#### TONIGHT'S GAME

• The Nittany Lions will return to action for the first time in more than two weeks when they host top-ranked Minnesota for a Sunday-Monday series at Pegula Ice Arena. Opening faceoff for both games is at 7 p.m., with the Monday night matchup airing live on BTN.

#### HEADING HOME TO HOCKEY VALLEY

• Penn State will play the Golden Gophers in its first Big Ten home series Jan. 12-13. The Nittany Lions, who opened conference play at Wisconsin Dec. 6-7, are 0-2-0-0 (W-L-T-SOW) in league competition.

• The Nittany Lions (2-4-1 at Pegula Ice Arena) will return home for the first time in 41 days since a two-game series against Union Nov. 30-Dec. 1.

#### BACK TO THE BIG TEN

• Penn State will open 2014 with its first of nine Big Ten series. The Nittany Lions will play 19 regular-season games, including 18 league contests, during the second half of the season. Penn State's lone non-conference games is a rematch against Boston College Jan. 25.

#### ANOTHER RANKED OPPONENT

• This weekend's series will mark the eighth and ninth games against a ranked opponent in a 10-game span. The stretch will include three games (No. 7/6 Boston College, two games vs. No. 1 Minnesota) against top-10 foes. The Nittany Lions' lone win against a ranked team came in a 3-2 OT win at No. 16 Wisconsin during the 2012-13 season (Feb. 25, 2013).

## GARDINER FACES OLD TEAM

- Redshirt junior forward **Max Gardiner** was a member of the Golden Gophers during the 2010-11 season.
- The Deephaven, Minn., native recorded three points (1g, 2a) in 17 games during his freshman campaign.
- Only four Gophers - Nate Condon, Justin Holl, Jake Parenteau, Tom Serratore - remain from the 2010-11 Minnesota squad.

## PLAYING THEM TIGHT

- The Nittany Lions have played in seven one-goal games (3-4-0) in 2013-14, tying for seventh among NCAA Division I teams.
- Clarkson and Michigan Tech lead the nation with 12 one-goal games.

## SCHEID SURGING

- Redshirt sophomore forward **Eric Scheid** has recorded nine points (5g, 4a) in the past seven games and is tied for seventh in the Big Ten in points during that span.
- The Blaine, Minn., native has recorded two three-game point-scoring streaks since Nov. 15.
- Since Nov. 15, Scheid's three power-play goals are tops in the Big Ten, while his five power-play points place him a tie for first.

## YOUTH MOVEMENT

- Penn State underclassmen have accounted for nearly 74 percent of the team's offense.
- The Nittany Lions' top four scorers are either freshmen or sophomores, with redshirt sophomore **Eric Scheid** leading the way with 13 points (8g, 5a).
- Freshman **David Goodwin** and sophomore **Luke Juha** are tied for second on the team with four goals and five assists each, while newcomer **Ricky DeRosa** ranks fourth with eight points (3g, 5a).

## JOINING THE FUN

- At least 20 players on the 26-man roster have notched at least one point during the 2013-14 season.

## SCOUTING MINNESOTA

- The Golden Gophers will enter the weekend as the nation's top-ranked team for the 11th straight week.
- Minnesota boasts the conference's best scoring offense (3.94) and scoring defense (2.11).
- Nine Gophers have recorded at least 10 points, with Sam Warning pacing the squad with 21 points.
- Minnesota enters Sunday on a six-game unbeaten streak (4-0-2) and has not lost since a 6-2 setback against Minnesota Duluth Nov. 24.
- The Gophers have outscored their foes, 20-12, during the span.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Sophomore forward **Casey Bailey** gave the Nittany Lions a 1-0 lead but Boston College scored eight straight in an 8-2 setback in the Three Rivers Classic championship game.

- Freshman **David Goodwin** also scored for Penn State, while junior defenseman **Nate Jensen** was named to the All-Tournament Team.

### PEPPERING THE NET

- Penn State's 27 second-period shots against Robert Morris Dec. 27 were the most attempts in a period in program history.

- The team's 62 total shots ranked second, trailing the 63 attempts against AIC in the Nittany Lions' first NCAA game Oct. 12, 2012.

