- ORU and Penn State will face off Friday in the first ever meeting between the two teams. The Golden Eagles are 3-11 all-time against the Big 10, having played seven of the 14 current members of the league. ORU's wins have come against Nebraska and Wisconsin
- The Golden Eagles have plenty to look forward to in 2017-18 with senior center Albert Owens being picked as a preseason first team All-Summit League selection while sophomore forward Emmanuel Nzekwesi earned preseason second team honors.  $\dot{\text{Additionally}}$ , Blue Ribbon Sports tabbed sophomore guard **Sam Kearns** as The Summit League's Preseason Newcomer of the Year.
- It is a new look for ORU this season. In addition to new Head Coach Paul Mills, who will bring a new look on both offense and defense, ORU has nine newcomers, including a trio of redshirts from last year. ORU also has a new logo and home court design that were both released just before the start of the season.
- In the 98th game of his career, Albert Owens reached the 1,000 point mark, tying him with Luke Spencer-Gardner as the 28th fastest to reach the mark. Owens was the 34th player in ORU history to reach the 1,000 point mark.



**MALIBU, Calif.** – The Oral Roberts men's basketball team fell 80-76 Tuesday night to host Pepperdine as the Waves' offense caught fire at the end of the game to erase an ORU lead in the final game of the 2017 Progressive Legends Classic.

Pepperdine hit five of their final six shots in the contest after coming back to tie the game.

All five ORU starters scored in double figures for ORU, led by Emmanuel Nzekwesi's 17 points and seven rebounds. Nzekwesi also added five assists and three blocks.

Pepperdine got 21 points from Colbey Ross, who was 7-10 from the field in the game and also dished out six assists. Trae Berhow grabbed a game-high eight rebounds.

#### **Turning Point**

With the game tied 70-70 with 4:17 to play after a pair of Kearns free throws, Pepperdine scored the next four points to leave ORU playing catch up for the rest of the game.

#### **Quote of the Game**

"Obviously in the first half our offense looked a whole lot better than in the second half, but that is too many 3-pointers, especially in a back-to-back game, knowing that you are going to be tired. We knew we had to play inside out and Albert did a good job but unfortunately it didn't go our way." – ORU Head Coach Paul Mills


#### **Individual Leaders**

- Pepperdine connected on 53 percent (27-51) from the field including a 61 percent (16-26) clip in the second half.
- Both teams were over 70 percent from the free throw line, with Pepperdine getting to the charity stripe nine times more than ORU.
- Pepperdine led the rebounding battle d32-27, but ORU had a 15-12 advantage in second chance points.

#### **News and Notes**

- The 58.3 percent shot by the Golden Eagles in the first half on Tuesday was the highest shooting percentage for a half this season, topping the 53 percent in the second half against Tulsa.
- White hit the first 3-pointer of his career at the end of the first half with the shot clock winding down to give ORU the 40-33 halftime advantage.
- Nzekwesi's performances earned him Malibu Subregional All-Tournament honors.
- Tuesday marked the 100th game of senior Albert Owens' ORU career.

#### **HOME SWEET HOME**

Since the start of the 2004-05 season, ORU is 133-35 (.791) at home and an amazing 90-21 (.810) in conference play in that time. During that stretch, the Golden Eagles have at least 10 wins in eight of the 12 years, including a 15-0 regular season mark in 2011-12.

#### **ABOUT THE SUMMIT LEAGUE**

In its fourth decade of Division I athletics, The Summit League offers 19 championship sports and has a combined enrollment of over 120,000 at nine institutions, including four located in top

60 U.S. metro populations and two land-grant universities. Member institutions include: Denver (University of Denver), Fort Wayne (Indiana University-Purdue University-Fort Wayne), IUPUI (Indiana University-Purdue University-Indianapolis), North Dakota State University, Omaha (University of Nebraska Omaha), Oral Roberts University, the University of South Dakota, South Dakota State University and Western Illinois University. Previously known as the Mid-Continent Conference, The Summit League rebranded in 2007 and has since produced eight NCAA Champions, and over 75 Academic All-Americans, 65 All-America selections and numerous former student-athletes competing at the highest professional level.

Since its inception in 1982, The Summit League recorded several transcendent moments that resonate on the national stage. While known as the Mid-Continent Conference, the league's first two decades produced a pair of appearances in the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament's "Sweet 16" and the Women's College World Series as well as three individual NCAA Track and Field Champions.
