. The Wolverines lead the Big Ten and rank third in the nation in scoring defense, allowing 56.5 points per game.
- Maryland (16-4, 7-2) saw its seven-game win streak end Monday at Michigan State. The Terps are sixth in the nation in rebounding margin (+9.8). Bruno Fernando is fourth in the nation in field goal percentage (67.5%) and has 11 double-doubles.
- Purdue (13-6, 6-2) is led by junior Carsen Edwards, who is fourth in the nation in scoring, with a Big Ten-best 24.7 ppg. Edwards has four 30-point games this season, tied for most 30-point games in the nation this season. The Boilermakers have won four games in a row and seven of their last eight games. They are 9-0 at home this year.
- Wisconsin (13-6, 5-3) is led by senior Ethan Happ, who has 11 double-doubles. Happ is the only individual in the Big Ten to rank among the Top 3 in scoring (19.2 ppg/third), rebounding (10.3/second) and assists (4.8/second). Happ, a four-time Big Ten Player of the Week this year, stands ninth in career rebounds in Big Ten history with 1,070 (fifth on NCAA active list).
- Iowa (16-4, 5-4) posted an 11-0 mark in non-conference play including winning the championship of the 2K Classic at Madison Square Garden. Iowa has won 10 of its last 12 games. Freshman Joe Wieskamp was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week on Monday after averaging 17 ppg in two Hawkeye wins last week. He tied an Iowa record going 6-6 on 3-pointers.
- Minnesota (14-5, 4-4) senior Jordan Murphy is second in the nation in rebounds per game with a Big Ten-best 12.1 rpg. Murphy is the second-leading active rebounder in the NCAA with 1,139. His total ranks third all-time in Big Ten history behind Ohio State's Jerry Lucas (1,411) and Purdue's Joe Barry Carroll (1,148).