### SACRIFICING THE BODY

- Junior defenseman **Patrick Koudys** leads the Big Ten with 34 blocked shots. The Smithville, Ont., native averages 2.27 blocks per game.

### JUHA AMONG NATION'S BEST

- Sophomore **Luke Juha** is tied for second among NCAA blueliners with four power-play goals. The Nittany Lions are 2-2-0 when he scores a goal.

### THE DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

- The Nittany Lions boast the nation's 13th-ranked and Big Ten's best power play, converting on 13-of-60 chances (.217).

- Penn State has scored at least one power-play marker in five of the last seven games.

- In 2012-13, the Nittany Lions scored 12 power-play tallies in 27 games and ranked 59th in the country in efficiency.

### LIONS AMONG BIG LEADERS

- Forward **Eric Scheid** is tied for sixth among Big Ten skaters with eight goals and is tied for 11th with six power-play points.

- Defenseman **Luke Juha** is tied for first among defensemen in power-play points (7) and is tied for second among all skaters in PPGs (4).

### FRESHMEN MAKING IMPACT

- **David Goodwin** (4-5--9) and **Ricky DeRosa** (3-5--8) are tied for seventh and 10th, respectively, among Big Ten rookies in points.

## CAREER YEARS

• Forwards **Tommy Olczyk** and **Eric Scheid** are boasting career years as Penn State moves toward the season's halfway point.

• Olczyk, who recorded four points in 26 games last season, already has seven points (4g, 3a). The Long Grove, Ill., notched his career-high fourth goal against Robert Morris Dec. 27.

• An Alaska Anchorage transfer, Scheid's eight goals are a career best and his 13 points are two away from his season total in 2011-12.

## LIONS PLAY FIRST B1G SERIES

• Penn State dropped both of its games to then-No. 17 Wisconsin in its first Big Ten series, falling 7-1 Friday, Dec. 6 before dropping a 4-3 game Dec. 7.

• In the finale, freshmen **Ricky DeRosa** (1g, 1a) and **Zach Saar** (1g, 1a) notched their first multi-point games.

• The Nittany Lions, who took a 1-0 following **Eric Scheid's** marker, twice erased one-goal deficits before allowing the game-winning goal with 8:08 left in the third.

## THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• In league action, each Big Ten team will play 20 league games, including 10 home contests.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a shootout win and one point for a shootout loss.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only BCS conference to sponsor men's hockey.

• The league tournament will take place at Saint Paul's Xcel Energy

Center March 20-22 with the tournament champion earning the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

## SHORTHANDED STRENGTH

• **David Glen's** shorthanded marker against Union Dec. 1 gave the Nittany Lions three on the season - matching the team's 2012-13 total.

## BACK OF THE NET

• With seven goals against Union Nov. 30-Dec. 1, Penn State scored its most goals in a series since netting eight markers against Alabama Huntsville Feb. 8-9, 2013.

## McADAM SETS CAREER HIGH

• Freshman **Eamon McAdam** set a career high with 41 saves against UMass Lowell Nov. 15.

• After allowing a pair of first-period goals, McAdam stopped all 31 shots he faced during the final two periods.

## RICHARD LIGHTS THE LAMP

• Freshman **Dylan Richard** netted his first career goal in Penn State's 3-3 tie against RIT Oct. 25.

## LIONS EARN FIRST DRAW

• Penn State skated to its first tie in the NCAA era with a 3-3 draw against RIT Oct. 25.

## DeROSA MAKES IMPACT

• Freshman forward **Ricky DeRosa** tallied a goal in his first career game when he scored with 2:46 left in the third period in PSU's 3-1 loss to Air Force Oct. 19.

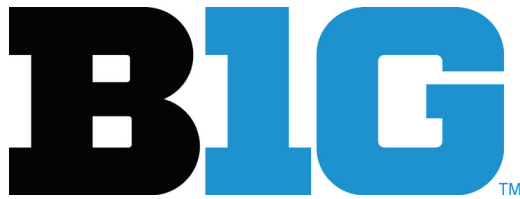

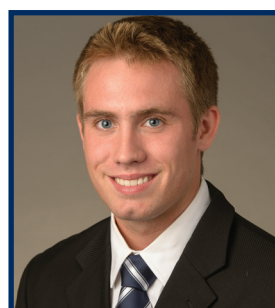
